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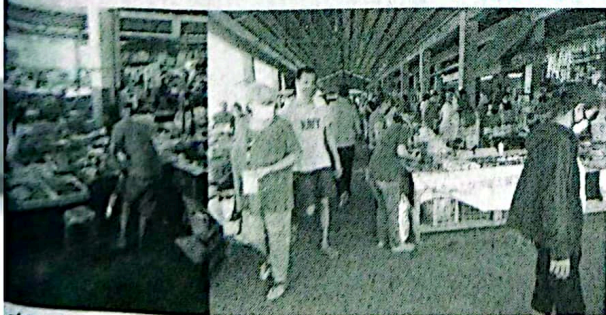

DTI 4-A's SSF-assisted coop runs 1st eco-friendly PUVs in Cavite

In line with the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP) of the Department of Transportation to make the country's public transportation system efficient and environment-friendly by 2020, a beneficiary of the Department of Trade and Industry Region 4-A's Shared Service Facilities Program—the Silang Transport Service and Development Cooperative (STSDC)—introduced their 23 new and modernized units of PUV to provide service in Imus City and Silang, Cavite last May 21, 2020.

DOH CALABARZON STRENGTHENS OWN HEALTH SYSTEM TO FIGHT DISEASES BEYOND COVID PANDEMIC

The Department of Health (DOH)- CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) has been strengthening its health system by establishing more health facilities and developing and upgrading existing hospitals including competencies of health care workers in the region not only to fight the current COVID 19 virus but also to fight diseases beyond the present pandemic.

"As part of the 'new normal', a health system must be ready to fight any epidemic that may occur such as the present COVID 19 pandemic or any other diseases that may endanger the health of the community," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo strongly stated.

"We now have two regional hospitals that can serve people from various municipalities of the region, the Batangas Medical Center in Batangas and the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Cavite, two specimen testing laboratories in the region at the Lucena United Doctors General Hospital in Quezon and the De La Salle Medical Health and Sciences Institute in Cavite."

Janairo added that the regional office is in the process of utilizing other health facilities in other provinces to further improve their health services.

CALABARZON is the region has a population of

about 15 million people. "We have to safeguard and protect the health and welfare of these people and at the same time, we want the region to be independent from Metro Manila in terms of medical services. This is also the best way to decongest hospitals in NCR because once we have a level 2 or 3 hospital in every province, residence need not go to Manila to get their treatment," he emphasized.

Janairo added that the regional office is in the process of procuring GeneXpert machines for covid19 virus testing to be distributed in identified health facilities in various provinces. These machines are actually initially intended to be used for testing tuberculosis. He explained that the GeneXpert analyzes TB by detecting the presence of TB bacteria, as well as testing for resistance to the drug Rifampicin.

"He also bares plan for

a disease testing laboratory which is now in the process of development and will be established in one of the provinces. "Laboratory medicine is an essential part of public health and it is a must for the detection of disease in individuals and populations. We can prevent the spread of any disease, from its early detection and diagnosis, to individualized treatment plans. It is the key to improving healthcare quality and avoiding long-term health costs."

"We need to plan beyond the COVID pandemic. We have to know how to protect ourselves and our communities. We need to have a successful response capability system and a capable emergency management structures that is in place and ready to use in case of any biological and other natural health hazards that may occur," he concluded. PhilHealth's Interim Reimbursement Mechanism (IRM)

The Interim Reimbursement Mechanism or IRM is an emergency cash advance measure applied by PhilHealth to provide hospitals with an emergency fund to respond to unanticipated events



like natural disaster and calamities. When the Covid-19 global pandemic was declared in February 2020, and drawing from the modeling forecast available at the time, PhilHealth prepared an IRM response equivalent to 90 days of annual historical benefit claims to be made available to all health care institutions nationwide including dialysis centers and lying in clinics. This requirement was estimated to be P30 Billion. Since the emergence of the first locally transmitted Covid-19 cases in February, the following pattern has emerged that will require PhilHealth to recalibrate its IRM response:

- The disease is concentrated only in high population density areas like the NCR and Regions 3, 4, 7 and 11. Many areas exhibit low or Covid-19-free incidence. PhilHealth's strategy is to provide IRM to all referral hospitals and laboratories in all provinces. This has already been achieved.
- Government's anti-Covid 19 strategy will entail expanded targeted testing and subsequent quarantine of confirmed individuals. This will require funding which will fall on PhilHealth.

- Financial sustainability of the antiCovid-19 response. With still no vaccine in sight PhilHealth will take the prudent path to ensure that sufficient funds continue to be available to protect all citizens from the severe impact of the pandemic.

To date PhilHealth has released a total of P13.8 Billion to 599 health care institutions nationwide, P7.3 Billion or 53% of which was released to private institutions. Of this, almost P4 Billion or 29.7% was released to NCR, the ground zero of Covid-19.

PhilHealth will now scale down its IRM release and preserve its funds for the anticipated expanded targeted testing required by the national anti-Covid 19 strategy. Further releases will be selective and following above mentioned considerations.

