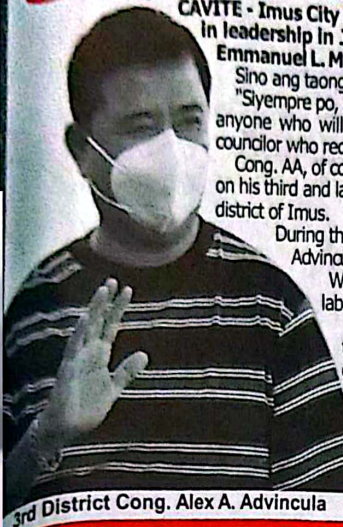


THE NEXT IMUS CITY MAYOR!

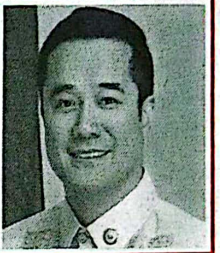

FM DECLARES MARTIAL LAW

The nat'l situation in brief

This is not a military takeover. Civilian government still functions. The officials and employees of the national and local governments continue to discharge their duties as before within the limits of the situation.

All executive departments, bureaus, offices, agencies and instrumentalities of the government, as well as government-owned or controlled corporations, government-owned or controlled enterprises, municipalities and local government units continue to function within the limits of the situation.

The judiciary shall continue to function under the provisions of the constitution and laws in effect at the time of the declaration of martial law.

All schools shall be closed for one week beginning this Monday for all levels.

Carrying of firearms outside the residence is prohibited without permission of the local government.

Censorship will be imposed from 12 midnight to 4 o'clock in the morning.

Departure of Filipinos from abroad is temporarily suspended except for official missions.

As the day wore on, however, the apprehension seemed to fade.

But civilian gov't still functions; no military takeover

President Marcos announced last night that he had placed the entire country under martial law to prevent violent overthrow of the government by a foreign-backed Communist insurgency.

The Chief Executive said he signed the martial law decree (Proclamation No. 1081) last night, 23, and authorized its implementation by the military at 9 p.m. Friday.

"I am ordering the proclamation of martial law," he said. "For any purpose known to save the Republic and the nation."

"To save the Republic and form a new society"

In imposing martial law, Mr. Marcos said he would threaten with this emergency power to establish for the country a "new society" which would be based on the principles of justice and order.

He said he was imposing martial law to prevent the overthrow of the government by a foreign-backed Communist insurgency.

Isa ito sa mga binanggit ni Marcos makaraang ihayag na nilagdaan na niya ang Proclamation 1081.

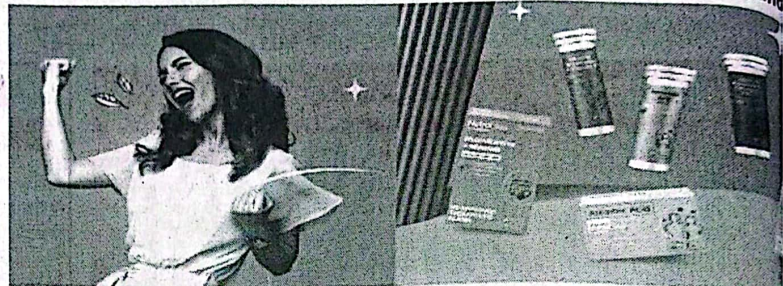

DOH CALABARZON STRENGTHENS HEALTH SYSTEM AGAINST DELTA VARIANT THREAT

Department of Health (DOH) CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Quezon) continuous to strengthen its health care system against threat of Delta Variant cases in the region.

"We have already established the "One Hospital Command Center (OHCC) in which we have link the health and medical services of our regional hospitals, particularly the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Cavite and the Batangas Medical Center in Batangas. Kabilang rin sa network na ito ang ibang malalaking public hospitals sa probinsya ng Laguna, Quezon at Rizal upang magbigay ng kinakailangang health services sa ating kababayan lalo na sa mga positibo ng Covid virus. Kaya mayroon tayong well-coordinated response at referral system na syang namamahala sa ating mga Covid cases," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

"We all Covid-19 cases as Delta Variant cases and this is the reason why we initiated and established the "Project Delta" with the objective of preventing the immediate spread of the virus in high-risk communities."

