





PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 283-2020

AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING THE NUMBER CODING SCHEME IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE

Sponsored by: Vice Governor Ramon Jolo B. Revilla III and Hon. Fulgencio C. dela Cuesta, Jr.

:REAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922 on 8 March 2020, declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines, and ation No. 929 on 16 March 2020, declaring a State of Calamity throughout the country in light of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic;

REAS, Republic Act No. 11469 or the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act declared a State of National Emergency over the entire country due to COVID-19;

REAS, Resolution No. 41 series of 2020 of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) placed the Province of Inder General Community Quarantine (GCQ) until 15 June 2020;

REAS, the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines issued by the IATF-EID allowed the operation of public ration in areas under GCQ only at a reduced operational and vehicle capacity and subject to the guidelines issued by the Department of Transportation;

REAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 164, as amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 173, implemented the Number Coding Scheme Ordinance of the Province of Cavite, the motor vehicles allowed to traverse particular roads in the Province;

REAS, frontline workers and workers allowed to return to work face difficulty traveling to and from their places of work due to the limitations imposed on the in of public transportation, as well as the restrictions under the Number Coding Scheme;

REAS, there is a need to ease the situation for persons traveling during the limited operation of public transportation by lifting the restrictions imposed by the Coding Scheme on private vehicles;

f, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. dela Cuesta, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it enacted by the niang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

TION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Suspending the Number Coding Scheme in the Province of Cavite."

TION 2. Suspension of Number Coding Scheme. The Number Coding Scheme in the Province of Cavite shall be suspended. TION 3. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions and executive orders inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified ngly.

TION 4. Separability Clause. If any part or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in ree and effect.

SECTION 5. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take immediately.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 268-2020, AS AMENDED BY PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE

ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING CURFEW HOURS FROM 8:00 PM TO 5:00 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY, WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE DUE TO COVID-19"

Sponsored by: Vice Governor Ramon Jolo B. Revilla III and Hon. Reynlel A. Ambion Co-sponsored by: All Sanggunlang Panlalawigan Members

HEREAS, Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides in part that every local government unit shall be the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, to see which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare and shall ensure and support, among other things, the promotion of health and safety;

IEREAS, a total of 30,052 confirmed cases of COVID-19 was reported by the Department of Health as of 21 June 2020, 4:00 PM;

IEREAS, the Province of Cavite, previously being placed under Enhanced Community Quarantine, was placed under General Community Quarantine (GCQ) as per ion Nos. 35, 40, and 41, Series of 2020, of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-MEID), signed by its Chairperson and Cabinet Secretary, Sec. Karlo Alexei B. Nograles;

EREAS, the Province of Cavite remains under GCQ until 30 June 2020 as per the announced decision of President Rodrigo R. Duterte last 15 June 2020;

EREAS, the Province of Cavite has a total of 434 confirmed cases of COVID-19 as of 14 June 2020, 3:00 PM;

REAS, in the middle of this pandemic and quarantine and considering that there is continually increasing number of confirmed positive COVID-19 patients in the the Provincial Government of Cavite incessantly escalates its efforts to progressively flatten the curve of COVID-19 cases in the province, thus, certain measures actions shall be continually implemented;

FREAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 277-2020 extended the effectivity of curfew hours in the Province of Cavite when it was placed on GCQ as this continues limiting sorto-person contact and prevents individuals from going out unnecessarily, particularly during late night, especially in public places;

FREAS, in order to give more time for the majority of the working sector already allowed to physically report to work to commute, considering that they still to transportation difficulties, it is deemed appropriate to lessen the curfew hours period in the Province of Cavite, thereby amending Provincial Ordinance No. 268-thewise known as the Curfew Hours for the Province of Cavite due to COVID-19 Ordinance, as amended by Provincial Ordinance No. 277-2020;

W, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Ambion, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it enacted by the Sangguniang arigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

Prohibited Acts - It shall be unlawful for the public to loiter, wander, stroll, play or to remain or stay in public places within the territorial jurisdiction of the eg of Cavite without legal justifiable reason from 8:00 PM to 4:30 AM of the following day, daily, unless falling under herein exceptions.

al also be unlawful for any parent or guardian of a child to knowingly permit or negligently allow the child to remain in any public place within the Province of Cavite infew hours. Parents and guardians of minors are expected to keep their minor children from leaving their home.

TION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval and compliance with posting and publication requirements.
