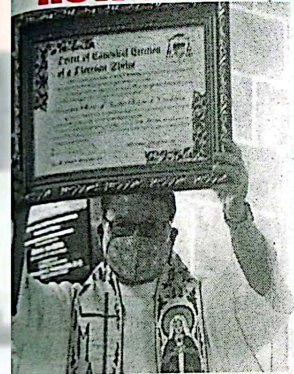

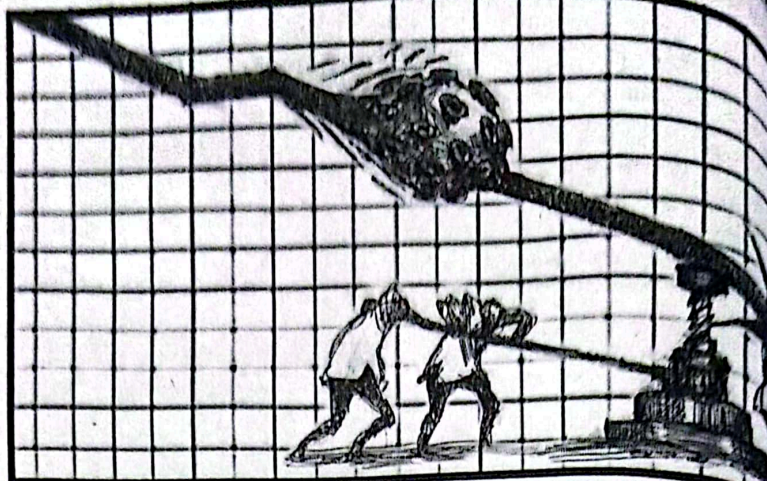

BRINGING HEALTH TECHNOLOGIES TO BICOLANO PEOPLE THROUGH BIOTEK-M™

The Department of Science and Technology Regional Office V (DOST-V) provides support amounting to Php 5,590,000 for the adoption of Biotek-M™ Dengue Aqua Kit in Bicol Region. Through the assistance of the Department of Health – Center for Disease Development (DOH-CHD) Bicol, the test kits will be deployed to district hospitals/public health centers accessible to communities assisted under the DOST's Community Empowerment Science and Technology (CEST) program in the region.



Medical technologists from 26 district hospitals/public healthcare centers in Bicol underwent hands-on training on Biotek-M™ Dengue Aqua Test Kit and NAAT Lamp (Lab-in-a-

Mug) on 27-30 April 2021 at Sto. Domingo, Albay. This training activity served as a significant component of the kit's successful deployment to district hospitals/public

healthcare centers.

The Biotek-M™ Dengue Aqua Kit is part of the "Lab-in-a-Mug Project" which integrates and miniaturizes all diagnostic kits into isothermal units as small as a mug. It functions as a multi-infectious disease diagnostic device similar to a portable laboratory. The Filipino scientists at the Institute of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology, National Institute of Health, University of the Philippines Manila led by Dr. Raul V. Destura conceptualized and designed the project. Manila HealthTek, Inc., a spinoff company of the project, directs the commercialization of the test kit.

The kit employs the

principle of isothermal amplification (LAMP). 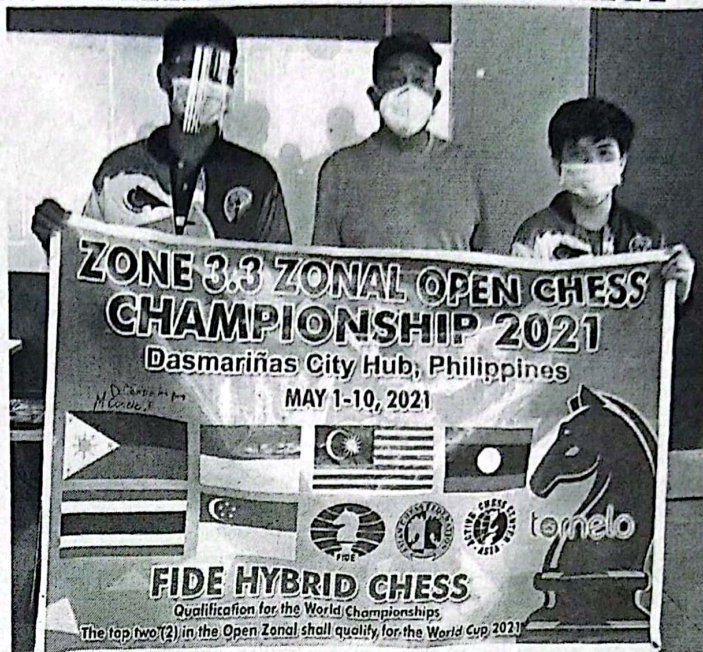

From the 25 technologies assessed in the previous activities under STARTT program, the Technology Transfer Day featured 12 technologies from CALABARZON and NCR regions and was attended by 224 participants including DOST key officials such as Secretary Fortunato T. de la Peña and Mr. Romeo Javate, Chief SRS from DOST-TAPI to represent their director, Engr. Edgar Garcia.

