

Bacoor LGU rolls out vax program simulations

Meeting with the CALABARZON Local Task Forces Against COVID-19, Councilor Alde Pagulayan said that they have launched the Electronic Immunization Registry (CEIR) to ensure a safe and efficient registration process.

Personnel were hired to form 25 vaccination teams to cover all of the city's 16 vaccination sites.

City Office and Private Hospital Workers will be at the front line of the program, handling the screening, monitoring and the vaccines.

Other personnel include the Sangguniang Kabataan and the City Information Systems, who will handle the registration of the individuals, as well as teachers who will join the City Social Development Office in providing counselling services.

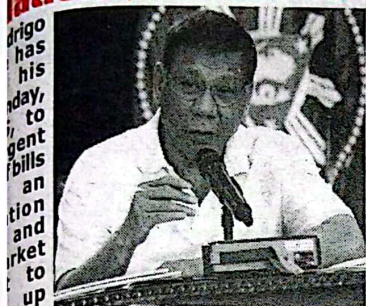

CALAMBA CITY, Feb. 16 - Cavite State University (CvSU) campuses are going paperless in their contact tracing efforts as part of their new normal.

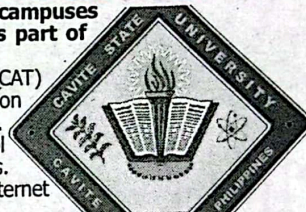
The Cavite State University College of Arts and Trades (CCAT) Research and Extension Team has developed a mobile application to make in-campus contact tracing safer and more convenient.

Visitors can use their smartphones that are connected to the internet to use the app.

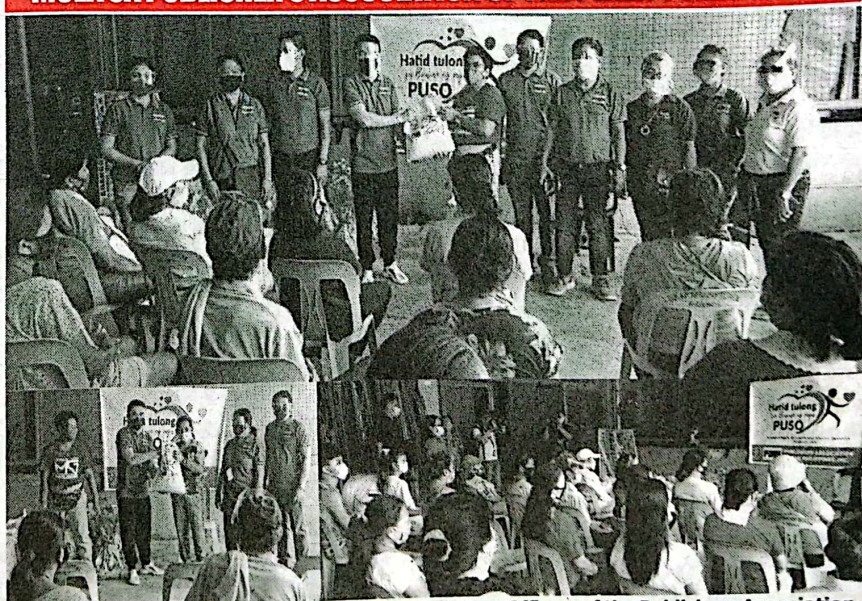
It also needs a phone camera, web browser and a QR code scanning application which can be downloaded for both Android and iOS users.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE COMPETITIVE SELECTION OF THE JOINT VENTURE PARTNER OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE SANGLEY POINT INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT PROJECT

The Provincial Government of Cavite (PGC) of the Republic of the Philippines is again inviting qualified firms to submit Joint Venture (JV) Proposals for the development of the Sangley Point International Airport Project (the "Project").

The Project is a master-planned 1,500-hectare new international airport development to be implemented as a commercial JV arrangement between the PGC and its selected JV Partner. The PGC is the implementing agency of the Project for the Government of the Philippines. The formation and execution of the JV will be done in accordance with Provincial Ordinance No. 002-S-2012, as amended, or the PGC's Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Code and JV Ordinance.

The selected JV Partner will be responsible for co-developing the Project in joint venture with the PGC; providing the necessary equity investment, debt financing, and credit enhancements; and securing/performing Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) services for the land and airport development components of the Project.

Under the terms of the Project's no objection clearance from the Department of Transportation, no sovereign loan or National Government guarantee will be granted.

STRH Hospital Chief Ephraim Rubiano established the STRH Command Center to facilitate patient consultations and referral system.

The center accepts calls, SMS, and chats from patients asking for medical and dental consultation. Information will be gathered including health concerns and proceed to set patients for appointment with the available doctors for TeleMedicine, TeleDentistry, and OPD.

The patient then calls the STRH Command Center and the navigators sets up an appointment for them either through TeleMedicine, TeleDentistry, or Face-to-face consultation.

Rubiano said that in

some cases where a case cannot be handled through TeleMedicine or if the patient opts for a face-to-face consultation, a schedule shall be set forth depending on the availability of the Doctor.

From October 2020 up to the present, a total of 244 clients were given consultations using the telemedicine system while 13 individuals were provided dental service through the TeleDentistry program.

Galvez said he is currently communicating with lawmakers, particularly with Sen. Christopher "Bong" Go, to fast-track the passage of the two pending bills. Senator Go said the President may certify the

measures as urgent this week.

