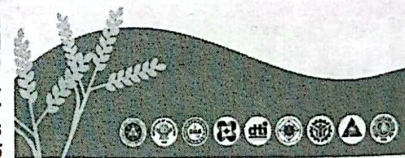
DOST-CALABARZON and CDA-R4A lead Regional Launching of the "Agri-Negosyo Para sa OFWs" in CALABARZON

who is in possession of credible information on such unethical acts to report directly to PhilHealth together with evidence so that the agency can act swiftly.

PhilHealth also reiterated that the National Health Insurance fund is a public fund, and any form of abuse shall be dealt with in accordance to the law. It also warned

that those who post such information without any proof to their claims are not helping insofar as making the public at ease in the face of the Covid-19 pandemic. They instead malign and compromise the reputation of hospitals, doctors and even the agency itself, acts that may lead to legal actions such as cyber libel and

violation of Article 154 of the Penal Code criminalizing publication of false information that may endanger the public order or cause damage to the interest or credit of the State.

Concerned citizens and whistleblowers are encouraged to report such cases through the following: Face-to-face meetings (observing minimum health protocols); Nearest

Ang mga rail workers ng LRT - 2, gayundin ang LRT - 1, Metro Rail Transit Line 3 (MRT 3) at ang Philippine National Railways (PNR) ito ay para matiyak ang kaligtasan ng mga commuters.

At sa di inaasahan na resulta mula sa pinakahuling tala ng DOTr noong nakaraang Abril 12 kinumpirma ng ahensya, na halos umabot sa 786 rail workers ang

nagpositibo sa COVID-19. Ito ay base sa kabuuang 1,994 personnel ng LRT-2 na kung saan nasa 1,870 empleyado na ang nasa ilalim ng pagsusuri. Dahil dito pansamantala munang pinaikli ang operasyon ng Light Rail Transit Authority (LRTA) at ang pinaikling operasyon ay magsisimula ngayong Abril 17 hanggang Abril 30, 2021. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 307-2020, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION
PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 268, AS AMENDED BY PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 300-2020"

WHEREAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 307, modified curfew hours to 10:00 PM to 4:00 AM of the following day, as to allow the working class to return before the start of the curfew hours and to travel at an earlier time, and the general public to attend to important tasks or matters and/or businesses;

WHEREAS, it has been more than a year since the pandemic and the cases in the province still are increasing at an alarming rate;

WHEREAS, as the province is now placed under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ), it is deemed necessary that the movement of the throughout the province be regulated so as to avoid loitering and unnecessary travel outside the residence, thus will somehow help in the reduction of the of the virus;

WHEREAS, as the National Capital Region (NCR) enacted an 8:00PM to 5:00AM curfew hours, it is deemed necessary that the province enact the uniformity;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Ambion, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it ordained Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Provincial Ordinance No. 268-2020, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

Section 2. Prohibited Acts - It shall be unlawful for the public to loiter, wander, stroll, play or to remain or stay in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Cavite without legal justifiable reason from 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM of the following day, daily, unless falling under herein exceptions.

It shall also be unlawful for any parent or guardian of a child to knowingly permit or negligently allow the child to remain in any public place within the of Cavite during curfew hours. Parents and guardians of minors are expected to keep their minor children from leaving their home.

SECTION 2. Repealing Clause. All other resolutions and ordinances which are inconsistent to this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 4. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after its approval.

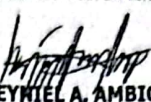

These services and programs are contained in the Agribusiness Portfolio, easily accessible online at <http://innovate.dti.gov.ph/programs/agri-negosyo-para-sa-ofws>. Usec. Aldaba presented several DTI programs, including the COVID-19 Assistance to Restart Enterprises (CARES) Program, an Enterprise Rehabilitation Financing (ERF) facility in support of MSMEs, and Rural Agro-Enterprise Partnership for Development and Growth (RAPID Growth) Project, which links farmers to markets. "Despite the COVID-19 challenges, there are agricultural opportunities to expand production through innovation and use of new technologies," she continued. The DTI, for example, has the eKadiwa, GoLokal, and "One Town, One Product" (OTOP), which are online marketing and trading platforms. Agribusiness-related services of CALABARZON government offices for OFWs Six (6) offices in CALABARZON, through their respective representatives, introduced their programs for OFWs interested to engage or are engaged in agribusiness: the DA Regional Field Office IV-A, DTI 4A Regional Office, CDA-R4A (CALABARZON), DOST-CALABARZON, TESDA-Cavite, and OWWA Regional Welfare Office IV-A.