Other esteemed guests, Dr. Rowena Cristina L. Guevara, DOST Undersecretary for R&D; Dr. Renato U. Solidum, DOST OIC-Undersecretary for ROS and Undersecretary for STS; and Dr. Enrico C. Paringit, DOST-PCIEERD Executive Director, extended their support by sending their recorded messages.

In her opening message, DOST-CALABARZON OIC-Regional Director Emelita P. Bagsit remarked, "We hope to provide more platforms in showcasing your technologies and connect you to more networks, partners, and linkages for your technologies." She assured the participants that DOST-CALABARZON will continuously assist them in ensuring the activity's sustainability.

Meanwhile, Mr. Javate relayed Dir. Garcia's message where he emphasized the importance of the previous STARTT activities conducted last February

and March, in order to prepare the technology generators in the actual pitching of the fruits of their labor.

"These homegrown technologies are made for the benefit of our local industries and society as a whole," the letter read, "We hope that the participants will use this venue to establish linkages and partnerships with the technology generators."

With DOST-PCIEERD as one of the partner agencies, Dr. Paringit presented the council's innovative programs supporting the technology transfer such as IP Management Program for Academic Institutions Commercializing Technologies, KTTO-IMPACT Program, Funding Assistance for Spinoff and Translation of Research in Advancing Commercialization, Higher Education Institute Readiness for Innovation and Technopreneurship, Technology Business Incubation 4.0 Program, Startup Research Grant Program, i-NEST Program, and WHWise Program.

Highlighting the importance of technology transfer in the R&D process, Usec. Guevara also presented DOST's Technology Transfer Programs. In her video message, she advised the participants that they should not consider their research to be finished until the technology is transferred.

Dr. Guevara further

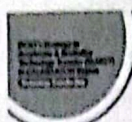
remarked, "This is being done because we want to maximize the impact of your research on the Filipino people."

Furthermore, Usec. Solidum echoed the sentiments of the previous speakers in terms of viewing technology transfer as an integral process aimed at improving the lives of Filipinos.

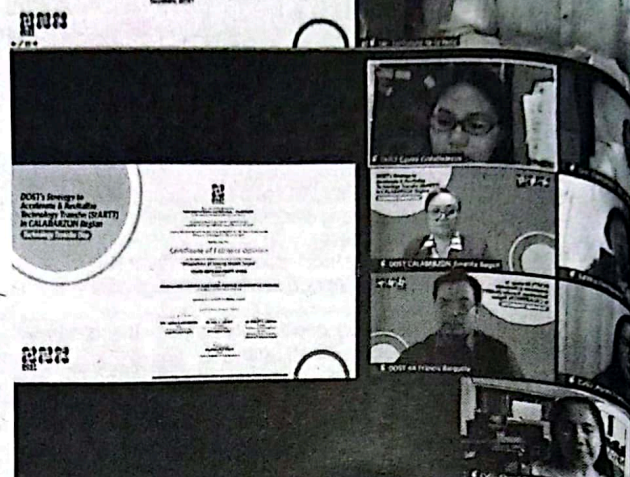
He acknowledged the importance of the possible technology adopters' role in technology transfer, "Without you, we cannot achieve our goal of a progressive S&T country. Let us work hand-in-hand to determine the needs and address them through the development of proper technologies. This is also a way of supporting our own local technologies. Your presence tells us of your support, trust, and confidence in the skills and capabilities of our technology generators."

Virtually present in the event was DOST Secretary Fortunato T. de la Peña who further encouraged the establishment of partnerships with different potential technology adopters including the entrepreneurs, manufacturers, investors, local government units (LGUs), non-government organizations (NGOs), and other industry players.

Sec. de la Peña said, "We are here to establish sustainable partnerships and linkages that would enable us to better showcase the Filipino ingenuity and support their continuous growth

and development all for the benefit of our stakeholders and of our country."

