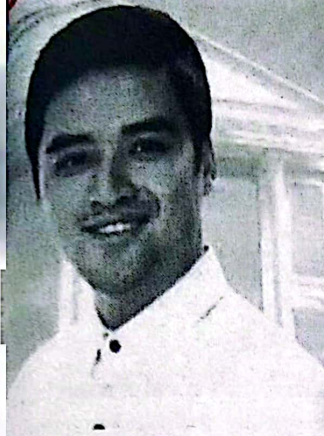


"Hindi kailangan ng permit, wala po tayong permit to help" - Pasig City Mayor Vico Sotto

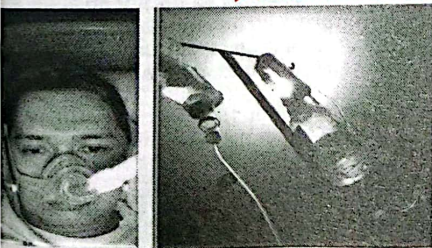

SM City Trece Martires and SM City Rosario Team Up With LGU for COVID-19 Vaccination Drive

SM Supermalls' SM City Trece Martires and SM City Rosario in Cavite, in its pursuit to fight the spread of COVID-19 and with its continuous support for the government, teamed up with their respective local government unit to provide a convenient, safe, and accessible venue for COVID-19 vaccination.

A total of more than 900 medical health workers, front liners, senior citizens and indigents in the municipality of Trece Martires and Rosario were given priority for immunization. This is in line with the vaccination program of the government dubbed as "Resbakuna, Kasangga ng Bida" in response to combat the virus and protect the citizens of both municipalities.

The kick-off happened at the Cinema lobby of SM City Rosario. Led and administered by the city

health office of Rosario, the first round was a success with a total of 200 vaccinated front liners.

SM City Trece Martires on the other hand, had its simulation activity conducted prior to the vaccination day to ensure the smooth flow and proper implementation of the safety protocols. Ngayon ay laganap na, isa nang bagong fad o trending activities sa ating bansa ang community pantry na binigyan ng bagong mukha, at pangalan ng 26-anyos na si Ana Patricia Non, mas kilala si "Patreng" sa itinayo niyang 'sharing of food' sa Barangay Maginhawa, Quezon City.

Sa pantry, walang bayad na makakukuha ng bigas, mga gulay, itlog, de-latang pagkain at bitamina at ang pakiusap na: Magbigay, ayon sa kakayahan; kumuha ayon sa pangangailangan.

Nakalulungkot lamang na isang pangkat ng babae ang nakita sa video na sinimot ang libreng food items sa isang community pantry (CP).

Kaya lang, may pumansin sa intensiyon ni Patring nang sabihin sa media na kaya siya nag-CP kasi, palpak raw ang ayuda ng gobyerno kaya marami ang nagugutom.

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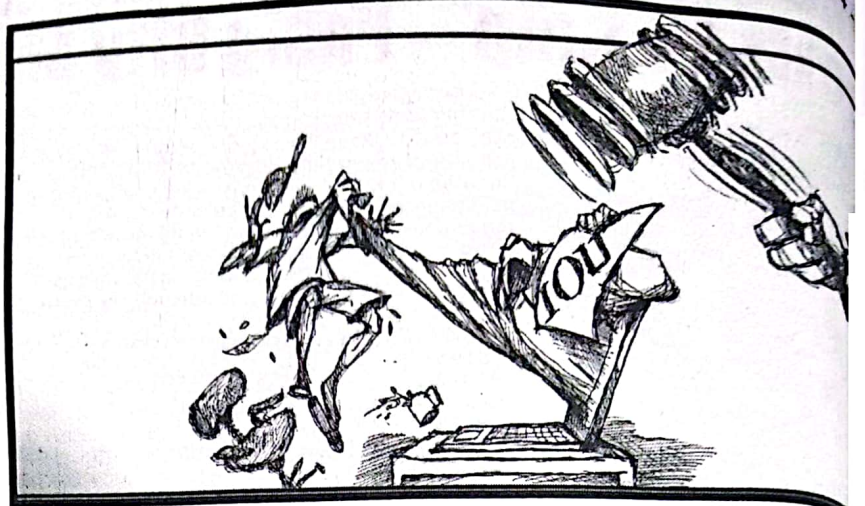

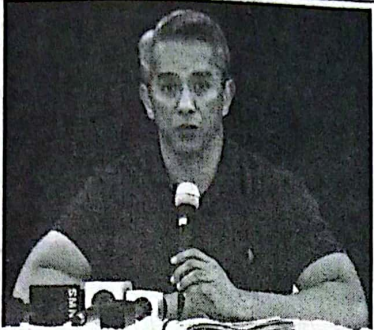

DOH-CALABARZON CLARIFIES PHP681 SRA PAY FOR LUCENA CITY NURSE

Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) Assistant Regional Director Paula Paz M. Sydliongco today issued a statement clarifying the social media post of a staff nurse of Mount Carmel Diocesan General Hospital in Lucena City, Quezon who received Php681.82 for his special risk allowance or SRA.

