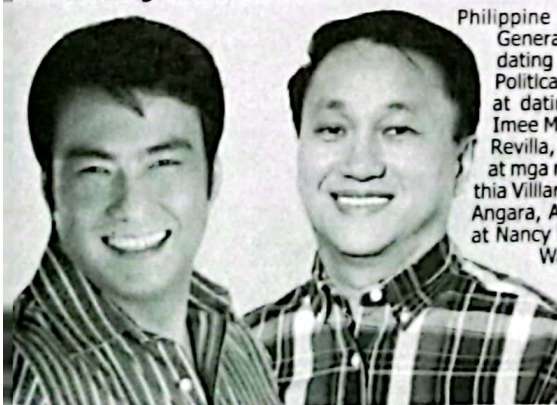

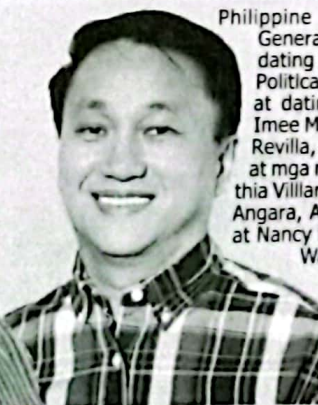

"China is willing to synergize its development plan with the Philippines, create cooperation highlights within the framework of the joint construction of the BRI (Belt and Road Initiative) and deepen the connectivity and development of China and the Philippines with other countries of the region," she said.

Zhou also noted that in November last year, the NRTA and the PCOO signed a memorandum of agreement on

Sino-Philippine Broadcasting and Television Cooperation.

"China is willing to continue to strengthen cooperation with the Philippines in the fields of news exchange, program production, technology R&D, industrial development and human resources construction, to achieve win-win and common development," she added.

Meanwhile, Liu Ying, vice president of NRTA's Research and Training Institute, said since the

diplomatic ties between China and the Philippines in June 1975, the two nations have put the concept "harmony" in working together to push for development.

"The workshop will build an extensive communication platform for media professionals in China and Philippines, actively promote the in-depth convergence and promote the common development of the industry of the two countries," she said.

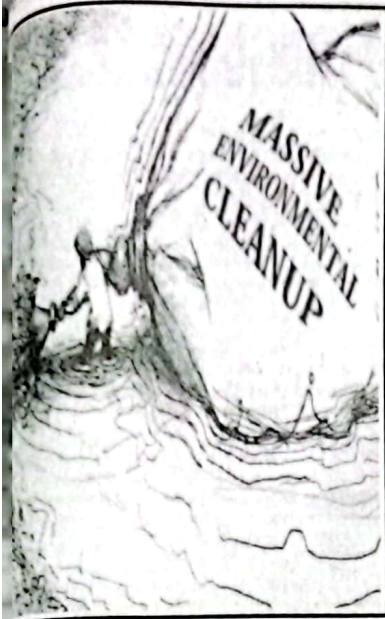

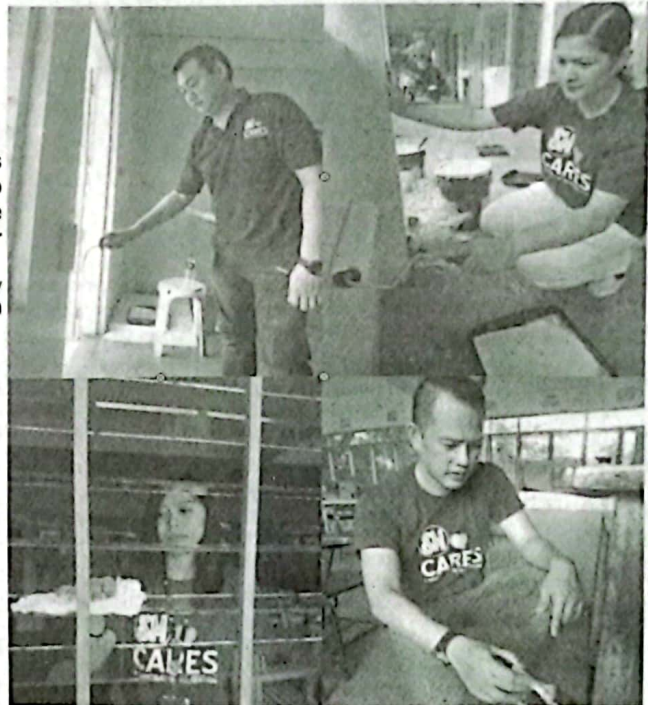

BREAKING COMMUNICATION BARRIERS THRU SIGN LANGUAGE TRAINING

DRIVEN by the aim to break the communication barrier particularly with the deaf, mute as well as visually-impaired members of society and formally address one major concern of persons with disabilities, the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (PSWDO) facilitated a Deaf Sensitivity and Conversational Sign Language Training on May 15-17, 2019 at PCLEDO Training Area, CaCoDec, Trece Martires City. The said training was attended by 30 PGC frontline personnel from different offices who usually cater to PWD clients.