Afterwards, Ms. Gilda S. de Jesus, SRS II of DOST-PSTC Cavite, together with the members of the Fairness Opinion Board, recognized the RDIs and SUCs and their commercialized technologies in the awarding of certificates. The following technologies were recognized: Production of Kaong Brown Sugar, Meat Hyacinth Dryer, Cacao Bean Roaster, Cacao Desheller/Winnower, and Cacao Grinder.

A Virtual Presser was also conducted to facilitate and address questions from the local and national media, directed at the VIPs.

With submissions from various RDIs and SUCs including the University of the Philippines Manila, Southern Luzon State University, DOST-ITDI,

Cavite State University, and Batangas State University, the video presentations of the 12 technologies were divided into four categories: Health and Wellness Technologies, Food Products and Processing, Industrial Technologies, and Disaster Risk Reduction and Management. After each presentation, an open forum was conducted to enable the discussion between both Zoom and Facebook Live attendees and the technology generators themselves with regards to their products.

After all the technology pitches, Engr. Francisco Barquilla III, OIC-Assistant Regional Director for Technical Operations of DOST-CALABARZON, delivered the closing remarks. He said that the Technology Transfer Day, despite being the last of STARTT's series of activities, is just the beginning of a larger vision in fast tracking the

commercialized technologies CALABARZON. he called for more for DOST-CALABARZON initiatives for R&D. "We hope the concerted effort enable research development to new and in products, we'll make an impact on the economy continuously on the country's index," Engr. said.

"COMMUNITY HERO" SHOT DEAD

PANDI, Bulacan -- A construction worker who was considered a hero in this town was shot dead recently by an unidentified suspect last in Angeles City.

Police report said that Jeffrey Ariz, 35 where with some 25 of his friends early morning of May 7 while fixing construction materials to be used in fencing the property of a private land developer.

Ariz, according to his live-in partner, Nerissa A. Frianela, 29, was a good leader and headed a 'breakaway' group from the controversial leftist group Kalipunan ng Damayang Mahihirap (Kadamay).

Sources said that Ariz's group was supposedly sub-contracted by Excelsum Properties Solutions, Inc. (EPSI).

In 2017, Kadamay members took over and illegally occupied a government housing project built for uniformed personnel of government and as resettlement for informal settlers (IS) in Pandi.

Kadamay led 8,494 families, or about 12,000 people, in forcibly entering idle houses at six social housing projects in Mapulang Lupa, Masuso, Cacarong Matanda, Cacarong Bata and Siling Bata villages on March 8, 2017.

The reckless take-over by the Kadamay drew the ire of President Rodrigo Duterte but later persuaded soldiers and policemen to drop their

claims to the houses to prevent bloodshed.

In 2019, Ariz and some 300 others disbanded themselves from Kadamay and returned to the government fold, according to published reports.

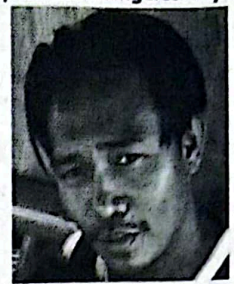
Frianela said that Jeffrey seemingly had premonitions of what would happen to him.

"Nung umalis siya ng umagang iyon, sinabi niya na bahala na raw yong mga kasamahan niyang magtuloy ng trabahong naiwan niya. Tapos sumasakit ulo niya noon at ayaw niya sanang pumasok kaya lang kailangang magtrabaho," Frianela recalled.

Ariz was shot at close range and sustained a gunshot wound on his chest and was declared dead on arrival at the Angeles University Foundation Medical Center.

An eyewitness, who requested anonymity, said that a group of men believed to be from the group of IS who refused to leave the private property, arrived at their place of work.

Another eyewitness who asked not to be named said that this group of men were "hardliners" allegedly being coddled and led by a certain Pyra Lucas.

Lucas, according to sources, had claimed to be a Pampanga coordinator of Volunteers Against Crime and Corruption (VACC) but documents show, she was already ousted by the group.

In a statement released to media, Hausland Development Corporation condemned the killing of Ariz.

"Hausland condemns in the strongest possible terms, this terroristic and criminal act. We call upon authorities to investigate the case with deliberate dispatch, arrest all those criminal perpetrators, their supporters and funders," its statement read.

