Imus BFP personnel undergo COVID-19 testing; negative result

CITY, Cavite -- The city government here recently conducted testing for firefighters and personnel of the Imus Bureau of Protection (BFP) pursuant to the provincial government's for frontliners in the province to be subjected to corona disease (COVID)-19 checkup.

Fire Marshal CInsp. Rowena H. Gollod led the city's BFP personnel and fire aides during the testing conducted June 10 & 11, 2020 at the Imus Molecular Laboratory.

Results released Monday showed all the Imus BFP personnel that COVID-19 testing are negative of the dreaded disease.

While, according to the latest data recorded by the City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (CESU), the city has a total of 71 COVID-19 confirmed cases with 45 patients already recovered, 9 deaths and 17 active cases who are currently convalescing.

With the opening of the Imus Molecular Laboratory on June 5, 2020, the first-LGU initiated COVID-19 Testing Facility in

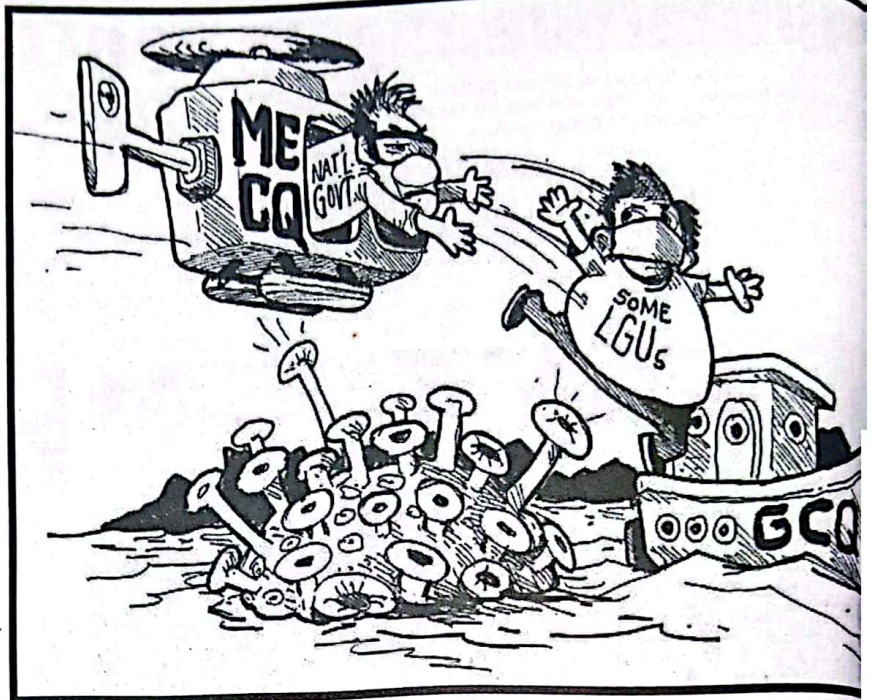

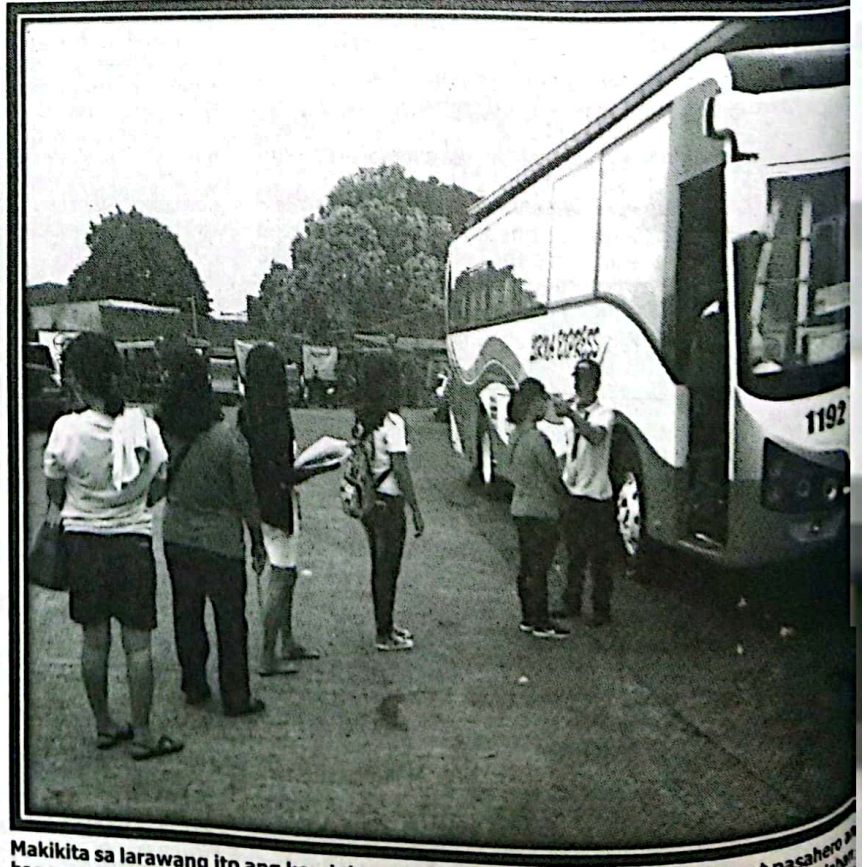

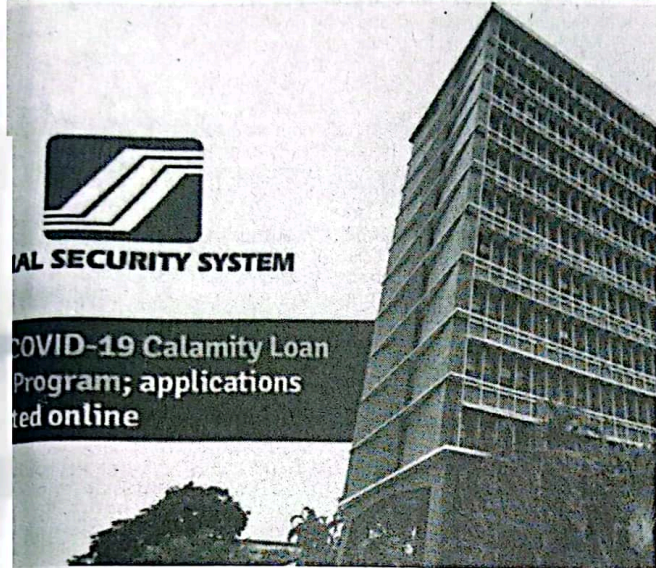

SSS binuksan ang online na aplikasyon para sa COVID-19 calamity loan

Digital na makatulong sa mga miyembrong apektado dahil sa mayyang Coronavirus Disease o COVID-19, binuksan ng Social Security System o SSS ang online na aplikasyon para sa COVID-19 Calamity Loan Assistance Program o CLAP noong Lunes, Hunyo 15, 2020.