Janairo also emphasized that Covid patients admitted in government health facilities in remote areas need not worry as they have been conducting telemedicine consultations since 2018. "Marami ng health facilities na nalagyan ng telemedicine services sa

iba't-ibang malalayong probinsya and the most recent is the tele-icu system placed at Quezon Medical Center in Lucena City, to monitor critical Covid patient in intensive care units (ICU) which is also designed to protect health-care workers from possible infection due to less exposure."

As of September 16, 2021, the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit recorded 406 Delta Variants with Laguna having the highest number of cases at 112 followed by Cavite with 99 cases, Rizal with 83, Batangas-65, Quezon-33 and Lucena City with 14 cases.

Most source of Delta infection comes from local transmission with 355 cases with the largest number also from Laguna with 107 cases

followed by cases, Rizal - 52, Quezon Lucena City

A total of cases came from Overseas with Cavite with 17 cases Batangas with Quezon with and Lucena case.

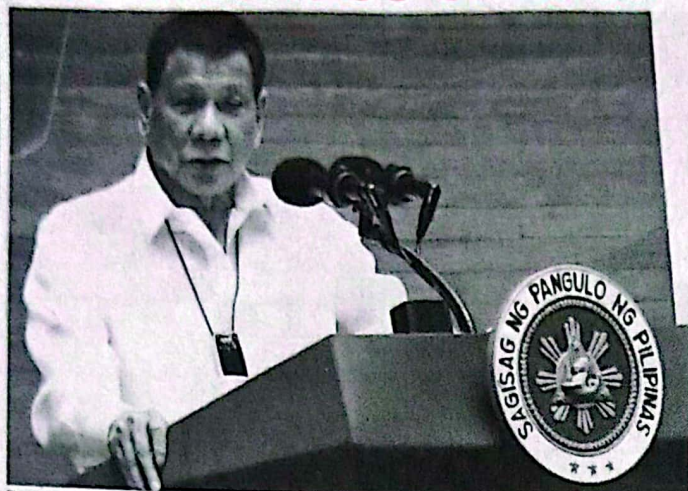

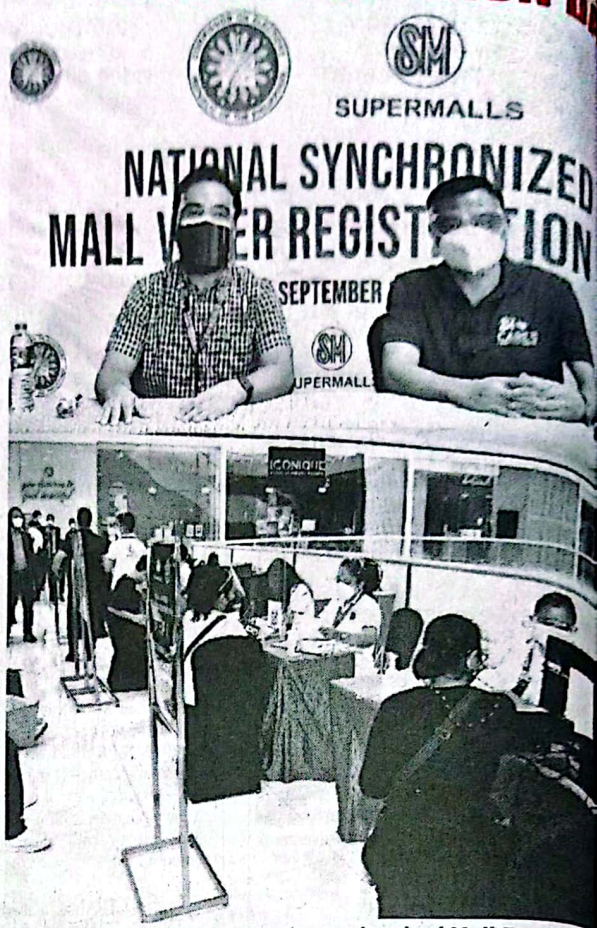