Social Welfare Officer IV Ms. Darylvy R. Avila acknowledged all the participants and echoed the

importance of the training as it would help to easily reach out and understand the needs of the deaf and

mute through their language.

On behalf of Governor Boying C. Remulla, Sr., Cooperative Development Specialist Atty. Reyes delivered an inspirational message that the training would be a venue for initiatives in eliminating discrimination of PWDs.

The 3-day training aims to equip the frontliners with proper knowledge on how to communicate language to persons with hearing and visual impairments.

Meanwhile, Guidance Counselor of Philippine Federation for the Deaf Ms. Irish Casaljay, Resource Specialist elaborated the topic on Hearing Impairment, PWDs with Hearing Impairment in which she gave an overview about the types of hearing impairment, causes and symptoms of hearing impairment and deaf culture. Actual demonstration on proper sign language for alphabet, numbers, colors, places, pronouns, quantity and office terminology was done. She also trained the participants on how to tell time and days, and count.

The last part of the training was a blindfold exercise wherein participants experienced what it felt like in darkness relying only from the assistance and instructions of their partners. The activity was a revelation to the participants of the plight of the impaired and how significant the senses are.

In conclusion of the 3-day activity, participants expressed their full commitment to extend and continuously apply the learnings to be effective service providers to constituents.

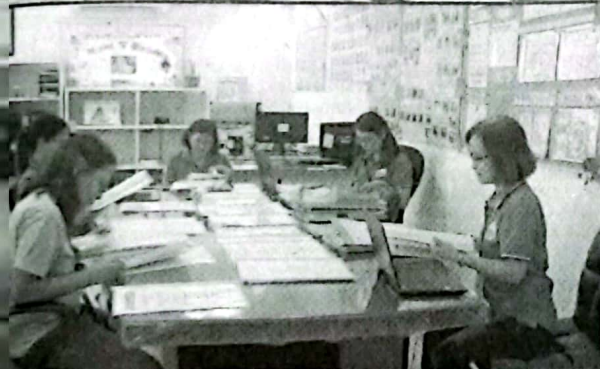

It is the updated monitoring and evaluation framework and the nutrition sector covering assessment of nationwide initiatives along legislation, nutrition service delivery, and capacity building. **MELLPI Pro** is the words **Protocol** that includes procedures and tools; **Promotive** since it raises awareness and observance to existing laws, rules and **Progressive** that scoring is based on desired progress of LGUs in terms of program implementation and **Professional** because it promotes an objective review of evidence using rubrics and spider web diagram. The tool was designed to evaluate and assess the performance of the City/ and local nutrition workers including Nutrition Action Officers.

PhilHealth's financial health is further bolstered by the Universal Health Care (UHC) Law which would raise premium contributions from PhilHealth members, national government subsidies, and shares from such government agencies like Philippine Amusement Gaming Corporation (Pagcor) and the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes (PCSO).

With these developments, Dr. Ferrer has rallied his PhilHealth "army" to be "very vigilant and aggressive" in bringing this anti-fraud campaign to a suitable conclusion: "Make fraud a thing of the past, and enable PhilHealth to focus on its mandate to help patients in confinement and in disease treatment." (END)

NBI, professional-hospital associations rally behind PhilHealth's drive

THE anti-fraud campaign launched by Dr. Roy Ferrer, acting president of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) is gaining momentum bolstered by the expressed support of investigative agencies, enforcers, professional groups and hospital associations.



The National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), Philippine Medical Association (PMA), Philippine Hospital Association (PHA), and the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) have thrown their support for PhilHealth's campaign against malpractices and violations that are defrauding government of its funds and resources.

The growing base of support for PhilHealth is prompted by people's perception that the Acting PhilHealth President has "shown his grit and determination to stamp out health insurance fraud," said one physician who belongs to the PMA. This is specially true, he noted, "since PhilHealth has succeeded in identifying violators, prosecuting them and are meted penalties."

The NBI has made its investigative skills and facilities available to PhilHealth to catch wrongdoers, produce evidence of fraud, and assist prosecutors to buttress their cases against violators.

The PMA, the countrywide association of medical doctors, has pledged its support for PhilHealth, vowing to apply peer pressure against practitioners

"who take the low road of deception and crime." "Ours is an intelligence network than can easily spot our fellow practitioners if they make false medical claims, fabricate forms and documents, and submit multiple claims for one disease, a PMA official said. "We are ashamed of hospitals which betray the trust of PhilHealth when they engage in fraudulent acts," said an official of PHA, who added that their association will not hesitate taking out these unethical hospitals from their membership roll. There have been cases of hospitals which connived with doctors to submit false claims — just so to make money.

The PRC, the regulator and licensing body for all professionals, said it is ready to suspend the licenses of unscrupulous medical doctors and participating nurses if evidence would show that they engaged in fraudulent activities, said a PRC official. "It is always good to cleanse our professional ranks of unethical
