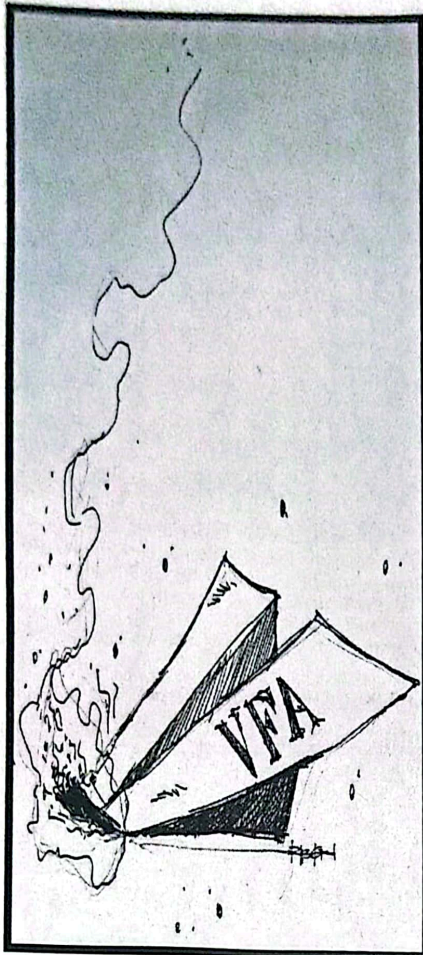

Corregidor Flag Raising: 75 years freedom and friendship

Corregidor Island, Cavite City — The Island of Corregidor had played an important part particularly during the invasion and liberation of the country from Japanese invasion.

The heavy bombardment that pounded the fortress that stood guard against the enemies is still evident with the ruins now serving as a military memorial to American, Filipino, Japanese and other allied forces who served or lost their lives on the battlefield.

It was on March 2, 1945 that the U. S. flag was raised on this island with General Douglas MacArthur declaring: "I see the old flagpole still stands. Have your troops hoist the colors to its peak, and let no enemy ever haul them down."

Seventy five years after that historic day we now celebrate 75 years of freedom and friendship with our allies, even with those we consider our foes during the war who now are our friendly neighbors.

According to MGen. Edgardo De Leon, Deputy Chief of Staff for Civil Military Operations J7, Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) special guest to the event and



representative to Defense Secretary Delfin Lorenzana, "This friendship was maintained in pursuit of a common dream."

"This was made possible by our common desire towards conciliation, and our collective commitment to promote peace, freedom, democracy, and amity among nations in this

civilized world," MGen. De Leon added.

The celebration of the Corregidor Flag Raising was graced by several foreign dignitaries that we kept friendly ties with and was made possible by the efforts of the provincial government of Cavite in coordination with the National Historic Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) and

the Department of Tourism.

ALLEGED MONEY LAUNDERING, POGO CRIMINAL ACTIVITY EXPOSED \$633M entered PH in 7 months: Gordon

FOREIGN currencies amounting to US\$633 million (P32 billion) has entered the Philippines carried by 60 individuals as of 5 March this year.

This was revealed by Senator Richard Gordon, chairman of the Senate Blue Ribbon Committee during the opening of the inquiry on the alleged money laundering scheme and other criminal activities linked to the Philippine offshore gaming operations (POGO).

Gordon said that the money was brought in the

country in "cold cash".

"Nagpapatuloy pa ang ganitong gawain. Bumabaha ang pera ng mga dayuhan," said Gordon.

The senator in his privilege speech last week disclosed that \$447.07 million or P22.69 billion in cash were brought in the country by 47 individuals including some Filipinos from September 2019 to February 2020.

Gordon expressed the fear that the "cold cash" being brought in by different individuals including a Filipino family

can be used in money laundering schemes.

"This might be associated with the POGO. Kaya kailangan nating maimbestigahan ito," the senator said.

Gordon said that from September 2019 to February 2020, the foreign currencies brought, about 49.77 percent were declared to be used for foreign exchange; 16.23 percent for investments and 15.01 percent for travel and casino.

