IMUS CITY, Cavite – The construction of the 27-km. Cavite segment of the 45-km. Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAEX) began after the ground-breaking at Alapan II-B village here Wednesday.

Envisioned as the "most advanced" expressway in the country, the Cavite segment, with an estimated project cost of PHP12 billion, will ensure a safe, efficient and seamless travel for motorists from Kawit town (in Cavite) to the South Luzon Expressway (SLEX) – Mamlasan Interchange. It is expected to cut travel time from 2.5 hours to less than 45 minutes and help decongest approximately 50,000 cars.

At the groundbreaking ceremony, Public Works Secretary Mark Villar said the project is part of the Duterte administration's masterplan to connect Luzon from north to south, to be called the "Luzon Spine Expressway Network" (LSEN), to increase the current 300-km. high-speed expressway to 1,000 km. by 2022, the end of President Rodrigo R. Duterte's term.

IMUS CITY, Cavite – Mayor Emmanuel Maliksi has launched "OPLAN SEMANA SANTA" 2018 to assist pilgrims and travelers in times of emergency as the city expects hordes of Catholic devotees to flock to churches and places of worship for penance and spiritual reflection this Holy Week.

The city government issued on Wednesday its advisory designating five First Aid Stations and help desks - with the support of the Cavite police, city disaster risk reduction and management office (CDRRMO) and Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP).

Also, four designated fixed spots were identified as PNP strategic areas.

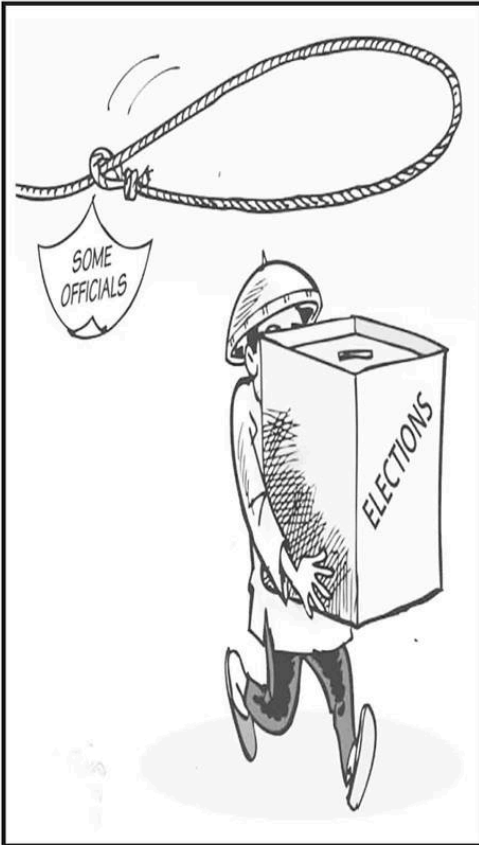
PhilHealth introduces new claim requirement to ensure quality of care

THE Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) recently introduced a policy to ensure that its members who seek treatment in hospitals are provided with health care services that are of the desired quality and at par with existing medical standards.

In its PhilHealth Circular No. 2019-0002 entitled "Documentation Requirements for Claims Reimbursement and Medical Prepayment Review of Claims (Revision 2)," the state health insurer prescribes a medical prepayment review and requires the use of Claim Form 4 (CF4) for all admissions starting March 1, 2019.

PCLEDO LEADS PATH TO ULTIMATE ENTREPRENEURIAL SUCCESS



THE Provincial Cooperative, Livelihood and Entrepreneurial Development Office headed by Atty. "We will deliver not just on our promise to solve traffic, but to bring development to our provinces," Villar said.

The high-speed expressways are not just expected to reduce travel time but, once completed, create a new period of development for the provinces of Cavite and Laguna.

Cavite is now the biggest in terms of population among the country's provinces, with an estimated 4.1 million people, 2016 data from the Philippine Statistics Authority show.

As Region 4-A (Calabarzon) now accounts for almost 20 percent of the country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP), the most productive region.

Cavite Governor Remulla said this "speaks volumes about the dynamism of the government and its private partner." He said the expressway will connect Laguna and Cavite, and decongest the South Luzon Expressway (SLEX).

The Laguna segment of the CALAEX project is now in full swing which, according to Metro Pacific Tollways Corp. (MPTC) president and Chief Executive Officer, Rodrigo Franco, is expected to open the first section during the third quarter or as early as July this year.

