

Imus City opens Isolation Facility to longest full bed capacity of hospitals

IMUS, Cavite Mar. 29 --The city government here has formally opened on March 28, the St. Dymphna Isolation Facility in Barangay Palico IV in response to the alarming rise in the number of CoVID-19 cases in the city.

During the blessing and inauguration of the facility, Mayor Maliksi said, the facility presents two basic advantages. The facility offers a comfortable and conducive place to isolate asymptomatic and mild cases for residents who could not afford proper home quarantining, and decongest the hospital's full bed capacity as it will serve as a step-down facility where convalescing CoVID-19 patients can continue the treatment and care until they are fully recovered.

"This way the hospitals can accommodate other patients with moderate and severe symptoms who will be needing

Immediate medical attention and treatment," added Maliksi.

The 5-storey, 141 room facility can accommodate more than 500 patients (Suspect, Probable or Confirmed) who are asymptomatic or with mild symptoms of the disease.

Patients will be provided food, medicines, and proper medical care thus, the use of the facility will mitigate the chances of the further spread of the infection since the said CoVID-19 cases are limited within the confines of the facility.

Consequently, the Ospital ng Imus (ONI) and the Medical Center Imus (MCI) announced

their facilities have reached 'full bed capacity' with the emergency room and CoVID ward of the latter health facility in full capacity as of March 27, 2021.

Due to this situation, hospital officials advised the public to seek treatment from other health care facilities within the city or in neighboring cities.

During his speech, Maliksi shared the LGU in collaboration with the DOH and the City Health Office developed four safe measures for the quick and safe administration of the CoVID-19 vaccines.

SULTAN BONG REVILLA (A.K.A. SULTAN AADIL): UMayUDA SA MGA BIKTIMA NG BAGYO SA MINDANAO



Bilang pagtugon sa mga pamilyang lubhang nangangailangan ng tulong, ang butihing Senador Ramon "Bong" Revilla Jr. ay personal na nagsagawa ng dalawang araw na operasyon-tulong para sa mga lugar na matinding sinalanta ng bagyo sa Mindanao. Di sinasadyang napasabay sa pagbibinyag sa kanya bilang Sultan.

Kasama ang kanyang maybahay at Kongresistang si Lani Mercado Revilla, binisita nila ang mga evacuation centers sa Cotabato city, Maguindanao at Sultan Kudarat kung saan ang may walumpung (80,000) libong pamilyang naapektuhan ng bagyo ay naroon.

Namahagi sila ng bigas at mga groceries; gayundin ng mga gamot upang pigilan angmabilis na pagkalat ng mga sakit na nakukuha sa maruming tubig. Ang operasyong ito ay bahagi ng programa ng Senador na "kaagapay sa araw ng Pangangailangan nasalanta o nabiktima ng anumang kalamidad sa buong bansa.

Ayon sa Senador, bagaman nakatulong ang kanyang programa na maibsan pansamantalang ang nararanasang paghihirap ng mga natulungan, dapat pa ring bigyan-diin at pansin ng pamahalaan, samahang pribado (NGO), mga ahensyang pribado at iba pang indibidwal na nagbibigay rin ng tulong sa mga ganitong pagkakataon.

"Ang tulong ko, alam kong di sapat. Ngunit ang mga tao dito sa Mindanao ay naging makabuluhan nang hirangin siya bilang adopted son ng Sultan Kudarat. kay Bong Revilla, na personal na nag pondo ng "relief activity" na ito.

Maliban sa pamamahagi ng relief goods, nakipagkita rin ang Senador sa mga opisyal ng Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH).

First, the vaccination site at the Ospital ng Imus where the official rollout of the vaccination was held, second, the COVID-19 Drive-Thru Vaccination Site at the Robinson's Place Imus, and third, the Onsite COVID-19 Vaccination/Mobile Vaccine Clinic, and lastly, the upcoming conduct of house-to-house vaccination of residents who are not capable of being physically present

at the vaccination centers.

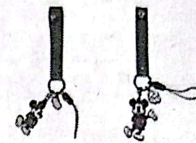

LUCENA CITY POSTS 36.3% COVID VACCINATION RATE, HIGHEST IN CALABARZON

Lucena City in the province of Quezon posted the highest coverage at 36.3% (1,387 out of 3,821 health care workers) since the start of the vaccine roll-out last March 1, highest in the region while Quezon province has the lowest rate with only 2.9% (330 out of 11,311).

