BATAY sa ating Konstitusyon, pinaniniwalaan muna na walang kasalanan o inosente ang isang akusado, ito ay hanggang mapatunayan nagkasala nga, sa hatol ng hukuman.

Kaya naman, nakalulungkot na ang isang 'inosenteng akusado' na dapat ay binibigyan ng tratong makatao, ay nagkakasakit at minsan ay namamatay sa loob ng piitan.

Kamatayan ang naging 'parusa' sa kanila, kahit hindi pa nadidinig o dinidinig pa lamang ang kanilang kaso.

Ganito nga ang maaaring isipin sa pagkamatay ng tatlo pang detenido sa Bacoar City Detention Cell, at isa naman sa piitan ng Imus police station.

Namatay sila, ayon sa balita, noong Enero 2, dahil sa sakit.

May pito pang detenido, ayon sa report ng Cavite Provincial Police Office, bago ang nakaraang Pasko 2018.

Hindi na natin babangitin pa ang mga minalas na masawi sa loob ng piitan bilang pagrespeto sa kanila, at kanilang kapamilya.

Pagtuunan natin ng pansin ay ang kalagayan ng mga piitan sa mga munisipyo at mga lungsod sa ating

lalawigan at sa iba pang lugar ng bansa.

Bukod sa napakasikip ang piitan, wala pang maayos na tulugan, bentilasyon at simpleng ginhawa—tulad ng paggamit ng washroom, paliguan at oras sa pag-eheersisyo.

Wag nang banggitin pa na wala o kulang sa rasyon ng pagkain ang ilang piitan, at kung walang dalaw ang isang akusado — na inosente panga dahil wala lang hatol — ay nagkakasakit at namamatay.

Kung may detenido na may nakahahawang sakit, sa sikip at init sa selda, tiyak ang pagkahawa ng kapwa bilanggo.

Malungkot din ay ang kalagayang walang doktor na agad matatawag sa panahon ng emergency.

Kaya nga sa ulat ng CPPO, mula Setyembre 1 hanggang Disyembre 25, 2018, naiulat na 16 na detenido ang namatay sa piitan habang hinihintay ang pagdinig sa kanilang mga kaso.

Sa report din, pinakamarami sa mga bilanggo sa Dasmariñas City Jail ang namatay bunga ng pagkakasakit at iba pang dahilan.

Panahon na pagtuunan ng mga pamahalaang lokal, lalo na ng probinsiya na magtayo ng mga bagong detention facility na magbibigay ng maayos na kalagayan sa mga akusado, lalo na sa mga babaeng may kaso.

Kawawa ang mga akusado na biktima ng kahirapan o ng bintang ng mga may makapangyarihang kaaway na nakukulong at sa kamalasan ay namamatay sa loob — gayong sila naman pala ay walang kasalanan.

Panahon na nga para pagtuunan ng gobyerno ang mga bilanggo pagkat sila man ay may mga karapatan na dapat na ipagkaloob habang hindi pa sila nahahatulan.

Following the launch, PCBI also showcased the Coffee Technology Center — a 5-hectare property owned by Ms. Chit Juan where different varieties of coffee are grown and harvested along with other organic vegetables, in Brgy. Maymanga, and the Eco-Farm in Brgy. Banay-banay, both in the municipality of Amadeo. With another establishment in Cavite ready to cater to coffee industry players, transforming the coffee industry in the country as an engine of economic growth is at its right track.

The launching program and pre-celebration of the Pahimis Fest was also attended by the Department of Trade and Industry-IV A, Industry Development Chief Priscila Flores, OIC Regional Director Teresita Gonzaga and DTI-Cavite Provincial Director Noly Guevara, who expressed continued support to the Coffee Roadmap of the province. In Cavite, the agency had already reached out to LGUs, cooperatives, farmers and MSMEs venturing into coffee through projects like Shared Services Facilities (SSFs) and Bottom-up Budgeting (BUB) program which have contributed to increase productivity among its beneficiaries.

For perfectly brewed partnerships, LGU-Amadeo and PCBI gathered coffee farmers of Amadeo and other neighboring towns to a symposium on proper ways of

growing, harvesting and producing good quality coffee beans. With harvesting Keynote speakers during the seminar promoted the "Pick Red Campaign" as the harvesting technique that ensures good quality of coffee. It encourages hand picking of red ripe cherries/coffee berries as one of the proper ways to achieve excellent flavor quality.