Ms. Vilma M. Dimaculangan, OIC—Regional Executive Director of the DA-RFO IV-A, laid down programs for OFWs in-line with their vision of "a food secure and resilient Philippines with empowered and prosperous farmers and fisherfolk." For 2021, the DA-RFO IV-A plans to conduct livelihood trainings on hybrid rice and white glutinous corn production, native chicken and duck production, among others. Hybrid and certified rice seeds, hybrid white glutinous corn seeds, mushroom starter kits, as well as fertilizers, are available for distribution to farms in CALABARZON. Through DA's Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Division (AMAD), capital grants, market matching activities, and enterprise development trainings are offered for OFWs engaged in agribusiness. Further, under its Agri-Fishery Credit Programs, OFWs may also borrow a working capital for their agri-fishery-based business from the DA. (For more information on DA's loan programs, visit <https://acpc.gov.ph>.) For the DTI 4A Regional Office, Assistant Regional Director Marissa C. Argente presented programs on their priority industries: processed cacao, coffee, bamboo, coconut, fruits and nuts, and wearables from indigenous materials. The DTI Negosyo Center in CALABARZON offers business advisory, information and advocacy, and facilitates business registration. More

notably, under its Helping the Economy Recover thru OFW Enterprise Start-Ups (HEROES) Program, repatriated OFWs due to the pandemic may borrow up to Php 100,000 from the DTI, to be used as working capital in starting and sustaining a business. (Visit <https://sbqfc.org.ph> for more information.) Through short video presentations, Dir. Salvador V. Valeroso of the CDA R4A, and Provincial Director Ben Hur B. Baniqued of the TESDA-Cavite introduced their respective services. OFWs may benefit from organizing themselves into a cooperative by registering online via <https://cda.gov.ph>. Accredited cooperatives may avail of CDA facilities, including legal services and development trainings. On the other hand, TESDA launched its flagship program, TESDA Abot Lahat ng OFWs, focused on serving returning OFWs and their dependents through scholarship and retooling. Agribusiness-related technical vocational courses offered by the agency includes aquaponics for urban agriculture and organic agriculture. Bagsit, OIC—Regional Director of the DOST-CALABARZON, outlined its new program for OFWs: Innovations for Filipinos Working Distantly from the Philippines (iFWD PH) Program. "Launched in 2020, the program addresses the unprecedented challenges brought about by the pandemic affecting our OFWs," Ms. Bagsit explained. Under the Capability Building Phase of the program, interested and driven OFWs will be guided, step-by-step, on how to establish and manage their own technology-based business. Under the Innovation Funding Phase, OFWs may receive Innovation Fund (iFund) Support of up to Php 250,000 to cover product development, market and laboratory testing, packaging and labeling, equipment acquisition, and other similar business costs. OFWs may apply for the pioneer batch of the iFWD PH at <https://ifwdph.dost.gov.ph>. Representing the OWWA, Ms. Veruschka Ardel Gonzales Maling, its designated focal person for the National Reintegration Center for OFWs (NRCO), delivered a brief overview of the OWWA Livelihood Programs for OFWs: the Enterprise Development Loan Program,

and the "Balik Pinas! Balik Hanapbuhay!" Program. The former is a loan facility of up to Php 2 million for individual borrowers or Php 5 million for group borrowers, with only a 7.5% per annum interest rate for the entire duration of the loan, available as working capital or fixed asset acquisition fund. The latter is a grant of up to Php 20,000 as livelihood support for returning OFWs, distressed or displaced due to the pandemic. The OWWA Tulang Pangkabuhayan sa Pag-Unlad ng Samahang OFWs (Tulong PUSO) is likewise an available livelihood grant opportunity to OFW groups. **Agri-Negosyo onwards** With around 130 Facebook Live viewers, and 160 Zoom participants, the launching event achieved its goal to expand the reach of available agribusiness-related services and facilities to more OFWs in and from the CALABARZON. One participant commented, "Kudos to the speakers and facilitators, especially to the government offices willing to help our kababayans." on April 8, 2021 being the first barangay to submit their validated master list to the MSWDO pursuant to the first come first served basis of the LGU.

Consequently, LGU Naic ordered for a P40M supplemental budget from its savings to augment the allocated funds to be able to help more families in the municipality.

