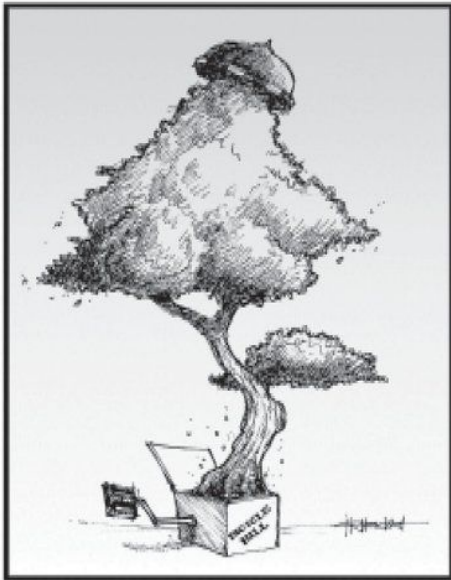

workshop because more new HIV cases are being reported among youths between age 12-24 years old. "We need to empower our students and give them the proper and accurate information on the basis of HIV/AIDS for them to avoid acquiring the virus."

"We need to train them, increase their knowledge and encourage behavior change for them to become an effective messenger among their peers for preventing HIV and other sexually transmitted infections (STIs) in the school and the community," Dr. Marquez stated in his message before a crowd of 161 students including teachers and guidance counsellors.

# Editorial

## SA IKAAPAT NA SONA NI DUTERTE PAGTAAS NG SAHOD NG MGA GURO KASAMA NA SA BUDGET

**S**A ikaapat na State of the Nation Address o SONA ni Pangulong Rodrigo Roa Duterte maraming Pilipino ang natuwa dahil sa kanyang accomplishments. Malinaw na binanggit ng Pangulo sa kanyang pahayag na kahit kakaunti ang kanyang accomplishments ay marami pa rin ang natuwa sa pagbabagong nangyari, gaya ng planong pagtataas ng sahod

Dr. Marquez disclosed that Bacoor City in Cavite registers with the highest cases of HIV/AIDS in the region with 726 followed by Dasmariñas with 686 and Imus City - 616, from 1984 to April 2019.

He also noted that all new confirmed cases last April are from the 15-24 age group.

The HIV/AIDS Registry of the Philippines (HARP), recorded a total of 9,926 HIV/AIDS cases in the region from 1984 to April 2019. Provinces with the greatest number of cases is Cavite with 3,555 followed by Rizal with 2,667 and Laguna with 2,032. Batangas recorded a total of 1,141 and Quezon with 531 cases.

Most affected age group is 25-34 years old with 5,187 cases reported followed by 15-24-year-old with 2,673 cases and 35-49 years old with 1,773 cases.

Dr. Mary Grace E. Javier, Medical Officer III of DepEd Bacoor City said that the activity is part of the "Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education" (OK sa DepED) which is a convergence of health programs and activities aim to provide students with health education and services to allow them to attain their full educational potential.

"The objective is to educate the youth and hear-out their concerns on age-appropriate issues particularly adolescent reproductive health and also ensure wellness of DepEd personnel through the provision of basic medical care for better productivity," she emphasized.

"Peer education training programs are effective ways to deliver risk reduction information because of the trust and confidence. youths rely on their peers for information and they prefer to receive info on most subjects, including sensitive issues such as reproductive health and human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)," she remarked.

The peer educator's training activity also included lectures on the National Drug Education Program. It was attended by 23 schools represented by 5 students

## FREE HEALTHCARE ASSISTANCE FOR IMUSEÑOS



THE medical and dental mission team of the provincial government of Cavite spearheaded by the OPG-Extension in partnership with the Provincial Health Office continuously visits barangays in the entire province to check the health status and address the medical needs of Caviteños. Last July 19, 2019, the mission team visited Brgy. Alapan 2A, City of Imus and catered to almost 400 patients who benefitted from the services rendered by doctors and dentists from PHO and its satellite hospitals with the assistance of barangay doctor, nurses and health workers. Medical services offered were adult/pedia consultation, chest x-ray, eye and dental check-up, and tooth extraction. Free eyeglasses, vitamins and medicines for common ailments were also provided. Captain Mark Albert Barzaga who expressed his gratefulness to the provincial government for always extending quality healthcare services to the community. —PICAD



## La Noceda Food Products Inc.

**KNOWN** for their jacobina, Noceda Bakery is currently managed by Nelson Noceda. It is a simple family owned business which started in 1947 out of his grandfather's passion in baking.



To further improve the quality of their products and sustain the market demand, Nelson decided to look for their family's original baker to bring back the original taste and look of the biscuit. It was in the year 2008 when the bakery hit the peak of their business by asking the DOST Bicutan to improve their packaging and labelling.

Aside from the packaging and labelling assistance, the DOST-CALABARZON thru the SETUP program provided equipment such as mechanical slicer, oven, and stainless tables to increase their production capacity. "SETUP program helped us modernize our workplace. It allowed us to replace our work tables with stainless steel tables which promoted hygiene and durability," Noceda shared. From their usual production of 84,000 packs of jacobina biscuits per month, it levelled up to 107,712 packs monthly! They have been distributing their products to major supermarkets in the country. Nelson said that there was a time where they've run out of stocks due to the high demand. Since then, they doubled their production and was able to employ 31 staff. The firm grew from a sole proprietorship enterprise to a family corporation, La Noceda Food Products Inc.

Training on good manufacturing practices and MPEX



program were also the other interventions provided by DOST-CALABARZON. Moreover, shelf life testing and nutritional analysis was conducted on their products to ensure its good quality. Such assistance brought a 62.29% increase in their sales enabling them to move in a 1.5 hectare factory from a small production facility in their old house.

Aside from jacobina, La Noceda Bakery also offers other pastries such as pandesal, loaf, biscuits, cassava cake, and egg pie.

## Cocoplus Aquarian Development Corp.

**COCOPLUS** Aquarian Development Corp. started producing virgin coconut oil using natural fermentation method back in 2005. As years go by, there is an increasing demand of buyer in Japan which the firm cannot meet due to their manual process.



It was in 2014 when Josefina Savares, president of the firm, was introduced to the SETUP program. "We experienced total transformation [in] the way we manufacture our products [as] automation began in our operations", said Josefina. She was able to acquire coco sheller bin, de-shelling machine, hammer mill, grated screw hopper, coco milk extractor, holding tank for coco milk and VCO, elevated holding tank, and centrifuge which automated the process. Aside from the equipment upgrading, consultancy was also given to them leading to more than 300% increase in their production capacity and creation of additional jobs.

Josefina highlighted that the most significant contribution of SETUP to them is that they were able to minimize their waste from the production process. One example is the development of skimmed coconut milk where the waste materials turned into an innovative product. This product has been selected by SIAL Innovation Independent Jury during the 2018 Canada Palais de Congress in Montreal, Canada. The firm also won the Most Innovative Product during the Kalakal Calabarzon Awards in 2017.

## CAVITE ENTREPRENEURS THANK DTI, BPI & PTTC FOR SME ROVING ACADEMY