One of the speakers who seemed to have caught the attention of farmers and made them realize the value of loving their own coffee and applying correct methods in growing coffee is Bea Belardo, manager of Café Belardo, supplier and roaster based in Amadeo. She continues to make a name in the coffee world with hopes of inspiring coffee farmers in their town and motivate the youth to find interest in farming.

Meanwhile, Amadeo Tourism Officer Jam Medina-Tibayan who welcomed guests on behalf of Mayor Conrado Viado, expressed appreciation to PCBI for the support, to the media for the promotions, and to the farmers for the cooperation during the Coffee Farmers Symposium.

Other guests in attendance to the coffee promotion event were Dr. Ruperto Sangalang who represented Cavite Governor Boying Remulla, Amadeo Vice Mayor Junnel Bayot and members of the Sangguniang Bayan, who delivered messages of commitment in providing projects to uphold sustainable growth for the coffee industry. FREE PARKING SA SENIORS, PWDs

MAY DAGDAG na namang benepisyo na kaloob ang pamahalaang lalawigan ng Cavite sa mga senior citizens (SCs) at persons with disabilities (PWDs), ayon sa ordinansang iniakda ni Dasmariñas Provincial Board Member Valeriano S. Encabo.

Ipinatutupad na sa buong probinsiya ang Provincial Ordinance No. 235 (Free Parking Ordinance for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs)) na nag-uutos sa mga may-ari ng mall at mga may-ari ng private parking facility na ilibre sa pagbabayad ang mga SCs at PWDs.

Upang makalibre sa parking fees, dapat na ipakita ng isang SCs o PWDs ang kanilang identification (ID) card kung sila ay drayber o pasahero ng pribadong sasakyan bago pumasok sa parking area.

Gayunman, bawal sa malilibreng pribadong sasakyan ang overnight parking.

Ayon kay Provincial Board Secretary Ms. Michelle Alcidi, epektibo at ipinatutupad na ang Ordinansa na pinagtibay ng Sanggunian sa pamamatuubay ni Vice Gov. Jolo Revilla at matapos itong pirmahan ni Gov. Boying Remulla noong Disyembre 11, 2018.

Supply of antiretroviral drugs for HIV adequate: DOH

MANILA — The Department of Health (DOH) has assured there is enough treatment for Filipinos with Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) amid rumors of anti-retroviral (ARV) drug shortage nationwide.

In a statement released on Friday, the DOH said it seriously takes the HIV issue that is why the department makes sure appropriate testing and treatment are available and accessible to those who are diagnosed with HIV.

"As of October 2018, we have enrolled 32, 224 persons living with HIV (PLHIVs) for treatment with ARV drugs

such as Nevirapine, Lamivudine or Tenofovir," the DOH said, adding that it has been providing free ARV drugs to PLHIV through the HIV treatment hubs.

The DOH said there are 3,200 PLHIVs who are on Nevirapine and 1,791 PLHIV on Lamivudine or Tenofovir as of December 2018.

To meet the need for Nevirapine for February to April 2019, the DOH said their data confirms there is enough supply of the drug has been delivered on January 4.

A month's supply for Lamivudine or Tenofovir has also been delivered to Regions I (Ilocos Region), VI (Western Visayas) and XI (Davao Region).

"The rest of the regions will expect deliveries within the week. We are working very closely with our suppliers to ensure that there are no gaps in our supply chain," the DOH said.

The DOH is still waiting for the delivery of 12,375 bottles of Nevirapine, equivalent to three months' supply; and 7,024 bottles of Lamivudine or Tenofovir, which are enough for two months' use. (**PNA**)

IGNITING THE FIRE OF SENSITIVITY FOR THE CITIZENS OF IMUS

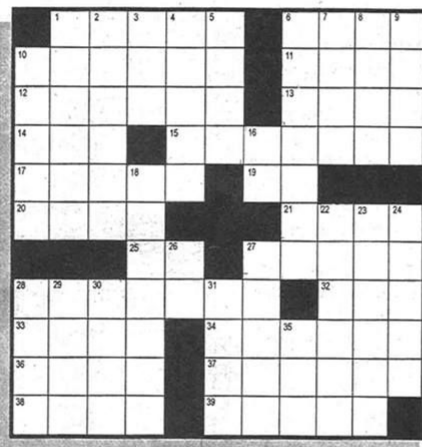