Assuring the President that Philippines is on top of COVID-19 vaccine program preparations, Galvez said they have already fulfilled requirements and agreements with international organizations and companies to proceed with the nationwide inoculation.

These include securing an emergency use authorization (EUA) for vaccines as well as providing necessary documents to the World Health Organization (WHO), COVAX Facility and Gavi, he said.

The country is expecting to receive up to 3 million vaccine doses by the end February from

the COVAX Facility global alliance seeking help poor countries to vaccinate population against deadly coronavirus.

Pfizer, Sino Moderna Therapeutics, Novavax, Johnson Johnson, AstraZeneca, Sino Biologicals and Gamaleya Research Institute are among pharmaceutical companies that Philippines is negotiating with to procure COVID vaccines.

The Department of Health (DOH) recorded 1,685 COVID-19 infections February 15, bringing the total number of cases in the country to 550,860 with 511,700 recoveries and 11,500 deaths. **PND**

Three Ultra High Temperature Freezers in the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital will also be utilized for storing vaccines to prevent them from spoiling upon reaching city borders.

To recall, Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla has signed an Executive Order for the establishment of technical working groups who will oversee the vaccination operations center, database and registry, communication and dissemination,

procurement and finance, and logistics

Local government offices, such as the City Health Office, MIS Public Information Office, City Budget Office, and General Services Office, have been tapped to handle the logistics entailed in the vaccination program.

Simulations in the city-wide vaccination plan were done in different venues, such as Bacoor Elementary School (ALIMA Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital, at Bacoor Coliseum determine which will be most conducive in terms of transportation, logistics and manpower - facilitating the successful vaccination rollout. On another note, WHO expert Helen Barry in her article on public finance methods employed by countries during the COVID-19 outbreak (posted May 21, 2020) cited the Philippines, among other countries, that used "alternative spending modalities to accelerate the release of public funds to subnational levels and/or purchasing agencies and/or directly to the health service providers on the frontlines", saying that "countries have tried different approaches to balance flexibility with control requirements" demonstrating "the effectiveness of these approaches to get resources to where they were most needed, including fast-track spending authorizations at the central level, accelerated procedures for fiscal transfers to subnational levels, and advance payments to health service providers as a complement to retrospective reimbursements."

It can be recalled that PhilHealth made available advanced financing amounting to P14.97 billion to its 711 healthcare providers to enable them to continuously provide health care to the people amidst the crisis. As of February 1, 2021, 94 percent or P14.09 of the said fund was already liquidated by its recipient

hospitals.

PhilHealth does not stop from responding to the increasing healthcare needs of its members as the country battles the pandemic. The state insurer is currently studying the inclusion of benefit packages for RT-PCR test using saliva, an intermediate package for probable cases of Covid-19, and coverage for those who will develop adverse reactions to the COVID-19 vaccine in a bid to increase public acceptance of the Government's drive to vaccinate a substantial portion of the population.

It paid over P80 billion with the indigent sector as top avalee at P22.5 billion or at 28 percent. PhilHealth is indeed one if not the largest payor of healthcare services in the country today, partnering with close to 2,000 strong hospitals and infirmaries, 6,500 other healthcare facilities, and 46,000 healthcare professionals to make such feats happen.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, it introduced benefit packages to provide patients with adequate financial protection for the needed testing, isolation and treatment depending on the patient's pneumonia. PhilHealth even shouldered the entire hospitalization expenses of health care workers afflicted by the virus as mandated under the two Bayanhan laws, Republic Act Nos. 11469 and 11494. As of February 10, 2021, PhilHealth

reimbursed more than P6.5 billion worth of benefit claims related to COVID-19, over P4.4 billion of which was paid for RT-PCR Tests. More than P2 billion was paid for in-patient benefits while P25.6 million was spent for community isolation.

STRENGTHENING PEOPLE'S TRUST

Despite the difficulties brought about by the pandemic as well as the intense public scrutiny, PhilHealth under its new President and CEO Atty. Dante A. Gierran has outlined his reform agenda PhilHealth 2.0 which will shift the "GEARS" towards UHC. GEARS, which stands for "Good Governance", "Essential Benefits", "All Filipinos covered/registered", "Responsive Health Care System", and "Stronger Anti-Fraud Initiatives", are all geared toward "... (improving) equity in accessing quality health care at various levels of care and efficiency in the allocation of (health) resources". Driving the PhilHealth GEARS is his Three-Point Action Plan that consists of Digital transformation; Anti-fraud measures; and Good governance and financial stability.

He intends to accomplish this through the outsourcing of critical IT services to fully automate operations for efficient and effective

management, monitoring and reporting systems. With his reputation as topnotch investigator and corruption buster, Gierran is serious in prosecuting erring facilities and professionals abusing the program through intensified investigations and the strengthening of its legal enforcement across all Regional Offices to help expedite and ensure success in prosecuting cases.

The new PhilHealth Management also believes that IT is key to boosting fraud detection. Hence, it is reviewing its electronic claims system and strengthening fraud scoring and red flagging of potentially fraudulent claims filed by unscrupulous providers. A centralized claims processing set-up is also being studied to avoid backlogs and further improve turnaround time. More reforms are on its way.

As PhilHealth welcomes a new era of reforms, it fully commits to take every challenge as the nation endeavors to progressively realize UHC for the generations of today and tomorrow.
