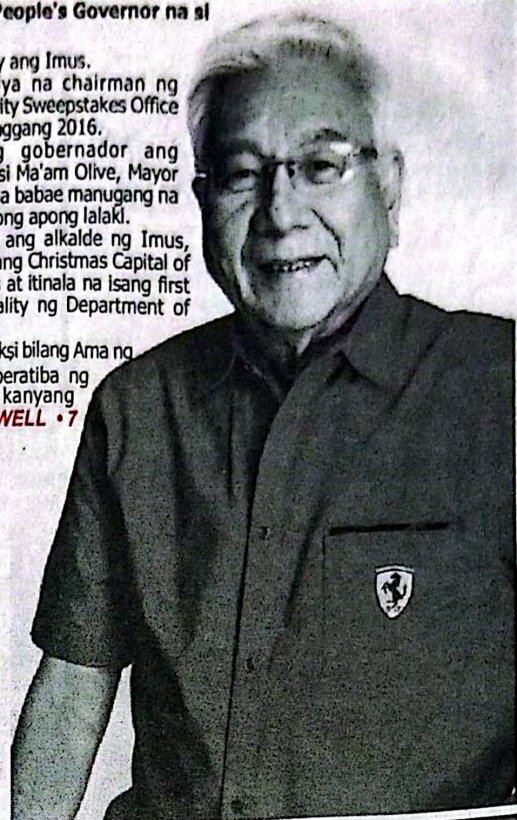

Online Public Library Ordinance signed into law

Imus, Cavite Feb. 25)– Cavite Governor Remulla on Thursday, February 18, signed Provincial Ordinance no. 314 known as the Online Public Library Ordinance which was approved during the 10th session of the Sangguniang Panglalawigan ng Cavite on January 11, 2021. P.O. no. 314 is an Ordinance Creating an Online Public Library for the Province of Cavite and the City of Imus. Therefor was authored by SK Federation President and Ex Officio Board Member (BM) Jerome Napoleon Maliksi of Dasmariñas City which would implement the Cavite WiFi Program of the Provincial Chief Executive.

The ordinance aims to help in this pandemic the students who lack access to research, teachers who lack books based on their needs for every Caviteños who need more.

The ordinance was supported by fellow legislators BM Jun dela Cuesta and BM Committee Chair on

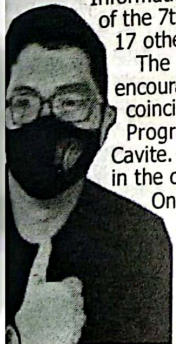
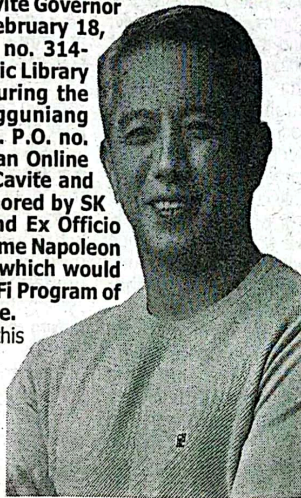
Information and Communication, and BM Ping Remulla of the 7th District Committee Chair on Education and 17 other Board Members.

The ordinance was born out of Gov. Remulla's encouragement to organize the E-Public Library to coincide with the launching of the Cavite Free WiFi Program and would set another milestone for Cavite. "We will be the first Local Government Unit in the country to envision through an ordinance an Online Public Library," said BM Jeg Gonzales. "I am not saying that this ordinance would be the all and all of education."

