## UNESCO, CPJ 'pleased' with PTFoMS work, initiatives

**MANILA**—The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) and the Committee to Protect Journalists (CPJ), an international body dedicated to the protection of journalists worldwide, have hailed the initiatives and work being done by the Presidential Task Force on Media Security (PTFoMS).



PTFoMS executive director, Undersecretary Jose Joel Sy Egco discussed recently with representatives of UNESCO and the CPJ the accomplishments registered by the task force in less than three years after its creation.

President Rodrigo Duterte created the PTFoMS soon after he assumed the presidency in 2016 in response to the violent assaults against media workers in the country, many of which have

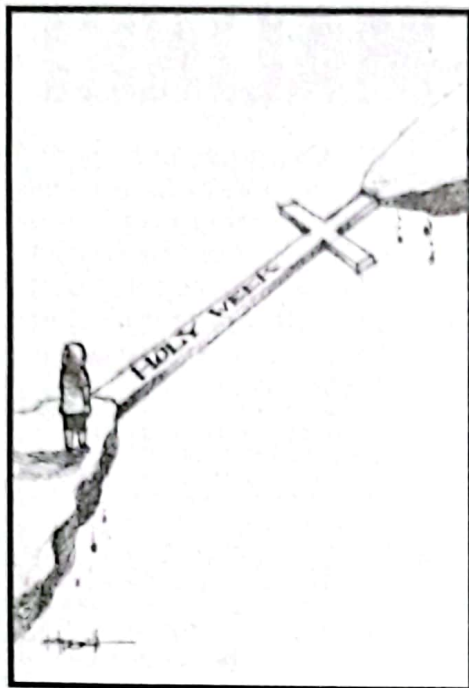
remained unresolved.

In their recent meeting with Egco, CPJ Asia program coordinator Dr. Steven Butler, CPJ board chair Kathleen Carroll, and Queensland University (Australia) Journalism and Communications chair, Prof. Peter Greste who represented UNESCO, have vowed to keep in touch with the PTFoMS for developments in Philippine journalism.

The senior citizens of this city are currently receiving financial subsidy, medical assistance, free wheelchairs and eyeglasses, aside from the free movie tickets.

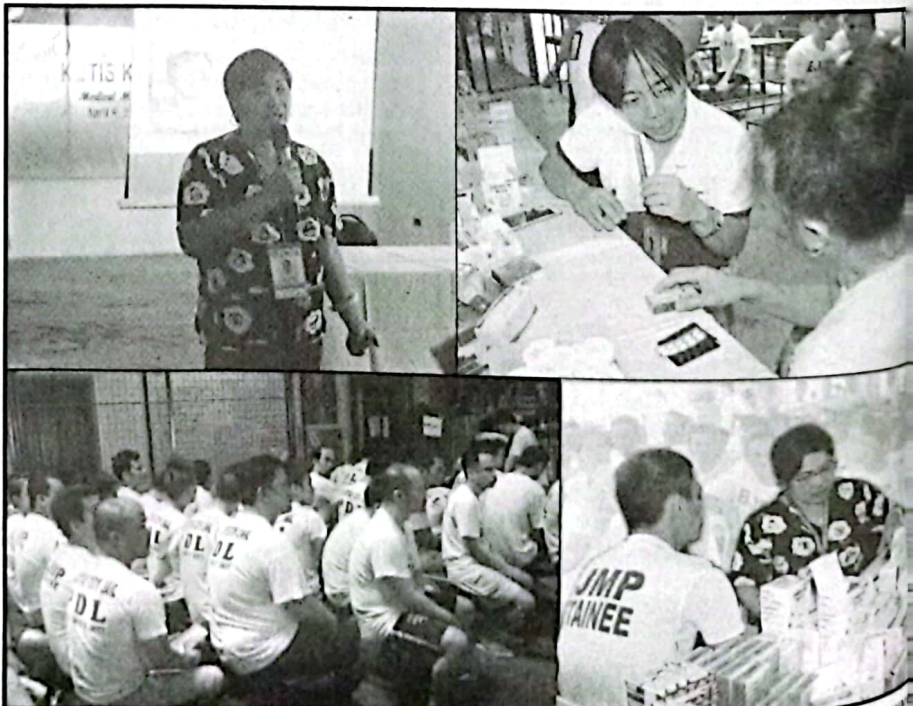

OPLAN RED was introduced to all Provincial Veterinary Offices and local government units where there is a need to fully implement the plan including training on population control like neutering and spaying for rabies prevention and control.

