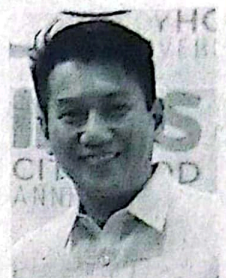

Also, a plaque of appreciation was also extended to the regional office for its support in promoting voluntary blood **► DOH • 5**

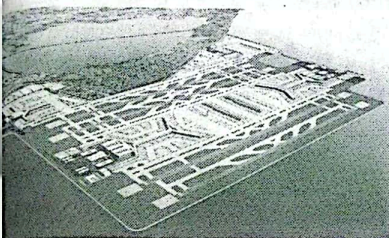

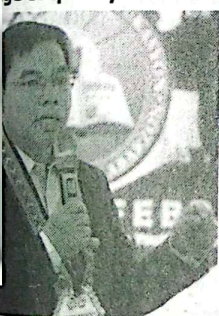

if necessary and to provide check points; liaise with the Local Price Coordinating Council, monitor prices of local medicines and preventive gadgets and file a case against businesses doing hoarding and overpricing; conduct clean-up drives in all parts of the city and encourage cleanliness of the environment and the home.

The participants were partnered with the business coaches who later paneled them in the Business Plan Presentation and recommended some

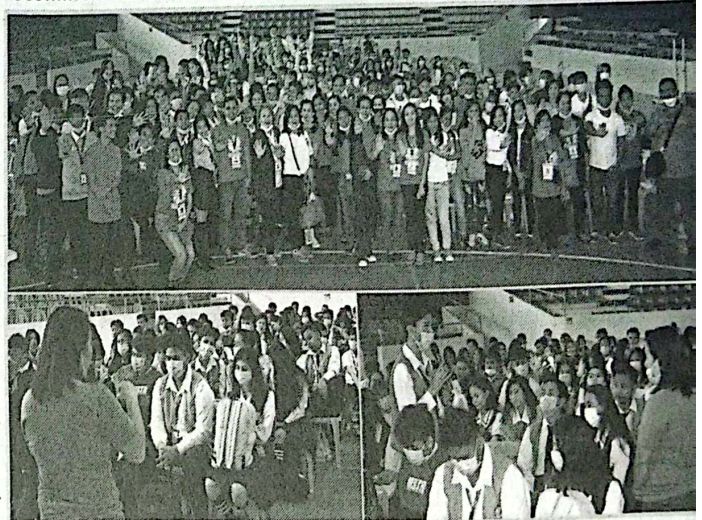

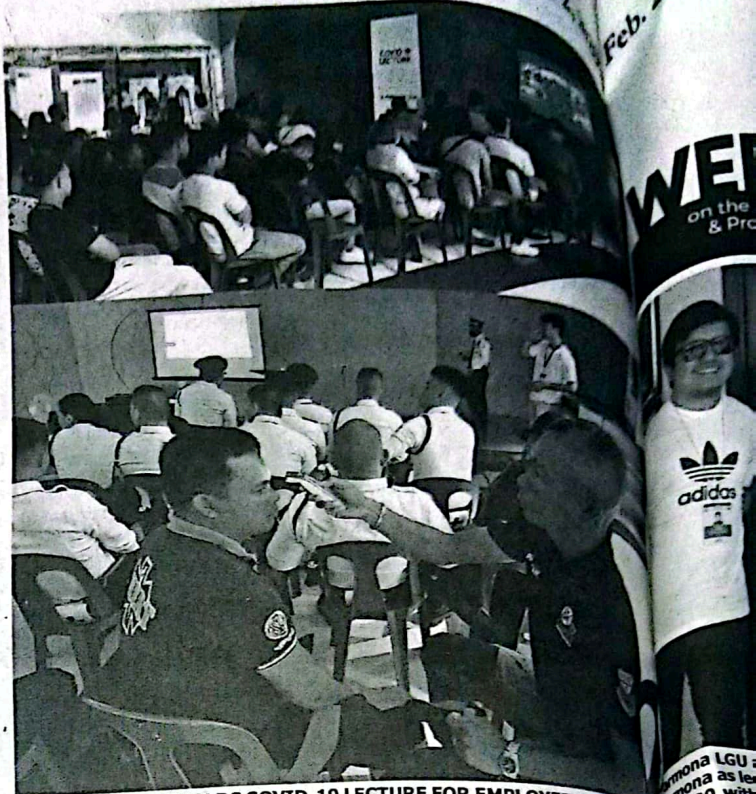
Hindi pwedeng

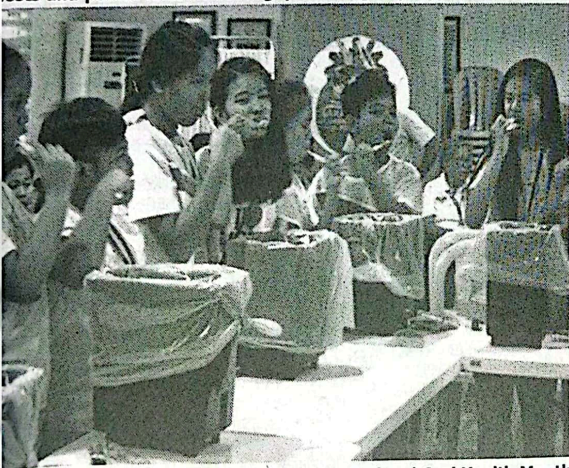

2020", the DOST is set to spearhead a series of technology launches and events for the entire year. The said technology launches will highlight the practical benefits of various R&D outputs and scientific services, particularly in the areas of agriculture, enterprise technology, space science, genomics, mass transportation, development of smart cities, health and

nutrition, disaster preparedness, nuclear technology, among others.

The Secretary emphasized that while technology remains the driving force of any developed economy, it is a must for the Philippines to develop more technologies that can help improve people's lives.

Among the 20 R&D outputs unveiled by the

DOST is the possible launch this year of two locally-built nanosatellites, an anti-dengue drug and biomedical devices, a 12-horsepower single cylinder diesel engine, and an automated guideway transit for Bataan.

Also presented was a program called Understanding Lightning and Thunderstorms for Extreme Weather and Monitoring and Information Sharing or ULAT, a comprehensive program on nutrition, and a partnership between the DOST and the Department of National Defense.