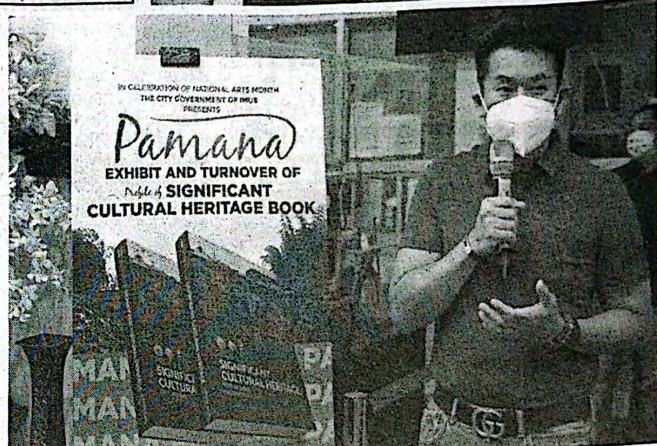

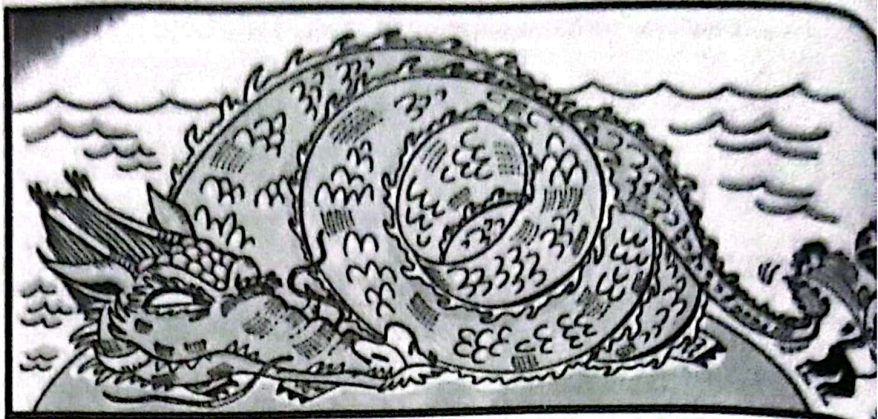

LGU Bacoor rolls out PUV Modernization Project

BACCOOR, Cavite — The City Government here held recently the blessing and launching of the Utility Vehicle (PUV) Modernization Project.



Mayor Lani Mercado Revilla and Regional Director Renwick K. Rutaquio of the Land Transportation Franchise and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) Region IV led the inauguration of the 15 units of modernized PUVs.

Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla led the launching of the project together with Land Transportation Franchise Regulatory Board (LTFRB) IV-A Regional Director Col. Renwick Rutakio.

The Magnificat Transport Cooperative will operate and manage the transportation system with the aim to generate additional income to Bacooreños particularly those in the transport sector who are most affected by the pandemic.

"Maraming bentahe ang PUV Modernization Program. Ang mga commuters ay magkakaroon ng safer at more modern public utility vehicles. Kasama sa upgrading, ang mga pampublikong sasakyang ito ay may technological features tulad ng GPS, CCTV cameras, automatic fare collection systems, at free wireless connection. Nakakatulong na tayong ating kababayan naaalagaan pa natin ang

ating Inang Kalikasan," stated Mayor Revilla.

(The PUV Modernization Program has many advantages. Commuters will have safer and more modern public utility vehicles. Included in the upgrading, these public vehicles have technological features such as GPS, CCTV cameras, automatic fare collection systems, and free wireless. Not only do we help our fellowmen but we are also taking care of our Mother Nature.)

"Para sa mga drivers naman, bentahe na mawawala na ang tinatawag na "boundary system" kung saan ang mga drivers ay kailangang makapagbayad ng fixed amount sa operator araw-araw mula sa kanilang pasada. Sa ganitong sistema, kailangang punuin ng driver ang kanyang sasakyan at ang paghihintay na ito ng mga pasahero ang nakakapagpahaba sa

travel time at nakakadagdag sa problema ng traffic. Sa bagong sistema, may fixed na sahod ang mga driver kaya hindi nila kailangang maghabol ng pangboundary bago sila kumita para may maiwi sa kanilang pamilya." dagdag pa ni Mayor Revilla.

(As for the drivers, the advantage is to discard of the "boundary system" where drivers have to pay a fixed amount to the operator for every day of operation. With this system, the driver has to maximize the capacity of the PUV with the waiting period for passengers prolonging the travel time and at times causes traffic congestion. With the new system, drivers will have a fixed wage so they do not have to complete the boundary before they can earn something to bring home to their family.)

Meanwhile, LTFRB Regional Director Rutaquio explained, "Hindi natin aalisin ang ating mga

jeepneys dahil sa Apektado pa din ang pandemya at ang surviving sila. Ito ang initiative ng LGU dahil makakatulong ito sa mga drivers at magiging mas ligtas ang mga commuters. Wala pang nakapamasahe ang biyahe."

(We will not do away with the jeepneys of this. They are affected by the pandemic and now the surviving. The initiative of the Bacoor LGU is because it will help the drivers and even commuters. No matrix has established yet.)

