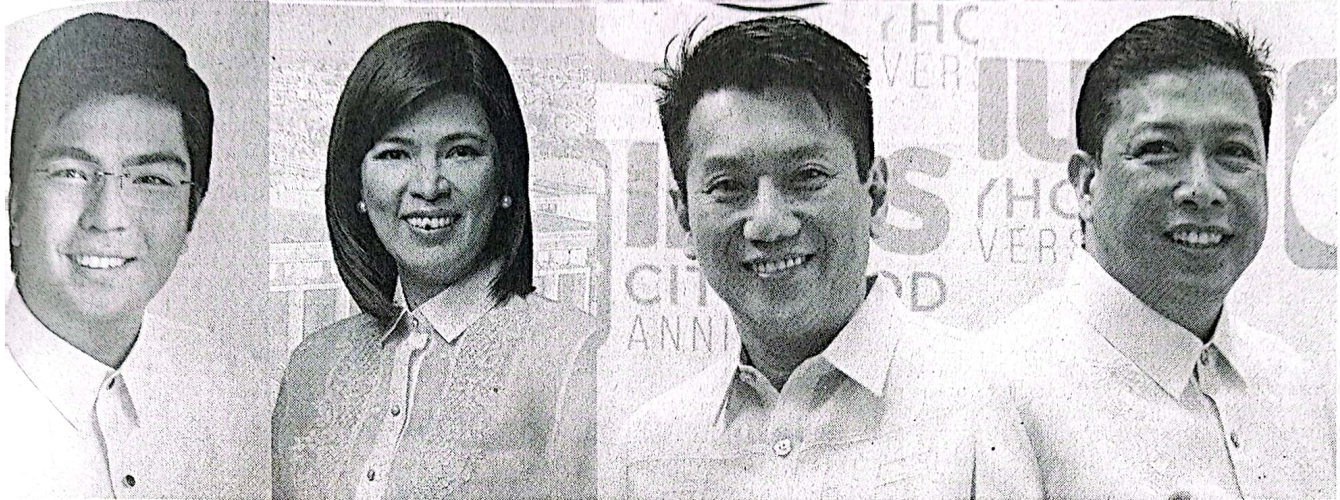

CLEAR national roads of traffic obstructions within 60 days and if the mayor failed to do this, he will face sanctions or suspension.

This is the content of a memorandum issued by Interior and Local Government Secretary Eduardo Año giving mayors across the country to clear national roads of traffic obstructions in compliance to the directive of President Rodrigo Roa Duterte in his 4th SONA speech recently.

This developed as the Cavite Mayors League leadership called on its members to discuss possible solutions to the perennial traffic problem of the province.

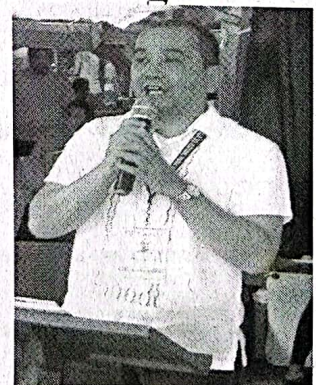

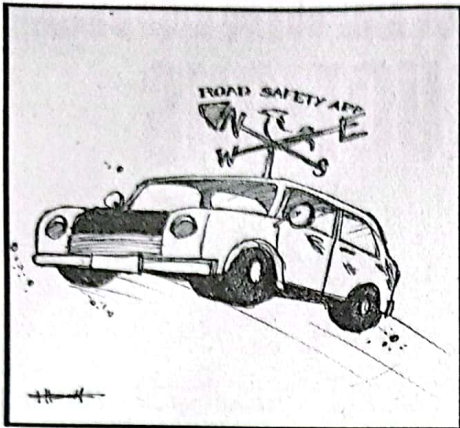

MAY 21,000 na lotto outlets na pinasara ng PNP sa utos ni Pangulong Duterte, ito ay dahil sa malawakang korapsyon na nagkukubli sa nasabing ahensya. Sa biglaang pagsara ng PCSO kasabay namang nanamlay ang halos 30,000 na mga nawalan ng trabaho dahil sa kakagawan ng mga buwitre.

Marahil hindi na naisip ng mga buwitrang ito kung ano ang magiging kahihinatnan kapag ang modus nila ay nabuking. Pero ang higit na apektado sa lahat ay ang mga empleyado ng

lotto outlets na nawalan ng trabaho, na muli sila magsisimula?

