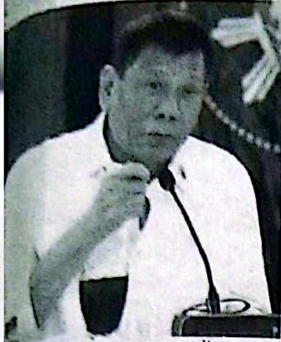

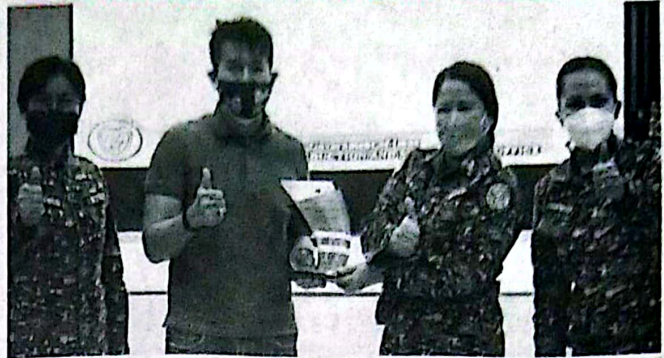
Ginawa ng Pangulo ang kautusan kay Calida upang alamin ang ilang impormasyon hinggil sa mga aktibidades ng ahensya.

## More vaccine needed to stop spread of CoVID-19

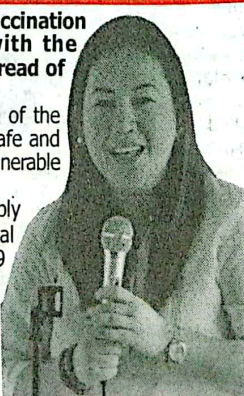

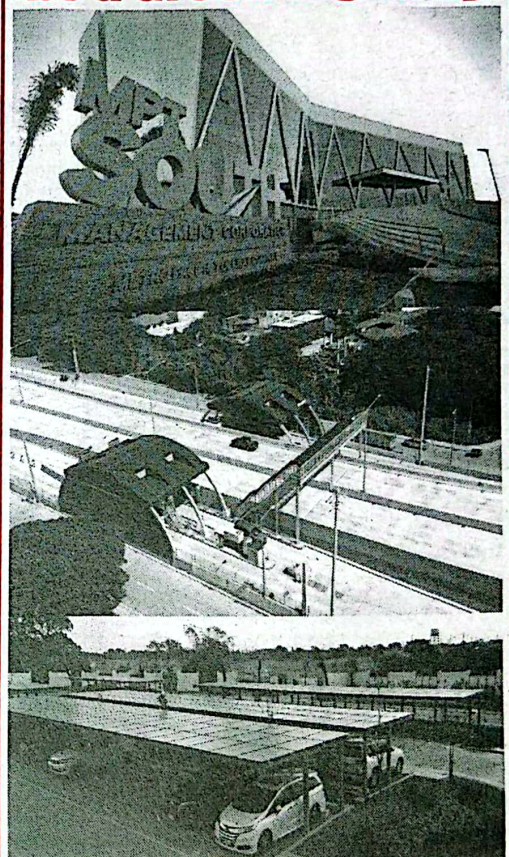
"We hope that the National Government will grant our request to have more allocation for our town because the number of cases of the disease continues to rise," said Poblete.

