


Areas of Special Concern declared due to spike in CoViD cases

General Trias, Cavite Aug 14, – By virtue of Executive Order no. 22 s. 2021 issued by the City Government here, areas observed with increase in the number of CoViD-19 cases are declared Areas of Special Concern.

On Thursday, August 12, 2021 Tierra Nevada Subdivision (Phase 1 & 2), Barangay San Francisco was declared Areas of Special Concern from August 13 – 22, while Barangay 1896 will be under this restriction from today, August 14 – 23. The order declares the strengthening of the Prevention, Detection, Isolation, Treatment and Reintegration (PDITR) Strategies for CoViD-19 response of the City Health Office.

Limitation on movement of the people in said area will be undertaken thru the establishment of PNP and Barangay Quarantine Control Points as well as strict enforcement of the Minimum Public Health Standards at all times. Visitors will not be allowed entry within the Area of Special Concern.

Only Authorized Persons Outside of Residence (APOR) and those aged 18-65 will be allowed to leave home to work in permitted establishments, purchase essential necessities or services, and obtain assistance from the Government. They are also exempted from curfew hours which runs from 7pm – 4am.

Essential businesses/establishments will be allowed to operate within the said area, while sales and consumption of liquor is strictly prohibited.

Based on the latest CoViD-19 Case Bulletin as of yesterday, August 13, a total of 80 new cases and 25 late cases of the disease was recorded for a total of 8,099 Confirmed positive cases. Out of the total, 594 are Active cases, patient recoveries reached 7,360, and 145 CoViD-19 related deaths recorded.

The declaration of Areas of Special Concern aims to contain the further spread of the disease caused by the CoViD-19 in the wake of the threat of the contagious Delta variant already detected in the province. (Ruel Francisco/City Government of General Trias FB page)


Vegetable farming in the new normal: A look into the women of the Angono New Normal Farmers Association

These were the words of Loreta Magadia, the former President of the Angono New Normal Farmers Association (ANNFA)—an organization mostly composed of women farmers who advocate for community vegetable farming to alleviate hunger in the new normal. Currently, the organization already has 50 members, 40 of which are women.

How it all began





Women in farming
Most of the women in
the ANFA expressed the
joy and fulfillment that
they found in vegetable
gardening. For some, it
was a source of livelihood
for their family; for others,
a newfound hobby.

"Mananahi talaga ako,
tapos natigil ako sa
pananahi at nagsimulang
maging housewife [na
lang] at magtanim-tanim
sa aking buhong," shared

Asteria Santiago, ANFA
member, "Pero ngayon
mas madalas na ako
magtanim kaysa manahi."

Meanwhile, Leodinis
Formentera, another
ANFA member, said that
her dream is to
continuously learn how to
farm and help others in
the process of doing so,
especially those who are
less fortunate.

"Ang pangarap ko [ay]

silang magtanim;
tuturuan ko sila," she
continued, "Pangarap ko
[rin] ay tuloy-tuloy mag-
aral sa tanim." She
eventually convinced her
husband to join the
organization so they can

However, despite their
hopeful dispositions, the
women farmers of ANFA
also have their fair share
of challenges. Ms. Narisa
observed that since most
of the member-farmers
are women between the
ages of 45 to 65 years old,
they find it difficult to do
laborious tasks such as
carrying heavy farm
equipment and tilling the
soil for longer periods of
time.

farming and expressed
her personal struggles as
a farmer herself.

DOH-CALABARZON TELLS RESIDENTS TO STAY INDOORS TO AVOID EXPOSURE FROM VOG

Department of Health (DOH)- CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal and Quezon) cautioned residents, especially those living in communities near the vicinity of the Taal Volcano to stay indoors as it continues to spew high levels of sulfur dioxide causing hazardous volcanic smog or "vog".

"It is best to stay at home and limit exposure outside as much as possible to reduce contact with the smog. This type of air pollution can cause eye, throat and respiratory irritation. It can also aggravate health problems like asthma, emphysema at chronic bronchitis," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

"Siguruhin din nating nakasara ang ating mga pintuan at bintana upang hindi makapasok ang smog sa loob ng bahay. Wear facemask and sunglasses when going out as added protection. At huwag kalilimutang magdala at uminom ng tubig. It is important to always hydrate yourself to reduce throat irritation."

According to Phivolcs "vog" is a type of air pollution caused by volcanoes, consisting of fine droplets containing volcanic gas, such as sulfur dioxide, which is acidic and can cause irritation to the eyes, throat, and respiratory tract in severities depending on the gas concentrations and durations of exposure.

According to the Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology's (Phivolcs)

bulletin at 8:00AM today, alert Level 2 is still in effect, where sudden steam- or gas-driven explosions, volcanic earthquakes, minor ashfall, and lethal accumulations or expulsions of volcanic gas can be expected occur that can threaten communities within and around the Taal volcano.

The sulfur dioxide (SO₂) levels in some areas of Luzon are presently elevated due to the activity of two volcanoes, particularly Taal Volcano and a submarine volcano in Fukutoku-Okanoba in Japan which recently spewed high levels of SO₂ which enhanced the present hazy conditions.

Janairo advised residents to seek immediate medical attention if experiencing physical complaints associated with vog exposure which includes headaches, breathing difficulties, watery eyes and flu-like symptoms.

Vaccine, discipline, & cooperation to overcome crisis – Mayor

Municipality of Mendez-Núñez Mayor Eric Aure Vida, in his address to his constituents, stated that getting vaccinated, exercising discipline, and staying steadfast in faith would help beat this COVID-19 pandemic.

