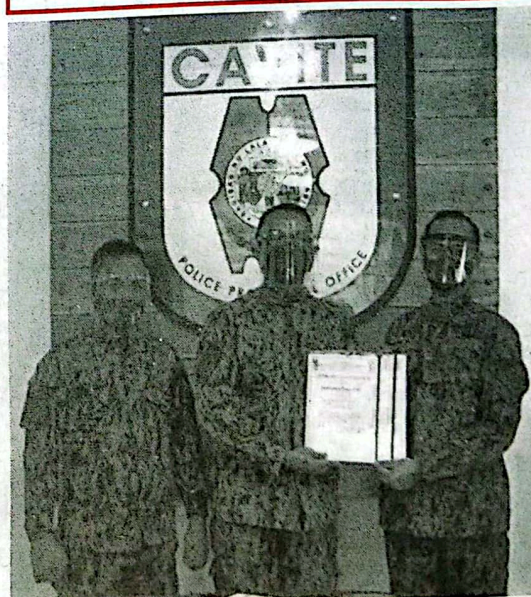
### DOH to launch nationwide MR OPV SIA in Gen. Trias

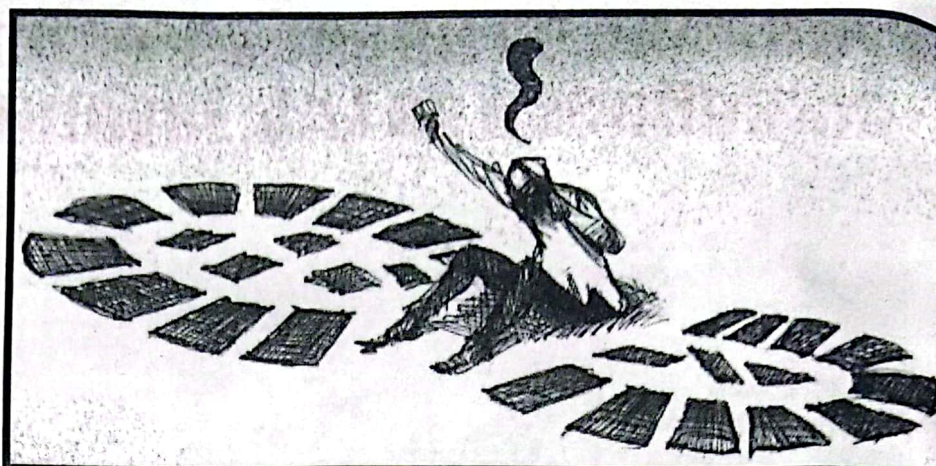

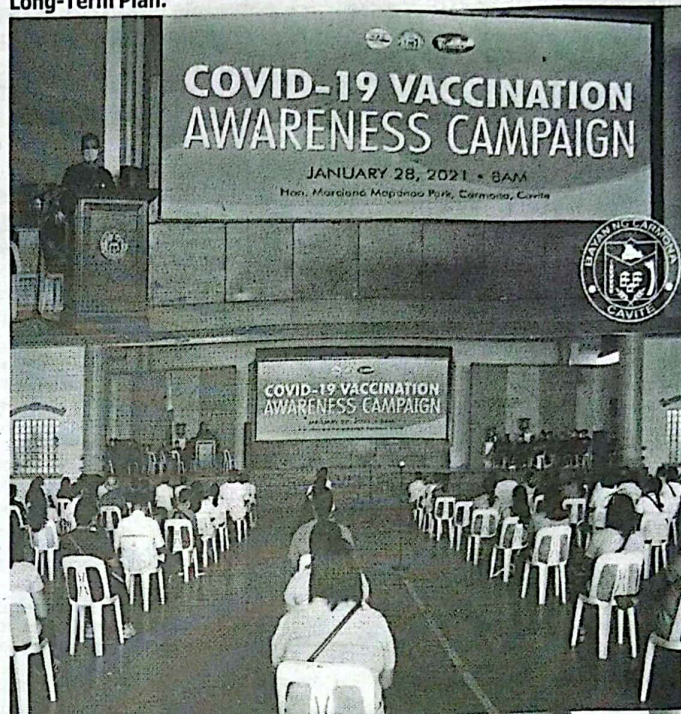

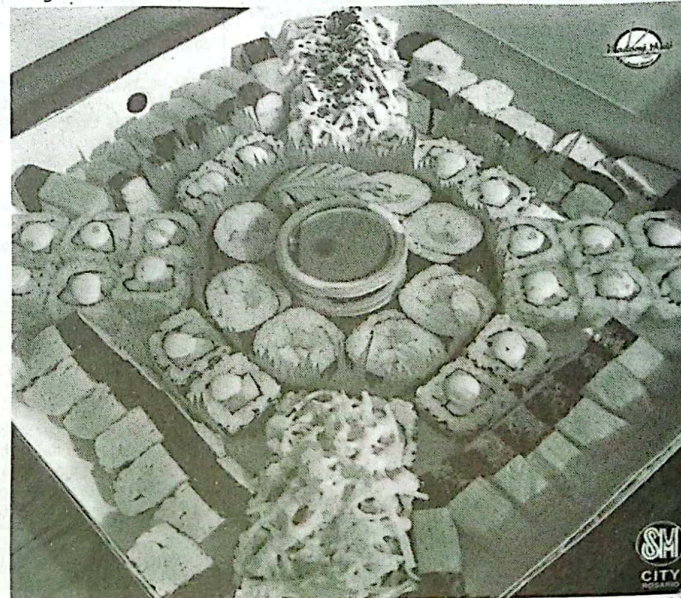
## Carmona's COVID-19 Awareness Campaign

The said location, which is the designated main COVID-19 vaccination site, is divided into six sections, namely: (1) waiting Area; (2) registration area; (3) pre-vaccination, counseling, and final consent area; (4) screening area; (5) vaccination area; and (6) post-vaccination monitoring area.

An Advocacy Center was also established at the C3, which is in-charge in the production and dissemination of information, education, and communication (IEC) materials that will promote the importance of COVID-19 vaccination to the community.

Aside from the Carmona Community Center, satellite locations will also be established in Barangay Bancal and

Lantic.

A COVID-19 Data Management Unit located at the Katsumi Onda area, Carmona Municipal Hall was also set up by the Municipal Information Technology Unit for the collating and safekeeping of COVID-19 vaccine recipients' information. Moreover, the Municipal Health Office had finished its preparation of the cold storage facility for COVID-19 vaccines, located within its premises.

The simulation activity was led by Municipal Mayor Roy Loyola, Congresswoman Dahlia Loyola, Vice Mayor Cesar Ines Jr., members of the Sangguniang Bayan, and the Municipal Health Office led by Dr. Homer Aguinaldo.

ORDER

The petitioner's Compliance and Manifestation, filed on October 14, 2020, anent the proof of service of copies of the petition to the Office of the Solicitor General, is hereby NOTED.

Petitioners-spouses Randy C. Dugay and Rhea Aguilar Dugay, filed this petition for the adoption of the minor child Maria Chrizela Cabrera Gonzales and with application to change the minor's name from Maria Chrizela Cabrera Gonzales to Maria Chrizela Gonzales Lopez.

