

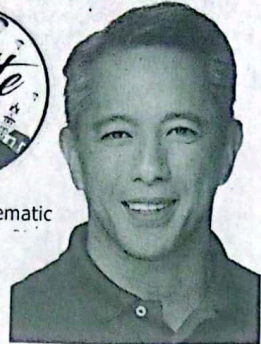
PGC delegates GCQ guidelines

Bacoor Mayor appeals for reconsideration of GCQ status

BACOR CITY, Cavite -- Bacoor City Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla wrote to the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging and Infectious Disease (IATF-EID) to reconsider the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) status for the city effective Saturday, May 16, 2020.

This move was made upon the advice of the Bacoor City Health Office and from the deliberation with the Bacoor COVID-19 Task Force on the latest data reported by the City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (CESU) on the COVID cases in the city.

Mayor Lani stated that, "To date, there are 200 COVID tests made to Bacoor patients with results that are still pending. We need to see the results of these tests before we can open up. We could not take the risk if ever most of these patients tested positive and we are already on GCQ."

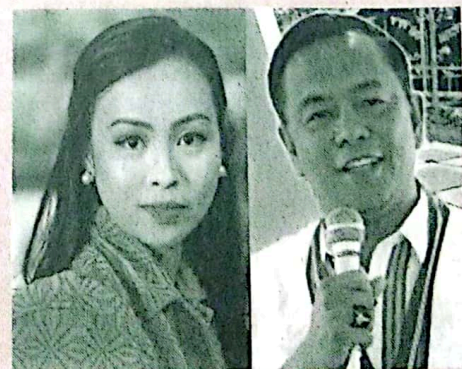


DOST-R02 boosts assistance to Isabela farmers with 20 units of Multi-Purpose Solar Drying trays

TUGUEGARAO CITY- Over 120 Isabela farmers in the Cagayan Valley region look forward to improving the quality of their produce after the Department of Science and Technology Region 02 (DOST-R02) office provided six of their agricultural cooperatives 20 units of Multi-Purpose Solar Drying Trays. The equipment were given free.

The six farmers cooperatives include the Nakar Agriculture Cooperative, IP Agricultural Credit Cooperative, Dimas Agriculture Cooperative, Jones Goat Raiser Agriculture Cooperative, and the Dibulan Farmers Organization. All six are in the fourth district of Isabela province. The last two are based in Jones, Isabela.

Isabela 4th district Representative Alyssa Sheena P. Tan said the cooperatives' farmer-members will significantly benefit from the post-harvest equipments provided by DOST-R02, particularly in speeding up the drying and ensuring the enhanced quality of their farm produce. The

DOH ESTABLISHES MORE COVID ISOLATION FACILITIES IN CALABARZON

The Department of Health (DOH)- CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, together with the local government units of Cavite have established isolation facilities to be used as quarantine facilities for persons under investigation (PUI) patients with mild symptoms of the COVID 19 virus.

"These isolation facilities were identified by the municipal and city government units of the province to be designated as quarantine facilities for COVID-19 patients. They were temporarily converted and designated for isolation and quarantine services," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

Among the designated community isolation units already accredited by DOH includes the Kawit ISO Facility and the Cavite City Quarantine Facility

which both operated last April 29, 2020, the Noveleta MeDCare Center COVID-19 Isolation Facility in Barangay San Jose 1 in Noveleta opened on April 30, 2020 and the Rosario ISO Facility located in Poblacion, Rosario, Cavite which began operation on May 4, 2020.

"The regional office will ensure that patients accommodated in these facilities will be well-taken cared of until they are fully recovered and tested negative of the novel

corona virus," he assured.

Community Isolation Units (CIUs) are DOH certified publicly or privately owned none hospital facilities set-up in coordination with or by the national government or local government units (LGUs) to serve as quarantine facilities for probable and confirmed cases of COVID-19 based on DOH guidelines.

