




## GenTri opens isolation facility; houses COVID-19 positive cops, new cases

GENERAL TRIAS CITY, Cavite Jun 28 -- GenTri City Mayor Antonio Ferrer together with City Health Office head Dr. Jonathan Luseco led the launching of the newly-constructed isolation facility located in Barangay Santiago.

The opening of the facility is very timely as the COVID-19 cases in the city is increasing, patients can now be isolated immediately, assessed and provided with proper medical attention and treatment until full recovery.

The air-conditioned facility is equipped with 50 hospital beds, disinfection chamber, comfort rooms, laundry site, pantry, and dining area. Stocks of personal protective gears are ready for the use of the medical staff and health workers attending to COVID-19 patients.

Meanwhile, the Targeted Testing of police frontliners in the city resulted to 14 positive cases of the coronavirus in the police force. They are now admitted in the newly opened isolation facility with their condition closely being monitored by health workers.

City Police Chief PLtCol. Marlo Solero had requested augmentation force from the Cavite Provincial Police Office (CPPO) for maintaining peace and order in the city.

The Gen. Trias Police Station also announced the temporary suspension of issuance of PNP travel authority and clearance.

"Issuance of travel pass and police clearance from the local police is (temporary) suspended while we are preparing for the online application system in the coming week," PLtCol. Solero announced.

Cavite 6th District Representative Luis 'Jonjon' Ferrer IV said

police frontliners are our heroes. "Despite the threat of the COVID-19 they courageously and faithfully perform their sworn duties to serve and protect the people."

As of June 25, 2020 the COVID-19 confirmed cases in the city rose to 54 cases with additional 10 new cases recorded, 24 recoveries, 25 active cases, and 5 deaths. The 14 GenTri cops found positive are not included in the new cases pending the result of the contact tracing being conducted.

"The public is strongly urged to strictly follow health protocols such as

social distancing, wearing of face masks, regular hand washing, and staying at home unless going out for essential goods and services, or working in allowed industries. Vulnerable groups such as senior citizens, individuals 20 years and below, pregnant women and those with pre-existing medical conditions are advised not to go out of their houses unless extremely necessary," Dr. Jonathan Luseco said.

The GenTri Covid Busters continues to conduct disinfection activities of public places such as public markets in Barangay Sampalukan and Manggahan, city hall, city health clinic, GenTri Police Station, BFP Office, and the public plaza to prevent further spread of the virus in the locality.

In support to disinfection activities, Representative Jonjon Ferrer distributed sanitizers and alcoholols to 33 barangays in the city. (Ruel Francisco, PIA-Cavite/with reports from Dennis Abrina)

**PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 282-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SPITTING AND EXPELLING OF SALIVA, MUCUS, PHLEGM AND OTHER SUBSTANCES IN ALL UTILITY VEHICLES AND PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF**

Introduced by: **Vice Governor Ramon Jolo B. Revilla III**

Sponsored by: **Hon. Kerby J. Salazar** and Co-sponsored by: **All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members**

**WHEREAS**, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides in part that each local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate and incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare and shall ensure the support among other things, the promotion of health and safety;

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo R. Duterte signed Proclamation No. 922 on 08 March 2020 and Proclamation No. 929 on 16 March 2020, declare the country under the state of public health emergency and state of calamity, respectively, due to COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 can be easily transmitted through droplets, hence, from carelessly spitting saliva, mucus, phlegm or other substances especially in public places, of any person, aware or unaware, that he/she may be already a suspect, probable or confirmed carrier of COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, the virus from the aforesaid substances may linger in floor or to any area where it was spitted or expelled by any person for several hours and may be easily spread when touched or stepped, with or without knowing, by other individuals;

**WHEREAS**, in the middle of this pandemic and quarantine, and considering that there is continually increasing number of confirmed COVID-19 patients in the province, it is deemed necessary that this measure be enacted and implemented as this will serve as one of the protective and safety measures against the spread of COVID-19 which will consequently help to flatten its curve;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Salazar, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

# ORDINANCE

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Anti-Public Spitting Ordinance in the Province of Cavite."

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is hereby declared the policy of the Provincial Government of Cavite to adopt measures that will the health and safety of its constituents and to mitigate the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and other infectious diseases.

**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

Spitting – refers to the act of forcibly or intentionally ejecting saliva, mucus, phlegm or other substances from the mouth

Expelling – refers to the act of forcibly or intentionally ejecting substances from the nose

Public utility vehicles – refer to all public transportation operating in the province, such as, but not limited to, jeepneys, buses, tricycles, vans, or similar modes of transportation.

Public places – refer to any place open to the public such as, but not limited to, streets, alleys, sidewalls, highways, parks, plazas, markets, terminals, malls, hospitals, churches, banks, schools, parking lots, and other similar places.

**SECTION 4. PROHIBITED ACTS.** All persons, which includes drivers and passengers, are prohibited from spitting or expelling saliva, mucus, and other substances from their mouths and/or nose at all times in all public places, including public utility vehicles, within the territorial boundaries of the Province of Cavite.

**SECTION 5. PENALTIES.** All persons who are found violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be meted with a fine of Two Thousand Pesos (2,000) and/or imprisonment of not more than one (1) month or both at the discretion of the competent court.

**SECTION 6. ENFORCEMENT.** All City/Municipal Mayors, thru their City/Municipal Health Offices, all Barangay Officials, the Philippine National Police (PNP), and other officials that may be deputized by the City/Municipal Mayors, shall be mainly responsible in the implementation of this ordinance.

**SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If, for any reason/s, any part/s or provision/s of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or if any part/s or provision/s hereof not affected thereby, shall remain in full force or effect.

**SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, resolutions and executive orders inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval and compliance with posting and publication requirements.





include but are not limited to the revocation of business permit and/or closure of the establishment.

As of June 24, 2020 the inspection team had visited 291 establishments out of which 112 establishments were ordered closed/temporary closed due to non-compliance.

Likewise, seven colleges and universities in the city were issued a notice/letter for proper guidelines and minimum health protocols for essential services and face-to-face transactions in accordance with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and

DOH guidelines.

An ongoing spot inspection of all the lying-in clinics, medical laboratories, private hospitals and dental clinics are underway to ensure the compliance with DOH guidelines and minimum health protocols on COVID-19 and on toxic and hazardous waste management. As of June 26, 2020, about 26 establishments were already inspected.