Petitioner-spouses alleged, in their Petition, that:

1. Petitioners are Filipino spouses of legal age, and residents of 139 Gen. Bautista St., Imus City, Cavite. For purposes of this petition, they may be served with notices and other processes of this Honorable Court through the office of the undersigned counsel at BUENA AND REYES LAW OFFICES, Lower Ground Floor, Dionets Commercial Place, Trece-Indang Road, Trece Martires City, Cavite;

2. MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES is a minor, having been born on 23 June 2008, at Las Piñas Doctors Hospital, Las Piñas City, evidenced by her Certificate of Live Birth, attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as Annex "A";

3. Petitioner HAZEL ANN G. LOPEZ is the biological mother of minor MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES, having conceived said child out of wedlock years prior to meeting her husband, petitioner KEREN T. LOPEZ. The minor's biological father has abandoned petitioner HAZEL ANN G. LOPEZ after knowing of the child's conception;

4. Petitioner HAZEL ANN G. LOPEZ has raised the child by herself until her marriage with petitioner KEREN T. LOPEZ on 22 July 2017. Their marriage certificate is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as Annex "B";

5. Since their marriage, they have jointly supported MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES who is living with them, showering her with love and affection and proving for her financial, physical and spiritual needs. Subsequently, on 31 July 2018, petitioners were blessed with a child – Lucas Emmanuel Gonzales Lopez and MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES welcomed her half-brother with love and joy;

