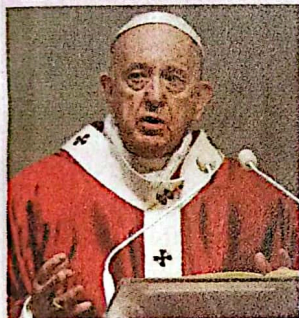

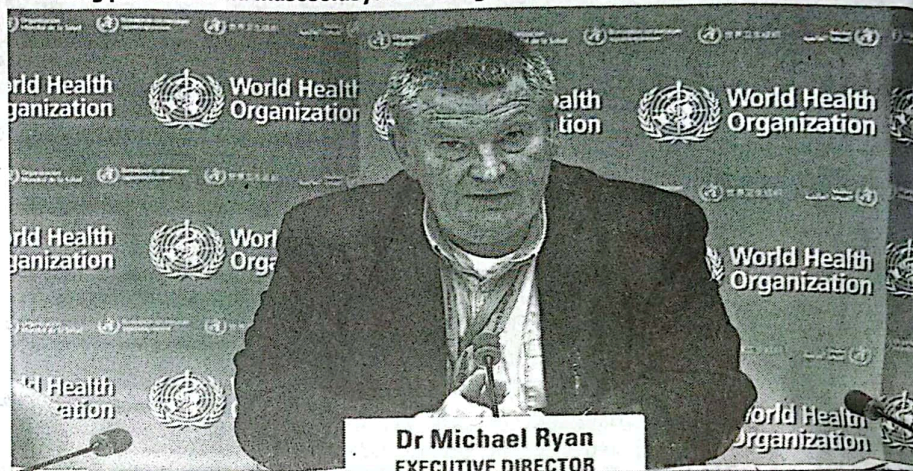
Maaring hindi ito kasing sigla ng dati, ngunit dapat ito manatiling makabuluhan, maramdaman ang kabanalan.

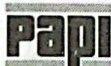

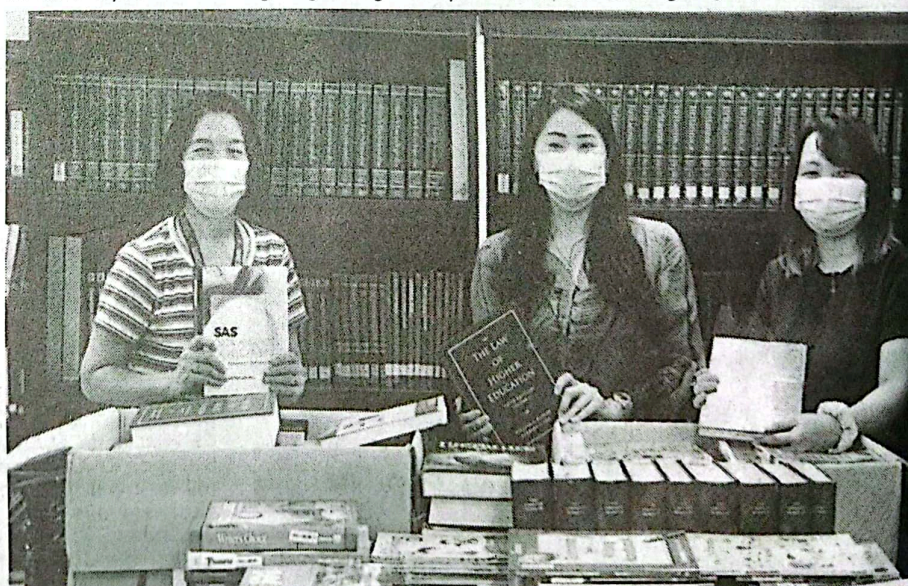

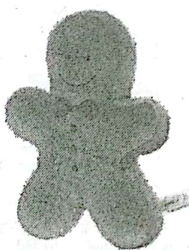

DTI 4-A lauds Rizal for bagging Most Competitive Province for the 5th time and CALABARZON winners in the 8th Regional Competitiveness Summit

The Department of Trade and Industry Region 4-A congratulates the Rizal Province for bagging the Most Competitive Province in the country for the fifth time, along with the winner cities and municipalities in the CALABARZON Region for different categories, during the 8th Regional Competitiveness (RC) Summit by the DTI-Competitiveness Bureau through the Cities and Municipalities Competitiveness Index (CMCI) on December 16, 2020 via Facebook Live. The Region bagged 21 out of the 111 awards in the Summit.