Kailangan pumunta saanmang branch ng SSS para mag-aplay ng loan dahil maaari nang pang-apply online.

Si SSS President at CEO Aurora C. Ignacio na mayroong aabot sa 1.74 na milyong mga potensyal na member-borrowers ang naturang programa. Ang threat of COVID-19 will likely remain in the coming months. To this end, developed an online facility in the My.SSS web portal in which we will allow calamity loan applications to reduce face-to-face transactions in our offices, paliwanag ni Ignacio.

Ang kailangan ay na mananatili ang banta ng COVID-19 sa mga darating na buwan kaya naman nag-develop ang ahensya ng isang online na pasilidad sa web portal kung saan nila maisusumite ang aplikasyon para sa calamity loan. sa nararanasang krisis kanilang inextend ang payment term ng CLAP sa 27 buwan, kasama ang tatlong buwan na moratorium period at ang interest rate nito sa six percent per annum o anim na porsiyento.

Ang regular na payment term aniya ay 24 na buwan at sampung porsiyento ng interest rate per annum.

Ang Loan amortization naman para sa COVID-19 calamity loan ay dapat sa ikaapat na buwan mula sa approval date nito. Wala ring advance payment ang icha-charge sa loan na ito at ang service fee na isang porsiyento ng interest ay icha-charge at iababawas mula sa loan proceeds.

Ang payment naman na hindi maireremita sa itinakdang due date ay dapat roon ng isang porsiyentong penalty kada buwan.