6. Petitioners desire to adopt MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES to give her the status of legitimacy and change her name to MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES LOPEZ so she could live her life in a happy and loving family without the social stigma of being an illegitimate child;

7. Petitioners are employees of Metropolitan Bank and Trust Company (METROBANK) and are financially capable of maintaining the support and care of said minor, should this petition for adoption be granted by this Honorable Court. Copies of their certificate of employment with disclosure of their annual salary are attached hereto and made integral parts hereto as Annexes "C" and "D";

8. The mother of petitioner HAZEL ANN G. LOPEZ also lives with them and takes care of her grandchildren when both parents are at work;

9. Petitioners have never been charged or convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude in the Philippines and are in a position to support the child in keeping with the means of the family. Copies of their Clearance from the Regional Trial Court, Municipal Trial Court in Cities, Office of the City Prosecutor, NBI

and PNP are attached hereto and made integral parts hereto respectively as Annexes "E", "F", "G", "H", "I", "J", "K", "L", "M", "N";

10. Petitioners have not suffered or are suffering from any disqualification provided for by law on the contrary, they possess all the qualifications for the adoption of the herein minor and have attended Pre-adoption Services in compliance with Article III Sec. 4 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 8552 (Domestic Adoption Act of 1993). The certification by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as Annex "O";

11. Petitioners are physically and psychologically fit to adopt the said child, evidenced by their psychological examinations and joint medical certificates which are attached hereto and made integral parts hereto as Annex "P", "Q", and "R";

12. Petitioners are also respectable members of the community shown by affidavits of disinterested persons and Clearance from their Barangay respectively attached hereto and made integral parts hereto as Annexes "S", "T", and "U";

13. The minor MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES is now a healthy eleven (11) years-old, has no known estate or property and is not disqualified by law to be adopted. A copy of her medical certificate and affidavit of consent to the adoption are attached hereto and made integral parts hereto as Annexes "V", and "W";

14. The adoption by the petitioners of the minor MARIA CHRIZELA CABRERA GONZALES will serve her best interest, well-being and security if she would be considered as true and legal child of herein petitioners and it will make her life normal and productive, thus becoming a respectable member of the community.

The petitioner-spouses pray that this Court grant their petition for the adoption of Maria Chrizela Cabrera Gonzales and for the change of the child's name to Maria Chrizela Gonzales Lopez.

WHEREFORE, finding the petition to be sufficient in form and substance, the Court hereby sets it for hearing on APRIL 15, 2021 at 8:30 a.m. Any interested party may appear and show the cause why the petition should not be granted.

Let this Order be published once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation, as may be chosen by raffle, pursuant to P.D. 1079.

Furnish a copy of this Order to the Office of the Solicitor General City Prosecutor's Office, Imus City, Cavite and to the City Social Welfare and Development Office, Imus City, Cavite.

The Court NOTES the submission of Ms. Glenda M. Obligacion RSW, Social Welfare Officer II, CSWD, Imus City, Cavite of the Comprehensive Child and Home Study Report, dated June 25, 2020

The CSWD, Imus City, Cavite is directed to conduct counseling sessions with the biological parent/s on the matter of adoption of the adoptee and submit her report before the date of hearing.

According to FNRI, the Enhanced Nutribun answers to the call of the Department of Social Welfare and Development's (DSWD) Memorandum Circular No. 12 Series of 2020, or the Guidelines in the Implementation of the Supplementary Feeding Program During Community Quarantine or Other Similar Emergencies. FNRI also shared that compared to the Nutribun of the 70s, the Enhanced one has more micronutrients like iron and vitamin A. Its texture is also softer and weighs 160- 165 grams per piece, which is easier for children to hold and bite. Each serving of Enhanced Nutribun weighing 160-165 grams per piece, has 504 calories, 17.8 grams protein, 6.08 milligrams iron and 244 micrograms vitamin A.