This year, 1,518 local government units participated in the CMCI—an annual ranking of Philippine cities and municipalities developed by the National Competitiveness Council through the Regional Competitiveness Committees (RCCs) with the assistance of the United States Agency for International Development. Rankings of Cities and Municipalities are based on the sum of their scores on the Four Pillars: Economic Dynamism, Government Efficiency, Infrastructure, and Resiliency. Provincial rankings are based on population and income weighted average of the Overall scores of cities and municipalities under a province.

During the Summit, 1st Placer for Best Research Paper, Rina Abner of the Partido State University, presented the 2020 CMCI Academic Symposium. DTI Undersecretary Rafaelita Aldaba also provided an overview of the launching of the CMCI Data Analytics Platform.

Moreover, a Memorandum of Understanding between Liveable Cities Philippines and the DTI and Joint Memorandum Circular signing on the

Mandatory Submission of the List of Business Establishments Registered in the City and Municipality between the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the DTI took place before the Awarding Ceremony for the Most Competitive Cities and Municipalities.

Under the Economic Dynamism, Cainta, Rizal bagged 1st Place for the 1st and 2nd Class Municipalities. Calamba, Laguna and Dasmariñas, Cavite placed 2nd and 3rd Place, respectively, for the Component Cities.

Under the Efficiency, CALABARZON got all the awards for the 1st and 2nd Class Municipalities: Cainta, Rizal as 1st Place; Taytay, Rizal as 2nd Place; and Silang, Cavite as 3rd Place. Moreover, Taal, Batangas and Alaminos, Laguna were awarded 2nd and 3rd Place, respectively, for the 3rd and 4th Class Municipalities. Pakil, Laguna won 2nd Place for the 5th and 6th Class Municipalities. For Component Cities, Antipolo, Rizal placed 2nd while Dasmariñas, Cavite placed 3rd.

Under the Infrastructure, Cainta, Rizal was awarded 3rd Place for the 1st and 2nd Class Municipalities. On the other hand, Antipolo, Rizal got 2nd Place for

Component Cities. Under the Resiliency, San Mateo, Rizal attained 2nd Place for the 1st and 2nd Class Municipalities, Pagsanjan, Laguna as 2nd Place for the 3rd and 4th Class Municipalities, and Antipolo, Rizal as 3rd Place for Component Cities.

For Best Practices Award, Dolores, Quezon won 2nd Place.

For the Overall Most Competitive Local Government Units, the Region also won big as Cainta, Rizal achieved 1st Place and Taytay, Rizal as 2nd Place for the 1st and 2nd Class Municipalities. Antipolo, Rizal was awarded 1st Place for Component Cities.

"We commend the cities, municipalities, and provinces in the CALABARZON Region who participated in this year's RC Summit. It's been a tough year for all of us, yet they attested that this pandemic is not a hindrance to improve and serve the public better. Congratulations to all the winners and participants! We, in the DTI, is with you in this endeavor for the improvement and progress of our nation," said CALABARZON Regional Competitiveness Chair and DTI CALABARZON Director Marilou Q. Toledo.

BatStateU inaugurates STEER Hub unveils first KIST Park in the country

BATANGAS CITY- Batangas State University continues to trail blaze era of university-based innovation as it inaugurates the Science, Technology, Engineering, and Environment Research Hub (STEER Hub) on December 15, 2020.



The STEER Hub complements the university's Knowledge, Innovation, and Science Technology (KIST) Park, the pioneer, university-based Information Technology Park in the country, and the first KIST Park registered by the Philippine Economic Zone Authority. Dr. Lilian A. De Las Llagas, Commissioner of the Commission on Higher Education and Chair of the BatStateU Governing Board, led the ribbon-cutting ceremonies, together with BatStateU President and KIST Park Chief Operating Officer, Dr. Tirso A. Ronquillo. Members of the university's Board of Regents and Executive Committee witnessed the event, following strict health and safety protocols.

A highlight of the event was the unveiling of the 3D model of the BatStateU KIST Park that showcases Technology Hub, Design Innovation Building, Technology Centrum, Data Center, Convention Center, and KIST Hotel.

The attendees toured the STEER Hub facilities after the unveiling ceremonies. They visited the research and development facilities, including the Manufacturing Research Center: LIKHA FabLab, Center for Technopreneurship and Innovation (CTI), Electronics Systems Research Center, GIS Applications Development Center, Digital Transformation Center, Innovation and Technology Support Office, and Material Testing and Calibration Center.

A launching program was held at the Audio-Visual Room of the STEER Hub. Department of Trade and Industry Secretary Ramon Lopez sent his video message, congratulating the university for the

pioneering endeavor. "Ang KIST Park ay panigurangod ng makakatulong sa pagbunsod ng kapasidad at kakayahan ng BatStateU na magsagawa ng mga pananaliksik para matugunan ang mga pangangailangan ng industriya," Sec. Lopez added.

