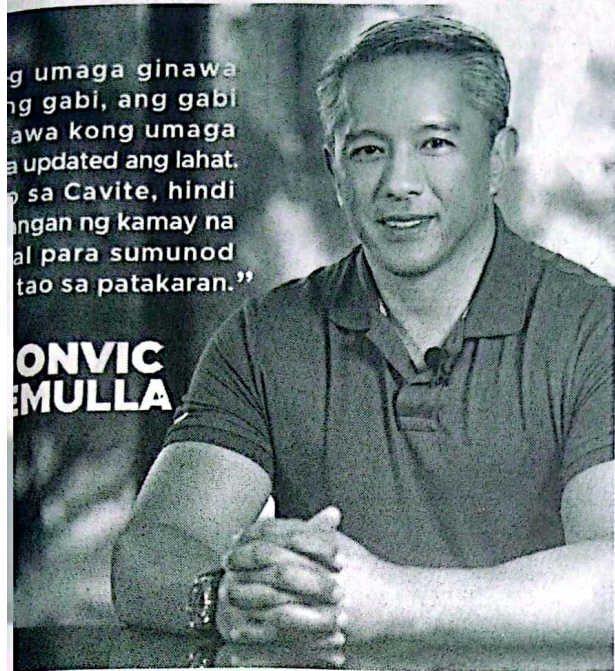


# Gov. Remulla reports on COVID, unemployment status in the province

**TRECE MARTIRES CITY, Cavite July 10 --**In a post in his FB Page yesterday, Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla reported on the COVID situation and the present status of unemployment in the province.

According to Gov. Remulla, the data recorded by the Provincial Health Office showed the number of COVID-19 positive cases tripled in the more than two months period from May 15, 2020 with 264 total cases up to July 8, 2020 now at 817 cases.

"This is how rapid the numbers are increasing with the loosening of the restrictions due to the lowering of the quarantine status from ECQ to GCQ to allow for the opening of businesses and eventually jumpstart the economy," the Governor observed.

Meanwhile, on the status of unemployment in the province, Remulla cited the Department of Finance that 51% have either lost their jobs or are on a limited work

schedule and have little to almost having no savings left while 11% are unemployed but still have savings to get them thru for sometime.

"Despite these figures, the province let alone the country could not possibly afford to return to the ECQ status that will cause the economy to collapse," Gov. Remulla stated.

"On the other hand, the people should find the balance between health and livelihood to be able to survive this crisis. We are in crisis. People are having a difficult time. People are suffering. People are dying.

The only thing that matters is that we put the country in the right direction to recover,"

the Governor emphasized.

He pointed out the importance of testing, tracing, isolation, medical care, jobs, transportation, and other major issues on locally stranded individuals (LSIs), OFWs in distress and the development of a rational educational plan for the continuation of education of the children.

"Now is the time for Leaders and not Politicians," Governor Jonvic concluded.. *(Ruel Francisco PIA-Cavite/with reports from the official FB page of Gov. Jonvic Remulla)*

