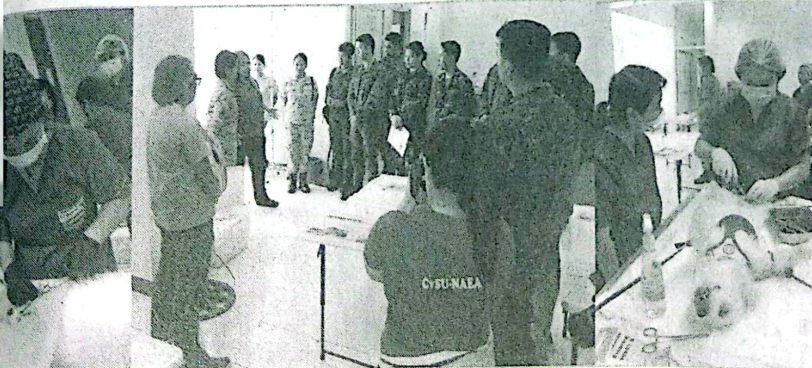

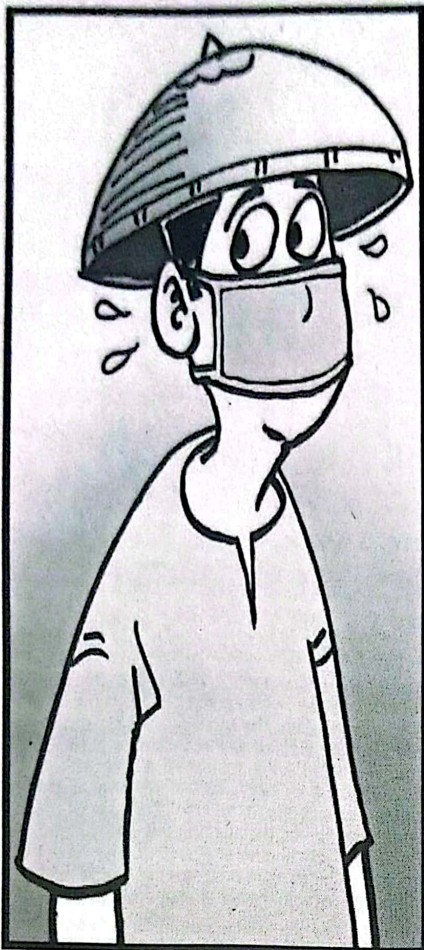

Provincial Vet Conducts Spaying and Neutering of Dogs and Cats: The Provincial Veterinary Office with the Cavite Veterinary Medical Association, Cavite State University-College of Veterinary and Biomedical Sciences and other veterinary associations conducted free spaying and neutering of dogs and cats on March 10, 2020 at CvSU, Indang, Cavite. In line with the celebration of Awareness Month with the theme "Rabies ay iwasan, alagang aso't pusa ay pabakunahan", the spaying and neutering is part of the dog and cat population control activity which aims to reduce the number of stray dogs/cats roaming the streets and also the incidence of rabies in the province. The activity will also be beneficial to the animals because it reduces the risk of acquiring reproductive diseases and illnesses. Fifty-one female dogs and cats were spayed and 99 male dogs and cats were castrated or neutered by veterinarians from the PVO, Military Veterinary Association of the Philippines, Philippine Animal Hospital Association, Vets Love Nature and from CvSU. ### MAGKAISA SA LABAN KONTRA COVID-19

## Editorial

**I**SINAILALIM na ang buong Metro Manila sa lockdown o ang mahigpit na pagbabawal ng paglabas at pagpasok sa 16 na siyudad at isang bayan sa National Capital Region.

Ito ayon kay Pangulong Duterte ay isang hakbang ng gobyerno upang maiwasan ang pagkalat ng nakamamamatay na sakit na coronavirus disease na tinawag ng World Health Organization (WHO) na COVID-19.

Ipinatutupad na ang lockdown na idineklara ng Pangulo kasunod ng paglalagay niya sa bansa sa ilalim ng State of Public Health Emergency. Ginawa ito nang ilagay sa Code Red Alert ng Department of Health ang bansa, kasunod ng dalawang kaso ng 'local transmission' sa Greahills, San Juan at sa Bonifacio Global Venter (BGC).

Nagkasunod-sunod na pagkaraan ang ulat ng mga kumpirmasyon ng mga pasyenteng positibo sa sakit na ito, na sa huling ulat ay mahigit na sa 4,000 ang namamamatay mula sa iba-ibang bansa. Kumalat na sa 114 bansa ang COVID-19 kaya idineklara ng WHO na pandemic na ang sakit na ito na unang kumalat sa Wuhan, sa Hubei Province sa China.