It includes the identification and classification of provinces, municipalities, cities and barangays into high risk, medium, low, candidate free zone and officially rabies free zone.

Spaying and Neutering is part of the dog/cat population control activity under the Rabies Prevention and Control Program. "This activity will not only reduce the number of unwanted

dogs/cats roaming the streets but it will also be beneficial to the animals because it reduces the risk of acquiring reproductive related diseases and illnesses," he emphasized.

"It will also prevent uterine infections and breast cancer, which is fatal in about 50 percent of dogs and 90 percent of cats. I encouraged every responsible pet owner to spay your pet because it is the best protection from these diseases," he reassured.

According to the regional rabies prevention and control unit, there were a total of 92,474 animal bites cases in CALABARZON for 2018. The province of Rizal has the highest number of cases with 28,430, followed by Cavite with 20,857 and Batangas with 16,116; Laguna - 14,638 and Quezon - 12,433. There were 30 recorded

deaths from rabies.

"We have to limit dog population in the community specifically in areas where they are unmanaged and tends to roam around. We need to reduce the problems they may cause in order to facilitate more effective rabies control,"

"Community cooperation is very important including responsible pet ownership, better veterinary care and regular dog vaccination will reduce the risk of rabies transmission," he stressed.

## DOH CONDUCTS HEALTH FAIR FOR MEMBERS OF HYPERTENSION AND DIABETES CLUBS IN CALABARZON

DOH-CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) on Friday, concluded the first "Non-Communicable Disease (NCD) Health Fair" for officers and members of hypertension and diabetes clubs of the region to provide them recent updates on the prevention and control of lifestyle diseases including the importance of practicing healthy lifestyle held at Ciudad Christia 9 Waves Resort in San Mateo, Rizal from April 4-5, 2019.

Regional Director Eduardo C.

Janairo stated that the health department established the Hypertension and Diabetes Clubs in 2016 to combat non-communicable diseases (NCDs). *Napakaimportante na ma-sustain natin ang serbisyo ng mga organisasyong ganito upang mapangalagaang mabuti ang mga maysakit dahil sila ang mangunguna sa komunidad at magsisilbing tagapamahagi ng tamang impormasyon kasama na dito ang pamimigay ng mga libreng maintenance medicines at medical check-up sa kanilang mga pasyente.*

"These clubs will also serve as support groups in the communities and will ensure that appropriate treatment and management will be provided to all patients. *Sila ang magbabantay sa kalusugan ng mga miyembro at sisiguruhin na lahat ay mabibigyan ng serbisyo pangkalusugan,*" he emphasized.

The DOH Non-Communicable Disease Prevention and Control Center reported a total of 600,000 patients are registered nationwide in the HPN and DM Clubs as of

February 2016..

To become a registered member, a patient must consult the nearest health center or primary health care facility in the community for proper assessment, screening and management using the Philippine Package of Essential NCD Intervention (PhilPEN) protocol. Once he/she is diagnosed to have hypertension and/or diabetes, he/she will be enrolled to the club.

A registered member is entitled to free maintenance drugs for hypertension

(Losartan/Amlodipine/Metoprolol) and diabetes (Metformin).

According to Dr. Marilou R. Espiritu, Medical Office III and head of the Non-Communicable Disease Cluster, the advocacy activity was conducted with the objective of providing officers of health clubs particularly the hypertension and diabetes clubs of the region, essential updates on the prevention and control of lifestyle diseases including the importance of practicing healthy lifestyle. "To fight and eliminate NCDs, it is important to practice healthy lifestyle choices early in our life."

"All of the municipalities in Rizal and Batangas have established their HPN and DM Club and more than 90% are already set-up in the three provinces," she added.

The health fair was attended by 175 officers of Hypertension and Diabetes Clubs of CALABARZON who have undergone medical screenings such as glucose testing, weight, height and body mass index (BMI) determination, urinalysis, nutrition counseling and dietary plan and medical consultation including provision of maintenance medicines.