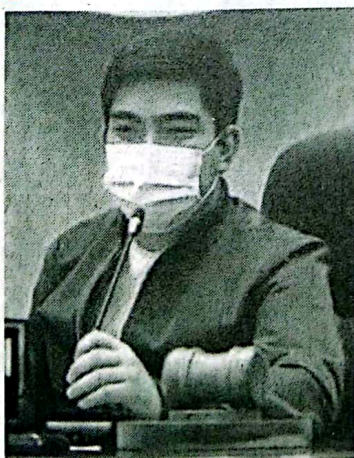

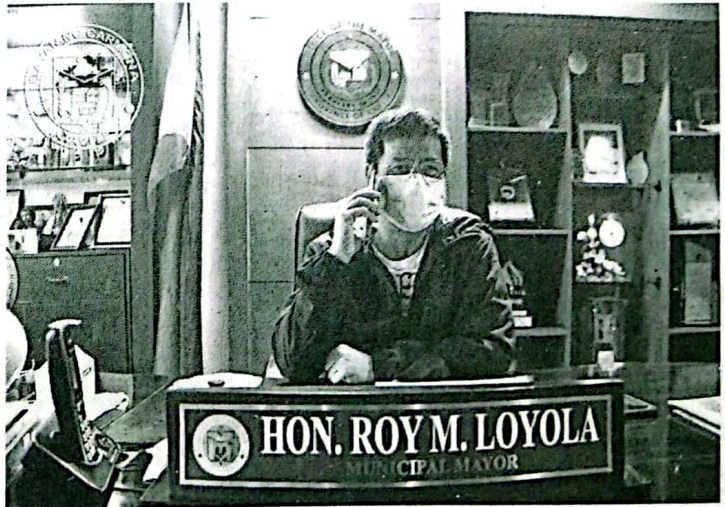

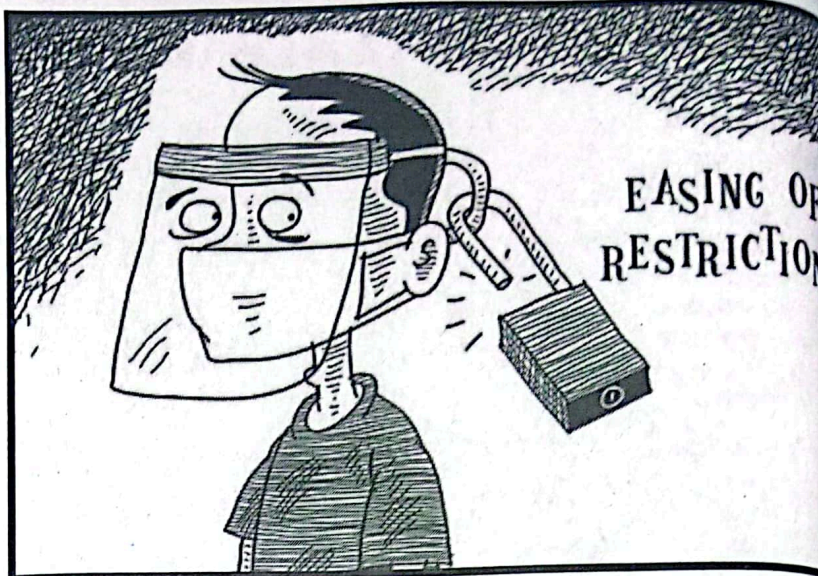
# Editorial

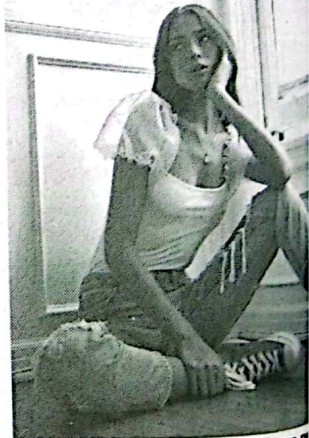

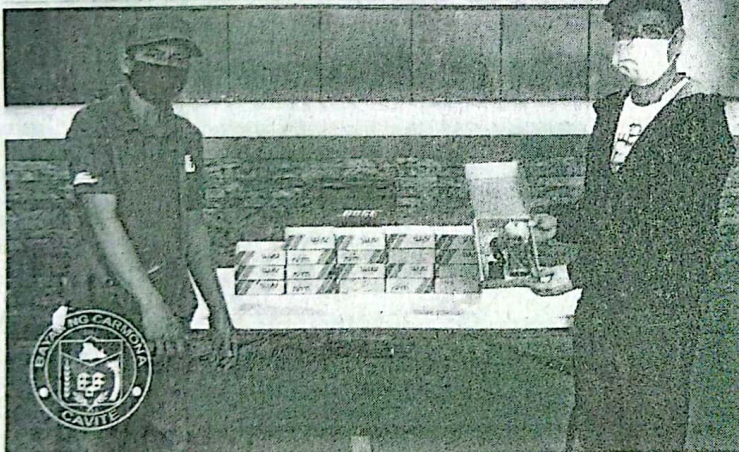

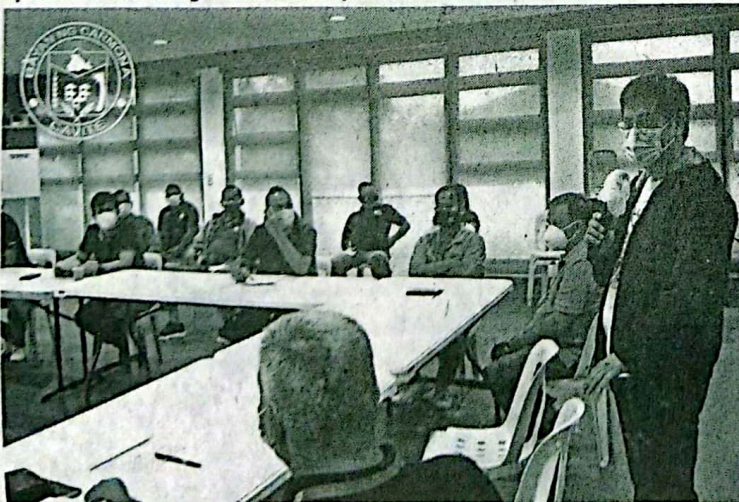

## #BANGON features Singapore COVID-19 food safety experience

Bayanihan recently conquered the international scene. Last June, the Department of Science and Technology-CALABARZON in partnership with Singapore's Nanyang Polytechnic International (NYPi) #BANGON's 6th webinar episode entitled, "Sharing of Singapore's experience in ensuring food safety during COVID-19 pandemic towards a new normal".



DOST, NYPi, and Temasek Foundation have been institutional partners since 2016. Officials and staff of DOST together with other departments like Department of Health, Food and Drug Administration, Department of Agriculture-National Meat Inspection Service and National Authority- Food Development Center have been trained under the Partnership Program. A total of 160 officials and staff completed the program. To date, DOST and NYPi's partnership continues to grow through collaboration and networking on food testing and analytical tools. A recent addition is this #BANGON webinar where they shared their experiences and

A total of 214 food safety trainers and MSMEs were better equipped with timely and relevant information through an interactive and insightful sharing of experiences and best practices in the field of food safety and technology led by Mr. Richard Khaw, Deputy Director of Nanyang Polytechnic School of Chemical and Life Sciences.

Mr. Khaw in his discussion proved that experience is indeed the best teacher as he shared the temporary and new measures of food safety in his country. He also shared specific best practices of industries in Singapore and highlighted the impact and different challenges to food regulators in this COVID-19 pandemic 'season'.

Usec. Brenda Nazareth-Manzano, DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations, in her opening remarks stated that unsafe food is detrimental to the economy. "When food is not safe, children cannot learn, adults cannot work, and humans cannot function." She then went on to emphasize that this is precisely the reason why DOST puts premium on the country's food safety

needs. Secretary Fortunato T. de la Peña in his inspirational message seconded this by stating that 60% of the MSMEs that DOST has been assisting are under the food sector specifically under food processing. He then went on to note the importance of food safety especially during these times. "We need all the knowledge for keeping food safe...particularly now that we are doing marketing in very different ways than before (as)...there are a lot of logistics involved and many stages where unsafe practices can come in." Dr. Alexander Madrigal, Regional Director of DOST-CALABARZON, also highlighted the importance of the webinar as a means to better equip our frontliners in the field of food safety with timely and relevant information that could help improve and innovate our strategies and practices.