Ang kailangan mag-kwalipika sa loan, ang miyembro ay dapat may ibabang 36 na buwanang kontribusyon, anim rito ay dapat na-ipost nang ibabang 12 buwan bago ang aplikasyon.

Ang kailangan ang dokumento ng katunayan na ang isang miyembro ay nag-iideklarang calamity area na isa sa mga requirements ng CLAP dahil sa bansa ang nasa ilalim ng state of calamity.

Ang kailangan ang mga member-borrowers kung nais nilang matanggap ang calamity loan sa pamamagitan ng Unified Multi-Purpose Identification Card (aka-enroll bilang ATM, Union Bank of the Philippines Quick Card, o ibang tseke na ipapadala sa kanilang piniling mailing address.

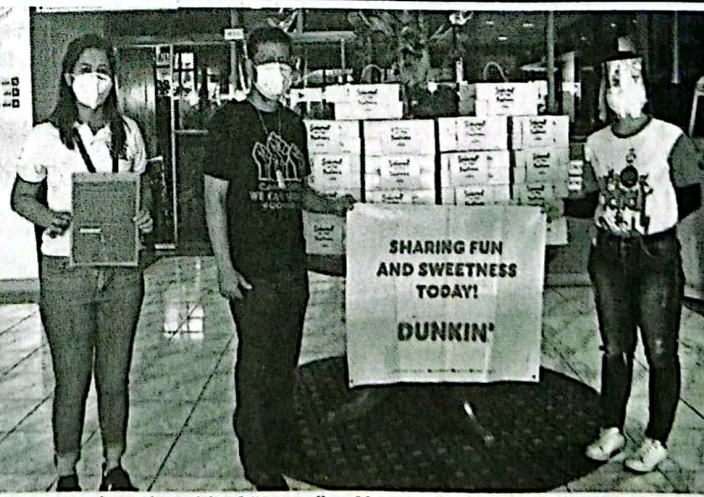

Saved by the Risen Lord

A story of a priest who conquered Covid-19 through faith and prayers

It all started with a simple cough", says Father Jay Hector Lituañas, a priest belonging to the Augustinians of the Assumption based in Quezon City. Fr. Jay travelled to Vietnam early this year for a meeting with fellow Assumptionists. Though already experiencing cough, he was not that bothered by it throughout his stay in the foreign land.

Upon his return to Manila, Fr. Jay continued on with his ministry and other related-activities such as recollections, saying masses, interactions with the urban poor, among others. As his cough aggravated, he went to his doctor for consultation and took anti-allergens for seven days. Fr. Jay remembered he could no longer sleep well at night as his cough persisted.

A doctor-friend advised him to go to the nearest public hospital for a swab test. He took the test and waited for the result after seven days. He was COVID-19 positive. In the morning of Holy Thursday, Fr. Jay was brought to the Lung Center of the Philippines.

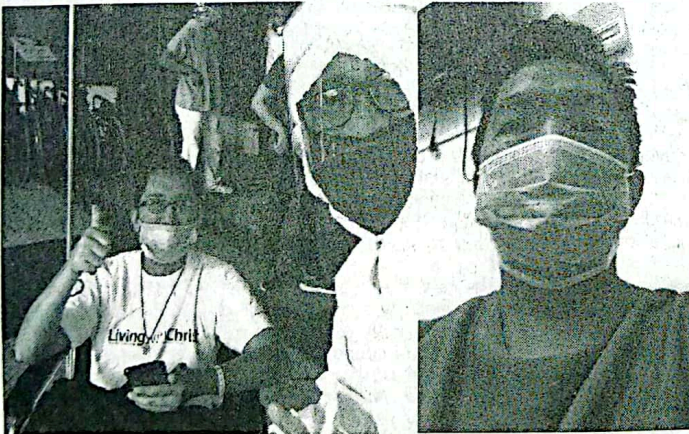
He spent 12 hours while undergoing a series of tests and while waiting to be admitted. At the emergency area, he was depressed at the sight of COVID 19 positive patients hooked up on ventilators struggling for life. He spent a total of eight days in the isolation room doing meditation, morning and evening prayers, reading the Scriptures, reciting the Rosary, and some physical exercises. He was still in touch with his family, fellow Assumptionists, and friends who were his prayer warriors.

