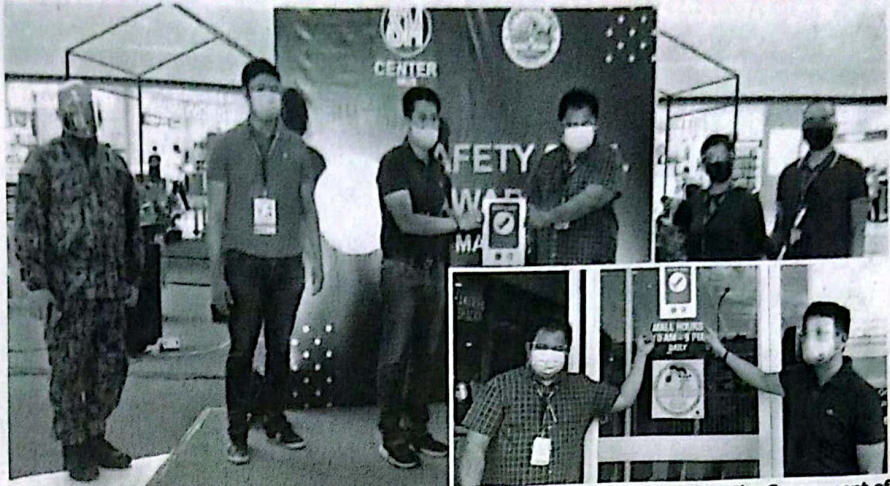


SM CENTER IMUS RECEIVES SAFETY SEAL CERTIFICATION

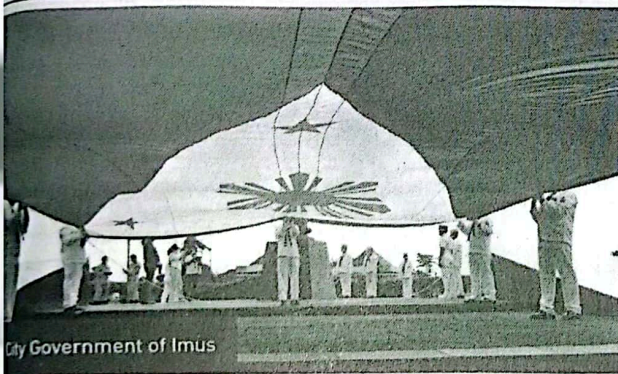

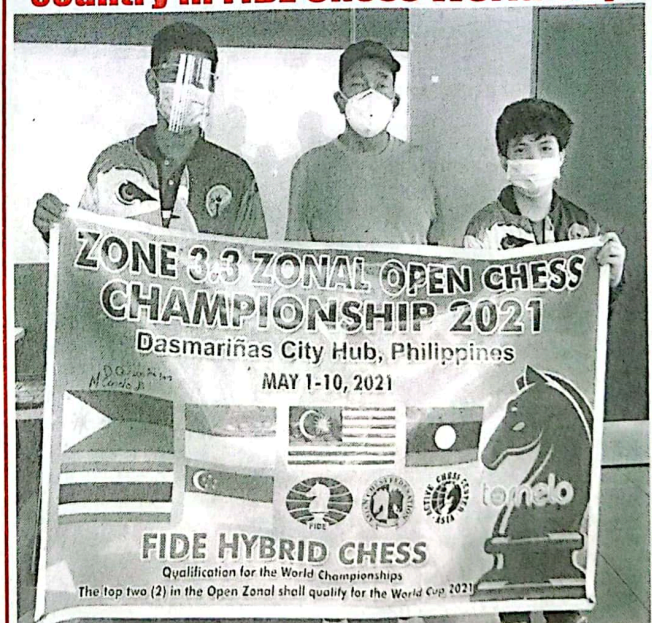

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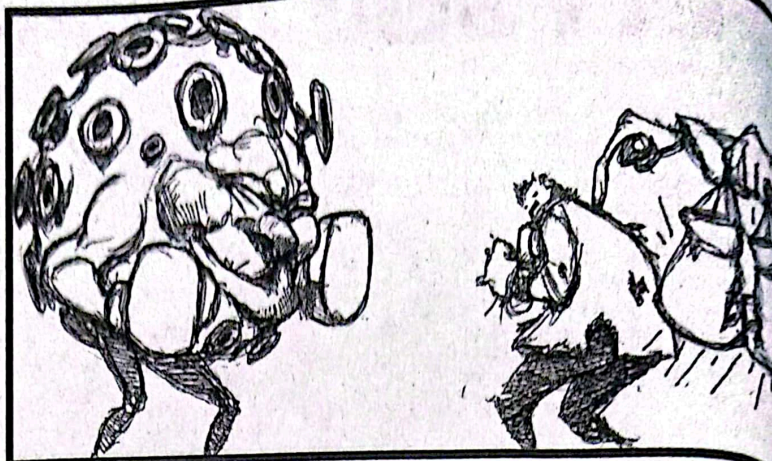

DTI 4-A launches its 1st batch KMME-MME mentees for 2021

The Department of Trade and Industry Region 4-A, in partnership with the Philippine Entrepreneurship (PCE)-Go Negosyo, conducted its KAPATID Mentor ME and Encounter (KMME-MME) Online Multi Sectoral Batch 1 for 2021 Program on May 10, 2021 via Zoom with its 50 mentees from the agribusiness, processed food, automotive furniture, garments, pastries, and tourism industries.



The KAPATID Mentor ME (KMME) has been implemented since 2016 as a 10-module mentorship program that optimizes weekly face-to-face interactions between the mentors and the mentees with the key goal of boosting the entrepreneurial capacity through improved access to Mentorship, Money & Market (i.e., the 3Ms).

With the COVID-19 pandemic upending lives and businesses all over the world, the KMME becomes more relevant and necessary albeit in a virtual or digitalized form. Thus, the KMME-MME Online is developed as the practical delivery mechanism for the same mentorship modules to be used to propel micro and small enterprises (MSEs) to survive and thrive in spite of the unprecedented setbacks that now confront

businesses of all types and sizes.

"This is a better program to help our micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) to adapt their business strategies to the new normal as digital marketing is incorporated. Moreover, because this program is done online, we are now able to accommodate more mentees instead of the usual 20 mentees per batch," said PCE Adviser Engr. Merly M. Cruz.

