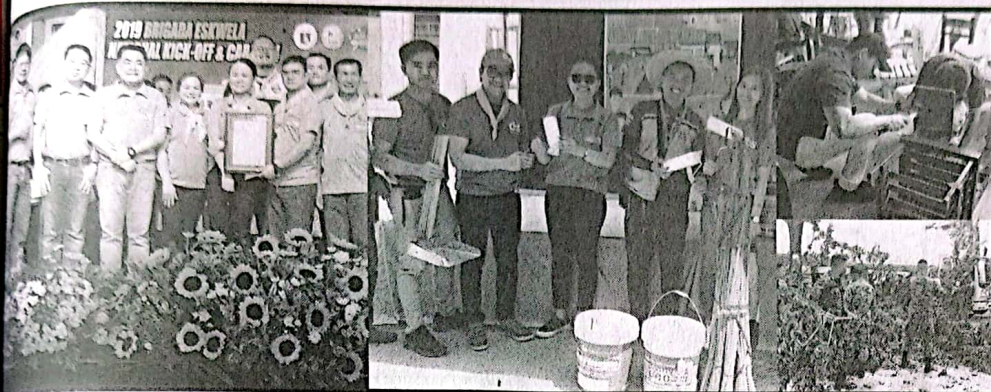


Cavite Province Hosts the 2019 Brigada Eskwela National Kick-Off and Caravan

PhilHealth reminds public facilities to register Point of Service patients promptly

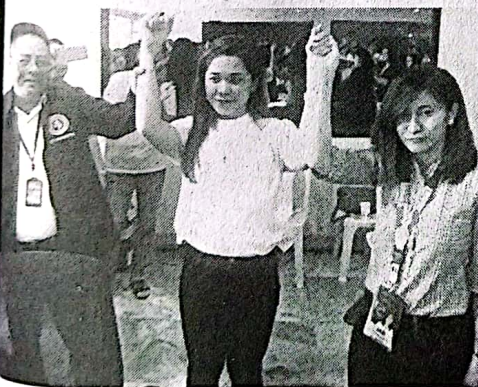

Trece Martires City Welcomes First Lady Mayor



TRUCE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite — Gemma Lubigan was officially proclaimed mayor-elect of this city on Wednesday by Commission on Elections (Comelec) officer, lawyer Jastine Marie dela Cruz.

Lubigan, who ran for mayor to continue the "unfinished business" of her slain husband, city vice mayor Alex Lubigan, is the first ever female to hold the city's top post.

"It's a challenge for me," Lubigan said on her new task, aware of the big expectations of city folks from her.

Lubigan and her partymates occupy the majority of local positions, including vice mayor Romeo Montehermoso and seven out of the 10 city councils.

Lubigan won by more than 6,000 votes against former city mayor Melencio de Sagun.

Trece Martires City has 92 clustered precincts, with 84,430 registered voters. Some 61,982 city residents came out to vote last Monday.

Boying' Remulla wins Congress seat for Cavite's 7th district

TRUCE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite — The provincial board of canvassers (PBOC) in Cavite officially proclaimed on Wednesday former Cavite Governor Jesus Crispin "Boying" Remulla as winner of the 7th district congressional race.

The proclamation at the Sangguniang Panlalawigan session hall here, was chaired by lawyer Arnulfo Pioquinto, with lawyer Gavino Mapano as vice-chair and Dr. Cherrylou Repia as member-secretary.

The proclamation was held after the canvassing of votes cast last Monday for the House of

Representatives member in 357 precincts of the 7th District of Cavite.

In the certificate of canvass of votes, Remulla obtained 128,674 votes over his rival Gengen Arayata, who garnered 61,031 votes.

The 7th district of Cavite covers this city, including the towns of Indang, Tanza, and Amadeo.

DOH PREPS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE IN CALABARZON

DOH - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) yesterday concluded the orientation of provincial, city and municipal health workers of Batangas and Quezon for the Universal Health Care – Advance Implementation Sites (UHC-AIS) and are now the preparing for the application of UHC health programs in these two provinces where both the public and private sector can work together towards the achievement of a successful and efficient health care delivery network.