In the face of Covid-19, he remained strong and optimistic that this too shall pass by God's mercy. There was even an instance when he was confronted by a sudden fear of death which moved him to fight for his life for the sake of his loved ones.

During his battle, Fr. Jay was very grateful to the doctors, nurses and other staff of the isolation ward. He even asked them to write their names on his small notebook so he can include them in his prayers and online masses. As days went on, he developed pneumonia and diarrhea and could not sleep well. But his strong will, and faith with doctors and nurses all helped him to recover well from the dreaded disease. He remembered his doctors saying, "Father, your positive and prayerful disposition is helping you a lot!"

After another week, Fr. Jay was finally discharged from the hospital completely healed. He left the hospital with deep gratitude to those who attended to him, to his countless prayer warriors, and also to PhilHealth which, according to him, provided him with financial support through its COVID-19 benefit package.

"I conquered COVID-19!", Fr. Jay exclaimed. But not long enough that he corrected himself, "No, it is the Risen Lord who conquered the disease for me!"

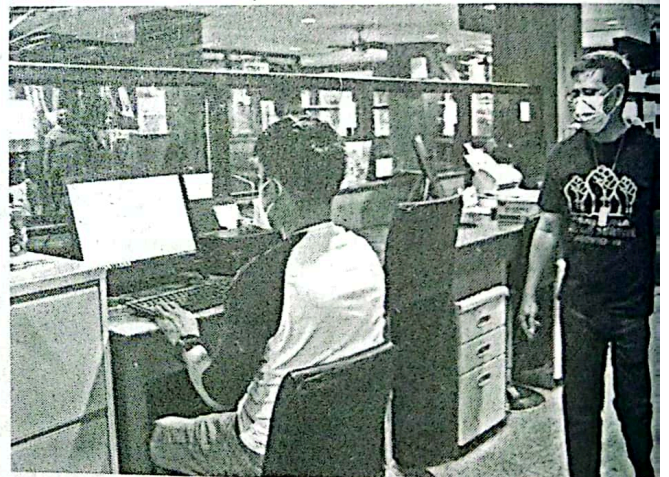

With his hard work, he was able to sustain his family's daily needs and even saved for a small business start-up. 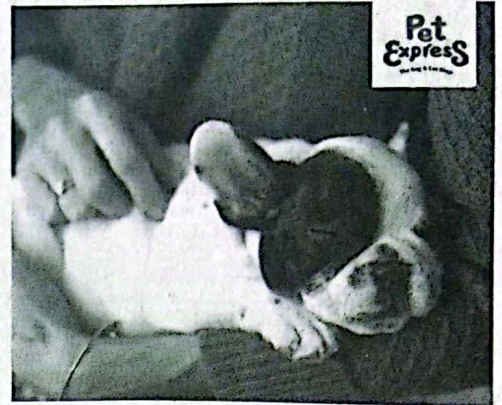

For relief from the financial challenges as a result of the CoVID-19 pandemic, the Philippine Insurance (PhilHealth) has extended anew the deadline of payment of contributions for members until June 30, 2020, while its flexible and deferred payment scheme remain in for Overseas Filipino Workers.

applicable months of February, March and April 2020 can be paid until June 22, 2020 without interest, in line with the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act.

They may also pay at any LHIOs and ACAs including CIS Bayad Centers and their third party agents, or through the electronic premium remittance system (EPRS) online. Meanwhile, PhilHealth also issued Advisory No. 2020-037 to prescribe "rules (that) may be observed by Overseas Filipino Workers affected by the enforcement of the Universal Health Care Act".

It said that OFWs "may



pay at the previous rate of P2,400 as initial payment" and are "granted One year or 12 months from the date of their initial payment to complete their balance for the year. The Advisory clarified that "premium payment shall be voluntary (for OFWs) for the duration of the pandemic", and that although temporarily suspended, the provisions of the UHC Law still apply pending its amendment by Congress.

PhilHealth said that repatriated migrant workers or OFWs in distress are advised to present a certification from the Overseas Workers and Welfare Administration to the local social welfare officers for them to be considered as Indirect Contributors of the program. Under the UHC Law, contributions of indirect contributors are subsidized by the national government.