Department of Health (DOH) - CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo disclosed that of the total 86,425 total eligible population for Priority Group A1 (i.e., health care workers (HCWs) in hospitals and infirmaries), a total of 13,311 individuals or 15.4% were already vaccinated.

The coverage rate for Sinovac is at 5.9% (5,129) and 9.5% (13,311) for AstraZeneca.

"All provinces are already implementing the vaccination campaign and we have 42 implementing sites registered in the COVID-19 Bakuna Center Registry (CBCR) that are

currently conducting vaccination in the region."

"We have six vaccination sites in Cavite, 12 in Laguna, 11 in Batangas, 7 in Rizal, 3 in Quezon and 3 in Lucena City where our HCWs can visit anytime to get immunized," he emphasized.

CALABARZON received a total of 94,860 vaccine doses for first and second dose use, 19.0% (18,060 doses) of Sinovac and 81.0% (76,800 doses) of AstraZeneca that are sufficient for 47,430 individuals.

"We have recorded deferrals and refusals during the health screenings but slowly and surely the importance of

getting the vaccine is having protection against the virus and negative respiratory health care eventually to be vaccinated."

"Since the roll-out there to real three from the vaccine most individuals receive their Sinovac or AstraZeneca vaccine."

"I encourage medical frontliners to get themselves vaccinated against COVID-19 now that we have another surge only for you but also to protect your well," he com

constructed Water Treatment Facilities to purify wastewater produced from the entire school.

The processed water in the facility is used as recycled water for watering the plants, handwashing, and others.

Aside from this, to maximize the facility, INHS also constructed a small man-made pond that serves as a breeding tank for catfish.

"Actually, nakakapagbreed na nga kami ng hito (catfish), once na lumaki sila, binibenta namin sila," the INHS property custodian shared.

Sustainable energy through solar panels to reduce carbon emission, as well as to encourage the use of renewable energy, the local government funded the installation of solar panels in INHS and some schools around the city.

Saria, however, admitted that not all public schools would be granted solar panels since some have problems with their school meter and school size, among others.

"Bukod sa location ng school, maaari din na mahirapan mag-install ng solar panels yung mga contractor ng isang school kapag hindi three-phase yung electrical lines nila," the INHS overseer stated.

In addition, INHS' solar panels gained an 8-kilowatt output from the second week of October up to October 30.

Eco-kooperatiba on financial and ecological education

Moreover, complying with Republic Act (RA) 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, the local government established Eco-kooperatiba to encourage the youth to protect and help the environment while saving money through waste segregation and recycling.

Eco-kooperatiba converts recyclable materials to monetary investment worth 20 pesos or more which can accumulate an annual interest of 1%.

Students receive a passbook to monitor their savings.

Partnership with CENRO

In line with the Green School's advocacy, on the other hand, City Environmental and Natural Resources Office (CENRO) conducted

programs and projects to educate students and promote ecological practices inside the schools.

CENRO carried out seminars and symposiums, where students learned solid waste management and climate change; Eco Tours, wherein Elementary and High School students get to know what a healthy environment looks like with the help of eco-parks; donations, where eco-plastic armchairs and segregated trash cans were distributed to different schools.

School-grown vegetables to combat malnutrition

As part of the Green School Program, INHS intensified the Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) department's existing "Gulayan sa Paaralan" program and required every subject department to grow their own vegetables from their own gardens.

The vegetables and herbs harvested from these gardens are then used to supply the feeding program of the school.

With this, the school recorded a significant impact on the progress of severely wasted students in the previous school year.

Extending medium-term effects to homes

Meanwhile, in order to assure sustainability and long-term effects of the program, City Agriculturist Robert Marges, urged parents to promote gardening in their homes despite limited space with the use of plant boxes or vertical gardening.

"Hindi naman natin kailangan gumastos nang malaki para makapag-grow ng vegetables sa garden natin eh, kaya nga may vertical gardening at homemade na talaga namang effective fertilizers," Marges explained.

The city agriculturist further explained that executing environmental practices like plant tending even at home will help students and even other members of the family to assume ecological responsibility. 51st STARBOOKS in Batangas Province homes in Golden Gate Colleges

Access to hundreds of thousands S&T information will no longer be hard to students of Golden Gate Colleges Batangas City with the installation of STARBOOKS, 51st system deployed in Batangas province.

