Local ordinance to protect public, care for dogs' welfare

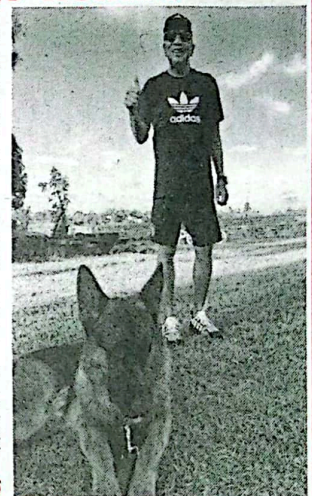
In the wake of the consequential problem of residents bitten by stray dogs in the city of Dasmariñas, 4th District of Cavite Representative Pidi Barzaga proposed the drafting of a city ordinance that will address the said problem, not only to protect the public but to care for the dogs' welfare as well.

According to the congressman, the city government allocates almost a million pesos of the LGU's funds on a monthly basis for the purchase of rabies vaccine.

He also cited that 50% of the victims were children or members of the household of the dog owners.

As part of this initiative, the city government will undertake the construction of a big impounding center to house the stray dogs with the support of a centralized dog catching system.

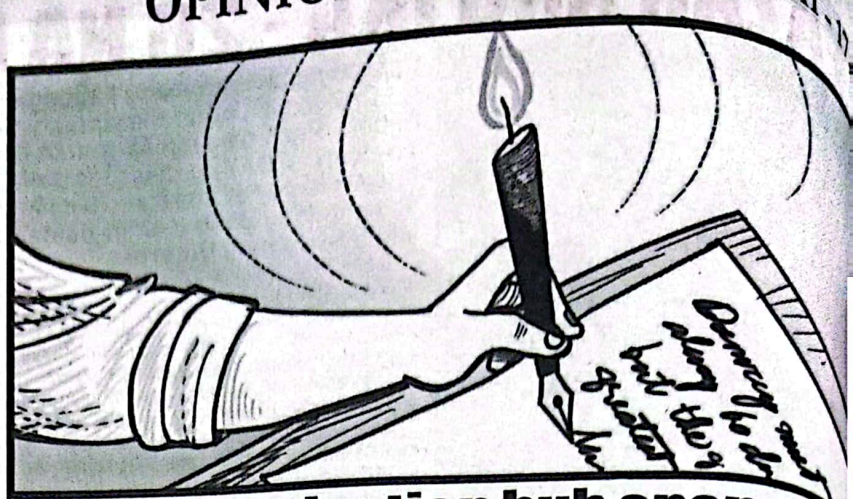

4th Vaccination hub opened to speed up distribution of vaccine

Bacoor, Cavite May 7, 2021 – The City Government here recently opened the vaccination hub at Queensrow Elementary School, the fourth vaccination site in the city.

The additional vaccination site will contribute to the speedy distribution of the CoViD-19 vaccines for the LGUs intensified campaign for the city's vaccination program.

A total of 1,377 Bacoreños were vaccinated with the continuous inoculation of the senior citizens (A2) and those with comorbidities (A3) in all four vaccination sites.

During the said opening, 286 residents were vaccinated while simultaneous vaccination activities gave out vaccine jabs as follows: 317 at Bacoor Elementary

School; 328 Coliseum; at the Niog Elementary School.

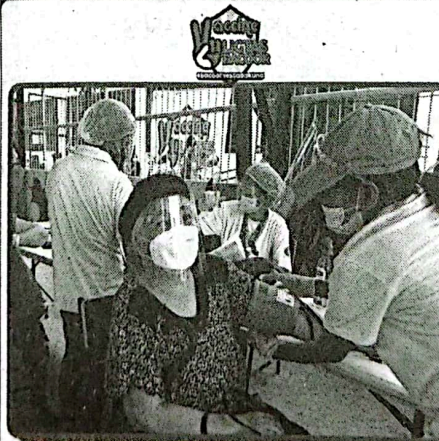

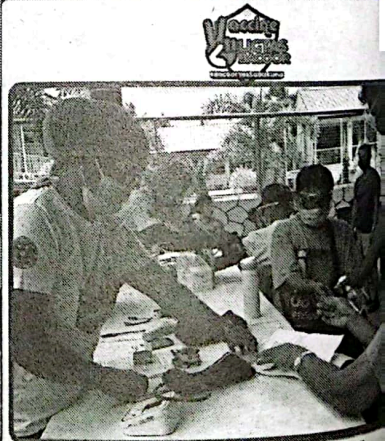

16. Spay and neuter your cat. Female cats should be spayed and male cats neutered by five months of age. This will prevent them from any reproductive diseases.