In a few days' time, 15 modernized buses will run the route along stretch of Molino Bacoor Boulevard Parañaque Inter Terminal Express in MIA Road, Para City and vice versa. **Francisco with n from Bacoor PIO**

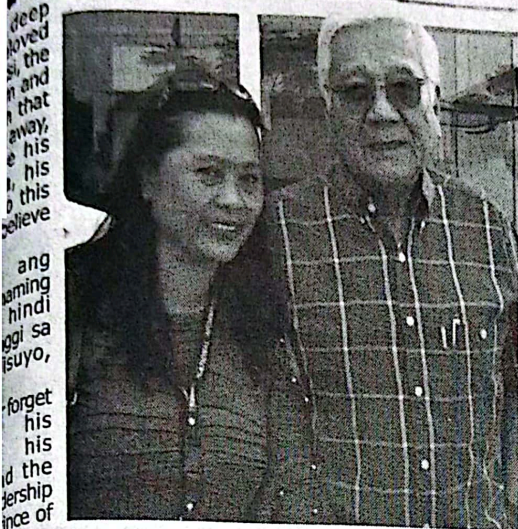

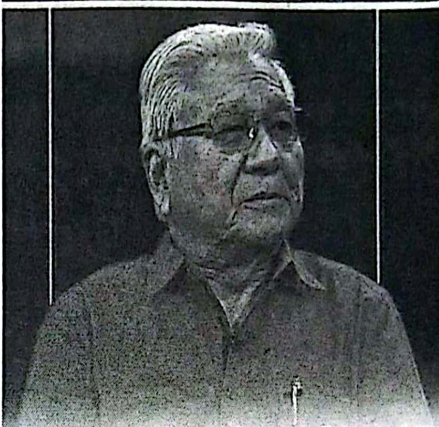

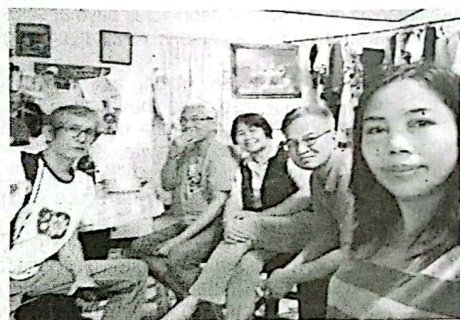

Guest of honors during the Inaugurations were Department of Transportation (DOT) Sec. Arthur Tugade, Assistant Secretary and LTO Chief Atty. Edgar Galvante, ASec. Mark Steven Pastor, ASec. Giovanni Lopez, LTO-IV-A UnderSec. for Finance Garry De Guzman, LTO-IV-A Director Atty. Noreen Bernadette San Luis-Lutey, LTO IV-A Assistant Regional Director Atty. In his speech, Mayor Loyola said that the establishment of the new LTO District Office marked another milestone for the progressive municipality of Carmona.

The mayor said that for the longest time, Carmona residents have to go to other LTO offices avail themselves of vehicle registration and licensing services.

"But it will be different from now on. We are

hoping to accommodate not only our residents but those from nearby areas as well," Mayor Loyola said.

LTO Carmona District Office Chief Ms. Lynn Gutierrez said her office is offering vehicle registration, student permits, renewal of professional and non-professional licenses, among other services.

Gutierrez is being assisted by Assistant Chief Renel Macaraig.

Mayor Loyola said that the new LTO District Office is a one-stop-shop for applicants and it's a high-class facility with a medical center and a hub for driving lessons.

"We also made sure that the entire office is accessible to persons with disabilities. It is also mother and child-friendly as we have a designated area for breastfeeding and for resting of toddlers," he added.

The mayor added that the new facility will really

be beneficial to the of Carmona especially during this time of 19 pandemic.

"This is really a moment of accomplishment. We have many plans for Carmona with our goal to it into a Smart Infrastructure development is one of them," Mayor Loyola said.

2 and Segment 3A-2 this beginning of 2021. With the challenges brought about by the pandemic, we will ensure to stick to the timeline as close as we can and be able to open the new segments in Cavitex C5 Link next year," said Mr. Roberto V. Bontia, CIC President and General Manager.

The construction activities has an average of 200 manpower daily working and is 24/7 operational. CIC ensures the safety of these workers against COVID-19 by strictly following the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and the National Government's directives on health protocols.

C5 Link Expressway comprised of Segments 2 and 3. Segment 2 is a 1.9-kilometer, 2x3 lane expressway from Cavitex (R1) Expressway to a proposed interchange at

Sucat Segment 3A-2, a sub-section of Segment 3 is a 1.6-kilometer, 2x3 lane expressway from Merville to RSG (Airport View) Subdivision in Parañaque.

Upon completion, this 15B project is expected to serve 50,000 cars and reduce travel time to Makati and Taguig from Parañaque City, Las Pinas City, and Cavite Province from an hour to about 10 minutes, and play a huge role in economic development.

Moreover, CIC is set to conduct a heavy maintenance in Cavitex. Mobilization start last February 27, 2021 and will last for 60 days. The project aims at maintaining the performance standard of the expressway: improve the quality of carriageway and drive experience of its motorists.