"In two years' time, we hope the province of Cavite will have a brand new expressway that will connect the existing Cavite Expressway, which is also operated by the Metro Pacific Group," Franco added.

CALAEX will employ some 1,200 personnel for its Laguna segment and close to 1,300 more for site and office personnel as its Cavite segment progresses. It is part of the network of toll roads that the MPTC is constructing and developing, which will connect to Cavite and the C5-South Link and will make transfers from Laguna, Cavite, Las Piñas, Parañaque, and CP Garcia Ave. seamless.

Other projects under the MPTC's portfolio are the recently opened Harbor Link Segment 10, North Luzon Expressway (NLEX), Subic - Clark - Tarlac Expressway (SCTEX), and the Cebu-Cordova Link Expressway in the Visayas.

Medical pre-payment review is done prior to actual processing, wherein claims that are not compensable as well as those that are not compliant with existing policies and standards on quality of care shall no longer be processed. The review shall be based on data from the CF4 which summarizes a patient's pertinent clinical information. The submission of the CF4 eliminates the submission of voluminous complete clinical charts for claims reimbursements. The policy does not preclude submission of other documents if necessary.

The new policy shall cover claims using case rates with the exception of directly filed claims those for confinements abroad and claims for Z Benefits, among others.

The new system enables PhilHealth to efficiently assess provider claims and to detect irregular practices such as over utilization or under-utilization of services; unnecessary use of diagnostic and therapeutic procedures and interventions; irrational medication and prescriptions; fraudulent, false or incorrect information; gross or unjustified deviations from currently accepted standards of practice and/or treatment protocols; inappropriate referral practices; use of fake, adulterated, misbranded or unregistered drugs; among others.

"With this new policy, we aim to maximize our limited human and financial resources to promptly act on good and compliant claims. This also translates to faster turnaround time for claims processing, and good health outcomes for our patients," PhilHealth Acting PCEO Dr. Roy B. Ferrer explained.

The Policy, signed last Feb 8, 2019, allowed for a transition period for the month of March for hospitals to align and update their systems. To help HCIs in adapting to the new system, PhilHealth allowed facilities with eClaims systems to transmit the encoded CF4s of admissions starting March 1, 2019, while other HCIs may still use available offline applications provided by PhilHealth. On the other hand, those manually submitting claim applications shall submit soft copy of encoded CF4 together with manually transmitted claim application. Claims submitted to PhilHealth without the required CF4 shall be returned to the hospital for compliance starting April 1.

people," sabi ni Madam Gigi.

Isipin nga naman, sa loob ng tatlong taon lamang, sa pangunguna ni Congressman Mikee Romero, umakda, at naging co-author at co-sponsor ang 1Pacman sa 26 bagong batas.

'FIXCAL' SA DRUG LIST, IIMBESTIGAHAN NG DOJ

Joint Nutrition Action Officers and Provincial Nutrition Committee Technical Working Group Meeting

COMMITTED to address the malnutrition problems in the province, the Provincial Nutrition Committee under the Provincial Health Office remains persistent in formulating and delivering programs that cater to the nutritional needs of Caviteños as they facilitated the Joint Nutrition Action Officers (NAOs) and Provincial Nutrition Committee-Technical Working Group (PNC-TWG) Meeting on April 4, 2019 at the Cavite Collaboration Center for Public Health in Trece Martires City.

During the gathering, Provincial Nutrition Action Officer Angeles Peñaalba explained the scope and overview of the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition 2017-2022 for the neophyte NAOs. She also asserted the call for action on the rampant measles cases in the province which reached more than

1,000 and 17 deaths. Ms. Peñaalba also pointed out the urgency of collaborating with all the NAOs in the province as the data on stunting or short for age cases alarms the PHO and malnutrition continues despite the efforts of the provincial government to reach out the poorest members of

the community.

On the other hand, background on the updated nutrition Monitoring and Evaluation of Local Level Implementation Protocol (MELLPI) for local government and nutrition workers was discussed by Nutrition Officer II Ms. Liberty

'Visita Iglesia' in Cavite, a mix of spiritual and historical journey

KAWIT, Cavite – The Holy Week is a very sacred time for Filipinos, a time for reflection and penance, and a time for honoring traditions, such as the pabasa (chanting/singing of the Passion of Christ), the Way of the Cross, and the Visita Iglesia.