In his message on steering innovation and knowledge creation in science and technology, Dr. Tirso Ronquillo underscored the university's efforts to serve as the anchor of CALABARZON Regional Inclusive Innovation Center, as it maps the key innovation actors and initiatives in the region and facilitates the engagement of innovation players in government, academe, and industry.

He also thanked the Board of Regents and Executive Committee for the commitment to advancing the innovation initiatives of the university. The Chairman and CEO of Pythos Technology Philippines, Inc., Engr. Ernest Thomas Nieras, said in his presentation that it was important for them to commit as the BatStateU KIST Park's first locator. "We want Pythos to set an example for all semiconductor companies and start-ups in the Philippines. Right now, KIST is structured in such a way that it encourages companies to come in, create technology, and share technology," Engr. Nieras stated.

He also presented one of the company's latest product innovations. It is a special type of facemask with advanced filter and virus deactivation technology that is simulated by the engineer researchers of Batangas State University. CHED Commissioner Dr. Lilian De Las Llagas said, in her

closing message, the university is "trailblazing landscape" and its initiative serve as "a blueprint for other SUCs" in expanding their technoprene and inclusive innovation programs.

She ended by saying that, "As BatStateU continues to build intellectual capital in the new normal, it is important that the university continues to help build a better normal for the community and the region, and should continue to be a driving force in the production of innovative solutions to real problems."

It can be remembered that President Rodrigo Duterte signed Proclamation No. 9 May 22, 2020, designating the BatStateU KIST Park as a Special Economic Zone. Already open for 10 years, the KIST Park offers incentives for companies and start-ups, including tax holidays and other incentives.

Business locators can also benefit from knowledge generation, technology transfer, and commercialization initiatives of the university. BatStateU is a state university, the only SUC in the CALABARZON region accredited by the Accrediting Board of Engineering and Technology (ABET) Engineering, Information Technology, and Computer Science programs.

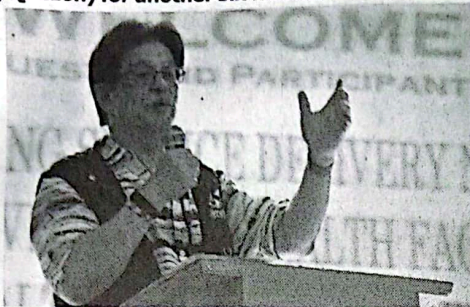
President Rodrigo Roa Duterte has approved the extension of government service of Dr. Eduardo C. Janairo beyond the compulsory retirement age, as Director IV of the Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) for another six months.

"I welcome the privilege to serve the government again. Tagpapasalamat ako sa ating Presidente, kay residente Duterte, sa ngay nang suporta at agitiwala sa aking akayahan upang patuloy sa maisulong ang iba't-ibang program na atin ng aumpisahan sa ALABARZON." Janairo stated.

"Marami pang dapat awin. Marami pang dapat isaayos at bilangang magtrabaho para isakatuparan lahat ng."

"Six months will pass quickly and we need to make impact programs that will have a solid effect to our people. Gaya sabi ng ating presidente, kailangan ang bisyo ng ating byerno ngay iraradaman, karanasan at walang iwanan. Lahat dapat kinabang, mayaman n o mahirap," he emphasized.

Dr. Janairo retired on November 20, 2020 leaving the DOH for 38 years.

He is the only health executive to serve in nine DOH Regional Offices as Director and the only one to receive an extension in service.

He has enforced the needed change on the current set-up of DOH in order for the government to improve health access to grass roots level and provide the necessary health care for the poor, the Indigenous People (IPs) and those in the Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA).

The Executive Order was received on December 15, 2020.

Janairo assured that the next months will be a busy schedule for the regional office, continuing health reforms, strengthening health programs at the community level, upgrading health facilities and preventing communicable and non-communicable diseases including the present pandemic.

"We will continue what we have started, we have to strengthen the foundation of CALABARZON prime making it a model region for everyone to emulate," he stressed.