Salceda: Aangat ang Pinas sa 'Global Innovation Index'

TINATAYA ni Albay Rep. Joey Salceda ang patuloy at lalong bibilis ang pag-aangat ng Pilipino 'Global Innovation Index' (GII) bunga ng mga pagsusumikap ng Department of Science and Technology (DOST) at mga suportang batas mula sa Kongreso.

Pinuri ng mambabatas ang DOST sa pag-aangat ng Pilipinas sa ika-73 ranggo ng GII ngayong taon mula sa pang-54 noong 2018 sa pangkalahatang 179 bansang kasali.

Kamakailan Inilathala ang bagong GII ng Cornell University graduate business school INSEAD at ng World Property Organization, kung saan tumalon ng 19 na antas ang Pilipinas at umiskor ito ng pangkalahatang 36.18 ngayong taon mula 31.56 noong 2018.

Sa pamantayan ng United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), dapat mayroon man lang ng 380 'researchers, scientists and engineers' (RSE) ang nagsisimulang lumagong mga bansa kada milyong mamamayan, at ang gastos nito para sa

'research and development' ay dapat isang porsiyento (1%) man lang ng Gross Domestic Products (GDP).

Ayon sa ulat ng DOST, lumalaki diuman ang porsiyento na naturang gastos ng bansa sa ilalim ng RA 11035 na umakit ng 14 na 'Balik Scientists' sa unang dalawang buwan ngayong taon na maaaring sa 70-80 bago matapos ang 2016 na mahigit sa 60 nilang target.

Ang mga 'Balik Scientists' ay mga ekspertong Pinoy RSE na nagtatrabaho at nakatira sa ibang bansa. Sila'y kinukontra ng pamahalaan na bumalik sa bansa at ibahagi at ibuhos ang kanilang mga kaalaman sa mga larangan ng kalusugan, agrikultura, mga yamang dagat at ilog, enerhiya at mga lumilitaw na bagong

teknolohiya.

Bukod sa 'Balik Scientist' at 'SC Change Program (S4CP)' na nagpalaguin ang maka-sensiyang pagkakatibay, at pananaliksik ka pagpapasulong ng lipunan, inakda din ang iba-ibang panukalang batas sa teknolohiya. Kasama rito ang Philippine Space Agency na naghi- lamang na mabigyan ng kaukulang bilang nito. Kasama rin siyang may panukalang 'National Innovation Act'.

Kasama rin sa mga 'bills' ni Salceda ang 'Comprehensive Nuclear Regulation Act' (RA 8733) na magtatatag ng kumpleto ng 'nuclear regulatory policy framework' at lilikha sa Philippine Nuclear Regulatory Commission (PNRC).

of different city departments, especially the City Traffic Management Office (CITMO), the local office to make proposals on how to ease the heavy traffic in the city.

While, Cavite Vice Governor Jolo Revilla called on traffic management offices to strictly implement a coding system to lessen the congested national and provincial roads.

Senate, Sen. Sherwin Gatchalian is asking the President to certify as urgent the Proof-of-Parking Space bill, to ease traffic in the big city.

The President will certify the bill as urgent, very much aligned with his vision of alleviating the struggles of the commuting public."

After learned that the Lilac Center for Public Transporting the Chief Executive to consider building a Pasig River Viaduct Elevated Highway and Rapid System.

It, already endorsed by an accredited private firm, to the Department of Public Works and Highways, is touted to cut travel time from Pasig to just 30 minutes, and reduce traffic along the congested Epifanio de los Santos Avenue (EDSA) by 39 percent.

SONA, the President told all mayors to "reclaim roads that are being used for private ends."

In an interview, Bacoor City Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla said since before the May elections, the city has been implementing the Ordinance which aims to clear all city roads of traffic obstructions.

Revilla said the city government is conducting a survey of road network to identify which road is a problem of congestion.

Within the vicinity of the Bacoor City Public Market, it has been cleared of sidewalks and streets being used by illegal and ambulant vendors, Mercado-

Vice Mayor Ony Cantimban said that the Panlungsod has started reviewing traffic ordinances with provisions that allow on sidewalks—and amend them to prohibit, thus clearing the way for pedestrians.

Listening to the directives of the President under recent SONA, that is why Mayor Maliksi has orders to review the national roads, city and identified roads to serve as alternative cantimban said.

Maliksi said that he has received proposals to open spaces in cities into parking areas for who do not their own parking spaces.