As millions of devout Catholics make the rounds of at least seven churches to commemorate the last days of Jesus on earth, pilgrims may opt to add a "historical" twist to this annual tradition by doing it in the historical province of Cavite.

Cavite's churches not just present colonial influences but they have figured well in the nation's history, former Kawit tourism officer and now freelance curator, Angelo Jarin Aguinaldo, said in an interview on Thursday.

His advice as an ideal first stop from Manila, a few minutes' drive down South, is the Iglesia Catolica Apostolica Romana Parish of St. Michael the Archangel.

Located along Evangelista St. in Bacoor City, this was where Fr. Mariano Gomez served as one of its parish priests.

"Gomez is the GOM in GOMBURZA – the three Filipino priests who were executed (on) charges of subversion arising from the 1872 Cavite mutiny," Aguinaldo added.

In nearby Kawit town is where you will find the Church of St. Mary Magdalene, where the first president of the Philippine Republic, Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo, was baptized. Saint Maria Magdalena is known as the patroness of the Revolutionists.

It is located near Gen. Aguinaldo's birth house, which has been turned into a Shrine and museum in his honor and run by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP).

Saint Mary Magdalene is believed to be the general's inspiration in naming his Katipunan council "Magdalo".

Just a few minutes' drive from Kawit is the town famous for its smoked fish – Rosario.

"This is where you'll find the image of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary, Reina de Caracol, who saved the

lives of people in the midst of a strong typhoon during the Spanish era," Aguinaldo said.

Historical accounts reveal that the church was burned in 1896 at the height of the Katipuneros' hostilities against the friars, and was converted into a "cuartel" of revolutionaries during the fight with the Americans in 1901.

Another popular church in Cavite that boasts of priceless religious relics and high-vaulted ceilings reminiscent of the Spanish colonial era and the Katipunan period, is the Imus Cathedral of Our Lady of the Pillar.

Built by the Jesuits, the cathedral was declared a

structure of historical significance in November 2006.

In Dasmariñas City, the Immaculate Conception Church – the city's first Catholic church – was the site of the bloody Battle of Perez Dasmariñas, a Cavite offensive in 1897 commanded by Major Gen. Jose de Lachambre to recapture Cavite since the loss at the twin battles of Binakayan and Dalahican.

Close to it, in Silang town, sits the church known for

its Spanish colonial architectural style and Rococo-influenced retablos called the Our Lady of Candelaria Parish Church.

The church served as kuta (camp) of the guardia sibil (civil guards) at the height of the hostilities of Filipino revolutionaries to Spanish friars in 1896.

Like the church in Imus, the "Retablo Mayor y Menores and the complex of the Church of Nuestra Senora de Candelaria, more known as the Silang Church, has been declared a National Cultural Treasure in 2016.

Other churches that pilgrims may consider are the churches of Our Lady of Assumption in the upland town of Maragondon, the Sto. Niño de Ternate Parish that sits in the coastal town located in the western part of Cavite, and the St. Gregory the Great Parish in Indang town.

The "Our Lady of Assumption" served as Emilio Aguinaldo's base during the Philippine Revolution in 1897, while Ternate's "Sto. Niño" was said to be ruined by the battle with only the Holy Image of Santo Niño left intact.

"St. Gregory" was also burned and destroyed during the Philippine Revolution against Spain but was impressively restored, capturing the 18th century.

The church is famous for its impressive interiors, paintings on the ceiling, and the old pulpit platform, which gives prominence to the officiating priest during Mass.

There is also the old church in Tanza town, the Sta. Cruz Parish Church, where Gen. Aguinaldo and Gen. Mariano Trias took their oaths as President and Vice President of the Philippine Revolutionary Government some 120 years ago.

Last is the Saint Francis of Assisi Parish Church in General Trias where the Banda Matanda, a local marching band, practiced the Marcha Filipina – the music of the Philippine National Anthem, before they played it when independence was proclaimed in Kawit town on June 12, 1898.

DOH CONDUCTS 2ND BATCH OF BASIC WHEELCHAIR TRAINING FOR BATANGAS PWDs

DOH CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) in partnership with Philippine Society of Wheelchair Professional Inc of UP Manila conducted the second batch of "Wheelchair Service Training Package: Basic Level" for service providers and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) from April 2-5, 2019 at Ciudad Christia 9 Waves Resort in San Mateo, Rizal.