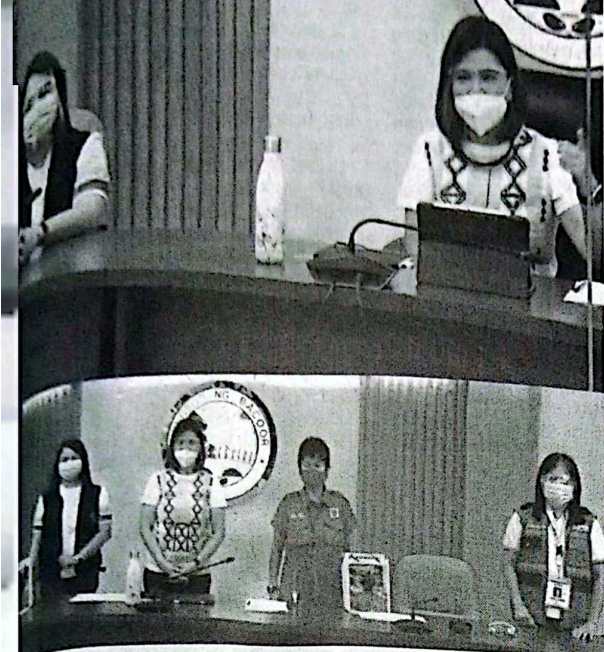
EPSI has sent its lawyer, Jairus Baldemor Rubio, to assist the bereaved family of Ariz in its quest for justice and to extend financial assistance.

Ariz left behind two young boys, seven and a year old sons.

the Council of Presbyters Diocese of Imus, the solemn declaration went through memorably last May 4, amidst the strict health protocol of the pandemic.

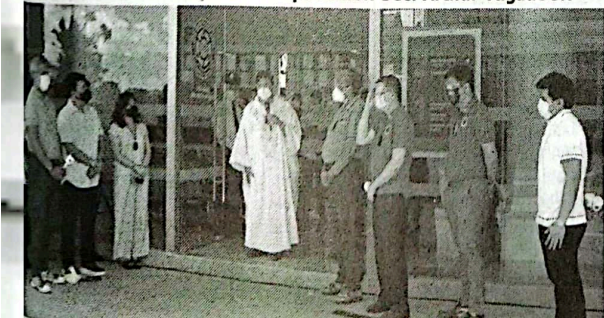

Upland Cavite, "is a testament of the ever-growing devotion to Our Lady of Candelaria whose Marian devotion history can be traced back as early as 1640."

"A timely event, as the nation celebrates 500 years of Christianity, this declaration acknowledges Silang Church's role in the mission of evangelization since most of the upland churches were born from the Mother Church of Silang," adds Medina.

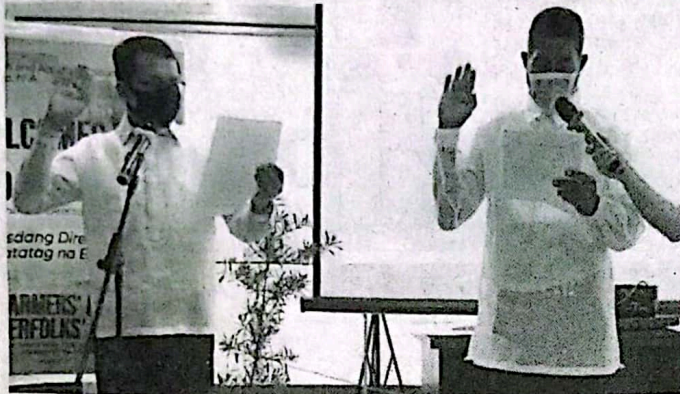

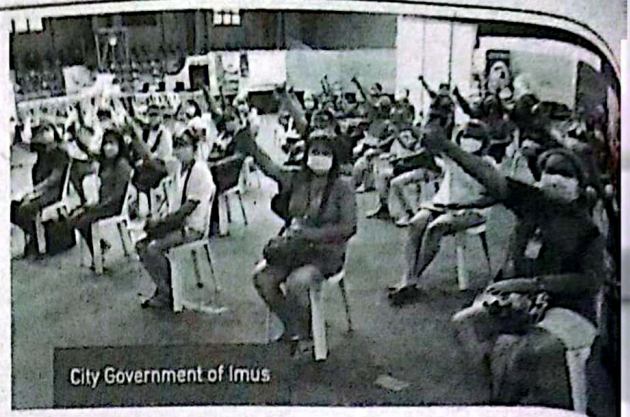