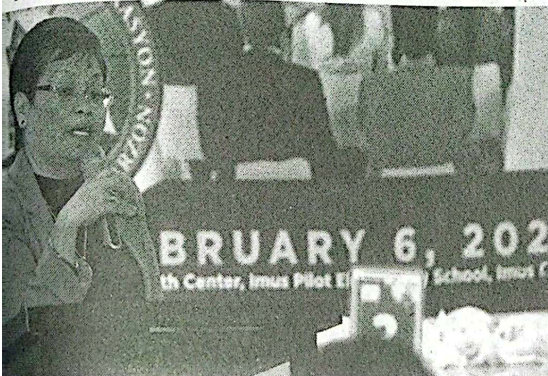

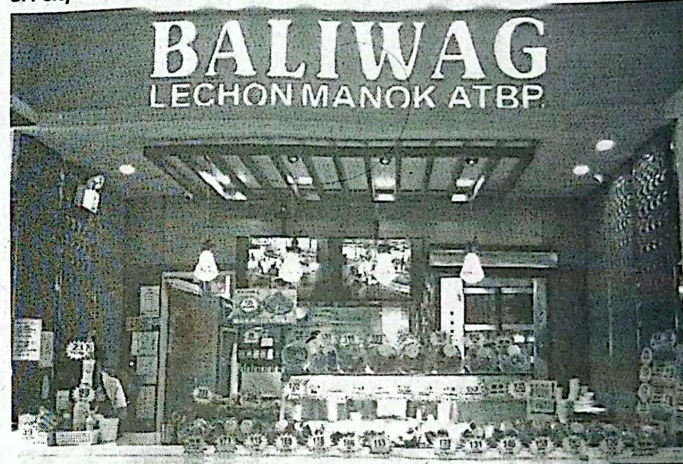

PGC trains Internal Quality Auditors for ISO 9001:2015

To fully grasp the requirements of ISO 9001:2015 in the context of an internal auditor, the provincial government of Cavite thru the Cavite Quality Management Office (CQMO) conducted the ISO 9001:2015 Internal Quality Audit Training at the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Legislative Building in Trece Martines City on February 11-12, 2020. The training aimed to capacitate the internal auditors for the continual improvement of the Quality Management System of the different offices of the provincial government in preparation for re-certification.

Adopting of the process approach and risk-based thinking, PGC-QMS Consultant on Operations, Mr. Antonio Santos shared valuable inputs on

auditing to equip IQAs with knowledge and understanding of what objective evidence are needed to demonstrate conformance with the QMS requirements. The training also aims to prepare the internal auditors on reporting valid information, factual and value-adding audit findings.

Among the topics tackled on the first day were Audit Principles, Understanding the Requirements, and Initiating the Audit and Audit Preparation. Participants were also taught on how to prepare the correlation matrix and how to fill out the auditors note.

On the second day, Audit Execution, Audit Reporting and Audit Follow-up were deliberated and a mock audit was initiated to let

the internal auditors have a feel of how an audit is conducted in an organization with situational problems to test their skills in finding evidence that will support their audit reports.

Previous trainings and seminars were initiated in preparation for the external audit to be held on the second quarter of this year. On August 7-9, 2019, Internal Quality Auditors Training was also conducted at Tagaytay Haven Hotel for the new set of internal auditors. It also served as a refresher course for the senior internal auditors. Likewise, on January 21, 2020, ISO 9001:2015 Appreciation and Risk-Based Thinking Seminar was held to fully grasp the concepts of the QMS international standard. (PICAD)

