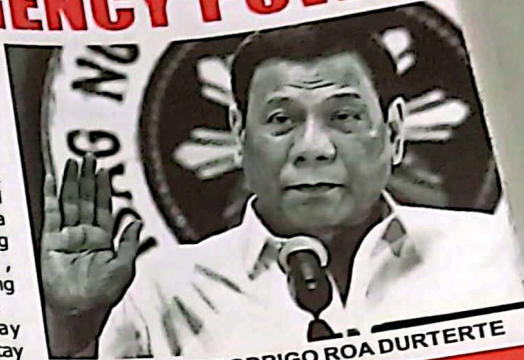

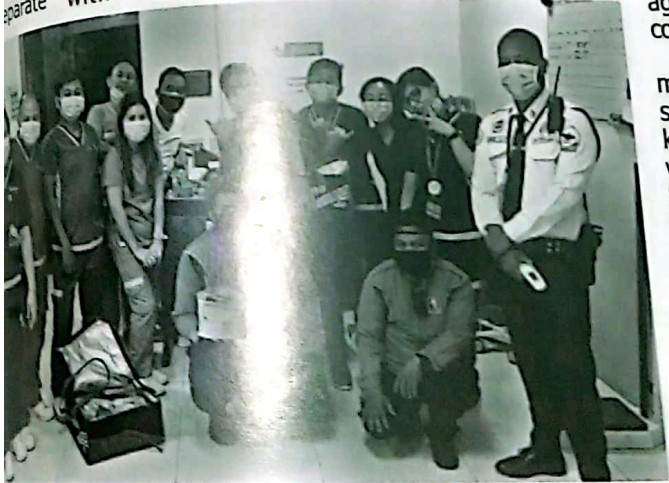

DOST to focus on researches that will help solve Covid-19 woes

MANILA – Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Secretary Fortunato dela Peña on Wednesday said the department will focus first on researches that have the potential to address the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19).

"Maybe we will focus first on taking advantage of some researches which we have already supported, and which have the potential to help in addressing the Covid-19 problem now," he told the Philippine News Agency (PNA).

Dela Peña mentioned the Ateneo de Manila University's study on whether virgin coconut oil (VCO) components could be used as a safe antiviral agent against the novel coronavirus.

"While it (study) was more on developing standards, there is some knowledge derived from it which we can extend. Since it is widely cited in publications that VCO has anti-viral properties, we can look into that through some tests on Covid-19. We can have it tested in Singapore where they have the facilities in place," he said.

Ateneo's study was done in partnership with the Duke-National University of Singapore.

Another DOST-funded study that ADMU did, in

partnership with the Department of Health (DOH), was the Feasibility Analysis of Syndromic Surveillance using Spatio-Temporal Epidemiological Modeler (FASSTER) for early detection of diseases. The researchers developed the FASSTER app for visualizing the spread of diseases, using data from the Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (PIDSR) system, Electronic Medical Records, and SMS-based reports of primary care facilities.

"This app might be able to predict how long this Covid-19 problem will last, given the data that DOH is

collecting and compiling in relation to the outbreak," he said. Currently, the FASSTER app is being used to create predictive models and visualize possible scenarios of outbreaks of dengue, typhoid fever, measles, at specific time periods. According to DOST, the research will enhance the system so it could be used for Covid-19 surveillance and response.

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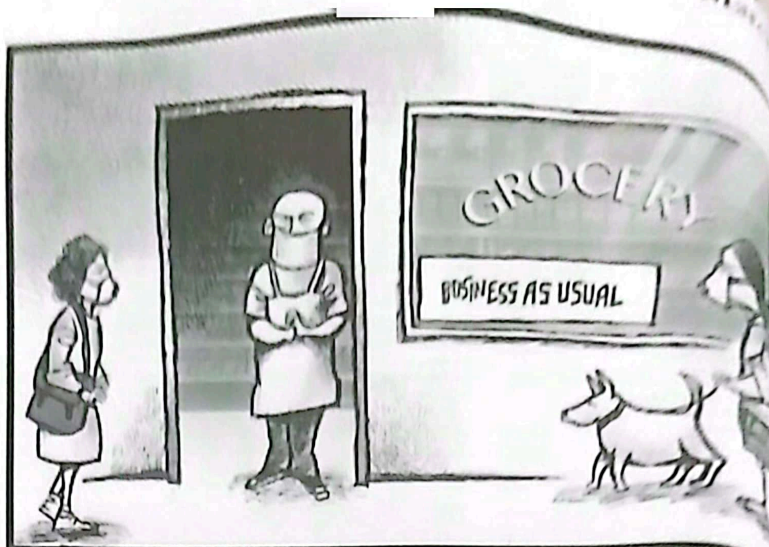

Carmona IATF on COVID-19 conducts consecutive meetings: Members of the Carmona Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) held a meeting on March 15, 2020 at the Municipal house to discuss about the current status of the municipality regarding the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic that has been evident in the whole country as well as the preventive measures and Executive Orders that the local government will issue. It was followed by another meeting on March 16, 2020 after Provincial Governor Jonvic Remulla announced the implementation of "Community Quarantine" for the whole province of Cavite. President Rodrigo Duterte announced the execution of "Enhanced Community Quarantine" for the whole Luzon. On March 17, 2020, a follow-up meeting was held which discussed the specific guidelines of the latter. For the meeting held on March 18, 2020, the COVID-19 updates and assessment of ongoing measures were tackled.



