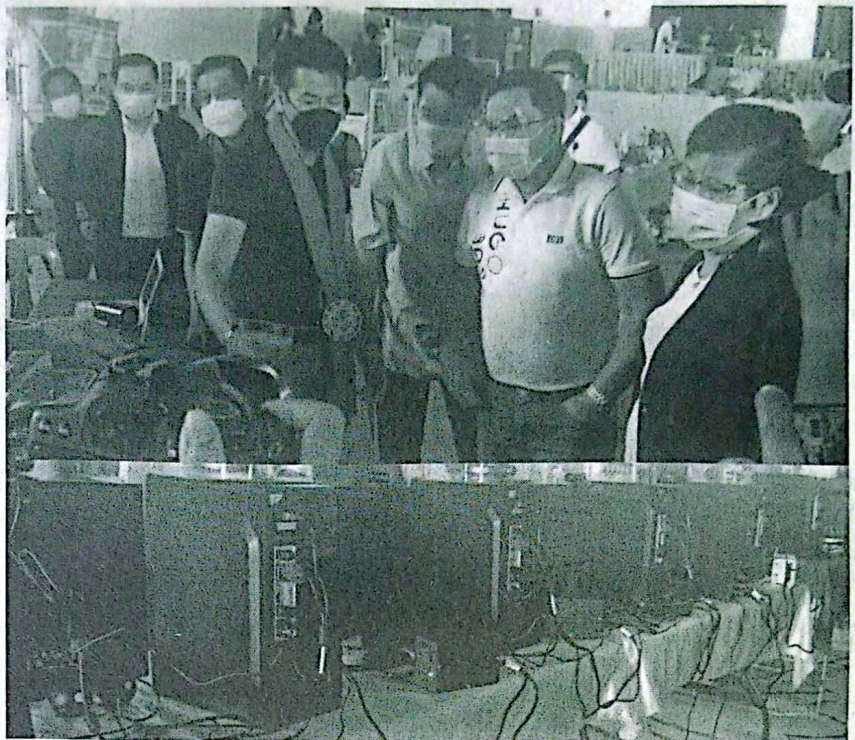

NOVELETA, Cavite Aug. 24, 2020 -- The local government here thru the Municipal Health Unit recorded a total of 62 recoveries from COVID-19 and maintained zero death status for the town.

Based on the latest COVID-19 update as of August 19, 2020, the total confirmed cases recorded was 82 out of which 62 had fully recovered or 76.32% for the past 150-days.

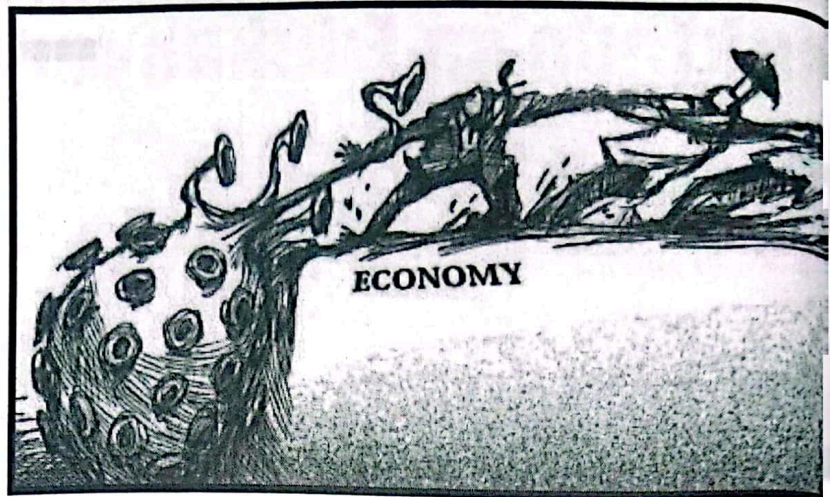
Totoo na panahon nang baguhin ang sistema ng ating gobyerno, at gawin itong federal system.