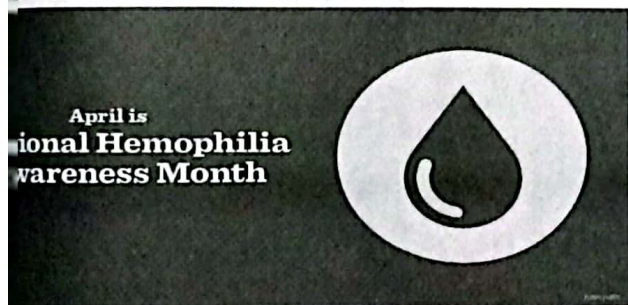

## Facts you need to know on Hemophilia

Hemophilia is a bleeding disorder, passed on from mothers, which affects a person's ability to clot. The World Hemophilia Federation estimates that 1,000 Filipinos have hemophilia, with about 1 million suffering from the disease and other bleeding disorders. As we celebrate the Hemophilia Awareness Month this April, here are five facts on hemophilia from a study entitled "Hemorrhagic diseases in Filipino children" in The Philippine Journal of Pediatrics.



### April is Hemophilia Awareness Month

There are two main types of hemophilia. Hemophilia A is the most common type of hemophilia, occurring in about 1 in 10,000 males. It is caused by a defective factor VIII. Hemophilia B is a less common type of hemophilia, occurring in about 1 in 10,000 births. It is caused by a defective factor IX. Having a factor means that a person has no way to repair themselves when there is a leak in the blood or injured tissue that leads to excessive bleeding and internal damage beyond repair.

damage beyond repair.

### It affects children

Hemophilia B Leyden is an extremely rare form of Hemophilia B that causes young children to bleed excessively throughout childhood but when they reach puberty, very little bleeding occurs afterward.

### Women can get affected too

Hemophilia is a recessive x-linked trait which affects approximately 1 in 4,500 males, but there are cases in which the mutation can cause the same disease issue to the carrier [mothers].

### No cure available yet

Medical scientists haven't found a cure yet for this condition. The only treatment available for hemophilia is replacement therapy wherein concentrates of clotting factor VIII (for hemophilia A) and IX (for hemophilia B) are slowly dripped or injected into a vein. This helps in replacing the

defective clotting factor of the blood. Out of the 10,000 Filipinos that suffer from hemophilia, 3 out of every 4 people lack the resources required for proper treatments.

This research is one of the many studies on hemophilia uploaded in the Health Research and Development Information Network (HERDIN), an online database of PCHRD that enables online publishing, exchanging, and dissemination of quality health information in the Philippines. It is the only health research repository for published researches in the country.

In the spirit of raising awareness on Hemophilia Month, PCHRD invites universities, colleges, laboratories, and medical and research institutions to upload their published and unpublished researches to HERDIN to expand the reach of their study and foster collaboration to find research-based solutions to healthcare problems such as hemophilia.

### Controlled bleeding occurs

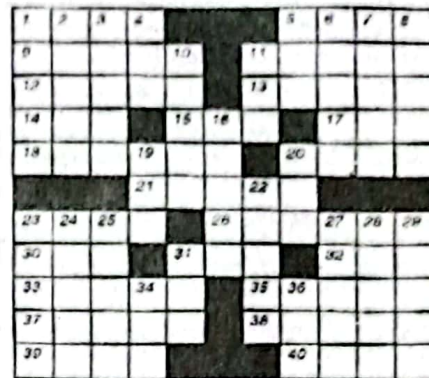
A serious concern for those suffering from hemophilia is spontaneous bleeding and the risk of not healing itself. It can be life-threatening because when a vital organ is injured, permanent

exhibits will also highlight the purpose and function of the Earth-observing microsattellites Diwata-1 and Diwata-2, which were made by Filipino engineers from the Advanced Science and Technology Institute (DOST-ASTI) and the University of the Philippines Diliman (UPD), in collaboration with Japan's Hokkaido University and Tohoku University. There will also be a feature on the Maya-1, the Philippines' first nanosatellite, which was built and designed by Filipino scholars participating in the BIRDS-2 Project in Kyushu Institute of Technology (Kyutech). "There is something deeply human about the excitement for space exploration," says The Mind Museum curator Maria Isabel Garcia. "Just look at how excited young kids can be about outer space. Through these exhibits, we hope to show to kids that they actually can pursue a career based on their sense of wonder and adventure."