Both firms expressed their appreciation to FNRI and DOST CALABARZON for the opportunity given to them. To Ms. Marites Ramirez, General Manager of SIMCO, the adoption of Enhanced Nutribun would create a

good advantage for their cooperative particularly in serving as additional income source and in responding to the call for a healthier nation. "Isa pong napakalaking opportunity para sa SIMCO ang maging adaptor ng Enhanced Nutribun. Malaking bagay po ito para sa SIMCO sapagkat may panibagong produkto kami na mail-offer sa aming mga members at higit sa lahat ay makakatulong ito na madagdagan ang kita ng kooperatiba! 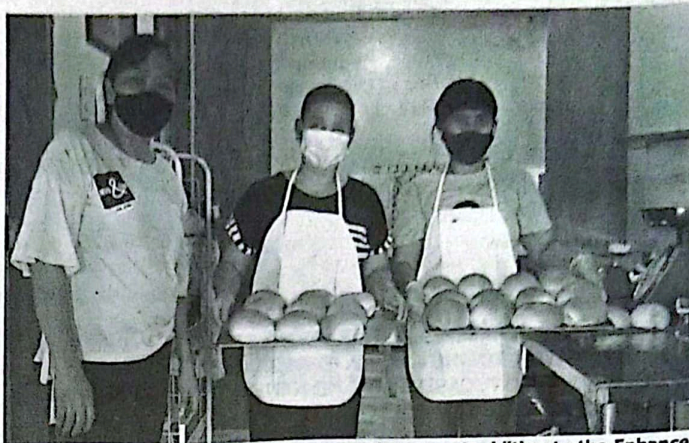
On the other hand, General Trias Mayor Antonio Ferrer would want to wait for amount of COVAX the national and provincial governments will provide to their city.

"We are still waiting on the national government and the provincial government to confirm how many COVAX they can provide for each locality, especially here in GenTri, before we can take action,"

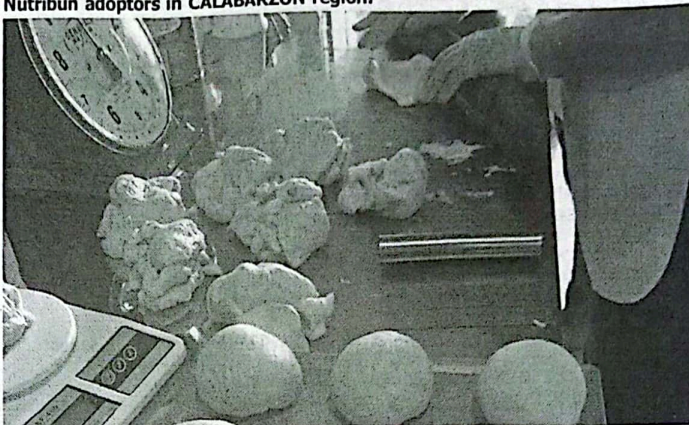



During its launching last July 2020, the product was introduced to have added micronutrients (such as iron and vitamin A), softer texture, and better taste compared to its original version.

During the Regional Launching of the Enhanced Nutribun last November 2020, the DOST-CALABARZON introduced Amira's as one of its assisted MSMEs belonging to the first batch of licensed Enhanced Nutribun adoptors in the region. Since 2011, the firm has been with the DOST-CALABARZON through its Small Enterprise Technology Upgrading Program (SETUP). Through these partnerships, the DOST-CALABARZON extends to

Amira's the opportunity to supply and deliver Enhanced Nutribun to public schools in Cavite, particularly in Tagaytay and Silang, Cavite, and nearby towns.

Simon highlighted the significance of the Ivatan Beer to the people of Batanes. "The fact that the Ivatan Beer is made from the locally-grown 'wakay' or sweet potato, which is abundant in Batanes, the product becomes even more interesting and appealing to the locals of Batanes," he told the Philippine News Agency.  
Lim, a former college instructor who had turned entrepreneur, said the Ivatan

Beer's commercialization will "immensely contribute to the flourishing Batanes' tourism industry."  
The Department of Science and Technology-Cagayan Valley through Regional Director Sandho Maborang has issued the Fairness Opinion Report (FOR) on the licensing agreement's terms and conditions.  
In September 2020, Tawson Agri Ventures and BSC

signed the term sheet of the licensor and the licensee to agree on the conditions to push through with the Ivatan Beer's commercialization.  
BSC received a P400,000 fund from the DOST to develop the beverage in 2018. The following year, the native beer made its public debut during the Science and Technology Caravan in Batanes.  
In the same year, the product won third place in the Regional Invention Contest and Exhibit.



# DOH TO VACCINATE 1.5 MILLION CHILDREN FROM MEASLES AND POLIO IN CALABARZON

The Department of Health (DOH) – CALABARZON (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) is targeting to vaccinate about 1,524,327 children in the region on the upcoming nationwide "Measles-Rubella and Oral Polio Vaccine Supplemental Immunization Activity (MR OPV SIA) Phase 2 Campaign from February 1-28, 2021.