As of May 7, 2020, a total of 1,251 COVID-19 cases were reported in the region, with 156 patients recovered and 84

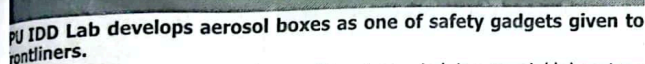

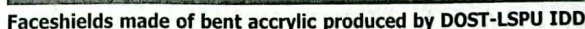
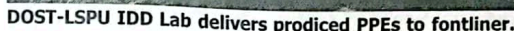
Per DTI Fair Trade Permit No. RA4-04-118 Series of 2020

Department of Science and Technology-CALABARZON together with Laguna State Polytechnic University (LSPU) San Pablo through their Innovation, Design, and Development (IDD) Laboratory have joined forces in the battle against COVID-19. The DOST-LSPU IDD Lab has developed a total of 1,240 PPEs composed of the following: 600 bentonite face shields, 140 safety gown suits made from poly microfiber and water repellent microfiber (white) fabric, 20 aerosol boxes, and 40 ventilator valves.



With the completion of the project's deliverables, that even surpassed the targets, an on-going survey to evaluate the level of acceptability of the produced PPEs is now being conducted. The recipients of these PPEs will evaluate their satisfaction in terms of quality, usability, safety, and aesthetics of the face shields, safety suits, aerosol boxes, and ventilator valves. The results will help the DOST-LSPU IDD Lab team to assess the outputs and note the improvements to be made in the next production.

Lab is a special laboratory which makes use of 3D printers to facilitate product development, design, and prototype. Originally intended for local designers and potential technopreneurs, the DOST-LSPU IDD Lab has now ventured into serving a different customer- answering the call of service in these trying times. This also led the LSPU to gain experience and confidence in the production of PPEs paving the way for their submission of a proposal to CHED in the amount of Php 466,050 for the production of PPEs intended for the frontliners. 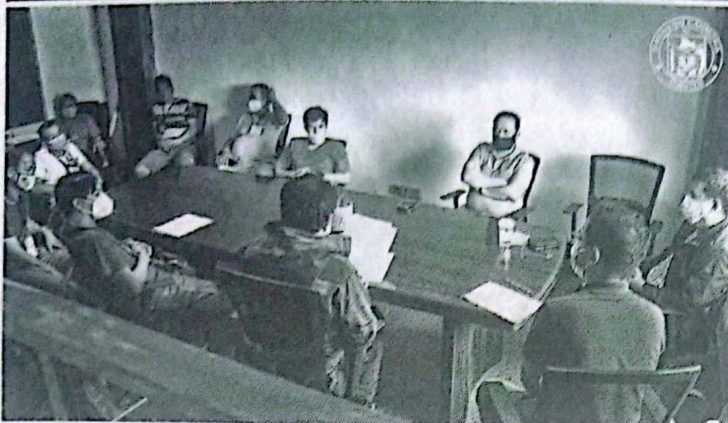

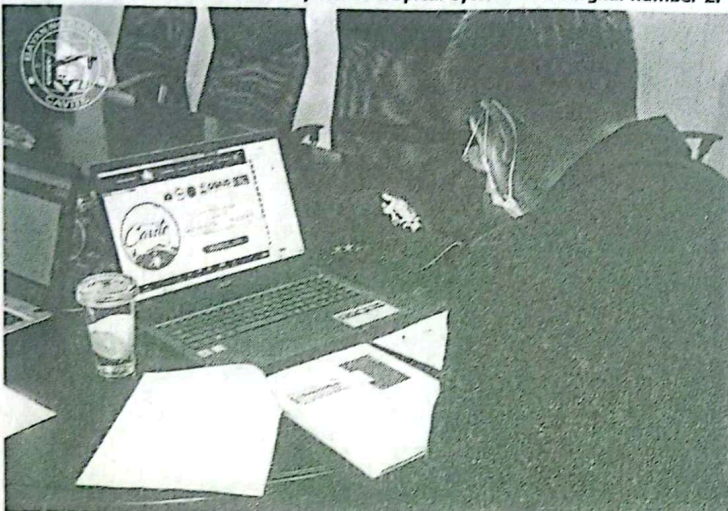

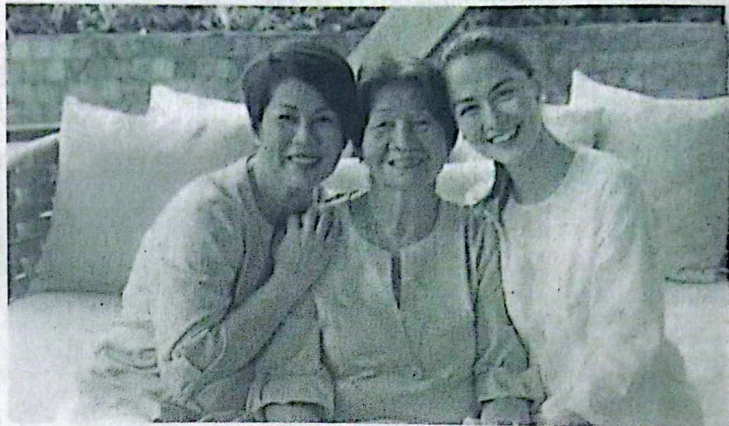

a total of 156 beds, air conditioning units, ceiling fans, exhaust fans, restrooms, shower areas, and nurse lounges. The EQFs are set to accommodate COVID-19 patients who are asymptomatic or with mild symptoms.

