


5 million Caviteños to get COVID-19 vaccine for free — Gov. Remulla



IMUS, Cavite Mar. 29 --The city government here has formally opened on March 28, the St. Dymphna Isolation Facility In Barangay Palico IV in response to the alarming rise in the number of CoVID-19 cases in the city. During the blessing and inauguration of the facility, Mayor Maliksi said, the facility presents two basic advantages. The facility offers a comfortable and conducive place to isolate asymptomatic and mild cases for residents who could not afford proper home quarantining, and decongest the hospital's full bed capacity as it will serve as a step-down facility where convalescing CoVID-19 patients can continue the treatment and care until they are fully recovered. "This way the hospitals can accommodate other patients with moderate and severe symptoms who will be needing immediate medical attention and treatment," added Maliksi. The 5-storey, 141 room facility can accommodate more than 500 patients (Suspect, Probable or Confirmed) who are asymptomatic or with mild symptoms of the disease. Patients will be provided food, medicines, and proper medical care thus, the use of the facility will mitigate the chances of the further spread of the infection since the said CoVID-19 cases are limited within the confines of the facility. Consequently, the Ospital ng Imus (ONI) and the Medical Center Imus (MCI) announced their facilities have reached 'full bed capacity' with the emergency room and CoVID ward of the latter health facility in full capacity as of March 27, 2021. Due to this situation, hospital officials advised the public to seek treatment from other health care facilities within the city or in neighboring cities. **▶ 1.5 MILLION • 6**





My City, My SM, My Art, which recently launched its book just in time for the National Arts Month, is the latest edition in the My City, My SM series, which celebrates the beauty, culture, traditions, and great people in cities around the Philippines where SM has malls.

National Artist Ben Cabrera

A painter, printmaker, and sculptor, he has exhibited widely in the Philippines, and in Asia, Europe, and the United States.

National Artist BenCab BenCab Cabrera — is BenCab — has come back to Baguio where he grew up, not only with his work, but also with his ability to inspire, educate, and uplift the community.

A Bachelor of Fine Arts graduate of the University of the Philippines, he returned to the Philippines in 1958, where he lived and worked in Manila for two years and then to settle in Baguio.

There, he co-founded the Baguio Arts Guild, helped put Baguio on the map of global art on Christmas of the fourth Baguio Arts Festival in 1972, and helped set up

the Tourism Village for the preservation of Cordillera culture and tradition.

In 2009, he established the BenCab Museum in Baguio to honor his collection of Philippine contemporary art and museum from the indigenous culture of the Cordillera.

A painter, printmaker, and sculptor, he has exhibited widely in the Philippines, Asia, Europe, and the United States. BenCab has received numerous awards and was conferred the Order of the National Arts for Visual Arts in 2006.

National Artist Jose Joya

As an artist who pioneered abstraction, Jose Joya imagined worlds of possibility beyond the confines of linearism. In doing so, he paved the way for new ways of thinking about art as its structure, its profound message, and its value to the viewer.

Joya became interested in studying art early on at the age of 11. Under a scholarship, he attended the University of the Philippines (UP) College of Fine Arts in 1950, where he graduated in 1953, earning the distinction of being the college's first Magna Cum Laude.

Joya served as dean of the UP School of Fine Arts from 1976 to 1978, where he introduced the curriculum, established scholarships, and organized art programs and workshops all over the country.

As a visual media arts practitioner and theorist, Jose Joya's pioneering work in the Philippines with printmaking is characterized by his vigorous

styles of color and gestural painting, the typical use of repetitive, sweeping brushstrokes, and his paper collage of his powerful, and abstract work. The color schemes of his works were strongly influenced by the tropical landscapes of the Philippines.

In his lifetime, Joya received numerous awards, including the National Artist Award for Painting in 1981, Republic Cultural Heritage Award in the same year, ASEAN Cultural Award in 1970, Order of Creative Arts in 1967, and the French Government in 1967, and Order of the Star Outstanding ASEAN Artist in 1992. He was posthumously named as a National Artist of the Philippines in 2003.



Joya's talent was only matched by generosity. He did workshops, work supplements and classes in many provincial municipalities and schools.

He also introduced art to depressed abandoned kids.

Our cultural journey began on March 2016 at SM Seaside City in Cebu with an exhibit featuring artists from the Queen City of the South including maestro Romulo Galicano; and concluded on March 2019 at SM City Cebu with the masterpieces of Manuel Rodriguez, Sr., the Father of Philippine Printmaking leading the way.

In between, our search for art and artists brought us as far north as the Baguio and the Cordilleras and as far south as General Santos in Mindanao. During those three years, we advocated art for all by working closely with communities, schools, and the public to mount exhibits, workshops, and contests in key cities around the Philippines. These were featured in the Philippine Star, our project partner, as well as in local media, and a cultural series in regional cable channels.



Along the way, we were able to have a glimpse of what makes Philippine art unique, and how close family ties, ingenuity, and a sense of community played key roles in its development.

We have seen how Filipino art has flourished through families like that of Cebu; as well as those of masters Mauro Malang Santos, Jose Pitok, Eduardo Castrillo whose children — and in some cases grandchildren — are a new generation visual artists. There are also wonderful examples of fathers and sons together — National Artist Abdulmari Imao and Toy Living Treasure Eduardo Mutuc and Eduardo, Jr., Ricarte Puruganan, Manuel Baldemor and Monnar, Romulo Olazo and Jonathan.


Family members have also played significant roles in preserving legacies of their loved ones: Josie Baldovino for her brother National Artist Jose Joya, Daisy Tolentino-Mendez for her father National Artist Guillermo and Totong Francisco II for his grandfather National Artist Carlos Botong. We were both honored and touched when the family of Manuel Roc flew all the way from the US and the Bahamas to join us in the tribute at SM City Cebu.

We were also amazed at how Filipino artists created groundbreaking art from non-traditional materials. With art supplies either too costly, unavailable, Baguio's Jordan Mang-osan and Patric Palasi found their solar and coffee art, respectively; while Palawan's Elordie Mesac crafted from rubber slippers. When his materials were washed away by super typhoon Yolanda, Tacloban-born Dante Enage began using tuba, a local wine made from coconut juice, as his medium.



The third part of the STARTT program is the Mock Pitching event where 12 technologies from the chosen RDIs and SUCs will present their recorded pitching videos to the panelists, followed by the open forum.

Ms. Russell Pili, Chief Science Research Specialist and Chief Technology Transfer Officer of the Research Information and Technology Transfer Division (RITTD) of DOST-PCIEERD, gave the opening remark.

"I know that this is not exhaustive enough but this is enough to give you at least a glimpse of what it's like [to pitch]," admitted Ms. Pili. "The purpose of the pitch naman is to start a conversation." She assured the participants—especially the new ones—in the form of a joke, saying that while they should be nervous, they should also envision the mock pitching event as the "real" pitching session.

The program proper involved the video presentations from the chosen RDIs and SUCs in the first session of STARTT last month. After each product pitch, the panelists offered their critiques and suggested ways on how to better "market" these technologies. Mr. Edward Paul Apigo of DOST-PCIEERD, together with the speakers from the previous STARTT workshop on investment pitching namely, Mr. Benjie Mirasol, Mr. Jon Fernandez, and Mr. George Quitariano of ADMU, served as the panelists. As part of the banner program, STARTT, the previous workshops are to prepare the participants for the Regional Technology Transfer Day where potential investors and adopters will be invited, and the actual pitching will take place. 




