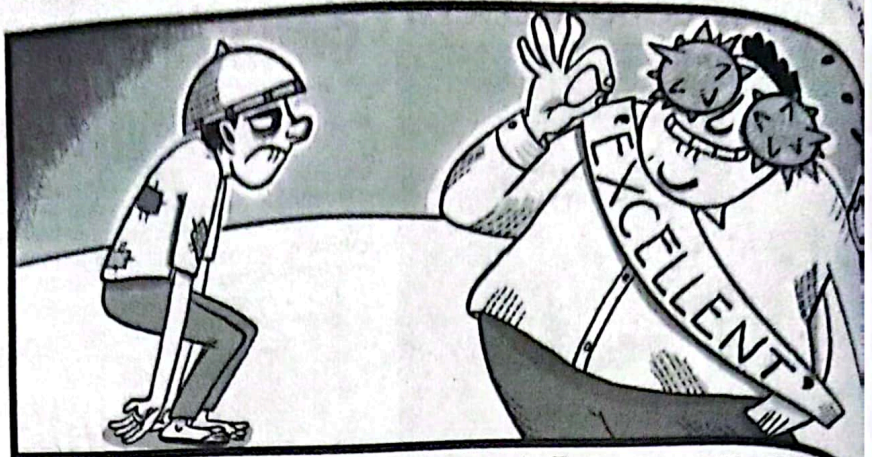

LGU Bacoar City orders stringent protocols under MGCQ

BACOR CITY, Cavite Mar. 15-- In the wake of the continued rise in the number of COVID-19 cases, the City Government here issued Executive Order No. 06 s. 2021 that mandates the implementation of a much stricter quarantine guidelines under the Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ).

Issued on Friday, March 12, 2021 and effective immediately, EO 06-2021, is an order reiterating local directives and policies and revitalized action to curtail the spike in the community transmission of COVID-19 in various areas/barangays in the city.

The order declares that curfew will be from 10pm-4am with prohibition for residents aged below 14 years and those 66 years and older are not allowed to leave their residences.

The sale and purchase of liquor/intoxicating drinks of any kind is strictly prohibited within the curfew hours with

drinking and consumption of liquor limited within the house premises only.

Business establishments within the city jurisdiction should be closed by 9pm.

Strict implementation of the mandatory and proper wearing of face mask and face shield in all public areas and inside transport vehicles will be carried out by the Bacoar-PNP.

LGU officials urge the public to practice the prompt isolation of COVID-19 patients in home quarantine to prevent infection within the household and in cases of suspected COVID-19

symptoms felt, immediate notification of the Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHRT) or Homeowners Association (HOA) HERT must be done, or call Alert 161 for help.

Meanwhile, the LGU had conducted the 2nd round of the COVID-19 Vaccination rollout last Friday, March 12, 2021 at the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital with about 160 healthcare workers that were inoculated.

Out of the said total, 77 medical frontliners were given jabs of the Sinovac while 83 received

vaccines AstraZeneca. All part of the government.

While the implementation does not totally ensure safety from the disease, somehow gives a degree of safety from having severe cases of the disease.

Health experts urge the public to maintain the habit to frequent handwash, proper hygiene, wearing of face mask, physical distancing is still the best against the virus. **Francisco with from Bacoar**

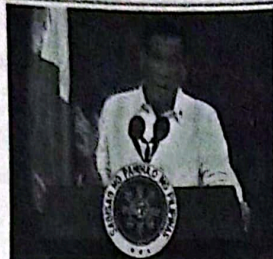

Tagaytay including Mercado at Sky where pet parents can indulge in flavorful bite spending the day at the paw park.