Department Heads meet regarding COVID-19 status: In relation to the ongoing containment efforts of the local government unit of Carmona for the coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the department heads conducted a meeting led by Municipal Mayor Roy Loyola on March 16, 2020 at the Mayor's Office to discuss about the temporary suspension of the services provided by the LGU in order to give additional assistance to our frontliners to maintain the health and welfare of the community. PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 271-2020

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER, LIQUOR, AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE DURING THE ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

Sponsored by: Vice Governor Ramon Jolo B. Revilla III and Hon. Francisco Paolo P. Crisostomo, Chair, Committee on Barangay Affairs

Co-sponsored by: All Sangguniang Panlalawigan Members

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo R. Duterte issued Proclamation No. 929 on 16 March 2020 declaring a state of calamity throughout the Philippines and imposing an enhanced community quarantine throughout Luzon from 17 March to 12 April 2020, due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in the country;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 12, Series of 2020, issued by Provincial Governor Victor C. Remulla placed the entire Province of Cavite under enhanced community quarantine to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the province;

WHEREAS, one of the primary means to effectively contain the spread of the virus causing COVID-19 is to implement social distancing and limiting close person-to-person contact;

WHEREAS, the drinking of liquor and other alcoholic beverages is typically done in groups and in households;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, gives local government units such powers expressly granted, necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or essential for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 922 capacitated local government units to immediately prevent loss of life, utilize appropriate resources to implement urgent and critical measures to contain or prevent the spread of COVID-19, mitigate its effects and impact on the community, and prevent serious disruption of the functioning of the government of the community;

WHEREAS, there is a need to control the accumulation of people in confined spaces to ensure proper social distancing and to prevent the spread of COVID-19;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Crisostomo, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and unanimously approved by the members present, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Prohibiting the Sale and Consumption of Beer, Liquor, and Alcoholic Beverages of Any Kind in the Province of Cavite during the Enhanced Community Quarantine, and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof."

SECTION 2. Liquor Ban. The consumption and sale of beer, liquor, or alcoholic

SECTION 3. Penal Clause. Persons who shall sell beer, liquor, or alcoholic beverage in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined with a sum of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and/or the revocation of their license to sell. Persons who shall consume beer, liquor, or other alcoholic beverage in violation of this Ordinance shall suffer the following penalties:

- First offense – a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) or imprisonment for a period not exceeding five (5) days;
- Second offense – a fine not exceeding Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) or imprisonment for a period not exceeding ten (10) days;
- Third and succeeding offenses – a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and/or imprisonment for a period not exceeding fifteen (15) days.

SECTION 4. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions, or administrative orders inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 5. Separability Clause. If any part or portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and shall remain in force until the enhanced community quarantine is lifted.

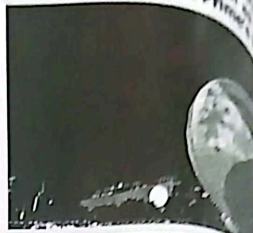
SM allocates Php100M towards COVID-19 support to PGH, RITM, and other government hospitals

"To ensure the safety of medical frontliners, SM is bringing in personal protective equipment (PPE) - face masks, gowns, visors, hoods, gloves, and shoe covers, as well as medical supplies to help government hospitals who badly need them," said SM President and CEO.

Assistance has also been extended to Philippine General Hospital (PGH) and Research Institute for Tropical Management (RITM) for their urgent needs and for improving their laboratory testing capacity. SM has also allocated PPEs and

medical supplies to the UP Medical Foundation Inc. to reach a wider network of hospitals.

To improve availability of tests, SM has reached out to Manila Healthtek Inc. to distribute 20,000 tests for free to government hospitals, once approved for use.



DOST to donate reusable masks to health workers

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) and partners plan to start donating reusable face masks, and donate the first batch to the Department of Health (DOH) Inter-agency Task Force (IATF), a staff said.

"With the implementation of the Enhanced Community Quarantine, we are laying out the logistics and securing necessary permits to move and produce these masks. We aim to get going by next week and release the first batch," Evangelina Manalang, DOST-Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI) promotions head, told the Philippine News Agency (PNA).

The plan is to donate the masks through the IATF and/or DOH which are in better position to identify who needs the mask the most, she added.

Manalang said PTRI Director Celia Elumba already approved the funding for the mask production, adding that PHP15 million from the government and PHP3 million from DOST's private partners were allotted for this.

With the rising concerns about protection from the coronavirus disease 2019 (Covid-19) and the shortage of masks available in the market, DOST Secretary Fortunato dela Peña announced on his Facebook page last Wednesday that the PTRI has partnered with the local government of Taytay, Rizal and some private firms to produce 500,000 reusable masks using the PTRI-developed technology.