There will also be a nationwide tissue-cultured coconut planting day, the maiden voyage of a hybrid trimaran, launching of a "Science for the People" book

series, a concert using bamboo musical instruments, the launch of several DOST-enabled smart cities, and an exposition on innovations in disaster risk reduction and response.

Several DOST facilities are lined up to start offering services this year including the country's first fully automated gamma irradiation facility, a Regional Yarn Production and Innovation Center in Miagao, Iloilo, a tissue-cultured laboratory for ornamental plants in Bulacan, opening of various science discovery centers, the Philippine Genome Center in Visayas, and several laboratories including metrology laboratories in chemistry and biology, simulation packaging testing and green packaging laboratories,

Curriculum Learning Management Division, on curriculum adjustment through R4AQuBE BOW or Budget of Work, which focuses on recall, remediation, reflection and relearning.

"Learners should understand the context of their daily activities. Since the curriculum is sacred and we don't have the hands to change it, we should think of what really

matters to our learners," he said, when asked about learning competencies and number of school days.

There's a plan that they would pass a joint resolution, something," sabi ng Pres. Duterte sa interbyu sa Malakanyang noong Miyerkoles, Feb. 26. Sa tanong na sa pagtanggap ng paghingi ng patawad ng ABS-CBN, hindi na niya pakikialaman ang aplikasyon ng ABS-CBN para sa renewal ng prangkisa nito – na matatapos sa Marso 30, sinabi ng Pangulo na wala siyang magagawa dahil ang desisyon at nasa House of Representatives. Walang sinabi si Duterte kung aaprubahan o hindi ang renewal ng prangkisa ng radio-TV network. Kallangan ang pirma ng Presidente sa prangkisa bago ito maging epektibo ang batas na magkakaloob ng 25-taong prangkisa sa isang kompanyang katulad ng ABS-CBN. Aniya, isang napakabigay na desisyon ayon. "Maybe I will call the media to help me out. It would be a difficult decision, really. So I will... I will cross the bridge

