OFWs forward: DOST-CALABARZON welcomes first batch of iFWD participants in CALABARZON

Pioneering the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Program for OFWs in DOST-CALABARZON conducted an orientation on the Capability Building Phase (Phase 1) of the iFWD PH for 60 OFW-participants last April 14, 2021 via Zoom.



The iFWD PH, launched in 2020, "aims to provide support opportunities for OFWs and their immediate families to establish technology-based enterprises in the country"—a DOST answer to the adverse impact of the pandemic to our economic landscape. Ms. In her welcome message, Emelita P. Bagsit, OIC - Regional Director of the DOST-CALABARZON, hoped that through the iFWD PH, repatriated OFWs and their dependents would be able to recover from last and this year's challenges. "Congratulations and welcome to your journey in technopreneurship," she remarked.

Ms. Lyn A. Fernandez, Regional Program Management Operation (RPMO) Unit Head, discussed the activities under each of the two phases of the iFWD PH. Ms. Lyn A. Fernandez,

TO-RPMO Unit Head, outlines the activities for the Capability Building Phase (Phase 1) of the iFWD PH, April 14, 2021.

Through the Capability Building Phase (Phase 1), the accepted applicants will be guided, step-by-step, on how to establish and maintain their own technology-based business. DOST-CALABARZON partnered with the Atikha Overseas Workers and Communities Initiative, Inc. to facilitate Phase 1. Atikha Chairperson Estrella Mai Dizon-Añonuevo presented the Start and Improve Your Business (SIYB) online training for OFWs and their families, as part of their "BalikBayanihan: Bayanihan Para sa Balik Kabayan" initiatives. The topics for the 6-week training beginning April 21 are Business Idea Screening, Digital Marketing, Business

Registration, Law and Taxation, among others.

Ms. Estrella Mai Dizon-Añonuevo, Chairperson of the Atikha, details the SIYB training package, April 14, 2021.

During the Phase 1, while training, the participants will be monitored and mentored in crafting and improving their business plan, ready for the Innovation Funding (iFund) Phase (Phase 2) of the iFWD PH. The DOST allotted a maximum of Php 250,000 as iFund support to be lent to each successful participant who has completed Phase 1 at no interest rate. Besides the DOST, Ms. Dizon-Añonuevo detailed a matrix of financing opportunities which the participants may explore.

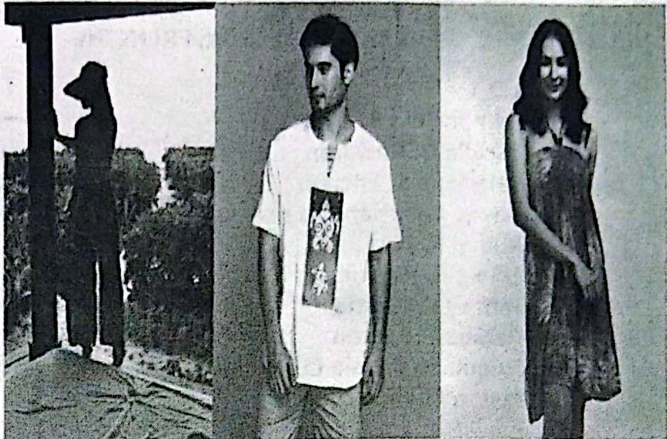

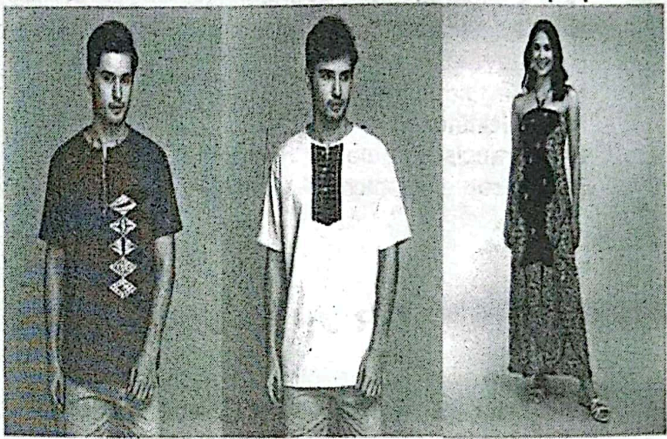

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 317-2021

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE PERIOD FOR THE PAYMENT OF REAL PROPERTY TAX, SPECIAL EDUCATION FUND TAX, TAX ON THE TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY OWNERSHIP, AND FRANCHISE TAX TO JUNE 30, 2021

Sponsored by: **Hon. Ivey Jayne A. Reyes**
 Chair, Committee on Ways and Means

Co-sponsored by: **All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members**

WHEREAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 272-2020 previously extended the period for the payment of Real Property Tax, Special Education Fund Tax, Tax on the Transfer of Real Property Ownership, and Franchise Tax;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the same ordinance provides for period of payment of real property tax levied, together with the additional levy on real property tax, as well as transfer taxes that become due and payable during the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) on or before the deadline;

WHEREAS, the payment period of Real Property Tax given to the taxpayers for the first quarter was until March 31, 2021, however, due to the ECQ in the Province of Cavite on March 29 to April 04, 2021 which was further extended until April 11, 2021, quarterly paying taxpayers and also those availing of 10% discount were not able to pay on the said date;

WHEREAS, in response to the numerous requests of taxpayers, especially those affected by the current situation financially and logistically, extending the deadline of payment of the said tax and other necessary taxes will give taxpayers sufficient time to settle their obligations and will likewise ease their paying penalties;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Cavite is serious in its campaign to generate additional revenues to support the mission and vision of the Province, thus, it has continual commitment in providing a better public service to its constituents amidst the pandemic;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Reyes, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

Section 1. The period for the payment of Real Property Tax, Special Education Fund Tax, Tax on the Transfer of Real Property Ownership, and Franchise Tax is hereby extended to 30 June 2021.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval.

