SHFC, a government owned controlled corporation is the lead government agency to undertake financing of social housing programs that will cater to the formal and informal sectors in the low-income.

This housing project according to Mayor Randy Salamat will be on a rent-to-own financing payable to the national government thru SHFC within 30 years by qualified

Local ordinance to protect public, care for dogs' welfare

In the wake of the consequential problem of residents bitten by stray dogs in the city of Dasmariñas, 4th District of Cavite Representative Pidi Barzaga proposed the drafting of a city ordinance that will address the said problem, not only to protect the public but to care for the dogs welfare as well.

According to the congressman, the city government allocates almost a million pesos of the LGU's funds on a monthly basis for the purchase of rabies vaccine.

He also cited that 50% of the victims were children or members of the household of the dog owners.

As part of this initiative, the city government will undertake the construction of a big impounding center to house the stray dogs with the support of a centralized dog catching system.








AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 268-2020, AS AMENDED, TO CHANGE THE CU HOURS FROM 8:00 PM TO 5:00 AM TO 10:00 PM TO 4:00 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 cases has again increased at an alarming rate in the Province of Cavite since the quarantine regulations became less:

WHEREAS, continual implementation of curfew hours is deemed necessary to regulate the movement of the people, thus, will somehow help in the of the spread of the virus;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Ambion, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it ord: Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Provincial Ordinance No. 268-2020, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

Section 2. Prohibited Acts - It shall be unlawful for the public to loiter, wander, stroll, play or to remain or stay in public places within the territorial of the Province of Cavite without legal justifiable reason from 10:00 PM to 4:00 AM of the following day, daily, unless falling under herein exceptions

It shall also be unlawful for any parent or guardian of a child to knowingly permit or negligently allow the child to remain in any public place within to fCavite during curfew hours. Parents and guardians of minors are expected to keep their minor children from leaving their home.

SECTION 2. Repealing Clause. All other resolutions and ordinances which are inconsistent to this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified a

SECTION 3. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by competer such judgment or action shall not affect or impair other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 4. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after its approval.

Among those who received their first dose of Sinovac jabs were from the transportation, manufacturing, food at janitorial service sector.

On April 15, 2021, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases has approved the vaccination of Priority Group A4 which includes commuter transport (iand,

air, and sea), including logistics; public and private wet and dry market vendors; frontline workers in groceries, supermarkets, delivery services; workers in manufacturing for food, beverage, medical and pharmaceutical products; frontline workers in food retail, including food service delivery; frontline workers in private and government financial services; and frontline workers in hotels and accommodation establishments.

Also included in the Priority Group A4 list are priests, rabbis, imams, and other religious leaders; security guards/ personnel assigned in offices, agencies, and organizations identified in the list of priority industries/sectors; frontline workers in private and government news media; customer-facing personnel of telecoms, cable and internet service providers, electricity distribution and water distribution utilities;

frontline personnel in basic education and higher education institutions and agencies; and overseas Filipino workers, including those scheduled for deployment within two months.

Frontline workers in law/ justice, security, and social protection sectors; sectors; frontline government workers engaged in the operations of government transport system, quarantine inspection; worker safety inspection and other COVID-19

response activities: frontline government workers in charge of tax collection, assessment of businesses for incentives, election, national ID, data collection personnel; diplomatic community and Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) personnel in consular operations; and the Department of Public Works and Highways personnel in charge of monitoring government infrastructure projects are also part of the Priority Group A4 list.

Sydiongco assured that the sectors included in the A4 lists will be receiving their Covid jabs through the established vaccination centers in their area.

"I encouraged all individuals included in the A4 group to enlist and get vaccinated. It is better to have additional protection against the virus than not at all."

The regional office was joined by officials and staff of the Department of Labor and Employment -Calabarzon, Laguna Provincial Health Office and Calamba City Health Office during ceremonial vaccination activity.



"Unlike In other countries, very few in the Philippines have explored the potential and utilization of the non-fruit parts of the mango, such as the bark and leaves," Sapin said.

Sapin's team looked for the presence polyphenolic compounds in the local mango leaves, along with the antioxidant capacity and inhibitory effect against elastase and tyrosinase – enzymes which cause aging and darkening of skin.

Previous studies on foreign mango cultivars reveal that mango leaves are excellent source of polyphenolic compounds, which provides health benefits such antioxidation, antidiabetic, anti-cancer, and anti-inflammatory properties,

among others. Abroad, mango leaves have proven its application in food, pharmaceuticals, and cosmetics. In fact, there have been an approved patent, such as that of Loreal's, on the extraction and application of polyphenols from mango leaves.

In terms of skin whitening, extracts from young leaves of pico and carabao varieties were most potent in inhibiting tyrosinase, the skin darkening enzyme. On the other hand, among the extracts from the mature

leaves, the apple mango exhibited the greatest potency. While these extracts are better whitening agent than the ascorbic acid, such is not the case with kojic acid.

In terms of anti-aging, extract from apple mango leaves was the most potent elastase (enzyme for aging) inhibitor, which was about two times to four times more potent than the other extracts. Compared the standard tocopherol (Vitamin E compound commonly found in nuts, oil, and vegetables), the mango leaf extracts were probably 10 times more effective.

"The results of this study could provide consumers with effective nature-based ingredients for safer cosmetic products, and for healthier and beautiful skin, as an alternative to the synthetic ones available in the market," Sapin said.







LOCAL MANGO LEAVES FOUND AS EFFE SOURCE OF ANTI-AGING AND SKI WHITENING INGREDIENTS, STUDY 9


Extracts of the local mango leaves have shown great potential as ingredient with good antioxidant, anti-aging, and whitening phased on the study conducted by a team of researchers lead by B. Sapin of the National Institute of Molecular Biology and Bioter of the University of the Philippines Los Baños.

This research on the "Evaluation of the Bioactivities of Natural Phenolics from Mango (Mangifera indica Linn) Leaves for Cosmetic Industry Applications," investigated samples of fresh leaves of mango cultivars (carabao, apple mango, pico, sinaging, and sipsipin) collected from San Miguel, Bulacan to explore its possible cosmetic applications.



While mango has been one of the top three produced and exported or country, most studies centered on the industry profitability, mainly on fruit production, and processing.