when I get there," sabi ni Duterte. Aniya pa, hindi niya masasabihan ni Solicitor General Jose Calida na itigil na ang quo warranto petition. (QWP) na isinampa sa mga mahistrado ng Supreme Court. "Ang problema kasi nitong sa SolGen, once he makes an official statement that there is a violation of law, then stoop na ako ... parang, hindi na ako makagalaw," sabi ng Pangulo. Aniya, kung may makitang paglabag sa batas ang SolGen at sabihin na iimbestigahan niya iyon, "Wala na akong... Hindi ko masabihan, 'Do not do it. Stop it.' 'Yan ang problema.' Maraming inilahad na paglabag sa batas na ginawa ang ABS-CBN, ayon sa QWP ni Calida sa SC. (ADELA ZAMORA)

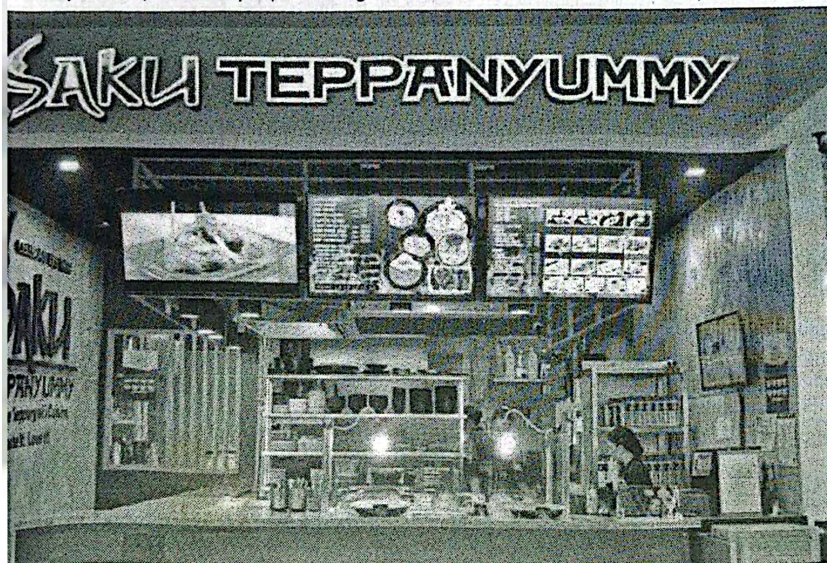

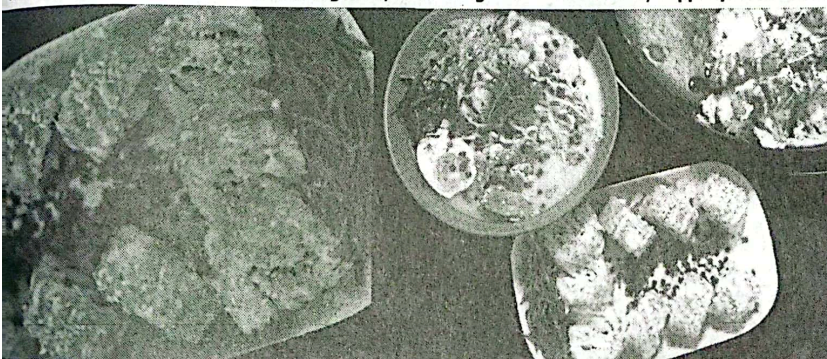

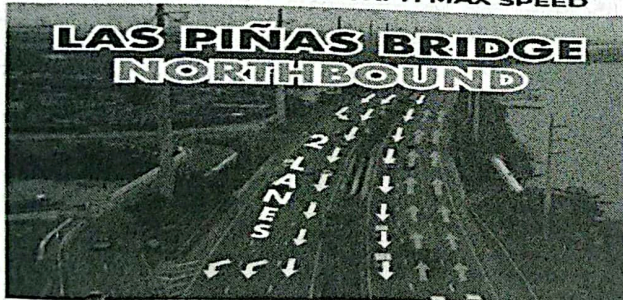