Officials from DOST are also excited that the country's efforts in space science are getting a wider audience. "The projects to

use space technology are for the benefit of Filipinos," says Dr. Enrico C. Paringit, Executive Director of the Philippine Council for Industry, Energy and Emerging Technology Research and Development (DOST-PCIEERD). "Since these projects are publicly funded, we at DOST believe that communicating our projects' benefits to Filipinos is a crucial part of what we do."

DOST Secretary Fortunato T. De La Peña also welcomes another avenue to popularize a project of Filipino scientists and engineers. "This is an important step in advancing Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) education in the country," De La Peña says. "By showing to young Filipinos what our scientists and engineers have accomplished, we can inspire students to go into STEM fields and contribute to science in the country."

Some of the exhibits will be housed permanently at The Mind Museum, which is found in Bonifacio Global City, Taguig. Meanwhile, other exhibits will be included as part of Space

Adventure. Space Adventure is one of the museum's traveling exhibitions and will be in the Canopy Plaza of The Mind Museum until April 21, 2019. After that, Space Adventure will go to different sites in the country to bring the excitement of space exploration to more guests.

The exhibits were designed and created by The Mind Museum, with support from DOST-PCIEERD, DOST-ASTI, UPD, and the Development of Philippine Scientific Earth Observation Microsatellite (PHL-Microsat) Program which is succeeded by the Space Technology and Applications Mastery, Innovation and Advancement (STAMINA4Space) Program.

"The STAMINA4Space Program appreciates the efforts of DOST-PCIEERD and The Mind Museum in showcasing the outputs of the program to young Filipinos," says STAMINA4Space Program Leader and DOST-ASTI Acting Director, Dr. Joel Marciano, Jr. "We look forward to continued partnership with The Mind Museum in pursuit of our objective of advancing and promoting space technology research and development for the benefit of Philippine society."



# UNOPPOSED BETS STILL WOO VOTERS

CAVITE's unopposed local candidates or those who consider themselves unchallenged are still engaged into their local campaign sorties to keep in touch with their constituents.

These include a vice gubernatorial reelectionist, four unopposed congressional bets of Cavite's eight districts, six reelectionist mayors and eight vice-mayors from the 23 towns and cities.

Incumbent and reelectionist Vice Governor Ramon "Jolo" Revilla III of the Nationalist People's Coalition (NPC), who is seeking his third and last term, is running unopposed.

Revilla's running mate for governor under the Nacionalista Party, Juanito Victor "Jonvic" Remulla Jr. is challenged by former three-term Governor Erneo "Ayong" Maliksi of the Liberal Party.

The four congressional aspirants who are still campaigning in their respective districts include Strike Revilla for the 2nd District; Alex "AA" Advincula, 3rd District; and Luis "Jon Jon" Ferrer IV, 6th District or the Lone District of General Trias City; and Abraham "Bambol" Tolentino for the 8th District.

Cavite Provincial Election Supervisor lawyer Arnulfo Pioquinto told Philippine News Agency (PNA) on Thursday that six unopposed mayors and eight vice mayors have been into their campaign meetings with party stalwarts and still meet their supporters and constituents.

Pioquinto said the unopposed

candidates are all virtual winners in the May 13 mid-term polls.

Mayoral bets who have no political rivals include reelectionist mayors Antonio "Ony" Ferrer of GenTri; Dino Reyes Chua of Noveleta; Danny Bencito of Baiten; Perfecto Fidel of Indang; Bernardo "Totie" Paredes of Cavite City, and Agnes Tolentino of Tagaytay City.

"We are still actively campaigning for the party and for the people so they would be acquainted with the candidates of the Team GenTri," Ferrer said.

Noveleta Mayor Dino Reyes Chua, said, "kahit wala po akong kalaban, ikinakampanya ko naman po yung mga kandidato ko at ng partido."

Unopposed vice mayors include Rading Viado of Amadeo; Louel Golfo of Baiten; Ismael Rodill, Renato Dimapilis of Magallanes; Francisco "Cocoy" Mendoza of Mendez; Vltaire Ricafrente of Rosario; Morit Sison of Gen.Trias and Reymond Ambion of Tagaytay City.

6th District Board Member Felix "Jango" Grepo and Cavite Councilors' League (CCL) Federation president and ex-officio Provincial Board Member Kerby Salazar are also running unopposed.