Sa huling ulat, kulang o higit sa 200,000 tao na ang kinapitan ng COVID-19.

Hindi na pwedeng magpakuya-kuyakoy na lamang tayo, seryoso na ang banta ng COVID-19 at sa ganitong sitwasyon, kailangan na ang extreme measure tulad nga ng lockdown. Kailangan na ang suporta ng lahat, ang pakikiisa ng buong mamamayan, mula sa pinakamataas na yunit ng gobyerno hanggang sa pinakamababang barangay.

Hindi po ito politika, hindi tao o partido ang kalaban dito. Ang kalaban natin ay nakamamatay na virus. Isa itong "silent war" na tulad ng digmaan militar o pananakop na kilala ang kaaway.

Upang masigurado ang kooperasyon ng publiko, ating inaasahan ang pambansang gobyerno at ang matataas na opisyal, simula kay Presidente Duterte at miyembro ng Gabinete na maging transparent o lantad sa bayan. Pambansang sekuridad sa kalusugan na may banta ng kamatayan sa maraming mamamayan ang sakit na ito, kaya karapatan ng sambayanang Filipino na malaman

ang lahat ng umiiral na kondisyon at mga aksyon at polisiya upang malabanan ang sakit na ito. Walang dapat na itago, walang dapat na alinlangan sa isip ng publiko. Lahat ng mga Pangulo, Gabinete, mga opisyal ng pamahalaan, lalawigan, siyudad, munisipalidad at kasama ang sanga ng lehislatura at buong miyembro ng pulisya at militar ay dapat sa pagkilos at pakikibaka sa COVID-19 ay ating matalo.

Sa mga maghahasik ng kaguluhan, magpapakalat ng mali at inimbenteng propaganda na magdudulot ng sindak na mamamayan ay dapat na mapigilan at parusa — mabigat na parusa ng buong buhay at katatagan ng Republika ang nakatutal na nagdeklara ng lockdown.

Bakit nagdeklara ng lockdown si Duterte tanong ng mga kritiko niya na nagsasagay kailangan. Ito ay Kailangan pagkatapos ng bansa na mas mayaman, mas maunlad, kakayahang sa larangan sa medisina ay nagdeklara ng sarili nilang lockdown.

May lockdown sa Wuhan, at iba pang mga estado sa China; lockdown din sa Italy, South Korea, ilang estado sa America, ilang lugar sa Japan ang desisyon ni Duterte na gobyerno na ang sa lahat ng kaso ng COVID-19.

Kailangang magkaisa ang mga lahat ng mamamayan at pribado na maglaan ng mapang pasilidad at todong pagsisikap na magpaggamot upang hindi dumami ang mga COVID-19 at tuluyan na itong masugpo.

## DOH SEA AMBULANCE SERVES IN CALAUAG, QUEZON

Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, yesterday turned-over the second sea ambulance to the port of Calauag, Quezon to serve patients from its distant

## AO 23 DIRECTS GOV'T OFFICES TO REDUCE BUREAU RED TAPE

MANILA – In a bid to promote efficiency in government processes, President Rodrigo Duterte has directed all state departments and offices to refrain from imposing excessive rules and regulations.

Under Administrative Order (AO) 23 signed on February 21 and released Thursday, all government offices and agencies, including local government units and government-owned and controlled corporations, are ordered to hasten the reform of their public transactions.

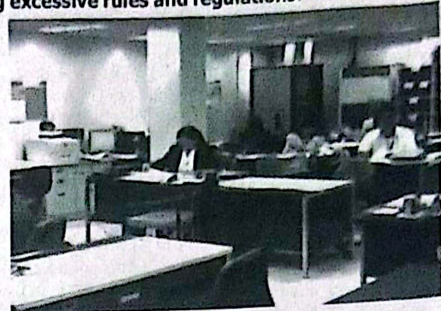
AO 23 instructed them to retain steps, procedures, and requirements that may be necessary to fulfill their legal mandates and policy objectives.

"All processes in excess thereof, including those which are redundant or burdensome to the public, shall be deemed manifestations of overregulation and shall be removed accordingly," the order read.

Duterte signed the AO to live up to his promise to reduce bureaucratic red tape and expedite business and nonbusiness related transactions in government.

His new AO also states that the entirety of an agency's processes for its public services would be subject to scrutiny, "from the most established and long-standing aspects thereof to the most recent."