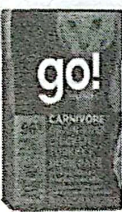

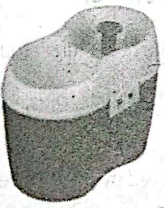

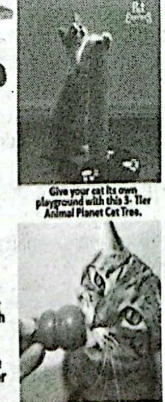

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 321-2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 268-2020, AS AMENDED, TO CHANGE THE CURFEW HOURS FROM 8:00 PM TO 5:00 AM TO 10:00 PM TO 4:00 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY

Sponsored by: **Hon. Reyniel "Rainier" A. Ambion**
 Chair, Committee on Peace, Public Safety and Order

Co-Sponsored by: **All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members**

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 cases has again increased at an alarming rate in the Province of Cavite since the quarantine regulations became less strict;

WHEREAS, continual implementation of curfew hours is deemed necessary to regulate the movement of the people, thus, will somehow help in the containment of the spread of the virus;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Ambion, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it ordained that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Provincial Ordinance No. 268-2020, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

Section 2. Prohibited Acts - It shall be unlawful for the public to loiter, wander, stroll, play or to remain or stay in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Cavite without legal justifiable reason from 10:00 PM to 4:00 AM of the following day, daily, unless falling under herein exceptions:

It shall also be unlawful for any parent or guardian of a child to knowingly permit or negligently allow the child to remain in any public place within the territorial jurisdiction of Cavite during curfew hours. Parents and guardians of minors are expected to keep their minor children from leaving their home.


SECTION 2. Repealing Clause. All other resolutions and ordinances which are inconsistent to this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 3. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, such judgment or action shall not affect or impair other sections or provisions thereof.

SECTION 4. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after its approval.

INDIVIDUALS FROM PRIORITY GROUP A4 RECEIVES FIRST DOSE OF COVID VACCINE IN CALABARZON

Labor Day celebration, workers in CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) yesterday were given their first shot of Covid-19 provide them additional protection as they continue to do business and work for our people.

On April 15, 2021, the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases has approved the vaccination of Priority Group A4 which includes commuter transport (land,

air, and sea), including logistics; public and private wet and dry market vendors; frontline workers in groceries, supermarkets, delivery services; workers in manufacturing for food, beverage, medical and pharmaceutical products; frontline workers in food retail, including food service delivery; frontline workers in private and government financial services; and frontline workers in hotels and accommodation establishments.

Also included in the Priority Group A4 list are priests, rabbis, imams, and other religious leaders; security guards/ personnel assigned in offices, agencies, and organizations identified in the list of priority industries/sectors; frontline workers in private and government news media; customer-facing personnel of telecoms, cable and internet service providers, electricity distribution and water distribution utilities;

frontline personnel in basic education and higher education institutions and agencies; and overseas Filipino workers, including those scheduled for deployment within two months.

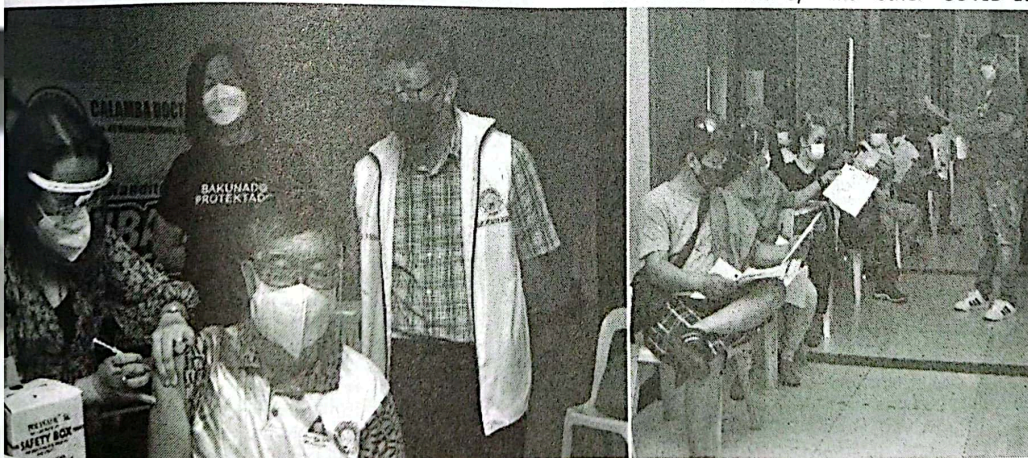
Frontline workers in law/ justice, security, and social protection sectors; frontline government workers engaged in the operations of government transport system, quarantine inspection; worker safety inspection and other COVID-19

response activities; frontline government workers in charge of tax collection, assessment of businesses for incentives, election, national ID, data collection personnel; diplomatic community and Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) personnel in consular operations; and the Department of Public Works and Highways personnel in charge of monitoring government infrastructure projects are also part of the Priority Group A4 list.

Sydigongco assured that the sectors included in the A4 lists will be receiving their Covid jabs through the established vaccination centers in their area.

