## **Bacoor Mayor appeals for** reconsideration of GCO status

BACOOR CITY, Cavite -- Bacoor City Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla wrote to the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging and Infectious Disease

Force on Emerging and Infectious Disease (IATF-EID) to reconsider the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) status for the city effective Saturday, May 16, 2020.

This move was made upon the advice of the Bacoor City Health Office and from the deliberation with the Bacoor COVID-19 Task Force on the latest data reported by the City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (CESU) on the COVID cases in the city.

Mayor Lani stated that, "To date, there are 200 COVID tests made to Bacoor patients with results that are still pending. We need to see the results of these

are still pending. We need to see the results of these tests before we can open up. We could not take the risk if ever most of these patients tested positive and we are already on GCQ."

Among the designated community isolation units already accredited by DOH includes the Kawit ISO Facility and the Cavite City Quarantine Facility which both operated last April 29, 2020, the Noveleta MeDCare Center CoVID-19 Isolation Facility in Barangay San Jose 1 in Noveleta opened on April 30, 2020 and the Rosario ISO Facility located in Poblacion, Rosario, Cavite which began operation on May 4, 2020. "The regional office will

The DOST-LSPU IDD

Lab is a special laboratory which makes use of 3D printers to facilitate product development, design, and prototype. Originally intended for local designers and potential technopreneurs, the DOST-LSPU IDD Lab has now ventured into serving a different customer- answering the call of service in these trying times. This also led the LSPU to gain experience and the in confidence production of PPEs paving way for their submission of a proposal to CHED in the amount of Php 466,050 for the production of PPEs for the intended frontliners. LIGTAS COVID Centers are managed by a Local COVID-19 Task Force (LCTF), Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT), a Sanitation Officer, and an assigned LIGTAS COVID manager.

The LGUs shall ensure that all health care workers and other frontline personnel exposed to the risk of infection are provided with proper and adequate personal protective equipment (PPE) according their roles and responsibilities.

According to Director

Janairo, the regional office has already provided the necessary and essential personal protection equipment (PPEs) to various LGUs in the region.

As of May 17, 2020, there are a total of 1,399 COVID-19 cases were reported in the region, with 25 new cases, 266 patients have recovered and a total of 94 deaths.

There is now a grand total of 12,305 cases, with 2,561 patients recovered and 817 deaths recorded nationwide.

Below is the list of the 254 isolation facilities established in the different cities and municipalities in the five provinces in the Region:

Cavite, 24 CIUs; Laguna, 40 isolation facilities; Batangas, 54 isolation facilities; Rizal, 19 CIUs in operation; and in Quezon, 117 LIGTAS COVID Centers.



travels.

For Q-pass holders who will resume work during the GCQ, the revised Q-pass should be given to the member of the household who will be left to housekeep, while for the senior citizens a special pass would allow them to go out of residence to buy food and basic essentials.

Resumption of public transportation like PUJ, PUB, Tricycles, Multi-Cabs and Baby Bus (Baby Bus operations are under IATF rules) will be at 50% capacity only to allow for social distancing

passengers. Tricycles will only have one passenger and their operation will be pursuant to the agreement between the LGU and respective TODA drivers/operators.

The appeal for backrides on single motorcycles was not tackled by the IATF, therefore there is no 'Couples Pass' yet.

Intra city tavel are allowed for official work duties but for non-work related matters, Q-pass holders need a 1-day Transit Pass from the Mayor's office which only be valid for the day while a 1-week Transit Pass is given to jobseekers that is renewable weekly.