The KMME-MME Online is designed to integrate the Money Market Encounter (MME) into the regular KMME Program. This will be achieved through the presentation of Business Improvement Plan (BIP) to an expanded panel of evaluators composed of representatives from banks, online market platforms, and other

business support organizations. Coaching is added in the program to assist the mentees during the drafting of their BIPs and improve their materials and presentation skills. Coaching is also envisioned to further develop their capacities in accessing capital and market. Thus, enabling them to pivot and prepare for the new normal.

"This is like taking up a Master's Degree in Business Administration, but the only difference is that this is free. The only investment of our mentees is to religiously attend all the sessions, do their homework and activities, and apply their learning in their business. 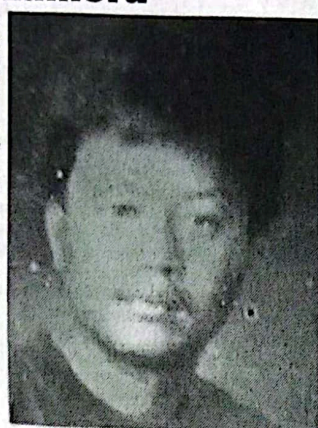

14TH MALASAKIT CENTER OPENS AT BATMC

Malasakit Center in Batangas is the second in the province, with the other one located at the Batangas City Center. The Malasakit Center in Batangas City was inaugurated in January 8,



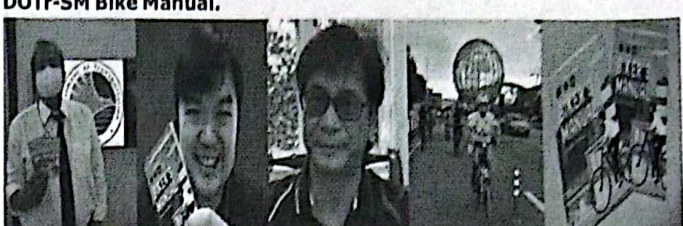
Mayor Christopher Go, the principal author of Republic Act No. 11168, otherwise known as the Malasakit Centers Act of 2019, reaffirmed his commitment to push for policies that will ensure access to health services, noting that come Filipinos experience poorer and receive poorer care quality compared to their wealthier counterparts. A patient needs only to bring the hospital bill and medical abstract in order to avail. DOH Undersecretary

