

Cavite launches own testing program

In line with the province's efforts to fight this disease, the provincial government will launch its own testing facility to screen all the PUIs in the province. Because this will result to ensure recoveries because these patients will be treated properly with the right care and medication.

On the other hand, Gov. Jonvic expressed his concern that, "12 days is unrealistic for the quarantine to end," now that quarantine period is on the third week.

The governor assured that other measures like the disinfectant program are still being conducted thru the various Bureaus of Fire Protection in all the province's cities and municipalities.

Talking about the issue

of the National Government's Social Amelioration program, the Governor stated that there are still no guidelines to implement this.

He assured that everyone would be included and could avail of this grant by the national government.



Disease 2019 (COVID-19), please be informed that the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) will shoulder the full cost of treatment for all COVID-19 cases until April 14, 2020. After the date, we shall continue provide financial coverage to Covid cases thru a recomputed case rate.

The reason for this accommodation window is due to the novelty and the wide range of severity of the disease in the country for which no existing case rate or package based on accepted protocols has yet been established. PhilHealth is confident that by the above mentioned date, more about the behavior of the disease in the Philippines can be learned, a final protocol established, and an appropriate case rate can be developed that will provide adequacy and sustainability to the antiCOVID-19 campaign.

Before then, PhilHealth shall issue a new set of guidelines which will include the appropriate case rate based on accepted protocols in dealing with the disease. Furthermore, as stipulated under R.A. 11469 also known as the Bayanihan We Heal As One Act, all health workers will be covered beyond the April 14 2020 cut-off date for all work and COVID-19 related health service.

Due to the exigency of the times, this will include all other personnel necessary for the operation of a health facility. We anticipate your full support and cooperation, now more than ever, as we face this global pandemic and continuously fulfill our mandate under the Universal Health Care (UHC) Law providing adequate health services to all Filipinos when the need arises.

Cavite officials discuss viability of COVID-19 testing facility in the province; LGU readiness

Cavite Governor Jonvic C. Remulla yesterday, met with heads of cities and municipalities, PNP Chiefs, City and Municipal Health Officers and the De La Salle-Dasmariñas medical team to discuss the viability of the province's COVID-19 testing facility and the readiness of each LGU in facing the challenge.

During the meeting, the following data were established to get a clear view of what are needed to fully capacitate the province for this undertaking.

As of April 2, there are already 1,200 PUIs in the province which could be tested within five days because the province has its own PCR (Polymerase Chain Reaction) testing machine.

It is also taken into consideration that there are only 125 ventilators available in all hospitals (both public and private) in the province and an estimate of 300 units are needed once the designated holding areas for COVID-19 PUIs and positive patients which are being prepared by the LGUs in their respective cities and municipalities start accommodating them.

Meanwhile, Gov. Jonvic pointed out that it is very depressing when one is a suspected PUI much more so if tested positive of COVID-19.

He surmised that, "Pag sila ay nandoon ay bawal ang sino man bumisita. Ito para di na kumalat lalo ang sakit. Ang LGU na ang magpapakain at magaga."

The medical team of the De La Salle-Dasmariñas reported that they are currently working on the accreditation of their facility as a Bio-Hazard safety certified laboratory by the Department of Health (DOH) and the Research Institute of Tropical Medicine (RITM) until April 12, 2020.

The Governor requested everyone to pray for the success of the team, "Magdasal natin ang mga taga DLSU na pumasat at gumana na ang laboratory," Remulla said. (Ruel Francisco, PIA-Cavite with reports from the official page of Gov. Jonvic Remulla)

DOST-LSPU's IDD Lab Develops Safety Gown to serve as PPEs for Frontliners

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) and the Laguna State Polytechnic University (LSPU) have developed a safety gown to help in the battle against COVID-19. The lab is currently operational and targets to produce prototypes (in close coordination with the Department of Health) to aim to serve hospitals and frontliners in the province. The target beneficiaries are seven hospitals in San Pablo City and the municipality of Los Baños.

This April 8, 75 pieces of bent acrylic faceshields were already turned over to the Los Baños Municipal Health Office and Healthserv Los Baños Medical Center. In the midst of growing public concern over the financial costs of getting treatment for the Coronavirus Disease 2019, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) once again assured the public that it will "shoulder the full cost of treatment of COVID-19 cases until April 14, 2020." In its Advisory No. 2020-022 addressed to all accredited hospitals and health facilities in the country, PhilHealth clarified that "after the (said) date, we shall continue to provide financial coverage to COVID cases thru a recomputed case rate," citing that "the reason for this accommodation window is due to the novelty and the wide range of severity of the disease in the country for which no existing case rate or package based on accepted protocols has yet been established."

The stated agency said that it "is confident that by (April 14, 2020), more about the behavior of the disease in the Philippines can be learned, a final protocol established, and an appropriate case rate can be developed that will provide adequacy and sustainability to the anti-COVID-19 campaign." 