OFFICIAL STATEMENT

PhilHealth denies cover up in Region 1 leak incident; remains committed to cooperate in all investigations by authorities

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) assures the public that there is no truth to allegations of a cover up on the leak incident in its PhilHealth Region 1 Office in Dagupan City due to a heavy downpour on August 19, 2020.

As earlier reported, all the documents are intact and are all accounted for, and no critical equipment suffered damage from the incident. The Philippine National Police, Bureau of Fire Protection, Criminal Investigation and Detection Group, and the National Bureau of Investigation have initially looked into the incident.

The PRO I is also conducting parallel investigation and is now coordinating with the NBI to secure a copy of their own report to the Department of Justice. Reports that circulated citing that the affected areas are the IT and Accounting Sections which are both located at the ground floor are false.

Footage that circulated showing the leaks affecting computers and printers was at the Benefit

Administration Section which is located at the mezzanine. PRO 1's IT personnel have acted swiftly

to save the said equipment. Nevertheless, data are secured in its data center electronic filing of claims. As to the agents in the head office, the Agency is their concern to protect essential documents by the Task Force PhilHealth in their

PhilHealth assures them that these intact and will be made available to the reiterates its commitment to fully cooperate the investigating authorities. It asks everyone to refrain from speculating so undue public concern.

since the lockdown started while other towns in the district like Kawit has recorded 9 deaths, Rosario, 6 and Cavite City also 6 deaths.

"The programs of the local government has been effective causing COVID-19 patients to recover quickly. One of these, is the immediate opening of the Noveleta MedCare Hospital (NMH) as COVID-19 facility for the people of Noveleta," stated Mayor Dino Chua-Reyes.

In addition, the Local Risk Reduction and Management Office (LDRRMO) continuously conducts misting and disinfection activities in the 16 barangays in the municipality that resulted in the containment and further spread of the virus.

The LDRRMO distributed free face masks to the vendors in

the public market and to tricycle and jeepney drivers for their safety as well as to the public they serve.

Face shields were also distributed to barangay chairpersons, kagawads and barangay police for their protection while guarding their respective villages.

Since the lockdown began, the LGU distributed 10,000 relief packs and is still providing relief assistance to all affected families in the town.

"The LGU is determined to surpass this pandemic with the help of every single citizen of Noveleta," Mayor Dino Chua-Reyes said in an interview.

Meanwhile, the COVID-19 patients in the town were under the care and supervision of Municipal Health Officer Dr. Hilda Bucu. These patients were 37 asymptomatic, 25 were admitted at the NMH were

already recovered while the remaining 20 active cases were either admitted in the hospital or under strict quarantine in the isolation facility.

The LGU provided free food and medicines to the patients until they fully recovered.

The barangays with recorded outbreak of COVID-19 cases were Magdiwang with 14 cases, San Antonio 1 with 17 cases, San Rafael III with 15 and San Juan 1 with 9 cases while two barangays remain Zero Covid case namely Santa Rosa II and San Rafael I.

"For our safety, please follow government guidelines of proper wearing of face masks and face shields, observe physical distancing, practice proper handwashing, and avoid crowded places," the mayor continuously reminded the people.

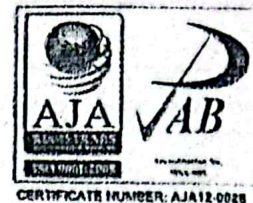

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 294-2020

ORDINANCE MANDATING THE STRICT OBSERVANCE OF PHYSICAL DISTANCING OF ALL PERSONS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

Introduced by: **Vice Governor Ramon Jolo B. Revilla III,**
Hon. Valeriano S. Encabo, and Hon. Edralin G. Gawaran
 Sponsored by: **Hon. Reyniel A. Ambion**

Co-sponsored by: **All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members**