The two provinces are included in the 33 Universal Health Care (UHC – Advance Implementation Sites (AIS) identified by the health department where UHC programs will be

supported and contracted by both DOH and PhilHealth to demonstrate various approaches and mechanisms to achieve technical, managerial, and financial integration as mandated by the UHC Law.

"We are preparing the foundation for the implementation of the universal health care sa local health system at dapat na nating makita kung paano ito patatakbuhan upang

because this is our chance to fix our health care system wherein dapat walang pasyenteng maliwanan, lahat ay dapat mabigyan ng sapat na pangangalaga sa kalusugan at the same

time walang matatakot at maglisip sa laki ng magagastos, dapat alam ng pasyente ang kanyang gagastusin at alam din nya kung saan sya pupunta kung sya ay magkasakit. These are the principles that we must include in the implementation of UHC upang lahat ng mga Pilipino ay maalagaan nating mabuti," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated during his presentation of the UHC plans for the two provinces during the UHC orientation held in Lucena, Quezon on last May 10, 2019.

"Ikakabit natin lahat ng ito sa buong health care system, kahit anong pangangailangan mong medikal dapat naka-access ka agad. Mamundok ka man o nasa kalye ka, dapat may sasalo sa iyo in times of medical emergency. Ito ang accessibility na nakapaloob sa tinatawag nating universal health care," he illustrated.

"Once these programs are in place, we will see improvements in clients experience. It will also provide more sustainable solutions, creativity and innovations, and eventually fill the gaps in the continuum of care," he emphasized.

"We will be addressing the inequities in health services, such as lack of manpower, health services and medicines. These will be resolved under the Universal Health Care Program through Primary Health Care."

According to Janairo, the 33 areas including Batangas and Quezon, was chosen because of the willingness and support of the local chief executives to participate in the program and also due to the high probability of success in these areas.

Janairo also presented strategies and approaches to attain the vision of UHC that will be people-centered based on actual and expressed needs of the people in the community, combined by implementing

comprehensive programs that problem-based including integration and identifying source in order to proper solution.

He added that lessons and experience generated from these will serve as the base for the development of national policies on integration of local systems in particular for Universal Health in general.

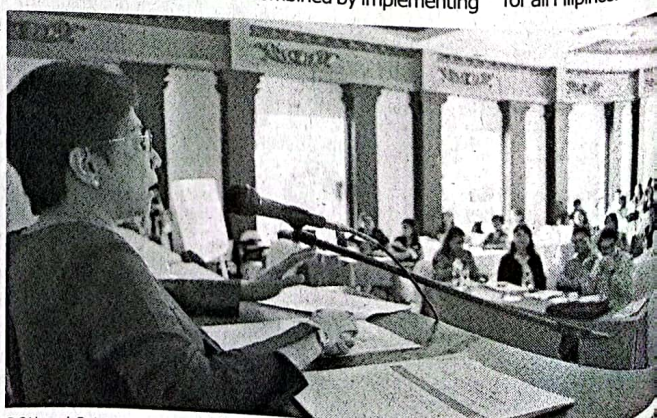

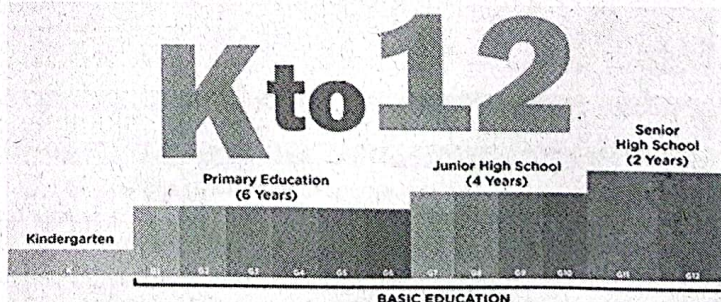