The city of Tagaytay and the municipality of Indang held their

payout on April 9 while the cities of Bacoor and Cavite City and the municipalities of Mendez-Nuñez and Carmona had conducted the distribution of the financial assistance over the weekend despite the challenges brought by employees undergoing quarantine and the work-from-home arrangement.

However, according to the Department of Interior and Local

Government's (DILG) Financial Accomplishment Report that as of April 11, the province had only distributed 1% of the target 3,444,448 individuals to be given the financial assistance.

Early this week, the cities of Dasmariñas, General Trias, and Trece Martires and the municipalities of Tanza and Noveleta held the payout of the financial assistance to their qualified beneficiary residents.

Meanwhile, the City

Government of Imus launched the online registration for the ECQ cash aid and the augmentation program Imuseño, that will expedite processing and validation of the financial assistance to be distributed to the beneficiaries thru accredited electronic payment partners or online banking. Imus City is the first LGU to opt for cashless payout which started yesterday.

To keep the residents safe, the local government of Alfonso

held house-to-house cash payouts to qualified beneficiaries in respective barangays thru the efforts of the employees of the local government, barangay officials, Barangay Health Workers, and Daycare Workers scheduled on April 14-18, 2021.

Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo-Bailen beneficiaries came out to claim their cash aid today while Mayor Jasmin Maligaya-Bautista released the schedule and list of beneficiaries yesterday

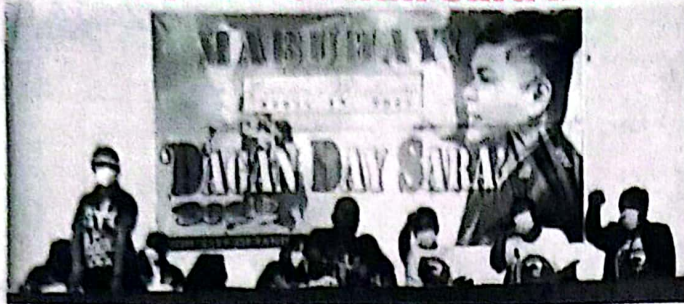

Surigao del Sur goes on all-out support for Run Sara Run



TANDAG CITY — Surigao Del Sur Gov. Alexander Ayec Pimentel, along with almost all municipal mayors of his province are rallying for Davao City Mayor Sara Duterte-Carpio to run for President this coming 2022.

Pimentel said different volunteer groups in Mindanao have initiated a Mindanao-wide Caravan starting April 12 to 17 to encourage support for their drive for the Davao City mayor to run for the country's top political post.

The caravan kicked off from Davao del Norte with 20 vehicles then proceeded to Surigao del Sur. Pimentel said they were warmly cheered by people in the cities and towns along the caravan route.

Some municipalities and province, he said have prepared short programs to welcome the caravan and its leaders including officials of Dagan Day Sara (DDS), Sara Duterte Support Group (SDSG), MOVERS for Inday Sara Duterte, and Inday Sara Initiative for President (ISIP).

Pimentel said he and friends are really determined to convince Mayor Sara Duterte to run for President to continue the legacy started by her father, President Rodrigo Duterte.

He recalled that when he asked the President during his recent visit the last typhoon that affect his whole province, what they can do for him, the President cited the need to continue what he has started. He said he took the President's reply to mean that they support his daughter to run for President in 2022.

PhilHealth Appeals to Report Cases of "Upcasing" or Any Form of Health Insurance Abuse

Noting the proliferation of video posts supposedly of health care providers colluding with patients to declare minor respiratory symptoms such as asthma as Covid-19 to claim higher benefits, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) announced that it will investigate such claims. The agency also enjoined those who posted their videos to provide the necessary proof and fully cooperate with the probe.

The state health insurer said that if found to be true, the incidents described in the video posts refer to upcasing or claiming for a related illness or procedure of higher severity or complexity to gain higher benefit payment. Upcasing is a form of health insurance fraud punishable with a fine of P200,000 for each count, or suspension of contract up to three (3) years of the health care provider, or both. It also constitutes a criminal violation punishable by imprisonment for 6 months and 1 day up to 6 years upon the discretion of the court in accordance to Section 38 of the Universal Health Care Law.

PhilHealth reminded the public that protecting the PhilHealth fund is also a responsibility of every member. It appealed to everyone. **PHILHEALTH • 2**