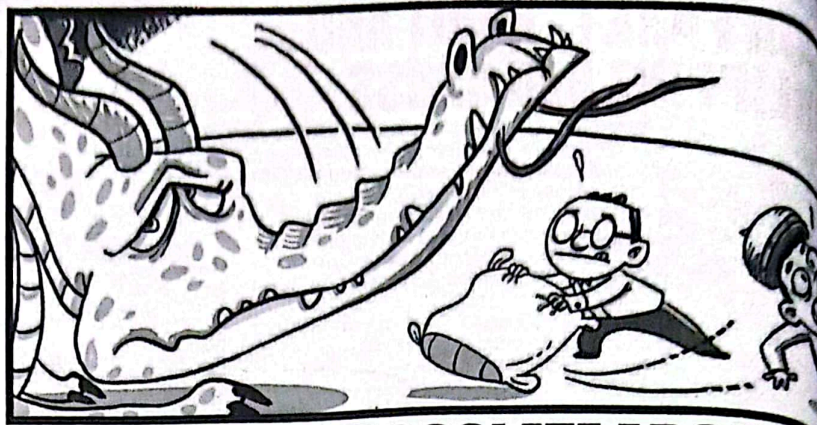

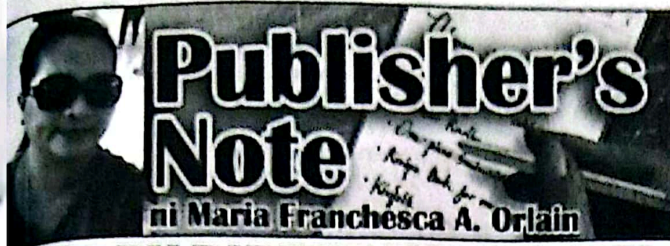

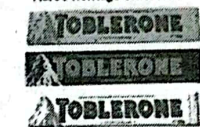

"This is another opportunity that I will be sharing with my PCOO family who has been as enthusiastic in attaining such overwhelming improvement in government media in the past 5 years. Thank you very much," he added.

According to the group, Secretary Andanar was given the award "for being the catalyst of effective media through his current undertaking as the Head of PCOO."

"His clear-cut approach in communicating the real status of the whole-of-government programs and efforts have bridged the information gap between the Filipino people and its civil servants," the award-giving body said in its official social media page

on Thursday.

Shortly after his assumption into public office, Secretary Andanar championed the institutionalization of the Freedom of Information through Executive Order No. 2 signed by the President in September 2016.

Among other game-changing initiatives he also spearheaded was the creation of the national communications policy that harmonized government media operations and messaging. The said policy also birthed the Laging Handa Crisis Communication that is now being extensively used amid the pandemic. Along with PCOO Undersecretary Joel Egco,

they pushed for the welfare of the media which created the Presidential Task Force Media Security.

Secretary Andanar stressed empowerment provincial government media, and satellite office through the success construction of a Mindanao Media Hub, Governance Strategic Communication Academy among other.

The award ceremony will be at the Conrad Manila Hotel, September 24, 2021. Secretary Andanar will join fellow awardee: public servant PD Director General Us Wilkins M Villanueva, who was cited as the leader who championed the implementation of the Barangay Drug Clear Program (BDGP), the framework of the agency anti-drug strategy.

The DVAS is part of the Vaccine Information Management System (VIMS) developed by the DICT in support of the national immunization program of the government. The VIMS is for the masterlisting and pre-registration for vaccination and the DVAS will serve as the central directory of vaccine recipients nationwide.

"Carmona was chosen to pioneer the latest version of DVAS because the municipality has been very adaptive and we are sure that service provided for the community won't be wasted," said Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) Luzon Cluster 2 Regional Director Reynaldo D. Sy who graced the said event.

The implementation of DVAS in the municipality will be supervised by the Information Technology (IT) Unit together with the Municipal Health Office (MHO). This will expedite the processes from registration to post-monitoring of vaccine recipients.

The latest version of DVAS will also shorten the COVID-19 inoculation process by half; streamline report generation; and reduce

risk of errors through paperless transactions and real-time and integrated sharing of data.

A series of training was already held for healthcare workers who will manage the said system to ensure the proper management of data and confidentiality of information.

"DICT has been Carmona's partner since before. Carmona was able to pilot various DICT programs such as the Rural Impact Sourcing (RIS) and Tech4Ed Centers and we ensured that these programs have been strengthened throughout the years," Former Carmona Municipal Mayor and current Representative of the Fifth District of Cavite Dr. Dahlia A. Loyola said.

