This verified petition, dated 15 May 2017, filed by the petitioner, through councel, prays that after due notice, publication and hearing, judgment be rendered for the issuance of decree of adoption declaring the minor IANTHE RIZ S. PALMA as the legitimate child of

Considering that the adopters were the biological parents of the child, the DSWD of General Trias, Cavite was directed to conduct a case study on the biological child as well as the other child of the adoptive father and to submit to this Court a certification that the adopted child is not opposing the adoption and is in fact giving her permission to the adoption to be submitted in the Court within thirty (30) days from receipt. On 3 December 2018, the DSWD of General Trias, Cavite was directed again to conduct

a child case study report and a home study report of the prospective adopter as well as the report on the biological parents.

On 18 March 2019, the Court directed the DSWD of General Trias, Cavite to explain within

fifteen (15) days from notice why the required report was not submitted to the court. On 1 October 2019, the Department of Social Welfare and Development of General Trias Cavite submitted a favorable recommendation for this adoption case.



BISE PRESIDENTE BIGYAN NG TIYAK NA TUNGKULIN SA GABINETE

A AMERICA, may tiyak na tungkulin ang halal na bise-presidente – na ibinoboto kasama ng president. Sa US, kung ano ang bilang ng boto sa pangulo, iyon din ang matatanggap na boto ng pangalawang pangulo, na ayon sa kanilang Konstitusyon.

Batay rin sa Konstitusyon ng mga Kano, ang vice president ang magiging presiding officer ng Senado. Kaya kung ano ang tunguhing politikal ng Pangulo, ito ang magiging tungkulin at pananagutan ng Pangalawang Pangulo ng America. Hindi ganito sa Filipinas, kaya madalas na

nangyayari, magkaiba ng Partido politikal ang halal na Pangulo at Pangalawang Pangulo, tulad ngayon, magkaibang partido politika ang dalawang pinakamataas na opisyal ng bansa.

Kasalukuyan, sa ngayon, isa sa pangunahing kritiko sa administrasyon ni President Rodrigo Roa Duterte ay si Vice President Maria Leonor "Leni" Robredo na kamakailan, sinabi na dapat nang itigil ang 'war on illegal drugs ng pamahalaan. Sabi ng ating batas, kung mamatay o magkasakit at hindi na makaganap sa tungkulin, ang VP ang mauupo sa Malakanyang. O kung matanggal tulad ng nangyari kay Erap Estrada, ang naupong Pangulo ay ang Bise niyang si Gloria Macapagal Arroyo.

Kung kusang magbitiw sa tungkulin, ayon din sa batas, ang Bise ang papalit sa tungkulin, at sa kasaysayan ng bansa natin, wala pang Pangulo na kusang nagbitiw sa tungkulin. Bukod sa mga binanggit na, wala nang iba pang papel ang Bise

Presidente, ayon sa ating Konstitusyon. Dahil sa matinding kritisismo laban sa giyera sa bawal na gamot, inalok ni Duterte si VP Leni na ito na ang humawak sa tungkulin laban sa ilegal na gamot – na hindi naman tinanggap ni Robredo. Bakit nga naman anim na buwan lamang ibibigay ang kapangyarihan sa Bise, sabi ni Senador Kiko Pangilinan, na aniya'y kung seryoso si Duterte, ibigay ang tungkulin sa VP na pangunahan ang digmaan laban sa bawal na droga sa loob ng tatlong taon.