"I encouraged all individuals included in the A4 group to enlist and get vaccinated. It is better to have additional protection against the virus than not at all."

The regional office was joined by officials and staff of the Department of Labor and Employment - Calabarzon, Laguna Provincial Health Office and Calamba City Health Office during the ceremonial vaccination activity.

within ten (10) days with a corresponding fine. Dogs that will not be redeemed within said period will be placed for adoption, while those that

will not be adopted will be "euthanized" by Republic of the Philippines. Moreover, a dog owner who wants to breed a dog must



from the city government. Puppies also need to have a cage and a corresponding space.

A public hearing will be held for the drafting of said ordinance with the concerned stakeholders present to give their views

on the proposed ordinance.

This ordinance will not only address the safety of the public but also prevent the proliferation of stray dogs, resolve related sanitation problems and will significantly reduce the

budget spent on anti-rabies the savings used for other projects.

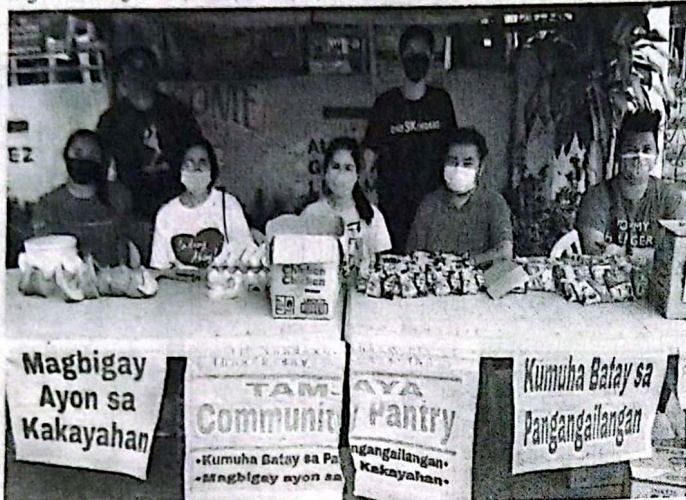

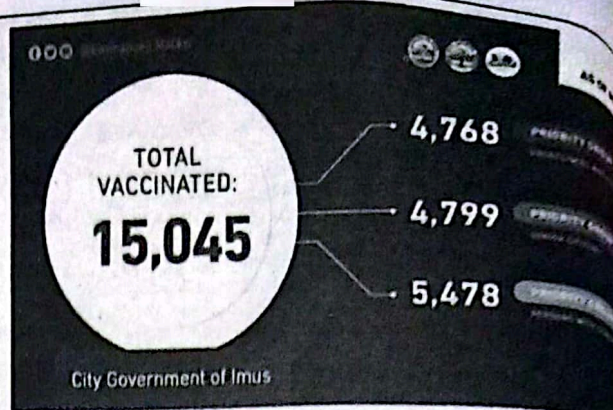

LOCAL MANGO LEAVES FOUND AS EFFECTIVE SOURCE OF ANTI-AGING AND SKIN WHITENING INGREDIENTS, STUDY SA

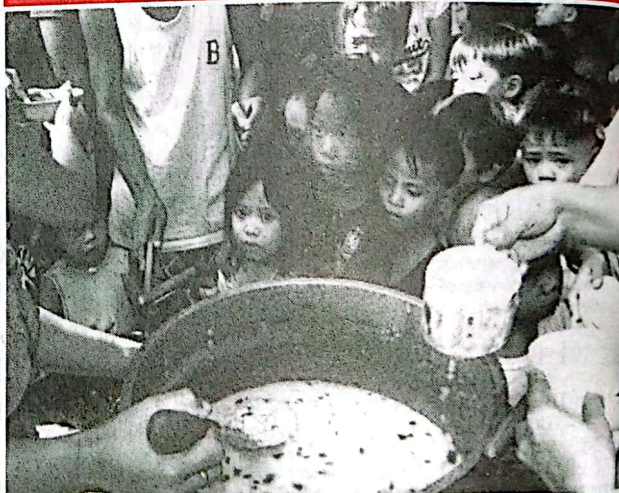
Extracts of the local mango leaves have shown great potential as ingredient with good antioxidant, anti-aging, and whitening properties based on the study conducted by a team of researchers lead by B. Sapin of the National Institute of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology of the University of the Philippines Los Baños.

This research on the "Evaluation of the Bioactivities of Natural Phenolics from Mango (Mangifera indica Linn) Leaves for Cosmetic Industry Applications," investigated samples of fresh leaves of mango cultivars (carabao, apple mango, pico, sinaging, and sipsipin) collected from San Miguel, Bulacan to explore its possible cosmetic applications.



While mango has been one of the top three produced and exported crop in the country, most studies centered on the industry profitability, mainly on fruit production, and processing. **LOCAL M**