Moreover, Municipal Mayor Roy M. Loyola expressed his gratitude to DICT for recognizing the efforts of the Municipality of Carmona in public service.

DICT Consultant Hadrian Cruz, Developer of DVAS Engr. Rex Avila from EBiz-DICT, Vice Mayor Cesar L. Ines Jr., members of the Sangguniang Bayan, IT Unit Head Angelo Macha, and Municipal Health Officer Dr. Homer Aguinaldo also attended the kick-off program.

**PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 328-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE STRENGTHENING THE NEWBORN SCREENING PROGRAM IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE**

Introduced and Sponsored by: **Hon. Kerby J. Salazar**  
 Co-sponsored by: **All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members**

**WHEREAS**, the 1987 Philippine Constitution declares that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of all its people and shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development;

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that local government units shall ensure and support, among others, the promotion of general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, according to the Philippine Pediatrics Society, the advancement of newborn screening has succeeded in reducing morbidity and mortality associated with certain congenital disorders;

**WHEREAS**, the newborn screening program in the Philippines currently includes screening of six disorders: (1) hypothyroidism (CH), (2) congenital adrenal hyperplasia (CAH), (3) phenylketonuria (PKU), (4) glucose-6-phosphate dehydrogenase (G6PD) deficiency, (5) galactosemia (GAL) and maple syrup urine disease (MSUD). The expanded screening will include additional disorders such as hemoglobinopathies and additional metabolic disorders, namely, organic acid, fatty acid oxidation, and lysosomal disorders which are included in the standard care across the globe;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Health (DOH) Advisory Committee on Newborn Screening (ACNBS) has approved the implementation of the Expanded Newborn Screening Program;



**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Salazar, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it enacted as it is hereby enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as the "Newborn Screening Ordinance" in the Province of Cavite.

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.** It is hereby declared the policy of the Provincial Government of Cavite to adopt adequate measures to promote the newborn screening system and to ensure the right of the newborn to have an opportunity to undergo newborn screening, thus, be spared from the heritable conditions that can lead to mental retardation and death if undetected and untreated.

**SECTION 3. COVERAGE.** This ordinance shall cover all government-supervised hospitals, private hospitals, health infirmaries, health centers, lying-in centers or pediatric services within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Cavite except those hospitals and centers which are directly monitored by the Department of Health.

**SECTION 4. OBJECTIVES.** This ordinance is enacted with the following objectives:

1. To ensure the people with proper information on the nature and benefits of newborn screening in the life of every newborn baby;
2. To ensure that parents recognize the rights of every children to survival and full and healthy development as individual;
3. To protect every newborn baby from certain heritable conditions that can result in mental retardation and death if left undetected and untreated through newborn screening.

**DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this ordinance the following terms shall mean:

1. Newborn – refers to child from the time of complete delivery to 30 days old.
2. Newborn Screening – refers to the process of collecting a few drops of blood from the newborn onto an appropriate collection card and performing biochemical testing for determining if the newborn has a heritable condition.
3. Recall – refers to the procedure of locating a newborn with positive results from a possible heritable condition for purposes of providing that newborn with appropriate laboratory testing to confirm the diagnosis and provide appropriate treatment.
4. NCNBSS - refers to the National Comprehensive Newborn Screening System Treatment Network that provides technical assistance to the Department of Health (DOH) in reaching the ultimate goal of screening Filipino newborns for common life-threatening heritable disorders.

**SECTION 5. Regulated Acts.**

1. Any health practitioner who delivers or assist in the delivery of a newborn shall, prior to delivery, inform parents/legal guardian of the newborn of the availability, nature and benefits of newborn screening.
2. The health practitioner shall have information materials for distribution to the parents/legal guardian of the newborn.
3. The health practitioner shall maintain documentation in the patient's records of the newborn screening conducted.
4. A parent or legal guardian may refuse testing on the grounds of religious beliefs, but shall acknowledge in writing their understanding that refusal for testing places their newborn at risk for undiagnosed heritable conditions. A copy of this refusal shall be made part of the newborn's medical record.
5. It shall be a joint responsibility of the parent(s) and practitioner or other person delivering the newborn to ensure that newborn screening is performed.
6. Newborn screening shall be after performed after twenty-four (24) hours of life but not later than three (3) days from complete delivery of the newborn.
7. A newborn that must be placed in intensive care unit in order to ensure survival may be exempted from the three (3) day requirement but must be tested by seven (7) days of age.