The regional office will be targeting 290,588 children in the province of Batangas, 380,067 in Cavite province, 306,619 in Laguna, 236,913 in Quezon and 310,140 in Rizal.

"The regional office, our LGU partners and the vaccination teams are ready to do their tasks and reach the target children including those in far-flung communities located in the mountains," Regional Director Eduardo C. Janairo stated.

"Mas madali natin ng ayon ng mababakunahan ang mga bata dahil ito po ay ligtas at ito lang ang magbibigay ng

kanilang mga bahay at bawal silang lumabas dala ng kasalukuyang pandemya. Kaya't madali nating magagawa ang pagbabakuna laban sa polio at measles."

Janairo added that additional manpower will be deployed in every municipalities to ensure that all target children from 0-59 months old will receive their vaccine shots.

"Sa mga magulang ng mga batang babakunahan, huwag po kayong mangamba at matakot sa ibibigay naming bakuna sa inyong mga anak dahil ito po ay ligtas at ito lang ang magbibigay ng

proteksyon sa inyong mga anak laban sa tigdas at polio," Janairo emphasized.

The DOH has already conducted the MR OPV SIA Phase 1 last October 26, 2020 to November 25, 2020. Phase 2 of the campaign will be implemented in Regions 3, CALABARZON, NCR and in Visayas.

The one-month phase 2 vaccination campaign will also have a nationwide launching activity on January 29, 2021 at the City of General Trias, Cavite.

## DA allots P80-M for ASF test kit mass production

Lipa City, BATANGAS, Jan. 27 (PIA) - Losses in hog depopulation caused by the African Swine Fever (ASF) will soon be over once the ASF rapid test kits made by the Central Luzon State University (CLSU), in partnership with the Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Animal Industry (DA-BAI), finishes its development and distribution to commercial and backyard hog raisers.

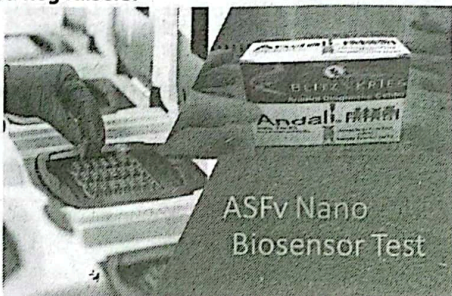
This positive outlook on the local hog raising industry has been shared by Agriculture Secretary William Dar during the inauguration of the 1st National Meat Inspection Service (NMIS)-accredited Triple A slaughterhouse held in this city last January 23.

In partnership with CLSU, the DA has allotted an P80 million fund for the mass production of 'ASFV Nanogold Biosensor' rapid test kits which can produce results within 10 to 15 minutes.

Designed to identify and differentiate ASF from hog cholera and other swine-related viruses, Dar said the test kits can be used for profiling farms for repopulation and surveillance in areas considered as the 'ground-zero' of this disease.

### PH agri grows amid pandemic

"Last year, despite a perfect storm which includes the eruption of Taal Volcano, the COVID-19 pandemic, the African Swine Fever, and the series of typhoons, the country managed to attain a 19.4MMT national yield. Pinakamataas sa history ng rice production sa bansa," Dar said during a visit at the International Training Center for Pig Husbandry (ITCPH) over the weekend.



Secretary Dar noted that the import level is starting to go down as local production continues to grow with interventions and assistance for seeds, fertilizer, and capacity building.

The DA chief added that the agriculture sector posted positive growth in 2020, thanks to efforts of farmers, fishers, and other stakeholders.

Unlike several industries which were forced to close shop during months-long nationwide lockdown, the Philippine agriculture thrived during the COVID-19 pandemic.

In fact Dar said rice production has reached 19.4-M metric tons of harvest yield, making it the 'saving grace' of the national economy.

For the next 12 months, Dar said the goal is for the industry to reach 85 percent rice sufficiency level.

