



17. When the petitioner learned the respondent was already cohabiting with another woman, the petitioner worked doubly hard to provide support to her children since the respondent has failed to support he family since 2009 even though he is presently working at a carpark in Nagoya, Japan;

18. The respondent did not attempt to reunite with the petitioner and never invited the petitioner live with him again after abandoning her and their children:

19. The petitioner could not fathom what pushed the respondent to turn his back on her, and their marriage could not be salvaged anymore because of the respondent's own shortcomings, willful neglect and infidelity;

20. The petitioner's hope of reuniting with the respondent became a wishful thinking because the respondent never communicated with her or their children anymore;

21. Four years after the celebration of the marriage, the petitioner realized the respondent was no longer interested in cohabiting with her anymore and would not want to live a marriage life with her from the time he decided to abandon her and committed infidelity;

22. The respondent failed and continuously fails to observe love, care, support and fidelity to the petitioner and he refused to adhere to the marital duties he has sworn to when he entered into marriage with the petitioner, that led to the disintegration or the marriage.

23. The respondent is incapacitated to assume and perform with his heart and mind the essential marital obligations expected of him, a condition detrimental to the survival of the marriage.

24. The petitioner is desirous of having her marriage with the respondent declared annulled on the ground that the respondent exhibited personality traits of a person suffering from a psychological disorder that incapacitated him to perform the essential marital duties, a grave, permanent and incurable condition detrimental to the marriage, that existed prior to the marriage but manifested during its existence, and this disorder can be attested to by a Psychologist.

25. The parties never acquired any real property during the marriage which formed part of their absolute community or conjugal property relation.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prayed of the Honorable Court that after due notice and hearing, judgment be issued:

A. declaring the marriage of the petitioner with the respondent before the Consulate General in Osaka, Japan on October 31, 2006 annulled on grounds of psychological incapacity under Article 36 of the Family Code of the Philippines;

B. ordering the National Statistics Office to delete and expunge from their respective books of marriages the entry of the marriage between the petitioner and the respondent and such other documents appertaining thereto.

Petitioner further prays for other relief and processes which are just and equitable under the premises.





Ron P. Palo of the Kabayan Party List, chairperson of the Committee on Information at the House of Representatives, was also around for his message of support. "Freedom of Information is not a privilege but a right guaranteed no less by our Constitution. The passage of the FOI Law will empower and inform the Filipino citizenry to contribute in nation-building, good governance and public accountability," the lawmaker explained.

Another message of support came from Undersecretary Ramon Cualoping III, directorgeneral of the Philippine Information Office under the PCOO, who aired his belief that FOI is the cornerstone "and probably one of the greatest legacies of Pres. Duterte."

"This is a program that the Filipino people should take advantage of because this is where people have the chance to make the government accountable," Cualoping told the audience.

Kristian R. Ablan, undersecretary and FOI program director, under PCOO, presented the FOI Report.

It was in Nov. 25, 2016, when Malacanang hosted the official turnover of agency FOI manuals and the official launching of foi.gov.ph.

The lean group of five people during that time, has now grown and expanded to three divisions and sub-units which formed part of the FOI Project Management Office.

Ablan also thanked their partners including the World Bank, Asian Development Bank (ADB), Dept. of Budget Management (DBM), Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) and others for backing the FOI up when they had "no mandate, no budget and no people."

"The real heroes in access to information are

the citizens who hold the government to account, who without pay, actually make sure that government information is available for all," Ablan stressed, adding that members of the Right to Know, Right Now (RKRN) Coalition as "the true FOI Champions."

He recalled that it was in the 8th Congress, when the late Cong. Raul Roco, representing Camarines Sur in 1987, filed the first FOI bill. It aimed to implement the constitutional right to access government information.

It was then that many congressmen and senators filed their own versions in each Congress, according to

Ablan.


