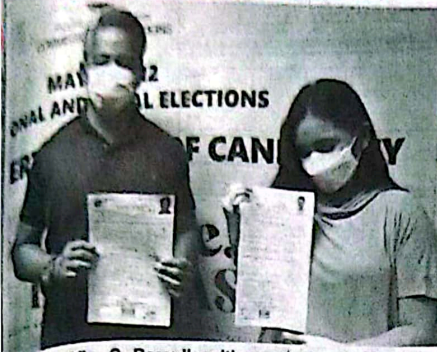
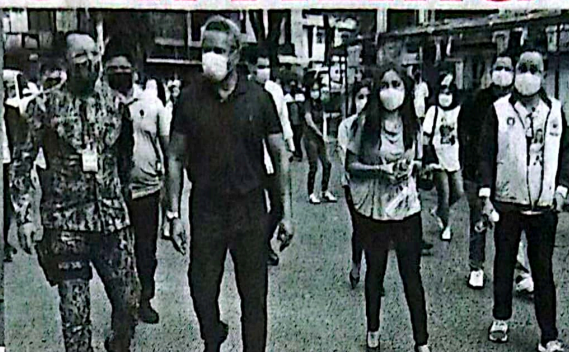


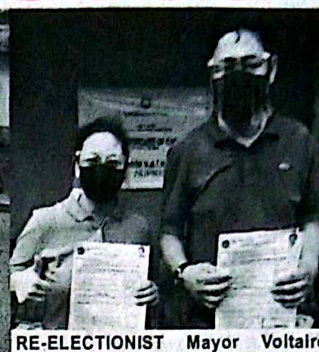

COVID-19 TRANSMISSION SA NCR PABABA NA?

Patuloy ang pagbaba ng 'reproduction number' ng COVID-19 sa National Capital Region (NCR) na naitala na lamang sa .94 na mas mababa na sa ideyal na mas mababa sa 1.0, ayon sa OCTA Research Group.

Ang reproduction number ang bilang ng posibleng mahawa ng isang pasyente na may COVID-19. Sinasabing wala nang transmisyon ng virus kung mas mababa na sa 1.0 ang reproduction number (R.O.)

Bukod dito, naitala na lamang mula 19%-20% ang positivity rate sa buong NCR. Pero mas mataas pa rin ito sa 'international standards' na 5% lamang. Ang positivity rate ay ang antas ng mga nagpositibo sa kabuuang bilang ng mga dumaan sa COVID-19 tests.

Naniniwala si David na nakatulong sa pagbaba ng mga kaso ang mga lockdown na ipinatupad ng pamahalaan sa rehiyon. Kabilang dito ang ECQ mula Agosto 6-20, MECQ mula Agosto 21-Setyembre 15 at kasalukuyang Alert Level 4 sa ilalim naman ng GCQ.

Bukod sa quarantine, naniniwala rin si David na ang pagbaba ng mga kaso ay may kinalaman din sa vaccination program ng pamahalaan at sa pagtalima ng mga tao sa health protocols.

Sa kabila nito, sinabi ng DOH na ang average daily attack rate (ADAR) sa MM ay nananatiling nasa "high risk" pa rin.

Bukod sa Metro Manila, nakapagtala rin ng mas mababa sa 1 na reproduction rate ang mga katabing lalawigan ng Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal at Quezon.

Ang Benguet, Cagayan Valley, Negros Oriental at Leyte naman ay nakapagtala ngayon ng pagtaas ng mga kaso na tinitingnan pa nila kung may trend na ito o clustering lamang.

Department of Health; Dr. Imelda Angeles-Agdeppa, Director, DOST-Food and Nutrition Research Institute; and Dr. Cecilia C. Maramba-Lazarte, Director, Institute of Herbal Medicine, UP Manila - National Institute of Health.

Dr. Regala discussed how isolation and quarantine works when managing mild COVID-19 cases at home as well as the importance of becoming agents of "tamang impormasyon"

by validating information through DOH website and reporting fake news to them. Meanwhile, Dr. Agdeppa and Dr. Lazarte presented the results of their studies on VCO and lagundi on mild COVID-19 cases, respectively. While the VCO mixed in the meals has helped to significantly reduce the symptoms of mild COVID-19 patients, the lagundi formulation study showed an insignificant difference to the recovery time of the study participants as compared to those who were not given with lagundi. Nevertheless,

adjuvant therapies offer ways to ease mild symptoms of COVID-19 and build stronger immune responses but it is not the cure itself. Like vaccines, adjuvant therapies do not guarantee 100% protection * from contracting the virus.

DOH-CALABARZON PRESENTS ACCOMPLISHMENT UNDER DUTERTE ADMINISTRATION

The Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) today presented its accomplishments as it joined the launching of the Duterte Legacy Campaign with the theme, "Barangayanihan Caravan Towards National Recovery" at the Batangas Police Provincial Office located at President Jose P. Laurel Highway, Camp Malvar, Batangas.

The campaign showcased the successful implementation of various programs, policies and projects by government agencies that provided better services and directly benefitted the people including those in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDAs). Assistant Regional Director Paula Paz M. Sydiongco, who represented Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo, showcased the significant accomplishments of DOH-CALABARZON under the Duterte Administration which includes the establishment, upgrading of services and renovation of health facilities including 43 hospitals, 33 rural health units and 74 barangay health stations together with the installation and provision of 113 various equipment in the hospitals, 184 in rural health units and 193 in barangay health stations. "We have provided 7 sea ambulance, 158 land ambulance and 100 bicycles for barangay health workers," Sydiongco shared in her presentation. The regional office also upgraded the services, facilities and equipment of its apex hospitals namely the Batangas Medical Center in Batangas City, the Maria L. Eleazar District Hospital in Tagkawayan,

Quezon, the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Bacoor City and the Northern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Rodriguez, Rizal will start construction this year.