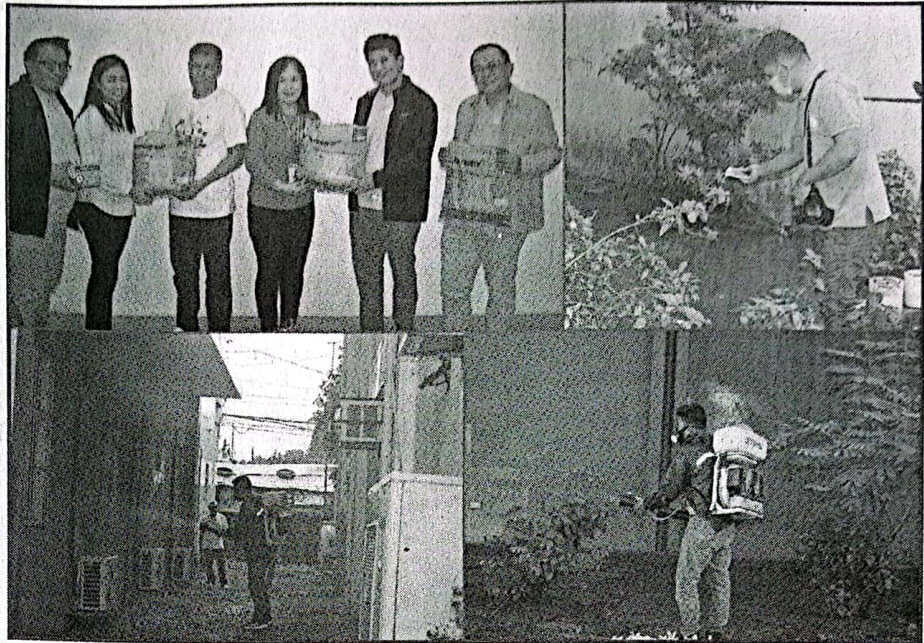

PETITION

COMES NOW the Petitioner, by counsel, and unto this Honorable

Court respectfully alleges: That,

THE PARTIES

1. Petitioner Joan Romela Abellar Erni is of legal age, Filipino, and with address at 009 San Jose St., Poblacion I, Tanza, Cavite;
 2. Respondent Marjhon Asas Erni is likewise of legal age, Filipino, and with known address at Block 11 Lot 35 Southville 2, Brgy. Inocencio, Bagong Pook, Trece Martires City, Cavite, where he may be served with summons and other processes of this Honorable Court;

THE RELEVANT FACTS
Pre-Marriage Facts

3. Petitioner first met respondent in 2007. Petitioner was at the wake of her father while respondent was guarding the neighboring wake of a co-army reservist. Petitioner was talking to another army reservist when respondent joined the conversation. Respondent asked for petitioner's cellphone number upon knowing that petitioner works for COMELEC.

4. Respondent introduced himself to petitioner as being married by later on retraced and said he is living in with a woman;

5. Respondent started texting and calling petitioner, first about the COMELEC procedures but late the calls and text messages became personal;

6. Respondent told petitioner that he already left his live-in partner;
 7. They decided to get married on March 10, 2008 in Tanza, Cavite, after barely four months of courtship;

8. After the wedding, the parties stayed for a while with petitioner's mother in Tanza, Cavite but later they stayed in the house of respondent's cousin who lent them the house for free;

9. The parties had no trouble with their relationship at first;

10. Even if Petitioner, as a COMELEC officer, earns more than respondent, an army reservist and a security guard by profession, respondent gives his full salary to petitioner and is mindful of their household chores and expenses;

Post-Marriage Facts

11. Both petitioner and respondent were working and due to respondent's schedule as a security guard, he would go home every other night;

12. When respondent resigned his job, his drinking frequented, often inviting friends to their house;

13. There was even a time during their first year anniversary that respondent invited his friends and neighbors for a drinking celebration leaving petitioner aside.

14. During trips which are supposed to be the couple's vacation, respondent would stay in their hotel room and sleep or he would contact friends within the area so he could spend some time with them;

15. When respondent started working again, he would not go home after his shift even if his work is only a few kilometers away from their house, he also started keeping his salary to himself;

16. There were rumors going around that respondent is seeing another woman but petitioner would brush it aside;

17. In 2011, petitioner and respondent got into a big fight and respondent left home only to return after a week and demanding a separation from petitioner;

18. Respondent told petitioner he thought his life would improve if he would settle with an educated woman but said he was wrong;

19. Petitioner cried and begged for respondent to stay and for them to try to fix their marriage but respondent left anyway, taking with him the motorcycle and the gun which petitioner paid for;