This mask is washable for up to 50 times, according to his post.

"We are finishing the masks with a protective treatment that will repel liquid. There are tons of cloth masks, but unless they are repellent, they are just good for street pollution, or maybe ashfall," Elumba told the PNA in a text message.

She added that her research team is doing

many tests to make sure that the mask, which will be called "REwear Face Mask Made Smart" delivers the idea.

Manalang then explained that since "REwear" is water-repellent, this would prevent liquid droplets from coughing and sneezing that potentially carry the virus and bacteria, from penetrating the mask.

"These masks will use a textile finishing technology based on the linkage on cellulosic textile substrate that will make it repellent to liquids. This finishing technology is the subject of a pending IP application," Manalang said.

Durability testing was done for PTRI to determine that the mask could be washed for up to 50 times.

PTRI developed the water-repellant finishing technology in 2012, and

commercialized. Soon, the one for leptospirosis would be released, and there are other things that they develop," he shared.

When news about the new coronavirus came in December 2019, he said UP immediately sent a proposal, "and they started the study by mid-January".

A team of researchers from the UP-National Institutes of Health led by Raul Destura developed a diagnostic kit that aims to detect Covid-19.

According to DOST, this

kit has a high specificity and efficiency through a one-step multiplex real-time polymerase chain reaction platform. The kit is projected to cost PHP1,320 per test.

On March 9, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued a certificate of exemption for this locally-developed kit for use in field testing coupled with gene sequencing at the Philippine Genome Center.

Dela Peña said Destura got a total research grant of PHP55.72 million, including the research for the dengue diagnostic kit.

"We at the DOST are proud of our local researchers having breakthroughs that will help our country. We are also happy that they could do these with the modest amounts of grants," he said.

"Things have fallen well into place, including our decision to jointly put up the Philippine Genome Center with UP, and with CHED (Commission on Higher Education) assistance also because it becomes a big help in times like this," he said.

will surely be of help in President Rodrigo Duterte's resolve to avert the spread of the virus." PhilHealth President and CEO Ricardo C. Morales said.

Further, the state health insurer will also provide its members and

service partners with additional relief in view of the recent declaration of a state of public health emergency in the country by extending the deadline of payment of contributions for its self-paying direct contributors. They can now pay their first quarter contributions on or before April 30, 2020

instead of March 31, 2020 without interest.

Moreover, its policy on single period of confinement and 45-days coverage are also waived in favor of the member, while the filing period for claims is also extended from the usual 60 days to at least 120 days in favor of the health care providers.

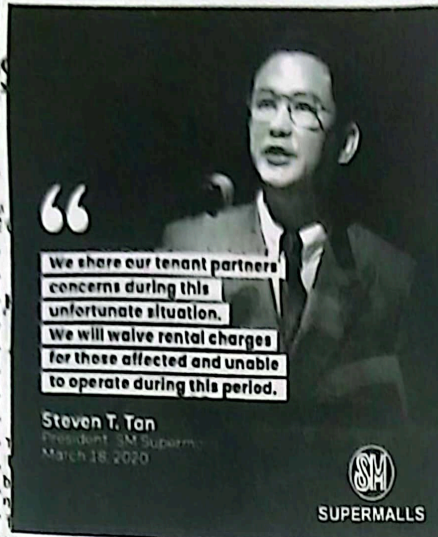

COVID-19: the threat is real

Province of Cavite – The world today is in terror, the country in chaos and the provinces in full alert because of the COVID-19 that is spreading like wildfire across borders, categorizing it as pandemic.

COVID-19 is a kind of corona virus much like the SARS virus that became epidemic in 2003. The outbreak of this new strain of corona virus was first identified in Wuhan, China in December 2019.

The first confirmed COVID-19 case in the Philippines was announced in Jan. 30, 2020, a 38-year-old female Chinese national who traveled from Wuhan, China to Hong Kong and then to Cebu, Dumaguete and Manila while her 44-year old partner who died on February 3, 2020 was the second confirmed case and the first fatality of COVID-19 outside China.

In almost a month reports showed 20 confirmed cases in the Philippines and later several new cases were recorded in just a span of four days with the province of Cavite confirming the first positive case of COVID-19 last Tuesday, March 10, 2020.

Cavite Governor Jonvic Remulla revealed in his facebook page, “The case was a returning seaman from Imus who passed through Narita airport in Japan.”

Meanwhile, Imus Mayor Emmanuel Maliksi clarified, “the patient was 48 years old, and was

PhilHealth to release P30 billion to fight CoViD-19

The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) is releasing an initial P30 billion to accredited hospitals to help them respond to the onslaught of CoViD-19 in the country. The move utilizes its interim reimbursement mechanism (IRM) which will provide health care providers with the much needed liquidity to adequately respond to the pandemic.

PhilHealth said that the amount is equivalent to three months' worth of claims based on historical data, which will be charged to their future claims. Hospitals will be asked to submit a letter of authorization to avail of the mechanism. This will include including those facing sanctions for various violations.