This is following the
released Department of
Public Works and
Highways (DPWH)
Department Order No.
35 (and its Department
Order No. 39, repealing
DO No. 35), Series of
2020 or the
"Construction Safety
Guidelines for the
Implementation of all
DPWH Infrastructure
Projects during the
COVID-19 Public Health
Crisis" as approved by
the Interagency Task
Force on Emerging and
Infectious Diseases
(IATF-EID).

"With the relaxing of
the Community
Quarantine, we need to
get the projects back on
track, most especially the
BBB projects which
aims to spur and sustain
economic growth by
c o n s t r u c t i n g
infrastructure projects
badly needed by the
country. The guidelines
set is to ensure the
health and safety of
everyone involved in the
projects. Strict
compliance is expected." Said DPWH Secretary
Mark Villar.

The construction of
major infrastructure
projects was suspended
when the COVID-19
pandemic hit the country
causing the adjustments
for construction
protocols.

"The guidelines of
DPWH are specific to
help stem the disease.
The contractors must
follow new protocols at
the jobsite which
changes the preparation
and mobilization time of
the projects, these
adjustments have an
effect on the timeline.
We also give great
consideration on the
renewed focus by the
government on BBB
projects; we want to
accelerate completion of
projects - subject to
DPWH and the
Department of Health
guidelines," said MPT
South President and
General Manager
Roberto V. Bontia.

MPT South has
resumed the road
widening construction
for CAVITEX R-1 second
phase of bridge works in
Parañaque, Las Piñas
and Wawa and now at
55% completion.
Construction Personnel
and allied services had
remobilized for the
resumption of works in
CALAX Subsections 4
and 5, and Cavite
Segment. ROW
acquisitions for Cavite
Segment and Subsection
4 are still ongoing.

Subsection 5, the
continuation from Santa
Rosa to Silang is at 96%
ROW acquisition with
siteworks at 57%,
significantly.

Meanwhile, CAVITEX
C5 Link Segment 3A2
and Segment 2 ROW
acquisitions are at 81%
progress. A letter of
award has been issued
to the qualified bidder
while details of project
execution are currently
in the works.

Preparing for the 'new
normal'

Around 1,600
employees went through

move is a reaffirmation

which could entail
c o r r e s p o n d i n g
adjustments to our
safety protocols over
time," he said.

Gradual return of
workforce will start upon
receiving the results of
the tests. Also, daily
health monitoring
protocols, provision of
basic personal protective
equipment (PPEs),
sanitation and
disinfection of office
spaces, and health and
safety guidelines will be
observed as part of the
preventive measures
against the spread of
COVID-19.

"We continue as an
organization to
demonstrate patience,
the spirit of collaboration
and malasakit - these
are elements which will
indeed see us through
the challenges of this
health emergency
situation," Bontia added.

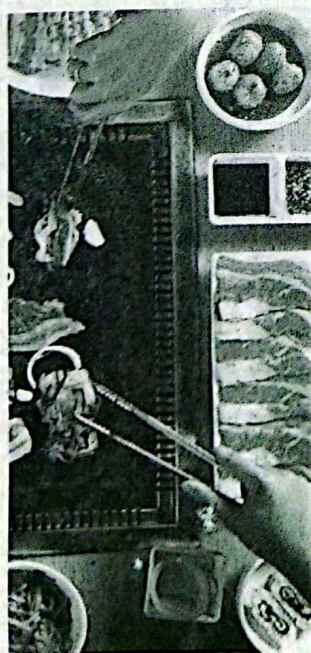

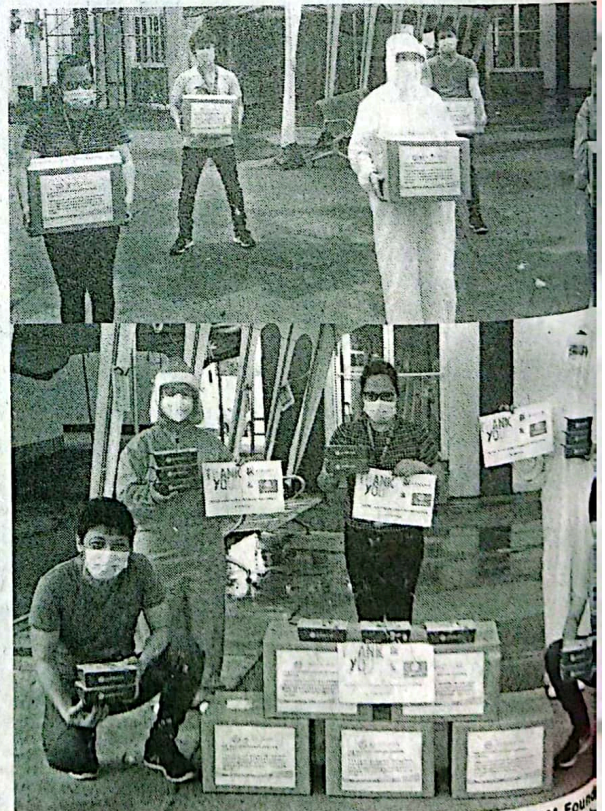