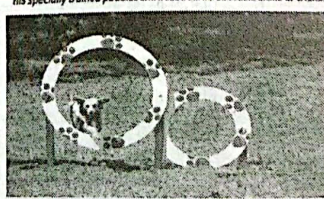

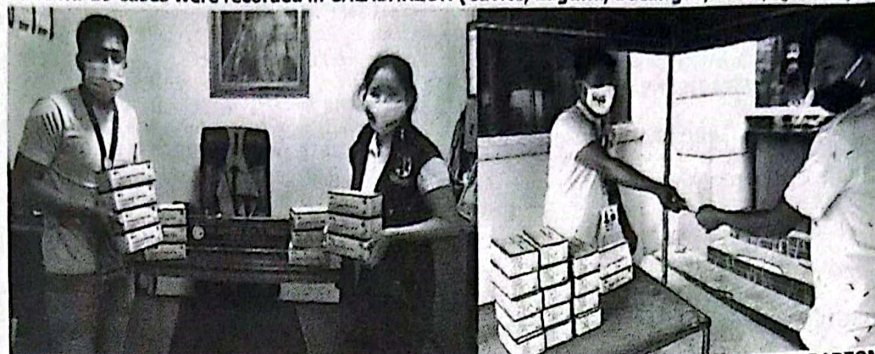

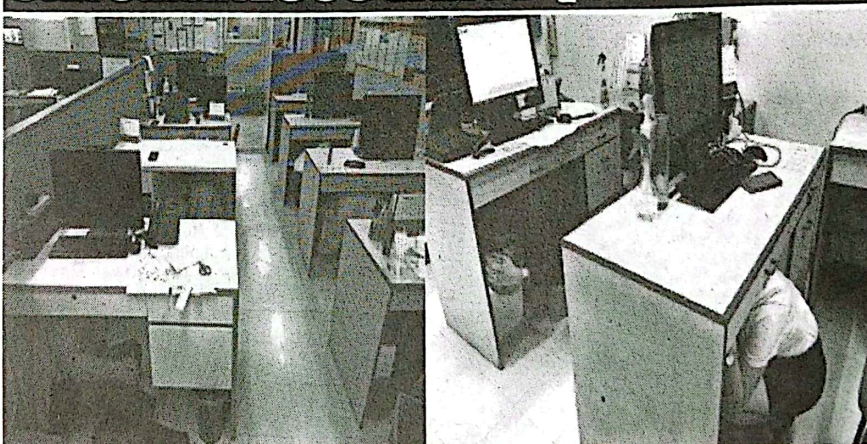

the pandemic in the city.

The LCE together with Vice Mayor Morit Sison conferred with the Chief of Police of the General Trias Component City Police Station and all Sub-Station Commanders for the strict and immediate implementation of said executive order.

This developed due to the alarming surge in the number of COVID-19 cases in the city in the past four weeks.

According to the GenTri City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (CESU), from the total 21 Active cases in February 16, 2021 the number of Active cases ballooned to 126 from the latest addition of 16 new cases as of March 16, 2021.

E.O. 08-2021 reads that curfew hours in the city will be from 10pm - 5am with residents aged between 16 - 65 years allowed to leave the residence with the curfew exemption for Authorized Persons Outside the Residence (APOR) supported by the proper identification at control/check points.

On the other hand,

curfew hours for children from 10 - 15 years of age is from 6pm - 7am.

Liquor ban in the city will be implemented from March 15 - April 15, 2021.

All forms of public, mass or social gatherings including weddings, birthdays, funerals, entertainment activities are limited to ten (10) persons or fifty percent (50%) of venue capacity which also applies to restaurant dine-in services.

For the observance of the Holy Week tradition, visita iglesia by non-residents will be prohibited, and only the designated local churches to visit on Maundy Thursday will be the historic St. Francis of Assisi in the town proper, St. Vincent Ferrer Parish in Manggahan, Our Lady of Guadalupe in Barangay Javalera, San Gabriel Arkangel Parish in Barangay San Francisco, and The Annunciation parish in Barangay Pasong Camachile.

Meanwhile, mourning rites or funeral wakes will be regulated to five (5) days if the cause of death is not COVID-related,

while immediate interment is mandatory for COVID-related death.

Entry to all returning residents and OFs will require coordination with the Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT) upon arrival at the city for recording and initial medical evaluation.

Only symptomatic individuals are required to undergo fourteen (14) days facility-based quarantine and the RT-PCR swab test while asymptomatic returning residents and OFs are exempted from the swab test.

And above all, the basic mandatory wearing of face mask and face shield in public places, and in private and public transportation and inside establishments at all times will strictly be implemented with corresponding penalties and fines for violators that will be apprehended.

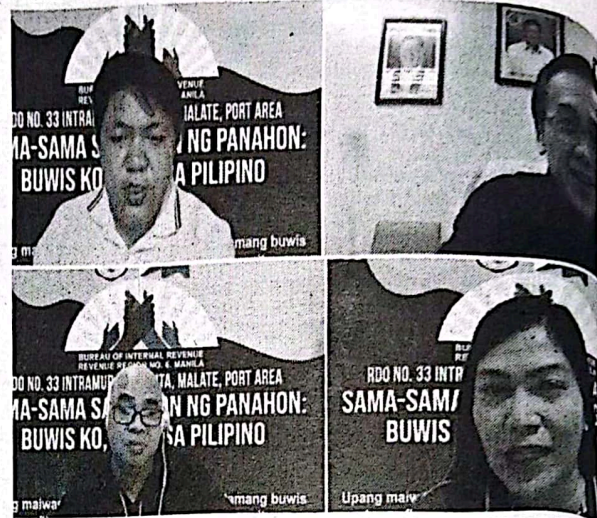