"There will definitely be an effect on the passage of our motorists in the

construction areas, why we have laid out comprehensive management supporting all these to ease their passage additional on-ground support and more ample signages will be positioned to ensure and smooth flow of vehicles.

We are working together with our partner the Philip Reclamation Authority (PRA) and the PEAT the implementation of traffic management activities at Cavitex segment."

Aside from the Cavitex C5 Link Express and the Cavite-Lag Expressway (CAL MPTC's tollways port includes the concession the North Luzon Expressway ("NLEX"), the Subic Bay Expressway ("SCTEX"), the N Connector Road, and Cebu-Cordova Expressway ("CCEX") Cebu.

After each section of the HACCP module, the DOST-PSTC Cavite officers guided the participants to craft a detailed plan specific to Fil-Fresh products. This allowed them to apply their learnings, and at the same time, draft an initial HACCP plan for their food production operations. Accurate documentation and record-keeping is one of the core ideas of the HACCP system. To emphasize this point, Ms. Daigan quoted "If it isn't written down, it didn't happen." The speakers then checked the HACCP plan accomplished by the participants, and made recommendations on how to improve it.

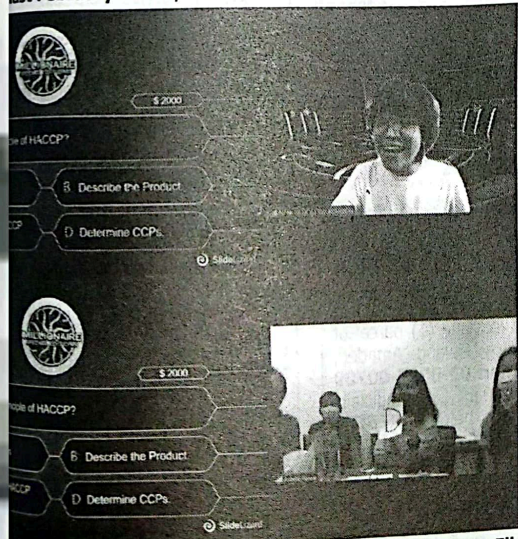
On the second and last day, after a short training evaluation and post-diagnostic exam, the DOST-PSTC Cavite through Mr. Matthew Henry Camitan awarded Fil-Fresh with a certificate

of completion for their active participation in the seminar-training. Ms. Jozelle Ponce, Quality Assurance Manager, received the certificate on behalf of Fil-Fresh. Ms. Ponce remarked, "The seminar was... interactive and gave us a better appreciation on the products we are processing. It enlightened us on how we can improve our work processes by properly assessing the risks to prevent and reduce them."

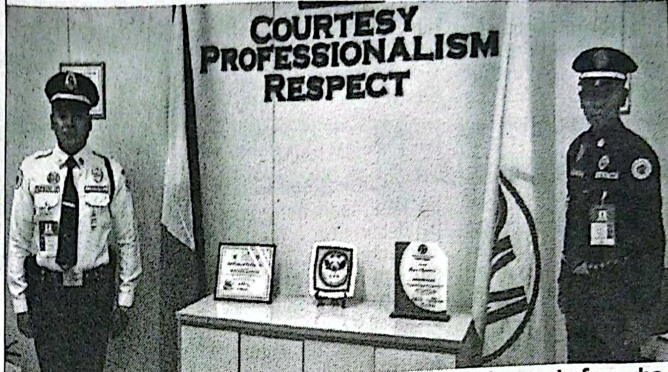

"I commend the STRH family for continuously implementing development and reforms for the improvement of its services. 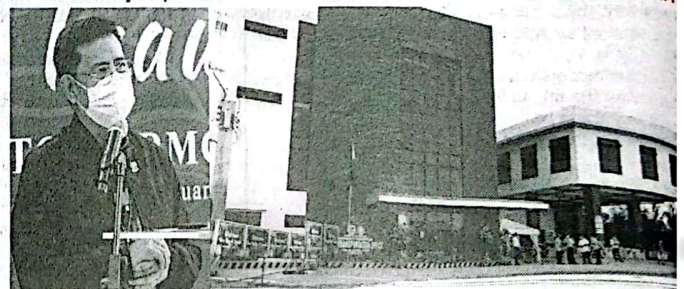

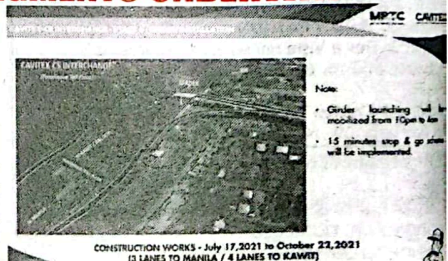