The training aims to provide coordinators of various local government units, PWDs and caregivers the knowledge in the proper measurement, specifying the correct wheelchair for their physique, preparing and installing fittings and preventive maintenance making it more suitable to their needs and at the same time enhancing their knowledge and skills on the proper handling of a wheelchair.

A total of 27 PWDs and federation officers from Batangas province attended the training.

The activity was conducted by the Non-Communicable Disease Unit headed by the PWD Regional Coordinator Ms. Paulina A. Calo who emphasized the importance of the training to wheelchair users and caregivers as it will allow them to have a complete understanding of what a wheelchair is and its significance to their daily life. "We have to accept the fact that most PWDs spent their life in a wheelchair kaya kailangang malaman nila ang mga tamang pamamaraan ng pangangalaga kasama na dito ang tamang paggamit upang sila ay maging kumportable at maiwasan ang pagkakaroon ng mga skin sores dahil sa matagal na pagkakaupo dito," she stated during the opening program.

"Mahalaga ring malaman na hindi basta-basta lang ang paggamit ng wheelchair dahil may panuntunan na dapat sundin at gawin upang maging ligtas ang sinumang gagamit nito," she added.

A wheelchair is a wheeled mobility device propelled either manually (by turning the wheels by the hand) or via various automated systems. It is used by a person who has

difficult in walking or impossible due to illness, injury, or disability. Some may include specialized seating adaptations, individualized controls, and some are specific for particular activities for sports and leisure.

According to the President of the Philippine Society of Wheelchair Professionals and head trainer Dr. Ferdiliza Dandah S. Garcia, emphasized that only one percent of the Philippine population has access to wheelchair. "Most wheelchairs are donated by government and private institutions and these are not match to fit the donee because of its large size which is generally not suitable for Asian users".

The basic wheelchair training was conducted through the initiative of Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo in line with his health roadmap: "Towards CALABARZON Prime," with the objective of providing a more efficient, effective and sustainable health care delivery in the communities.

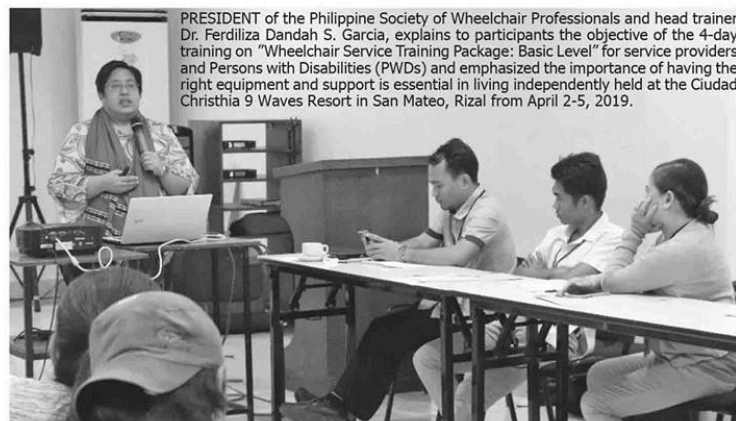
"Our vision is to make CALABARZON a prime which means you have the right accessibility, the right equipment aside from the facilities, the right service referral system for everyone, kahit sino,

namundok ka, nagkasakit ka o naaksidente, me sasalo sa iyo sa anumang oras na kailangan mo ng health service," Janairo emphasized.

Participants of the 4-day training program have undertaken various application of wheelchair services including proper sitting position, proper lifting and transferring of a disabled person from wheelchair to bed or chair, and avoiding pressure sores which is one of the most commonly experienced by a user due to improper wheelchair usage.

There is a total of 50 trained including 23 from the province of Laguna on February this year. The regional office is targeting at least 150 PWDs and federation officers from various societies for the basic wheelchair training.

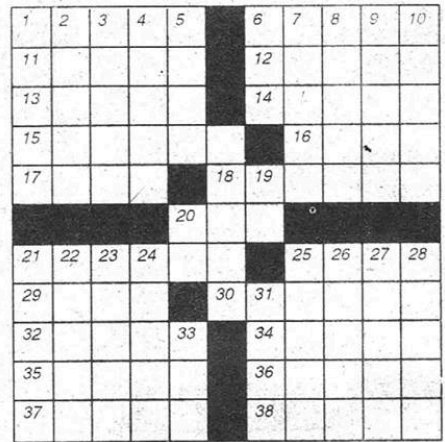
"This is part of the health department's commitment through the leadership of Secretary Francisco T.