I hereby certify that the foregoing ordinance was duly enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite during its 88th Regular Session on April 12, 2021.

from the onsite vaccination site at the Ospital ng Imus, the vaccine drive-thru site at Robinson's Place Imus, and the mobile vaccine bus that roam the remote places in the city.

Meanwhile, Mayor Maliksi said that the shortage in the supply of the COVID-19 vaccine from the national government is the main challenge for the

continuous conduct of the vaccination program.

The RVCL maintains its continued accreditation granted on November 4, 2019. The PAB Laboratory Accreditation Division assesses local laboratories on international standards, such as the ISO/IEC, if they are competent in carrying out tests, inspection, measurement, and/or calibrations. The ISO/IEC 17025: 2017 is specific to testing and calibration laboratories designed to determine if a laboratory is able to generate valid, reliable, and acceptable test results.

RVCL

The RVCL, based at the Provincial Science and Technology Center in Batangas (PSTC-Batangas), offers calibration of petroleum road tankers and other vehicle tanks, and of volumetric measuring equipment. To assure the quality of its services, the RVCL is managed by a Quality Manager, a Laboratory Head, a Calibration Officer, and a Customer Relations Officer.

The RVCL accreditation continues until November 24, 2021. Mr. Brigido K. Casanova, Jr. is granted approved signatory status in Calibration for the RVCL.

CWWTL

Located at the PSTC-Cavite, the CWWTL performs conventional and rapid tests of water and wastewater. Through its facilities and equipment, it is able to determine the physical, chemical and

microbiological parameters of waters and wastewaters in accordance to international standards. It is managed by a Registered Chemist, and supported by a Registered Medical Technologist and two Laboratory Aides.

The CWWTL accreditation continues until July 15, 2023. Ms. Verjo Angelie C. Maristela is granted approved signatory status in Chemical Testing. Ms. Anna Marie S. Daigan and Ms. Joan Mae B. Acasio, on the other hand, are granted approved signatory status in Biological Testing.

RSTL

The RSTL offers analytical testing services of water, wastewater, foods, feeds, and others such as fertilizer and hand sanitizers through its laboratory units: Chemical Laboratory (Chem Lab), Halal Verification Laboratory (HVL), and Microbiological Laboratory (Micro Lab). The Chem Lab and the HVL, operated by three Registered Chemists and four Registered Chemical Technicians, offer physico-chemical testing on food, water and other matrices and shelf-life testing of food, while the Micro Lab, operated by a Food Technologist, a Registered Microbiologist and a Biologist, offers microbiological testing for food and water. RSTL is supported by a Customer Relations Officer (CRO) and two Laboratory Aides.

The RSTL accreditation in Biological Testing

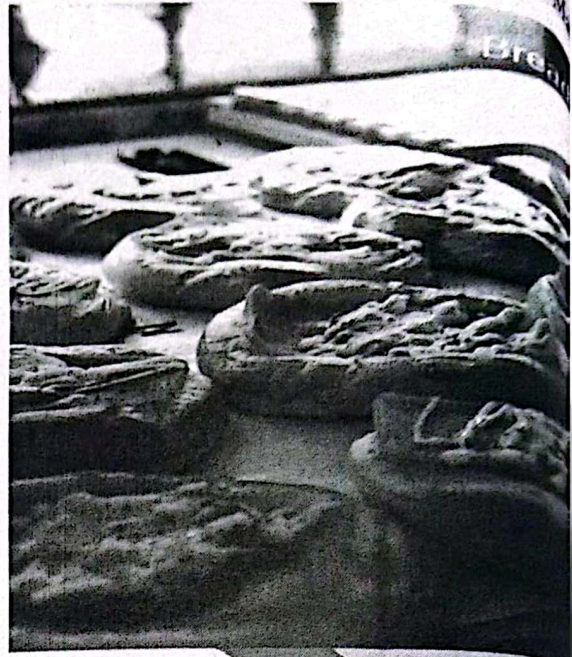
continues until December 23, 2023, and its accreditation in Chemical Testing, until August 28, 2024. Ms. Jenny S. Bronburac and Ms. Shaine M. Fonacier are granted approved signatory status in Biological Testing. On the other hand, Ms. Agnes G. Morales, Ms. Norshida T. Alimoden, Ms. Jasmin C. Hamid, Ms. Maria Teresa A. Pamplona, Ms. Ma. Lorelie P. Dorado, Mr. Mark Anthony R. Rodriguez, and Ms. Renalyn D. Mendoza are granted approved signatory status in Chemical Testing.

RML

With the aim to render internationally traceable measurements, and consequently to contribute in the fair trade of goods, the RML calibration offers services for mass, pressure, temperature, humidity, length, electrical and small volume.

The RML accreditation continues until May 21, 2023. Engr. Rogerson A. Esmeria, Engr. Mark Gilbert E. Marasigan and Mr. John June L. Paran are granted approved signatory status for the RML on the following: Masses, Weighing Devices, Pressure and Vacuum Measuring Devices, Calibration of Temperature Measurement Equipment, and Calibration of Temperature-Controlled Enclosure.