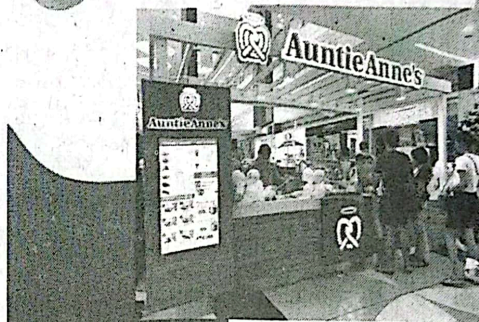

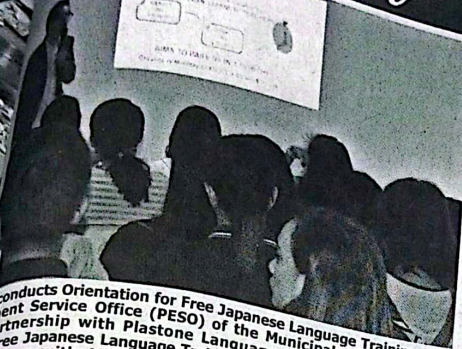

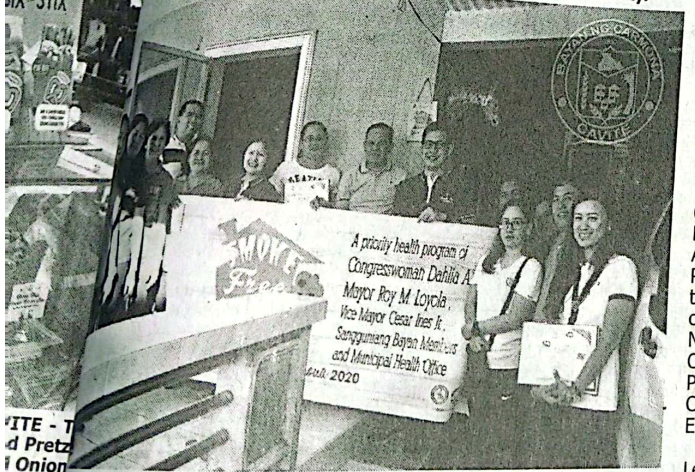

Similarly, MGen. De Leon reminded everyone to keep the spirit of patriotism and love of country in our hearts and mind saying, "Indeed, we can only do justice to the sacrifices of our forebears if we keep alive their valor and carry on with their dreams for our country."

confusion and panic and how it can be prevented. 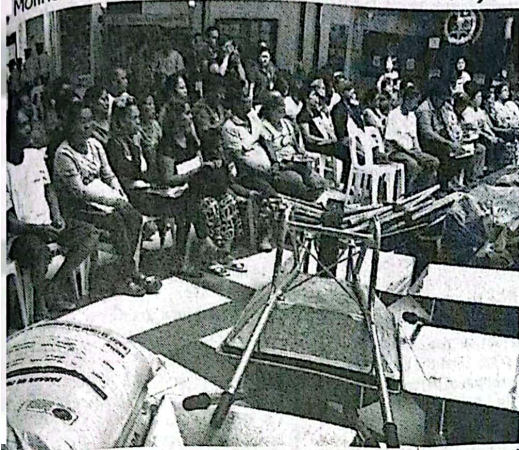

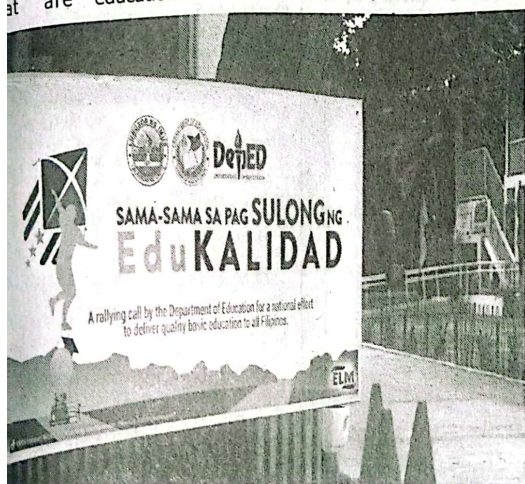

PNP ACCOUNTED 20 ARRESTS IN AN OVERNIGHT ANTI-CRIMINALITY DRIVE

most wanted persons; ranked Nr 3 in Dasmariñas City for the crime of Attempted Homicide and ranked Nr 8 in Cavite Provincial Level Manhunt Charlie List for the crime of Violation of RA 10883 (New Anti-Carnapping Act 2020 of 2016). The four other wanted persons were apprehended for the crimes of Serious Physical Injuries, Qualified Theft and Violation of RA 10883 (Anti-Carnapping Act). Six bettors were arrested while on the act of playing Bingo in Cavite City. They were charged for Violation of PD 1602 (Illegal Gambling). A former employee of Pat and Sam Delicacies & Pasalubong in Barangay 39, Caridad, Cavite City was arrested after a follow operation by Cavite City Police. Suspect was caught by the store owner inside the storage while on the act of stealing. Suspect attacked the store owner causing him to fall

unconscious. While the store owner was in the state of unconsciousness, the suspect even took the money inside his pocket amounting to Php 20,000.00. The Incident was captured by the CCTV which resulted in the suspect's identification and arrest.