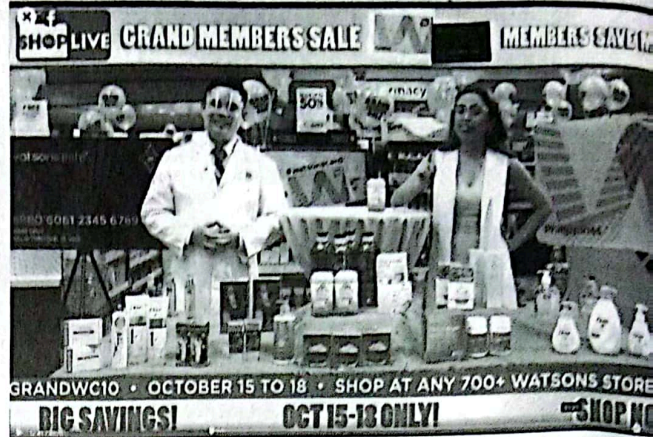

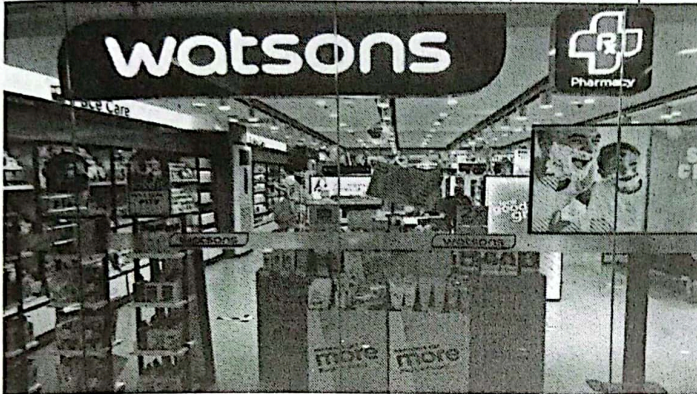

Mayor Antonio 'Ony' Ferrer along with Deputy Chief Implementer and 'Testing Czar' Secretary Vince Dizon led the inauguration and opening of the facility. GenTri Medical Center and Hospital President & CEO Dr. Jerrold Genuino, MD., Vice-Mayor Morit Sison, and members of the Sangguniang Panglungsod were present to witness the significant event.

Managed by the General Trias Medical Center and Hospital (GTMCH), the city's COVID-19 Molecular Laboratory is part of the LGU's counter measures against COVID-19 to mitigate the threat on the health and safety of Gentriseños and contain further spread of the disease.

The facility is equipped with the best technology in terms of equipment, the BD Max Machine and BIO-RAD CFX 96 RT-PCR,

which are expected to contribute much to the continuous facilitation of the Aggressive Community Testing in the city for a faster and efficient release of test results.

Since the ground breaking of the facility on September 14, 2020, the preparation of documents for the accreditation by the Department of Health (DOH) was fast tracked.

With the GTMCH medical team confident that the Molecular Laboratory was 100% ready and compliant with the standards set by the DOH and the RITM, the first visit and inspection was done November 6.

Further improvements had to be made for its final approval and accreditation paving the way to the formal launching and inauguration on December 12, 2020.

Meanwhile, according to the latest COVID-19

update reported to City Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (CESU), there were 6 recovered patients and 1 confirmed case as of December 17.

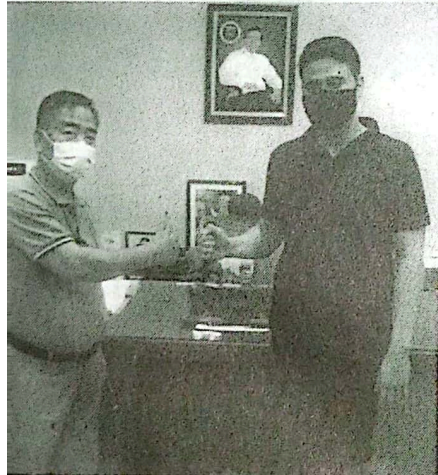

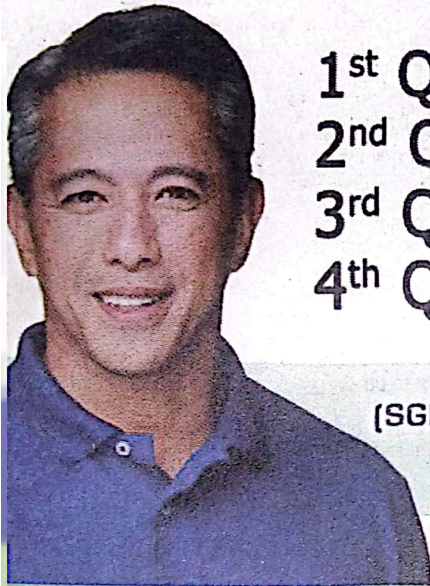

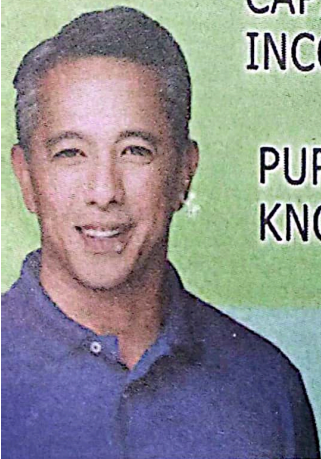