Roger Tong-an expressed his gratitude for the establishment of the center. 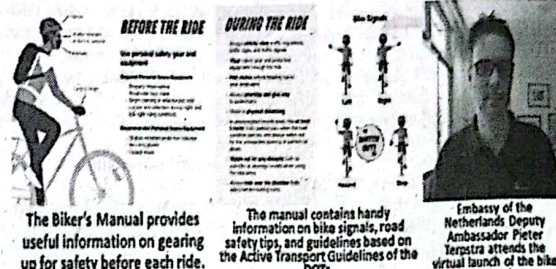

A bike rider at SM City Marikina gets a copy of the DOTr-SM Bike Manual at the mall's customer service counter. Bike riders and those interested to take up biking can get a copy for free at the mall's customer service counter or from guards assigned at the mall bike parking areas.

Through this public-private partnership, the DOTr-SM bike manual aims to promote safety, courtesy and etiquette on the road among cyclists, motorists, and pedestrians. It is based on the Active Transport Guidelines, spearheaded by the DOTr, with the support of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Department of Health (DOH), Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), and Move as One Coalition. Copies of the passport-sized manual have been published by SM Cares in English and Filipino, and will be distributed for free in all SM Malls nationwide. DOTr Secretary Arthur P. Tugade led the virtual launch together with MMDA Chairman Benhur Abalos, DPWH Undersecretary Roberto

Bernardo, DILG Assistant Secretary Odilon Pasaraba, DOH Director Beverly Ho, and Move as One Coalition Lead Convener Dr Robert Siy. They were joined by SM Engineering, Design, and Development President Hans Sy Jr. and SM Retail Assistant Vice President Mara Sy Coson, and SM Supermalls President Steven Tan. The biker's manual, which provides biking basics and safety tips for cyclists, forms part of SM's information campaign to complement the roll out of bike-friendly infrastructure and facilities in SM Malls nationwide. of Halal. She started her presentation with the definition of Arabic terms used in Islamic Law. Some of the consequences of consuming non-halal foods such as (1) invalidation of good deeds; (2) non-acceptance of forty days worship; and (3) unanswered supplication

were also mentioned to highlight the relevance of Halal. The importance of Halal which refers to any foods or drinks permitted under Islamic Law or Sharia including its benefits not only to Muslims but also encompasses non-Muslims were emphasized by the speaker. Examples of Halal

foods and products were likewise shown and explained. Ms. Jamid also discussed the opposite of Halal which is "Haram". According to Islamic Law, Haram means prohibited or unlawful. To provide a more concrete description of Haram, Ms. Jamid presented some examples of Haram foods.

Development (POPCOM), UNFPA Representative to the Philippines Dr. Leila Jouane underscored the challenges women face in enjoying their right to bodily autonomy, especially in the Philippines.

"The Philippines fared better as women have the power to decide on contraception and healthcare. However, we can see disparities across age, income, and location still exist," Joudane said.

"My Body is My Own"

This year's UNFPA State of the World Population (SWOP) report highlighted the legal, economic, and social barriers to securing bodily autonomy that would have allowed women and girls to ake their decisions over their own welfare.

According to the same report, 20 countries have "marry your rapist" laws where rapists escape punishments by marrying their victims, denying survivors an opportunity to attain justice.

With only 55 percent of Filipino girls and women who are able to make their own decisions concerning their own welfare, the Philippines records the

fourth highest maternal mortality in Asia. By global standards, it also ranks 54th out of 79 countries in the world in terms of promoting maternal health.

Bodily autonomy and teen pregnancy

Population experts believe that adolescent pregnancy has become a national, social emergency as the Philippines records one of the highest adolescent birth rates among ASEAN countries, where 47 for every 1,000 women aged 15 to 19 years old give birth.

"For women and girls, the decision making power is not always realized or respected," Joudane admits, as very few girls and women enjoy their right to body autonomy, or those who have the means to determine their lives and future free from violence.