Imposing tedious and time-consuming regulations on socially beneficial activities would be targeted for reform because it would be "impossible or extremely difficult" to accomplish such rules, according to

"Increasing competitiveness and the ease of doing business are pillars of this administration's 10-point socio-economic agenda," the AO said.

"Excessive regulations at all levels of government, which are more than necessary to implement their respective mandates, create high costs on businesses, inhibit job creation, and discourage private sector investment," it added.

AO 23 also directs the Anti-Red Tape Authority (ARTA) to monitor and ensure compliance of all government agencies.

All state departments and offices are also mandated to submit a Compliance Report to ARTA 60 days after AO 23 takes effect.

The Compliance Report should contain the government agency's list of regulations on its services offered to the public, particular procedures and processing times, legal

basis for regulations, and relevant provisions of its Citizen's Charter.

The ARTA is tasked to provide the Office of the Executive Secretary its findings and recommendations on the Compliance Reports submitted by all government agencies.

"Failure to comply with this Order shall result in the filing of appropriate administrative cases pursuant to the Civil Service Commission on Administrative Cases in the Civil Service, and other relevant laws, rules, and regulations," AO 23 read.

All other executive issuances, rules, and regulations that are inconsistent with the provisions of AO 23 are deemed repealed, amended, or modified.

Should any provision of the AO be held unconstitutional or invalid, the provisions not affected by the order should "continue to be in full force or effect."

AO 23 takes effect immediately. (PNA)

FOLLOW BASIC

Cardinal Tagle reminded everyone to follow basic guidelines that seem unimportant

but in fact have a big impact:

- Wash hands often.
- Do not touch your eyes, nose, mouth.
- If you cough or sneeze, cover your nose and mouth.
- Practice social distancing.

• If you feel under the weather, wear a mask.

QUARANTINE,  
CUARESMA

The Cardinal Prefect also reminded everyone that this is the time of Lent, or CUARESMA, and noted that the root word of quarantine and cuaresma are the same.

While this is a time when many are being quarantined, reminiscent of the quarantine done during the time of the Black Plague or Bubonic Plague in Europe, when

the time for avoiding the sick was elongated to 40 days from 30 days, he noted that this is also the time of Cuaresma or Lent: 40 days of preparation to commemorate the death of Christ and to celebrate his Resurrection.

Therefore, he said, it might good to look at what this crisis can add to the proper celebration of Cuaresma.

3 DISCIPLINES OF  
CUARESMA

He reminded everyone of the 3 Disciplines of Cuaresma:

- (1) Fasting
- (2) Almsgiving
- (3) Prayer

As we are unable to do things that we once regarded as valuable - trips, movies, shopping - let this be a reminder to fast and abstain from these things that we had become used to.

Ang kumalat na sa 114 bansa. As of 77 na kinapitan ng Covid-19; 4,633 ayon kay WHO Director General Ghenreyesus. Sa 126,277 pasyente, maging, at 59,000 ang infected; mild 7,649; malubha ang 5,708, at wala ginagamot na 72,910 na indibidwal. As of March 12, naitala ay 49 ang

kumpirmadong positibo sa Covid-19 at dalawa ang namatay, isa ay isang dayuhan at isang Filipino. Latest news ay ang utos ni Pres. Duterte na total lockwon sa Metro Manila sa loob ng 30 days para macontain ang sakit na ito, pero ang mga kritiko niya, nagpakalat ng takot dahil ang kasunod daw nito ay ang deklarasyon ng 'martial law.' Ay, naku, tumulong na lang at 'wag magpakalat ng takot at sindak sa mamamayan.

At least, si VP Leni Robredo ay sumuporta sa maagang pagkilos ng gobyerno at hinikayat ang taumbayan na makiisa at suportahan ang administrasyon sa pagsugpo sa nakamamatay na coronavirus.

Ano ba ang latest news sa China na pinagmulan ng COVID-19? Sa ating research, sa pagsiklab ng virus na ito, sa unang linggo ng Pebrero (unang na=detected ang virus sa Wuhan noong Enero), agad na kumilos ang mahigit sa 10,000 health workers na nagboluntaryo na tumulong para magamot ang mga pasyente. Balik na sa trabaho ang 90 porsiyento ng 58,000 worker sa 43,000 Starbucks store sa probinsiya ng Yunnan at Shanghai have opened, sabi ni Starbucks CEO Kevin Johnson. Balik na rin sa trabaho ang 60 percent ng may 78 milyon migrant worker sa China, sabi ni Shang Jianhua, ng China's Migrant Workers Office.

armed with caliber .38 revolver barged in looking for six individuals who apparently have betrayed him by maligning his reputation as contractor.