20. Respondent would often be seen by his own family and friends with an 18 year old woman and petitioner found out that the affair has been going on for quite some time way before their separation;

21. Petitioner has not heard from respondent since then except for the times when petitioner would talk to family and friends telling her that respondent has been spreading lies about their separation stating that petitioner is an evil person and was the one who threw respondent out of their house;

22. Seeing that reconciliation is impossible, petitioner decided to file this annulment case;

23. It turned out that Joan Romela Abellar Erni and Marjhon Asas Erni are both psychologically incapacitated to fulfill their essential marital obligations;

24. The clinical psychologist who evaluated Joan revealed in his psychological evaluation report the following findings:

a. Joan Romela Abellar Erni represents behavioral patterns encumbered by the Personality Disorder Not Otherwise Specified with features of the Dependent and Obsessive Compulsive Personality Disorders;

b. Marjhon Asas Erni's evaluated based on details provided by Joan is encumbered by the Personality Disorder Not Otherwise Specified with features of the Historic and Antisocial Personality Disorders;

c. The high level of global and marital distress, which Joan and Marjhon experienced in their marriage, is precipitated by the accumulation of unresolved problems. They were unable to resolve in mutually satisfying ways their extensive conflicts about their time togetherness, communication, problem solving, sexual relationship and financial difficulties. This unresolved conflicts led to major crises in their relationship, which pre disposed feelings of anger and alienation, and strong predisposition for separation. Joan and Marjhon were not able to adapt to healthy and effective decision-making process. On Marjhon's side, he was lost in his personal affairs and deceitful behavior. Instead, Joan, hoped for a change in Marjhon's behavior but consequently perpetuated his abusive behavior.

25. Based on the above, the clinical psychologist concluded that Joan Romela Abellar Erni and Marjhon Asas Erni are psychologically incapacitated to satisfy the essential obligations of marriage because their personality disorder is incurable, permanent and with judicial antecedents and clinical root causes.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is respectfully prayed that, after due notice and hearing, an Order be issued DECLARING respondent to be psychologically incapacitated and unfit to fulfill his marital obligation and DECLARING the marriage between petitioner and respondent NULL and VOID.

Such other relief that are deemed just and equitable under the premises are likewise prayed for.

DOH TARGETS MUNICIPALITIES OF CAVITE FOR THE INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT IN HEALTH

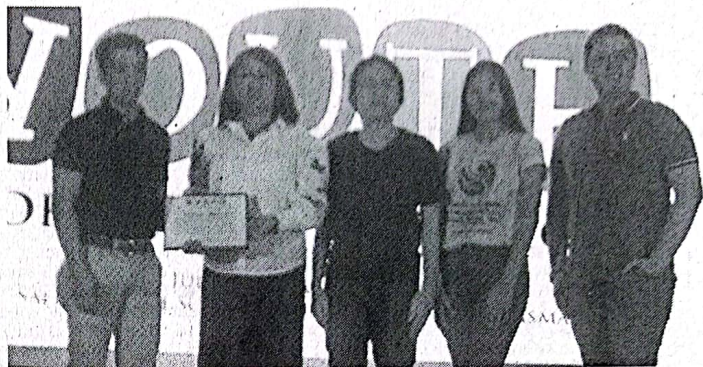
Nevertheless, she religiously pays her PhilHealth premium to provide peace of mind and security for her family's health. She never knew that this could come very handy in the future.

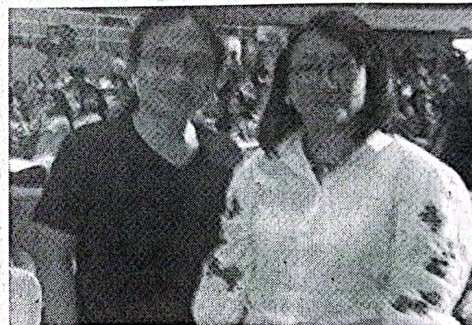

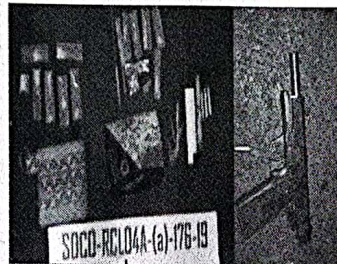

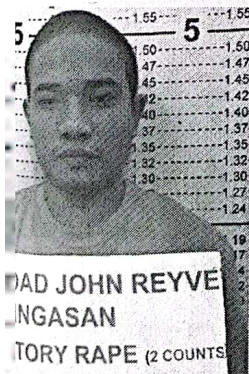