### Aid to farmers

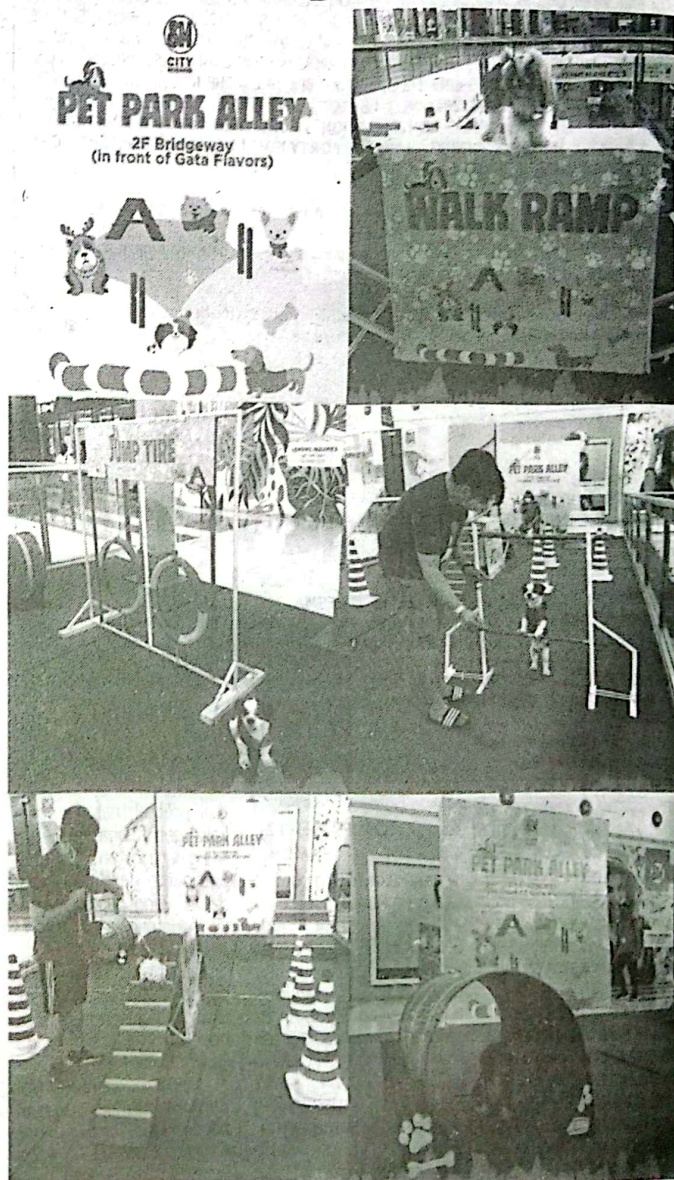
As the sector most

affected by the procession of typhoons and the COVID-19 pandemic, the DA continues to roll out projects aimed to empower farmers in ensuring food security and resiliency in the country.

Part of this initiative was the swift and effective implementation of the initiatives under the 'One DA' program, which follows 12 initiatives that aim to develop the national agriculture, including farmers, fisherfolk and agripreneurs.

Dar also led the distribution of P205-M worth of agricultural projects and intervention to farmer-beneficiaries in the province, which includes P75M in credit assistance from the DA-Agricultural Credit Policy Council as well as indemnity checks amounting to P1.08M for farmers who were affected by the Taal volcano eruption last year.

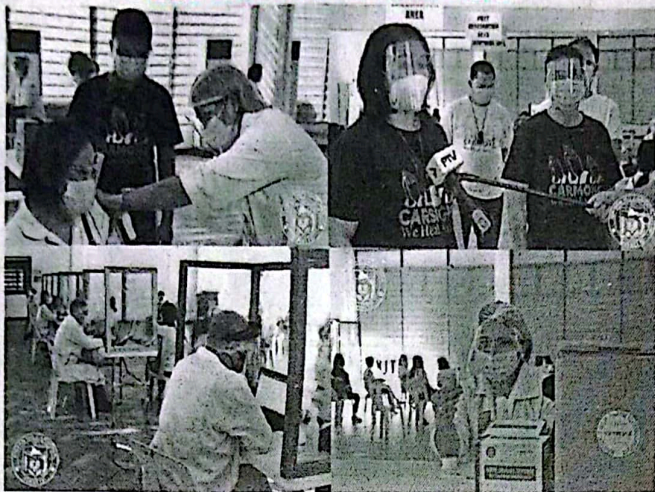

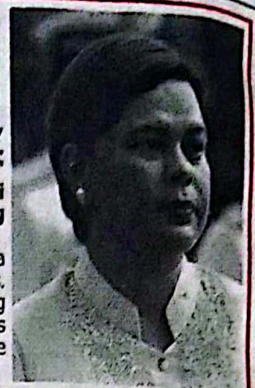