This lack of body autonomy, as exemplified by the culture of child marriage in some parts of the Philippines, is also one cause for the rising number of teen pregnancies in the country.

"In many of our laws, we tend to limit women's

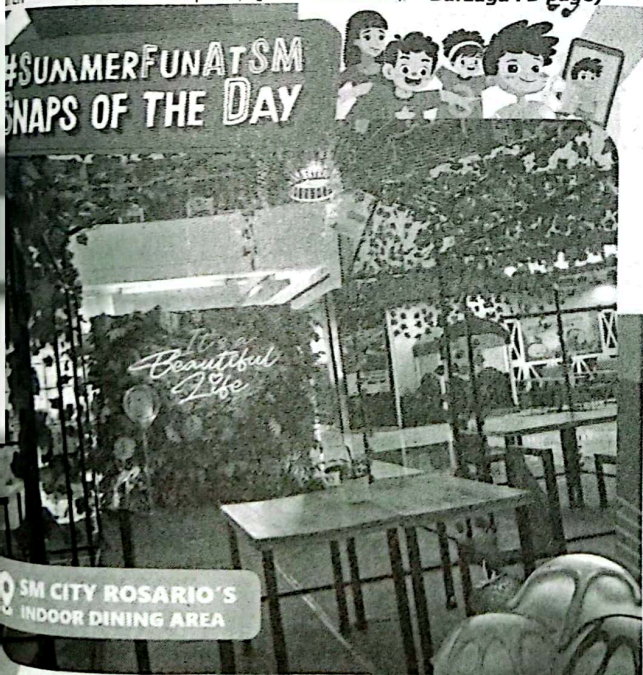
rights and it is changing the gender equity laws that we can make it possible for women to exercise their rights," POPCOM Executive Director, Usec. Juar Antonio Perez admitted.

"POPCOM's analysis reveals a degree of abuse Many young Filipinas are also subject to archaic practices, such as arranged marriages," he continues, citing the 'very timely' SWOP reports as the nation tackles the rising number of unplanned pregnancies among the youth.

Aside from being mothers at an early age Joudane said child bride are also prone to Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) where they experience abuse at the hands of the partners or spouses.

"Humanitarian crisis negatively impact women's bodily autonomy because our social system break down," Jouane said citing the 2017 Marawi siege has made child marriage a negative coping mechanism for families.

Since the COVID-19 related quarantine began UNFPA said that 12,000 additional IPV cases have been reported each month. (By Patricia Bermudez)

guiding principle is "service through strong brotherhood."

Enriquez of Bgy. Boloaen, said they gladly welcomed the offer from 'The Fraternal Order of Eagles,' (FOE) "Maagap NCR Super Eagles Club," in partnership with Mrs. Globe Philippines 2019, Mariz Songcuan; San Fabian PNP Chief Maj. Hermelita Gutierrez. There are other stakeholders, sponsors, donors. LGUs provided the logistics.

Enriquez said the bgy. population is more than a thousand but the pantry could only afford to provide for 300 residents. "We gave out stubs to those very indigent families. I even talked to my beneficiary friends to give way and I retrieved their stubs," she said.

Guitering who led the giving out of goods said Sitio Tابلon, Bgy. Bolaoen is a 'forgotten' village when it comes to relief goods or aids from the government, because of its distance from San Fabian proper. One has to pass through dirt road and only accessible by big cars or 4-wheel drives.

There is an ongoing road construction in the village.

Both Guitering and Enriquez, a former Aviation Security Group member, claimed that the village has zero crime, "not even simple theft."

Songcuan who hails from Bgy. Haway in Pozorrubio, Pangasinan on the other hand, said her heart is for the poor. "Naalala ko pa nang maliit ako, lubak-lubak ang daanan sa lugar namin. Mas malala pa dito. Laking bundok ako."

Songcuan, an IT graduate is now connected with the Bureau of Customs as its representative.

FOE "is an international fraternal non-profit organization founded in 1898 in Seattle, Washington. It unites fraternally in the spirit of liberty, truth, justice and equality to make human life more desirable by lessening its ills and by promoting peace, prosperity, gladness and hope."