A JICA project with 500 bed rehabilitation facility is currently on-going construction in Trece Martires, Cavite. "For Covid-19 response, critical care capabilities of intensive care units (ICUs) of five key Covid referral facilities were enhanced and improved including the installation of six ICUs and 11 ward tents to augment hospital capacities." "Dialysis centers were established in Cabuyao City Hospital and San Pablo City District Hospital (SPCDH) for Covid patients." "To provide access to specialized health care services, particularly in remote areas, the regional office established telemedicine services including the Kapit-Bisig Helpline for mental health, O-HI Doc for tele-dentistry and the KonsultaMD for primary healthcare services," she narrated.

The first Traditional Complementary and Alternative Medicine (TCAM) Center located at the Batangas Medical Center and Pagsanjan Rural Health Unit were inaugurated to highlight and put into mainstream the accepted forms of oriental therapy, such as acupuncture, homeopathy. In preparation for the

"Doktor Para sa Bayan Act", the regional office has partnered with medical schools including Southern Luzon State University, Cavite State University and Batangas State University where medical scholarships will be provided to deserving students who will then render a return service. DOH-CALABARZON also facilitated the establishment and licensing and provided technical support for the 25 molecular laboratories in the region, located in Cavite (5), Rizal (3), Laguna (1), Batangas (7) and Quezon (2). A total of six extensive Temporary Treatment Monitoring Facilities (TTMF) were also established.

"These accomplishments were done through the collaboration and support of other government agencies, the local government units and our various stake holders under the Duterte Administration." "These were implemented with regard to our people. Gaya ng sabi ng ating mahal na Presidente, kailangan lahat ng nangangailangan ng tulong pangkalusugan ay mapagbibigyan at walang maiiwanan. Tanza Catholic shrine for renovation

The first phase of the three-phased renovation of the Diocese of San Agustin in the municipality of Tanza recently completed funding of P11M from donations already on hand.

This phase will focus on the repairs of the main altar, and the construction of a sanctuary, and sacristy and is expected to be completed by December 2021.

The second phase will deal with the horizontal transit of the church which according to Diocesan Shrine of San Agustin Rector, Reverend Father Virgilio Saenz Mendoza, will be more difficult due to structural defects found and must be totally torn down.

Renovation for the second phase will require

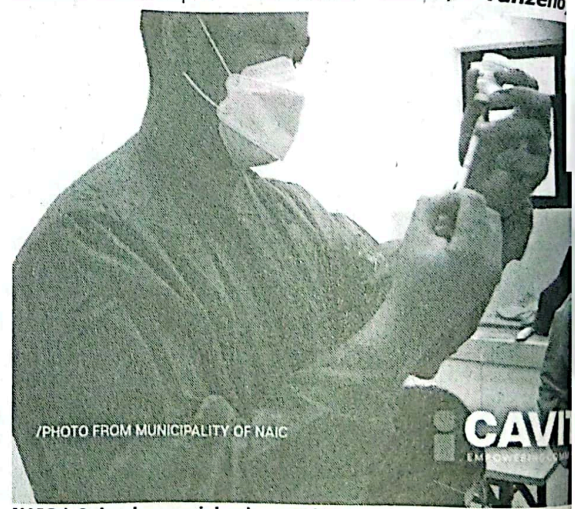
an estimated budget of P50M thus, the church is now saving up and sourcing for said funds.

Father Mendoza added that total renovations for the shrine might cost about P100M with renovations seen to be complete by December of 2022 if funding will be available.

A major change to be expected in the holy shrine are the images of 'Tata Usteng' and the Santa Cruz will be placed facing the parishioners instead of sideways.

Noveleta medical facility improved with add'l rooms, ambulances

During the event, Mayor Chua revealed that plans are set to open a Dialysis center on the third floor of the building to expand the medical services of the facility.

He also thanked the management of PNB and Asia Brewery for providing 600 doses of Astrazeneca vaccine which will be used for the LGU's vaccination program.

registration for the inoculation of children aged 12 to 17 years in the locality is now open in preparation for the go-signal for the vaccination.

Implementation of Annex E-Certificate of Classification of At-risk Individuals and Actual Charges for SARS-CoV-2 Test as a claim requirement for Accredited Testing Laboratories is moved to October 1, 2021

The PhilHealth Circular (PC) No. 2021-0001 (Revision 2) titled "Benefit Package for SARS-CoV-2 test using RT-PCR" and PC No. 2021-0003 titled "Benefit Package for SARS-CoV-2 test using Cartridge-based PCR" were both published on May 26, 2021 to provide guidelines for the implementation of PhilHealth benefits for SARS-CoV-2 RT-PCR tests. In both Circulars, PhilHealth required the submission of Certificate of Classification of At-risk individuals and Actual Charges for SARS-CoV-2 Test (Annex E) for claims reimbursement.

In consideration of the resources and adjustments of the accredited laboratories to enable them to comply with the said requirement, the Certificate of Classification of At-risk Individuals and SARS-CoV-2 Test shall be required **only from October 1, 2021 onwards**.