In the Camp Crame EQFs, each bed has a built-in call system and patients will have an access to Wi-Fi connectivity. PNP chief Gen. Archie Gamboa thanked SM Engineering Design and Development President Hans 'Chico' Sy Jr. and WTA Architecture and Design Studio for their contributions to the facility.

Apart from contributing to the ongoing fight against the COVID-19 pandemic, this social initiative also served as a platform for volunteerism for SM employees, especially those from SM EDD.

Through the EQF project, SM EDD employees were able to volunteer their time and expertise in constructing the insulated EQFs, an initiative that has received encouragement and strong support from the President of SM EDD, Hans 'Chico' Sy Jr.

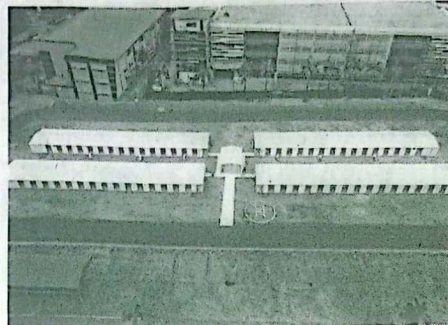

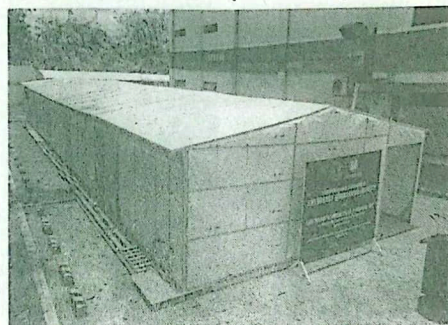

Earlier, SM, through SM Foundation donated over PHP170 million worth of personal protective equipment, testing kits, and intensive care unit (ICU-grade) ventilators to over 100 hospitals and medical institutions.

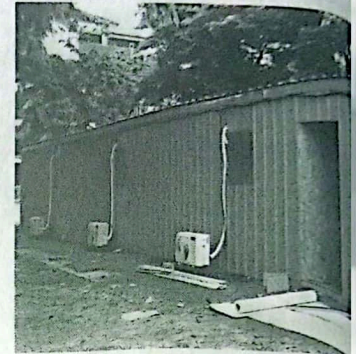

travels.

For Q-pass holders who will resume work during the GQC, the revised Q-pass should be given to the member of the household who will be left to housekeep, while for the senior citizens a special pass would allow them to go out of residence to buy food and basic essentials.

Resumption of public transportation like PUJ, PUB, Tricycles, Multi-Cabs and Baby Bus (Baby Bus operations are under IATF rules) will be at 50% capacity only to allow for social distancing of passengers. Tricycles will only have one passenger and their operation will be pursuant to the agreement between the LGU and respective TODA drivers/operators.

The appeal for backrides on single motorcycles was not tackled by the IATF, therefore there is no 'Couple Pass' yet.

Meanwhile, barbershops and salons will resume operations provided social distancing is observed

at all times. Children below 20 years of age will have to secure a Special Transit Pass from the Barangay and will be accompanied by the Q-pass holder in order to avail of these grooming services.

Intra city travel are allowed for official work duties but for non-work related matters, Q-pass holders need a 1-day Transit Pass from the Mayor's office which only be valid for the day while a 1-week Transit Pass is given to jobseekers that is renewable weekly.

The Sangguniang Panlalawigan have not yet passed an ordinance to approve the Liquor License Law therefore, the Liquor Ban still remains in effect.

Governor Jonvic stressed that, "The IATF ruled that the province will be placed under GQC status. It is not a freedom pass. It only allows for business and industries to open so the province's economy could start." (Ruel Francisco, PIA-Cavite with reports from Gov. Jonvic Remulla FB page)