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides in part that every local government unit shall exercise powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare and shall ensure and support, among other things, the promotion of health and safety;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte signed Proclamation 922 on 08 March 2020 and Proclamation 929 on 16 March 2020, which declare the Philippines under the state of health emergency and state of calamity, respectively, due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) states that while vaccines and specific medications are not yet available for COVID-19, other public health and social measures play an essential role in reducing the number of infections and in saving lives and that these measures must be implemented with the full engagement of all members of society;

WHEREAS, according to the same organization, COVID-19 is primarily transmitted by droplets through direct or close contact with an infected person and indirect contact with contaminated surfaces, also known as fomite transmission;

WHEREAS, WHO also said that the new coronavirus can possibly be transmitted through the air in crowded indoor settings with poor ventilation such as restaurants and offices;

WHEREAS, considering that there is continually increasing number of confirmed positive COVID-19 patients in the province, the Provincial Government of Cavite continually makes efforts to contain the spread of such cases in the province;

WHEREAS, compliance to safety measures concerning COVID-19 in the Province of Cavite, including the physical distancing, shall be intensified in order to help minimize and prevent the community transmission of COVID-19;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion Hon. Ambion, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Physical Distancing Ordinance of the Province of Cavite."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Provincial Government of Cavite to adopt and implement measures and policies that will protect and promote the health and safety of its constituents and to help prevent the massive spread of COVID-19.

SECTION 3. COVERAGE. All persons who are found within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Cavite are covered by this ordinance.

SECTION 4. MANDATORY PROVISION.

All persons are hereby mandated to strictly observe physical distancing of at least one (1) meter from other persons.

Physical distancing shall be strictly observed in the following places:

• Inside and outside of the business establishments, markets, pharmacies, banks, remittance centers, medical and quarantine facilities, private and government offices, and institutions allowed to operate.

• Highways, roads, alleys, streets, parks and sidewalks in all subdivisions, villages and barangays of the component cities and municipalities of the Province of Cavite

SECTION 5. APPREHENSION. The Philippine National Police, together with the Barangays are hereby deputized to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. PENALTY CLAUSE. Any person who violates this Ordinance shall be meted with a fine of Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00) or shall attend community awareness campaign on COVID-19 for four (4) hours as conducted by the barangay officials or the Philippine National Police (PNP).

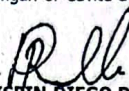
SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, provisions not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances and rules inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect after its approval and compliance with the posting and publication requirements.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON FROM WANDERING ABOUT IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL, WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE

Sponsored by: **Hon. Felix A. Grepo**
Vice Chair, Committee on Peace, Public Safety, and Order
Co-sponsored by: **All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members**

HEREAS, Section 5, Article XI of the 1987 Constitution provides that the maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

HEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No: 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, gives local government units such powers expressly granted, those implicitly implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

HEREAS, Section 468(a)(1)(v) of the Local Government Code states that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan shall enact ordinances intended to prevent, suppress and impose appropriate penalties for habitual drunkenness in public places;

HEREAS, public intoxication shall be curbed through its criminalization in order to ensure peace and order in the Province;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Grepo, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it ordained as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Cavite in a special session duly called and assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Prohibiting any Person from Wandering about in any Public Place while Under the Influence of Alcohol, within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Province of Cavite."

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance:

Alcohol refers to alcoholic beverages classified into beer, wine and distilled spirits, the consumption of which produces intoxication.

Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) refers to the measure of amount of alcohol in a person's blood.

Breath analyzer refers to the equipment which can determine the blood alcohol concentration level of a person through testing of his breath.

Under the influence of alcohol refers to the condition where a person's blood alcohol concentration level has, after being subjected to a breath analyzer test, reached the level 5% or higher.

SECTION 3. PROHIBITED ACTS. It shall be unlawful for any person to wander in any public place while under the influence of alcohol or to interfere with or obstruct or prevent the free use of any street, sidewalk, or other public way by reason of his or her being under the influence of alcohol.