Along Governors Drive Rd, San Roque Intersection, Brgy. San Roque, Naic, Cavite, a child in conflict with the law was apprehended after he disregarded the Oplan Sita while on board his motorcycle without helmet in a speedy and reckless manner. Police was able to grasp the T-Shirt of the suspect to stop but he was dragged in more or less 5-7 meters distance and uttered words "Bumitaw ka! Kung hindi mamamatay ka!" The police sustained injuries on different parts of his body and was brought to Naic Medicare Hospital for Medical Treatment. The minor was charged for Attempted Homicide, Violation of RA 10054, Violation of RA 4136,

Resistance and Disobedience involving one CICL (Child in Conflict with the Law).

An Indian National was pronounced dead on arrival by attending physician after he and his Indian friend were hit while they were standing at the side of the road by a Mitsubishi Sedan that transpired in Brgy. Neogan, Tagaytay City early this morning. The driver of Sedan was held under custody and was charged for Reckless Imprudence Resulting in Homicide, Physical Injuries and Damaged to Properties.

Arrested suspects and pieces of evidence were brought to Cavite Provincial Crime Laboratory Office (SOCO) for laboratory examinations while Criminal Complaints will be filed against them. Cavite Police Provincial Office is continuously strengthening its relentless and collective efforts in its fight against illegal drugs and all forms of criminalities.

GUNNED DOWN IN AN ARMED CONFRONTATION AND 24 ARRESTED IN AN OVERNIGHT ANTI-CRIMINALITY CAMPAIGN BY CAVITE POLICE

Shortly, operatives retaliated resulting in an armed confrontation that caused their instantaneous death. Recovered from the scene were; 6 FCC of Caliber .45, 7 FCC of Caliber 9mm, 1 unit 9mm Pistol 312B loaded with 1 live ammunition and inserted magazine loaded with 1 live ammunition, 1 unit Caliber .45 Pistol P45 Para ordinance loaded with 1 FCC and inserted magazine loaded with 2 live ammunitions, 1 Improvised Shotgun (Sumpak), 3 pieces of 12 gauge live ammunitions, 2 pieces 9mm Luger live ammunitions, 1 piece 5.56mm live ammunition, 1 unit Caliber .38 Special live ammunition and drug paraphernalia.

Another drug suspect identified as Joseph Nocuencia y Veluz a.k.a Joseph was killed after he exchanged fire with the operating Team of General Trias City PNP in a buy bust operation

conducted in Tropical Village PABAHAY 2000, Brgy San Francisco, General Trias City. Recovered from his possession were 1 piece Caliber 45 pistol Colt MK IV chamber loaded with 1 piece of live ammunition; 1 magazine loaded with 2 live ammunitions; 3 pieces fired cartridge cases of Cal 9MM; and bust money.

On campaign against wanted persons, Cavite police conducted 11 operations by virtue of warrants issued by different courts that resulted in the arrest of 11 persons to include 6 most wanted persons; ranked Nr. 1 in Imus City for the crime of Attempted Homicide, Rank Nr. 1 in Alfonso for the crime of Homicide, ranked Nr. 1 in General Trias City for Robbery with Homicide, ranked Nr. 2 in Kawit for Theft, ranked Nr. 3 in Imus City for Robbery, and ranked Nr. 9 in Pinamalayan Oriental Mindoro for Robbery arrested in Imus City.

The other five wanted persons were

apprehended for the crimes of Serious Physical Injuries, Acts of Lasciviousness, Violation of RA 9262 (Violence against Women and Children), RIR in Homicide (Vehicular Accident) and Violation of Article 184 of the Revised Penal Code (Offering False Testimony in Evidence).

Two suspects were apprehended through warrantless arrest for the crimes of Direct Assault in Bacoor City and Physical Injuries in Dasmariñas City.

Arrested suspects and pieces of evidence were brought to Cavite Provincial Crime Laboratory Office (SOCO) for laboratory examinations while Criminal Complaints will be filed against them.

PCOL Santos urged the public to continue their active participation and whole-hearted cooperation in giving information on drug activities to help the PNP in tracking down the sources of drug supplies in Cavite.

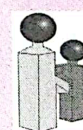
Benepisyo para sa COVID-19