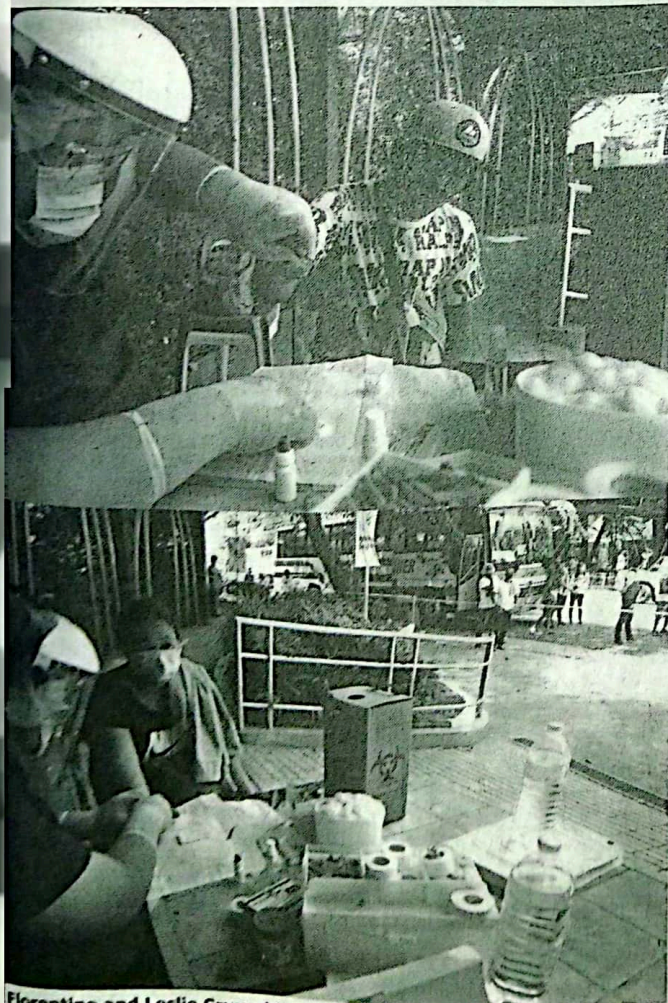

But like any other businesses, Harl's was caught off guard when the pandemic happened.

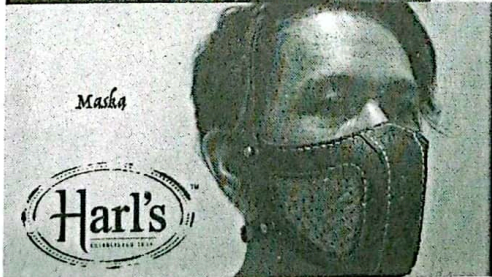

against coronavirus disease".

The said circular also defined health workers as "persons engaged in health and health-related work, regardless of employment status, which include doctors, nurses, allied health professionals, administrative and support personnel in health facilities, utility and security personnel working in health facilities, health volunteers deployed in health facilities and staff and personnel working in government health agencies." Aside from full coverage, these health workers are also

entitled to PhilHealth benefits for SARS-CoV-2 testing package ranging from P901 to P3,409 as stipulated in its Circular No. 2020-0017.

PhilHealth reminded that hospitals face sanctions should they be found to have refused admission or charged any copayment to any health workers exposed and treated for Covid-19. It also asked for broader public support to invoke this privilege granted by law and to immediately report any information of abuse or negligence on the part of health care providers.

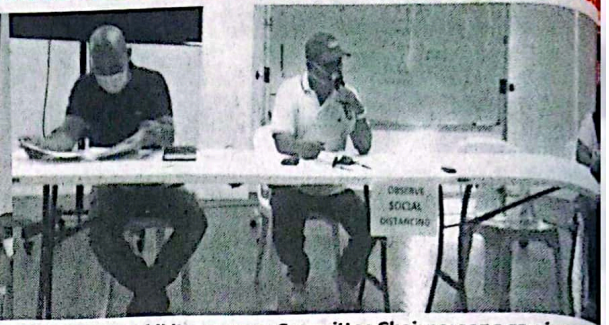

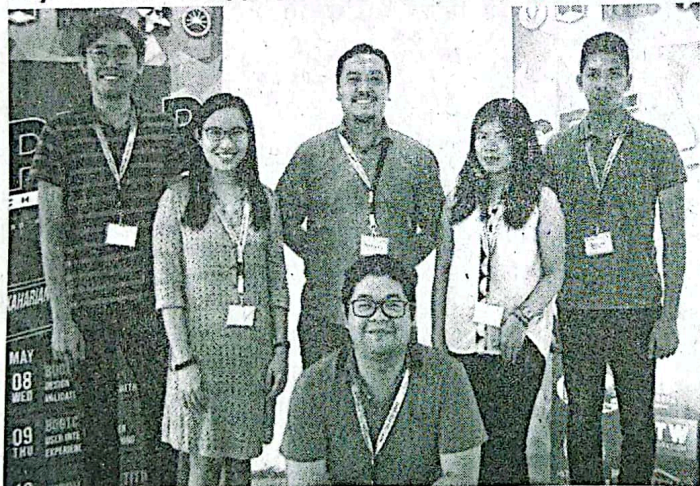