On the other hand, 'Eagles' was born in the Philippines in 1979 during a rendezvous of a group of men in Aberdeen Court in Quezon City. Several succeeding meetings saw

focused on Najs, an Arabic word which means "filthy, unclean" and includes vomit, excrement, lice, blood, and urine. Apart from being Haram, Najs has three types; the Mughallazah (severe najs), Mutawassitah (medium najs), Mukhaffafah (light najs). "Shubuhat" or "Mashbooh", another Arabic term which refers to any uncertainty about foods or drinks were similarly covered. The last part of Ms. Hamid's discussion focused on Genetically Modified Organisms (GMO) whose genetic material has been altered using genetic engineering techniques. Hence, the nature of how these GMOs can be considered Halal was explained.

The second cut of the episode concentrated on Halal Quality Assurance in Food Industry. Ms. Agnes C. Morales emphasized the importance of making food products Halal-certified to ensure safety and quality. She shared that there is about 2 billion global consumer base of Halal products with an estimated Halal market worth of 2.6 trillions of US Dollars. Thus, 62% of this include food and beverages, followed by pharmaceuticals at 22%, cosmetics and personal care

at 10% and 6% nutraceutical. Ms. Morales also enumerated several Halal services which oppose the conception that Halal is for food only. Specifically, these services include Islamic banking, securities and bonds, travel and tourism, supply chain and logistics, education and training, fashion, food services, food and non-food manufacturing. Furthermore, she stressed the significance of Halal Certification which guarantees the features and quality of the products according to the rules established by the Islamic Council. Some of the Halal logos which are present in Halal products were also shown and Ms. Morales explained how each certifying body differs in its respective Halal logo.

The process on availing Halal Certification was then explained. According to Ms. Morales, first step is the 'evaluation stage' where the firm is evaluated based on their submitted application. Second step is the 'inspection' at the firm's plant and process. The last step is the 'certification' which will be granted to the firm once they completed and passed the first two steps. Another part of Halal

Certification is the Halal Assurance System (HAS) which refers to the total quality health and sanitary system. Ms. Morales explained that this system involves adopting procedures for slaughtering, processing and other related operations as prescribed by the Islam Dietary Law. This system is also composed of four elements such as standard of halal management and system, standard audit of halal system, Haram critical control point systems, and Halal guide and database. Meanwhile, Halal Compliance Critical Control Point (HCCCP) system, a recommended approach to enhance food safety from farm to fork, was likewise discussed. As she ends her discussion, Ms. Morales reiterated that "Halal is not only for Muslims, it is for every Juan and Juana!"

Questions of the participants were addressed during the "Consultalk" segment. It served as the participants' avenue for lobbying their ideas to the speaker. Most of the questions and concerns raised were focused on the processes involved during application, resources needed, and the cost from start to finish of Halal accreditation/certification.

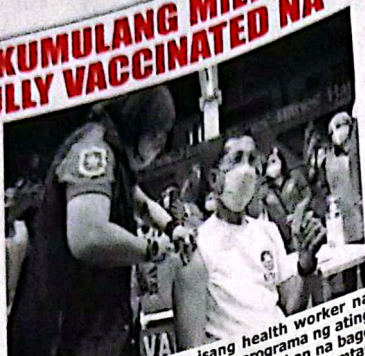

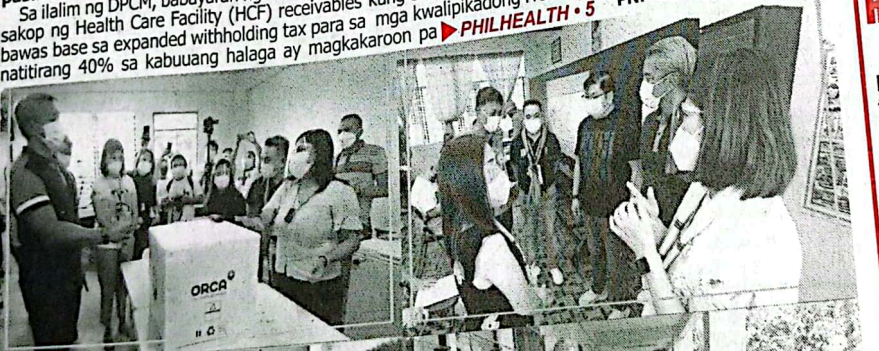