Condition of being unable to exercise care for one's own safety or the safety of others shall constitute probable cause to believe that the person is under the influence of alcohol.

SECTION 4. PENAL PROVISION. Any person found violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be penalized with a fine of not more than Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) or imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION 5. VIOLATION INVOLVING MINORS. Any person under the age of eighteen (18) found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be dealt with in accordance with existing laws, and regulations relating to Children in Conflict with the Law. This is without prejudice to any liability of the parents and/or guardians of such minors under existing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 6. CONCERNED CITIZEN PARTICIPATION. Any person who has personal knowledge of the presence of any person who is intoxicated with liquor or any alcoholic beverages or any combination thereof in any public place, may call the attention of any law enforcement officer or report the same to the barangay or police station for appropriate action.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTATION. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect until lifted or revoked by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan upon recommendation of the Provincial Governor.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, and executive orders inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

Attest and certify that the foregoing ordinance was duly enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite during its 12th Special Session on June 26, 2020.

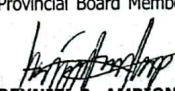

These face shields were fabricated by the DOST- Metals Industry Research and Development Center (DOST-MIRDC) to support medical and non-medical front liners nationwide.

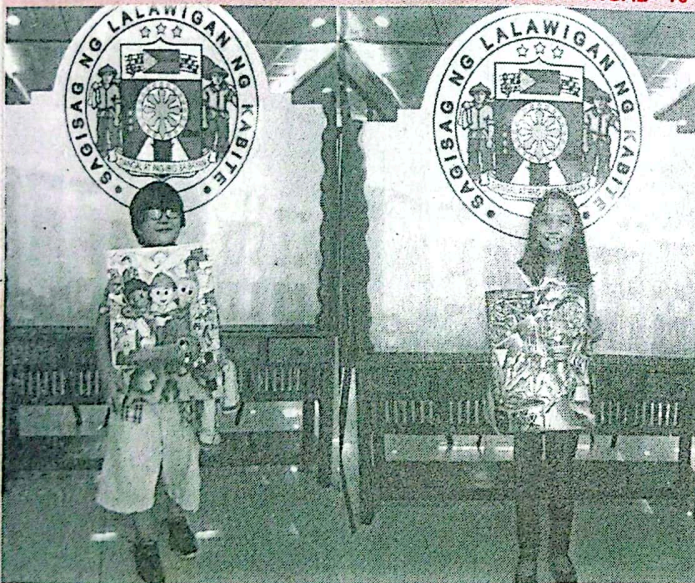
Aside from the protection for the eyes, nose, and mouth that it gives, the face shields are also believed by the local researchers as a convenient protection from the transmission of the virus.

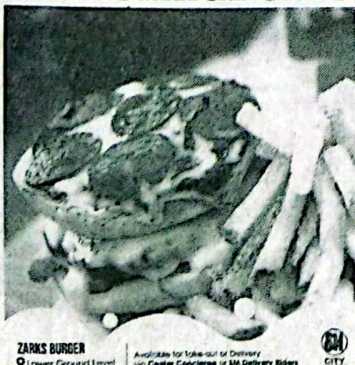

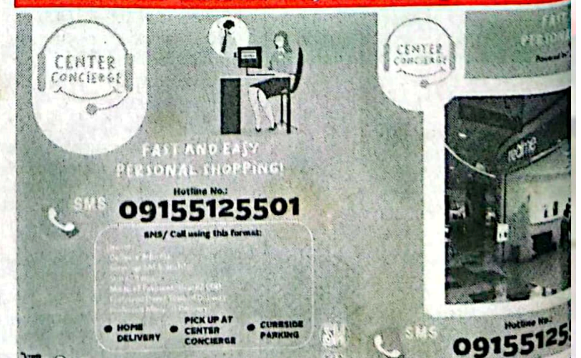
