CITY, Cavite --- The city government together with Foodpanda.ph signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) yesterday morning in support of the business sector for the New Normal.

The initiative came about after guidelines for the operations of local businesses that will open on June 1, 2020 were issued in the first ever webinar for the Bacoor Economic Council held May 29, 2020.

Public Employment Services Office (PESO) head Dr. Abraham De Castro facilitated the program aimed to generate income for the tricycle drivers in the city by converting their vehicles into single motorcycles for the use in delivery services which could somehow augment their limited income due to safety protocols.

E KSAKTO na sandaang (100) taon ang pagitan ng dalawang sakit na pumatay ng milyon-milyong tao sa mundo: ito ang Spanish Flu noong 1920, at ang pandemyang novel coronavirus disease o mas kilala sa tawag na Covid-19 (C-19).


Ayon sa tala ng kasaysayan, mahigit 50 milyong tao ang namatay sa Spanish Flu na kumalat sa maraming bansa sa mundo. Nangyaring milyon-milyon ang namatay sa sakit na ito dahil matagal bago natuklasan at naimbento ang gamot sa mga taong dinapuan ng sakit na ito.

Taliwas noong 1920 na hindi pa gaanon maunlad ang siyensiya at teknolohiya sa pagtuklas ng mga gamot at bakuna, kaya umabot sa mahigit sa 50 milyong tao ang nahawahan at namatay sa Spanish Flu.

Makabago na, napakalaki ng iniunlad ng siyensiya, marami nang magagaling na siyentista, doktor at epidemiologist sa mundo at marami nang natuklasang gamot ang pinakamalalaking laboratory sa maraming bansa.

Ayon sa mga experto sa medisina, inaabot ng maraming buwan at taon bago nakatuklas ng gamot na kailangan pang idaan sa paulit-ulit na clinical test upang matiyak ang epektibo nito at walang maging malaking pinsala sa tao.



PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 280-2020

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER, LIQUOR, AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE DURING THE STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AND STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) PANDEMIC

Sponsored by: Hon. Reyniel A. Ambion - Chair, Committee on Peace, Public Safety, and Order

Hon. Alston Kevin A. Anarna - Chair, Committee on Commerce, Trade, and Industry

Co-sponsored by: All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922 on 8 March 2020, declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines, and Proclamation No. 929 on 16 March 2020, declaring a State of Calamity throughout the country in light of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11469 or the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act declared a State of National Emergency over the entire country due to COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan passed Provincial Ordinance No. 271-2020, prohibiting the sale and consumption of beer, liquor, and alcoholic beverages of any kind in the Province of Cavite during the Enhanced Community Quarantine, while Provincial Ordinance No. 272-2020 extended the said prohibition through the General Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, gives local government units the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 922 capacitated local government units to immediately act to prevent loss of life, utilize appropriate resources, implement urgent and critical measures to contain or prevent the spread of COVID-19, mitigate its effects and impact to the community, and prevent serious disruption of the functioning of the government and the community;

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in the Province to safeguard public health and safety, peace and order;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Ambion, duly seconded by Hon. Anarna and Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a special session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Regulating the Sale and Consumption of Beer, Liquor, and Alcoholic Beverages in the Province of Cavite."

ON 2. Lifting of Liquor Ban. The sale and consumption of beer, liquor, or alcoholic beverage of any kind within the territorial jurisdiction of Cavite shall be allowed during the State of Public Health Emergency and State of Calamity declared due to COVID-19, subject to the following conditions:

The sale of alcoholic beverages shall be allowed only from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM each day; holders of a Quarantine Pass duly issued by the concerned local government unit shall be allowed to purchase alcoholic beverages; no alcoholic beverage in excess of the following amounts shall be sold to every person each day:

Type of Alcoholic Beverage	Amount Limit Per Person
Beverages containing more than 17 percent (%) of alcohol by volume (34 proof or more)	One (1) Liter
Beverages containing more than 11 percent (%) but not more than 17 percent (%) of alcohol by volume (more than 22 proof but not more than 34 proof)	Two (2) Liters
Beverages containing not more than 11 percent (%) of alcohol by volume (22 proof or less)	Two (2) Liters
Only one type of alcoholic beverage as provided in the previous item may be sold to each person per day.	
The consumption of beer, liquor, or alcoholic beverage of any kind shall only be allowed within private residences.	

N 3. Penal Clause. Persons who shall sell beer, liquor or other alcoholic beverage in violation of this Ordinance shall be meted with a fine ranging from Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and/or the revocation of their business permit.

Persons who shall consume beer, liquor, or other alcoholic beverage in violation of this Ordinance shall suffer the following penalties:





First offense – a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) and/or imprisonment for a period not exceeding five (5) days;
Second offense – a fine not exceeding Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) and/or imprisonment for a period not exceeding ten (10) days;
Third and succeeding offenses – a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and/or imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

N 4. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions and executive orders inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

N 5. Separability Clause. If any part or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

N 6. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect on 1 June 2020 and shall remain in force until the State of Public Health or the State of Calamity due to COVID-19 has been lifted, whichever comes later.



state of health emergency crisis emphasized the need to maximize the business of 'delivery services.'

"Our fellow Bacoorenos in the transportation sector are one of the most affected by the community quarantine. They are making money and relying on their daily trips so it had been very difficult for them with almost three months of not getting out to work," stated Mayor Lani Revilla.

"We decided to have an agreement with delivery services like foodpanda because this way, we're hitting three birds with one stone. First, we helped the Bacoorenos stay safe at home,

secondly, we provided extra services for entrepreneurs and third, we provided jobs for our tricycle drivers," justified the mayor.

Dr. De Castro shared that, "Bacoor is the first city in all of CALABARZON to enter into this agreement with a private sector in the delivery service from which 150 drivers will benefit from."