STARBOOKS is the country's first digital library with hundreds of thousands digitized science and technology resources in various formats (text and video/audio) placed in specially designed "pods" set in a user-friendly interface. It stands for Science and Technology Academic and Research-Based Openly Operated Kiosk Station (STARBOOKS upgraded and rebranded as SuperSTARBOOKS) developed by the Science and Technology Information Institute (STII), an agency of the Department of Science and Technology. As a standalone information kiosk, information access through STARBOOKS is possible even without internet connection. In fact, it is considered as a one stop S&T information source because of it serves a compendium of S&T information gathered from all over the world.

Given its relevance to education, many academic institutions, local government units, and national government agencies among others are requesting for its installation. Golden Gate Colleges has also found this digital library advantageous in providing S&T resources to their students, the reason why they have signified its adoption.

An Online Orientation Training on SuperSTARBOOKS was pursued upon deployment of the units to Golden Gate Colleges on March 25, 2021 via Google Meet. A total of twenty-four (24) participants comprised of the College Dean, coordinators, teachers, and other staff from Elementary to College

level of the beneficiary institution partook the online activity. DOST PSTC Batangas staff, Ms. Madel I. Macalinao, served as the speaker while Mr. John Maico M. Hernandez served as the program facilitator.

Before the discussion, Mr. Hernandez provided a brief background about the SuperSTARBOOKS and asked the participants to share their idea about it. Ms. Marie Paz B. Closa, Chief Librarian of GGC, shared her understanding of STARBOOKS and mentioned her familiarity of the system begun when she was still with the Library Hub of DepED Batangas where another STARBOOKS unit was deployed.

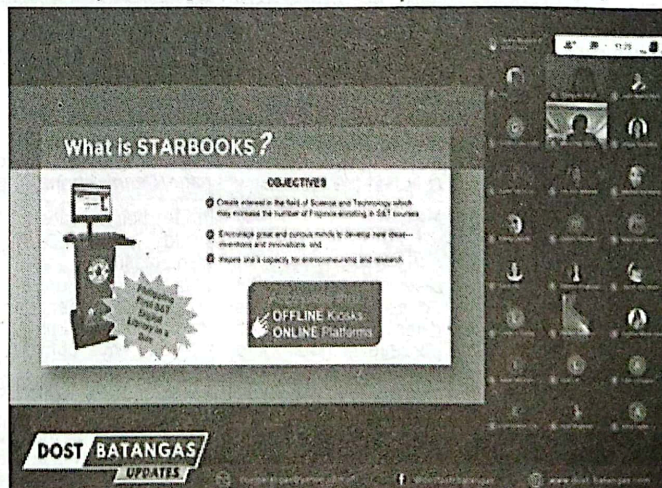
The discussion on SuperSTARBOOKS pursued on a two-part structure. First part was the introduction to STARBOOKS and orientation on available STARBOOKS platforms. Ms. Macalinao, presented the available platforms which participants can access during normal, new normal and better normal which include STARBOOKS Offline, Online (www.starbooks.ph), Mobile Application, Quiz Application and Geomap Application. Tons of resources itemized as books, magazines, journals, scientific and research papers, disaster preparedness materials, interactive courseware, and K-12 supplement materials were also discussed as contents of STARBOOKS. Based from STII report, upgrading of the content of STARBOOKS was carried out in 2016 where more materials have been added into the collection

including full-length livelihood videos from the former Technology Resource Center, scientists' profiles, DOST publications, Science: Cool Facts, significant dates in Philippine Science History and new science articles.

The second part of the discussion focused on the site admin training for both Offline and Online STARBOOKS. The speaker encouraged the participants to take note of the responsibilities of the site admin as it requires technicalities which incorporate the assistance on users, submission of transmittal files, uploading on the citizen's archive, updating on the contents of SUPERSTARBOOKS, and administration of the STARBOOKS kiosks. Questions and concerns of the participants were also addressed after during the activity.

Meanwhile, roles and responsibilities of Golden Gate Colleges as stipulated in the provisions of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) were likewise covered in the first part discussion. Emphasis on the submission of the transmittal file quarterly as a basic monitoring requirement of DOST was laid out.

According to Mr. Patrick Sanchez, the activity was a big help to them. "Great job in giving the overview of how STARBOOKS works and its potentials for use," he mentioned. More than this, they consider STARBOOKS advantageous in their pursuit to produce more competitive students in the fields of Science, Mathematics, and Technology. (John Maico M.