According to Dr. Sydliongco, based on the Certificate of Employment (COE) and Daily Time Records (DTR) of Mark Raven Dominguez, as validated by the concerned hospital in which he was employed, he only reported physically for work to the hospital for three (3) days for the month of November 2020 and none for September, October and December of the same year.

"The amount he received, which he posted on his social media page is equivalent only to the three (3) days he reported for work, as shown in his validated daily time record," she stated.

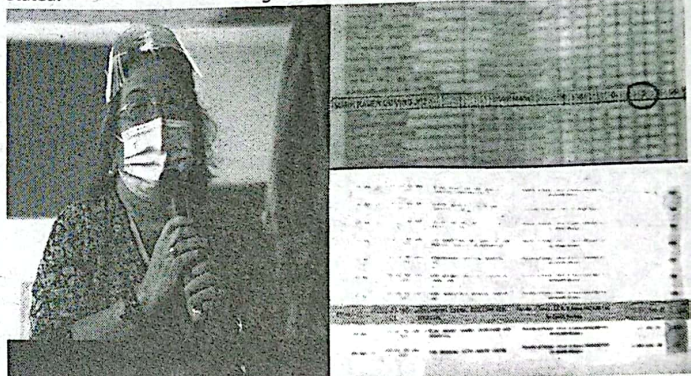
"Furthermore, the Administrative Order No. 36, series of 2020, authorizing the grant of SRA to private and public health workers only apply to health workers directly serving or in contact with Covid-19 patients. It is computed by the actual number of days a staff is physically reporting for work," she explained.

In addition, the regional office has already downloaded to Mount Carmel Diocesan General Hospital on March 9, 2021 for the payment of SRAs of health workers based on their validated COEs and DTRs.

"We hope that this will enlighten the matter. And

for future concerns, we advised our health workers to file their complaint directly to the regional office of the to the hospital concerned. As necessary, avoid posting issues and concerns publicly through social media as this will only cause conflict and anxiety to the public who have no knowledge of the issue at hand."

"The Department of Health remains committed in addressing issues and concerns raised by our medical frontliners and ensures the adaption of policies for the protection, welfare and benefit of all health care workers, especially during this pandemic," Sydliongco emphasized.

DOST-CALABARZON, together with DOST-TAPI and DOST-PCIEERD, is set to lead the conduct of its Technology Transfer Day on 7 May 2021, 1:00PM to 5:30PM via Zoom, to showcase local technologies and innovations and build partnerships with potential technology adopters in the region.

Bagsit, OIC-Regional Director of DOST-CALABARZON, said, "One result of this activity is the established partnerships and linkages with experts that would be very essential as this may lead to further coaching and mentoring in the next stages." This activity was followed by a back-to-back "One-day Workshop on Investment Pitching for Potential Startup Founders" and a "Mock Pitching" session last March.

As the last phase of the StARTT program, The Technology Transfer Day will serve as an avenue for the participants to apply what they have learned from the previous workshops through the actual pitching of their technologies to potential technology adopters and other institutions for technology commercialization.

Under the Philippine Technology Transfer Act of 2009 which prompted the conduct of DOST's Technology Transfer Day, DOST-CALABARZON aims to similarly fast track technology transfer and commercialization in the region through such efforts.