**SECTION 6. Performance of Newborn Screening.**

1. Collection of samples maybe performed by any trained health worker as physicians, medical technologist, nurses and midwives.



2. Newborn screening specimens shall be properly transported to the accredited newborn screening centers by other fast mode of transport within twenty-four (24) hours following collection of sample.

3. Laboratory results with an increased risk of a heritable disorder (positive testing result) shall be immediately twenty-four (24) hours so that confirmatory testing can be performed.

4. Negative screening result shall be released within seven (7) working days upon receipt of the specimen.

#### **SECTION 7. Recall.**

1. A newborn with positive result shall be located and recalled for confirmatory testing as soon as possible.

2. A newborn identified at high risk (positive) screening result for a heritable disorder shall be recalled immediately the diagnosis. The city/municipal health office shall be involved in the recall process.

3. The newborn screening center shall notify the participating health institution about immediate recall of the positive screening result.

4. The attending health practitioner shall assist the participating health institution in locating the and recalling the

5. The newborn with confirmed diagnosis shall be referred for treatment and management to a duly licensed medical specialist.

6. The parents with the assistance of the local government unit shall have the primary responsibility to ensure that the receive appropriate confirmatory testing as soon as possible.

**SECTION 8. Implementation.** The City/Municipal Health Office shall be the lead agency in the monitoring of the implementation of the Newborn Screening System with the following responsibilities:

1. Implement, monitor, supervise and evaluate the newborn screening implementation in all hospitals, lying-in centers and health centers within their territorial jurisdiction.

2. Establish a functional Case Management Referral System with National Comprehensive Newborn Screening System Network (NCNBSS).

3. Create a program for purposes of information, education, communication, screening.

4. Assist in the recall process of newborn identified with positive results.

#### **SECTION 9. Newborn Screening Fees.**

1. Expenses for the newborn screening shall be the responsibility of the parents/legal guardian of the newborn.

2. The health facilities may collect a reasonable fee which shall not be greater than the maximum allowable fee prescribed by the Department of Health and the Newborn Screening Center.

3. The government and private health facilities are highly encouraged to develop a scheme to provide partial or full coverage depending on the capability of the parents.

**SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, resolutions, executive issuances or rules and regulations thereto, whose provisions are inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby deemed amended or modified accordingly.


**SECTION 11. APPLICABILITY CLAUSE.** The provisions of existing ordinances, resolutions or executive orders dealing with the related subject matter, which are not contradictory with this Ordinance, are hereby adopted as an integral part of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If, for any reason, any section/s or provision/s of this Ordinance is/are found unconstitutional or invalid, the other section/s or provision/s not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval and compliance with the posting and publication requirements.





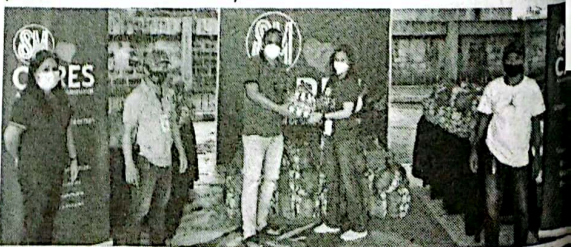

## OPERATION TULONG EXPRESS FOR BACOR CITY FLOODED COMMUNITY

**SM CITY BACOR, CAVITE** – With the recent flooding brought by the two typhoon - Jolina and Kiko, lowland communities were affected as Bacoor catch the waters from upland areas. High waters submerged most of their homes and made it difficult for them to work in the middle of the pandemic, especially as the city is still in MECQ and the Covid cases are consistently high.