The alarming rate of infection recently observed had recorded a total of 134 Confirmed cases for a period of two weeks from August 1 – 14 as compared to the previous months of the first half of the year. This has caused the overwhelming use of the present isolation facilities and hospitals in the town.

Mayor Vida disclosed that preparations of the CADIPSA Retreat Center is currently being undertaken for the inspection and approval of the Department of Health. Once the center is approved it will be used as the new isolation facility of the town in response for the upsurge in the number of cases.

On the other hand, the local chief executive said that getting the protection given by the COVID-19

vaccines is the most responsible thing to do that would make a huge difference to staying safe and alive.

Current vaccine statistics for Mendez town show that a total of 17,308 doses of COVID-19 vaccines had been administered that is equivalent to 65% of target vaccinees with 1,792 target residents receiving the 1st dose, and 15,516 or 58% are fully vaccinated against the coronavirus disease.

"We are already vaccinating all Mendezños 18 years and older with the vaccination program strictly following the Master List, and the Barangay schedule," said Vida.

He asked his constituents to be responsible by informing the Rural Health Unit, and the Barangay Health

CALABARZON DELTA CASES NOW

Department of Health (DOH)- CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal and Quezon) Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit disclosed a total of 148 cases of the dreaded Delta Variant.

From the five provinces Laguna tops the list with 48 recorded cases; Cavite follows with 44 cases; Rizal with 33; Batangas with 15; and Quezon with 8 Delta variant cases.

According to Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo from the total of 148 Delta Variant cases, 4 are fully vaccinated, 13 have taken single dose, 58 have no vaccination and 81 are for still for verification.

"Also, from the total number of cases, 102 are local cases, 24 are returning OFWs and 22 are for verification. Janairo added that there are no active Delta Variant cases in the region. "We have 56 recoveries and only 2 deaths recorded."

The regional office has initiated "Project DELTA" (Detect Early Local Transmission through Antigen Testing)

Antigen Testing) to all the provinces with Delta variant cases to immediate stop the spread of the virus in the community.

For Covid-19 cases, as of August 17, 2021, there were 2,929 new cases added. There is now a total of 230,599 cases in the region. Active cases are at 22,004 while 201,670 have recovered. A total of 6,925

DOH-CALABARZON INITIATES 'PROJECT DELTA' TO STOP LOCAL TRANSMISSION

The Department of Health (DOH) CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) recently initiated "Project DELTA" (Detect Early Local Transmission through Antigen Testing) to provinces where the Delta variant were identified.

The Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (RESU) together with the Regional Infectious Disease Cluster led the mass swab testing in the Province of Laguna from July 30, 2021 to August 13, 2021, particularly in Brgy. Sta. Monica in San Pablo City, Brgy. San Nicolas in the town of Bay, Brgy. Wawa in Lumban, Brgys. Barandal and Canlubang in Calamba City.

A total of 343 individuals were tested. Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated that those who have undergone antigen testing were direct contacts of individuals who were afflicted with the Delta variant virus.

"We need to strengthen the implementation of the prevent, detect, isolate, treat

and re-integrate response strategies against the Covid-19 virus."



PhilHealth assures coverage of patients admitted in ERs, tents

Patients admitted in emergency rooms (ERs) and tents within the hospital compound pending availability of hospital rooms are covered by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth).

This was reiterated by the state health insurer as COVID-19 cases continue to surge and several health care facilities have reportedly been running at full capacity to accommodate patients.

In its Advisory Nos. 2021-027 and 2021-028, PhilHealth stressed the provision of PhilHealth Circular No. 35, s-2013 that when admitted patients must stay in ER or within the hospital premises pending availability of rooms, full payment shall be given, provided the patient stayed in the hospital for 24 hours or more.

The Department of Health through Memorandum No. 2020-0171 has instructed hospitals to adopt strategies to increase their capacities to manage COVID-19 during surge of cases that includes setting up tents when necessary.

PhilHealth beneficiaries admitted in tents within the compound of accredited hospitals in areas categorized as high or critical risk for COVID-19 shall be compensable starting March 29, 2021.

The state agency also asserted that patients including COVID-19 cases being admitted and managed in ER due to lack of available regular rooms shall be paid by PhilHealth if the patient stayed within the hospital for at least 24 hours. However, private hospitals are required to submit a justification letter together with their claim in compliance with the said policy.

On the other hand, patients confirmed with COVID-19 and developed into severe illnesses can avail themselves of inpatient benefits for mild pneumonia, P43,997; moderate pneumonia, P143,267; severe pneumonia, P333,519; and critical pneumonia for P786,384. An intermediate package for previously managed as probable COVID-19 case but had negative RT-PCR test results are also covered with the intermediate package amounting to P18,000 and P38,000 for moderate and severe/critical pneumonia, respectively.

Meanwhile, PhilHealth calls on health care providers to honor all availments including those of patients staying in tents, ERs or within the hospital premises wherein services are provided as part of the inpatient care. ###

for an environmental-friendly transportation mode."

In his opening remarks, DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations, Engr. Sancho A. Maborang, who was a former DOST R-2 Director, said the HERT "will not only address the transportation problems in the region but will also provide the local governments with additional sources of



ILAGAN CITY, Isabela – The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), in collaboration with the Ilagan City government and the Isabela State University (ISU) here will shortly undertake the fabrication and production of the Hybrid Electric Road Train (HERT) and field them out as an alternative mode of mass transport in Isabela and the Cagayan Valley region.