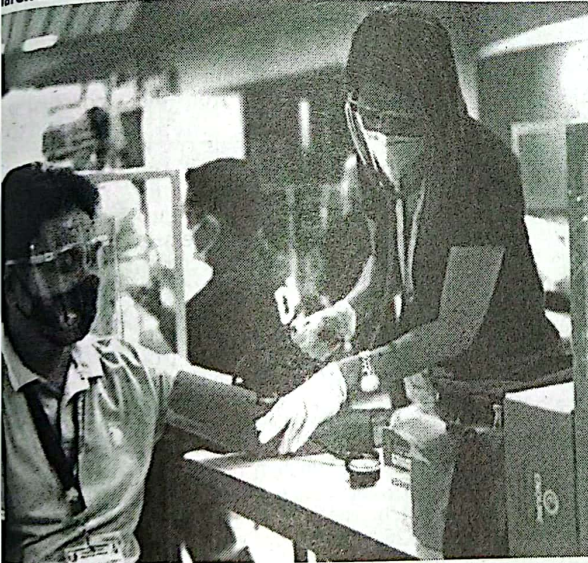

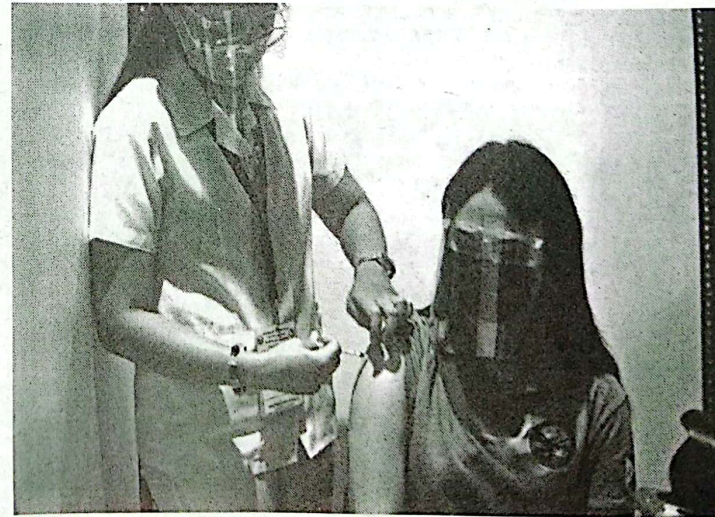

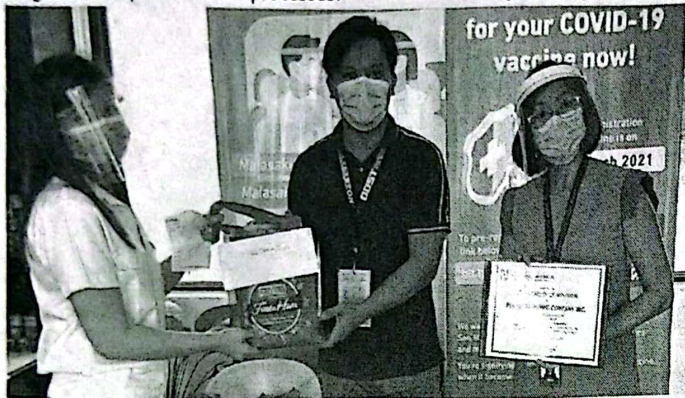
Mr. Peña and Ms. Bronburac alternated in detailing the HACCP and recommending ways to prevent, control, and reduce hazards in all stages of food production:

workers), 103,303 individuals have received their first shot and 8,885 were given their second shot.

For priority group A2 (senior citizens), 26,854 received their first jab and 62 got their second shot.

For priority group A3 (persons with comorbidity) 27,099 got their first vaccine and 271 have their second dose.

There are a total of 298 vaccination sites registered in the DOH - COVID-19 Bakuna Center Registry (CBCR), 47 of these are in Cavite, 74 from Laguna, 79 in Batangas, 43 in Rizal, 46 in Quezon and 9 from Lucena City.

CALABARZON received a total of 305,660 vaccine

doses for first and second dose use, 228,860 doses are Sinovac and 76,800 doses are AstraZeneca.

The regional office has already delivered 303,369 doses to vaccination sites in various provinces, 226,569 doses of Sinovac and 76,800 doses of AstraZeneca. There are only 2,291 doses of Sinovac left for distribution.

As of April 28, 2021, there are a total of 2,485 new Covid-19 cases added in the region reaching a total of 130,123 infections.

There are 24,451 active cases while 102,208 have recovered. A total of 3,464 death were reported.

The province with the

highest number of Covid cases is Cavite with 38,652 followed by Laguna with 30,301; Rizal with 29,067; Batangas - 22,793 and Quezon with 7,915 cases. Lucena City has a total of 1,926.

A total of 2,108 Covid dedicated beds are already occupied including ward, ICU and isolation beds in various hospitals in the region with a total of 1,198 vacant.

Meanwhile, the stock box community pantry in the municipality of Silang put up by Marvin Garcia caught the attention of netizens with the comic tag lines that remind people to take as they need.

"We don't mean to offend anyone. So we thought of a fun way to tell them," Garcia explained.

Government agencies also joined the bandwagon of goodhearted citizens such as the BARANGAYANIhan Community Pantry of the Trece Martires Component Police Station (CPS) headed by PltCol. Jose Junar Alamo together with the Sangguniang Barangay Condu as they gave out

noodles, rice, coffee, and sardines to the residents in need.

Aside from food sharing, LTO Carmona employees distributed road safety flyers and leaflets in their Hapag Damayan Community Pantry as part of its continuing efforts to keep the road safe for all.

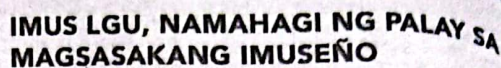
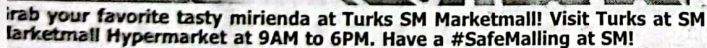

DOH-CALABARZON REPORTS 15TH ELIGIBLE VACCINATION GOT COVID

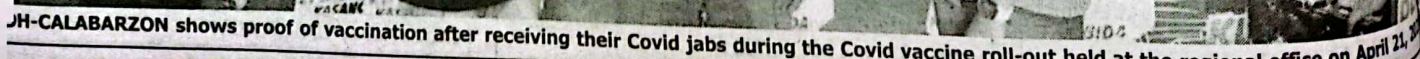
The Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) today reported a total of 157,256 population vaccinated with the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine at established vaccination sites in the region.

"Although we have the fixed vaccination sites, we also allow our vaccination teams go on a house-to-house drive to reach target individuals to be vaccinated.