Four victims died after sustaining fatal gunshot wounds. They were identified as MUHARMA BAUTISTA, female, 59 years old; ALBERTO SORIO, male, 57 years old, retired Phil Army; RECTO MARBIT, 47 years old, male, tricycle driver; and PILAR BACAOCO, 34 years old, female.

At that moment, two responding police officers were wounded when the suspect fired towards them. They were identified as PCMS Rizaldy Espiritu, male, legal age, COMPAC

Commander and PSMS Reynante Tan, male, legal age, married and both assigned in San Francisco Compact in General Trias City.

Accordingly, police officers while conducting surveillance against illegal gambling at the area, when subsequently, they heard gun shots several times more or less twenty meters away from the crime scene.

While the mobile car was approaching the scene, suspect stealthily situated on the right side of the road suddenly fired upon towards the responding police officers hitting PCMS Espiritu on his right arm and PSMS Reynante Tan on his right upper arm and abdomen.

However, PSMS Tan despite of the injuries sustained, managed to

drive the mobile car away to secure cover.

Consequently, two unharmed policemen hurriedly alighted from the mobile car and positioned themselves strategically but failed to fire back when they noticed that the suspect scampered with the crowd.

Despite of the negotiation with the suspect for his surrender, he has chosen to commit suicide by pointing his gun and firing it onto his head.

Wounded Police officers are now on stable condition but are still undergoing medical treatment for their fast recovery. While the cadaver of the victims were brought to the funeral for autopsy examination.

## MINOR INVOLVED IN AN ARMED CONFRONTATION WITH A RESPONDING POLICEMAN, DIED IN DASMARINAS CITY

A minor died after being involved in a riot in an armed confrontation with a responding policeman off duty in Dasmarinas City, Cavite, on February 29, 2020 at Phase 2 Bucal Park, Brgy Paliparan 3, Dasmarinas City, Cavite, PSSg Elmer Belaro who was off duty and while watching the game at the basketball court together with his friends when he witnessed 2 parties with more or less 10 persons each group having a riot with the use of undetermined caliber of firearms.

The police officer tried to pacify the situation but suddenly 1 suspect involved in the riot fired at him.

The police officer was prompted to return fire resulting in the neutralization of Darwin Pintang, while the members of the two groups involved in the riot

scampered away.

On the other hand, Brgy Tanods of Brgy Paliparan 3 immediately responded to the scene that resulted to the arrest of Lyod Brix Andre Cutsero and recovered from his possession 1 improvised SUMPAP.

PSSg Elmer Rojas Belaro, 37 years old, an active PNP member presently assigned in Regional Intelligence Division, Camp Vicente Lim, Calamba City, Laguna, and residing in Brgy Paliparan 3, Dasmarinas City, Cavite, voluntarily surrendered himself to Dasmarinas City Police after the incident.

Cavite SOCO Team immediately arrived at the

scene and conducted technical investigation. They recovered 3 pieces of fired cartridge cases for cal .9mm.

Recovered from Darwin Pintang's possession were 1 unit of Sentinel cal .22 revolver loaded with 3 pieces live ammunitions, 5 pieces of heat sealed transparent plastic sachets containing suspected marijuana and 2 pieces of improvised glass tooter.

The body of Darwin Ruaya Pintang was brought to Alindog Funeral Services for autopsy examination while Lyod Brix Andre Cutsero will be turned over to CSWD for proper disposition.

suspected shabu with DDB value of Php 138,720.00 pesos and .20 grams of dried marijuana with DDB value of Php 24.00 pesos.

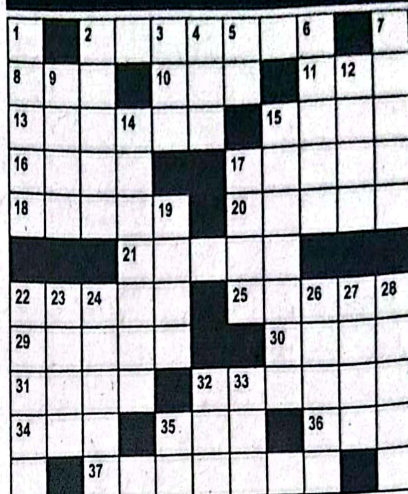

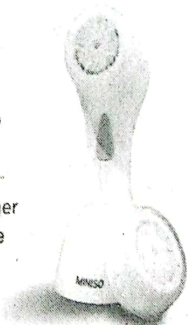
