

IKAW ba ay senior citizen – may edad na 60 anyos pataas – at nang humingi ka ng 20 percent discount, tumanggi ang establishment, kasi wala kang dalang identification card (ID) na inilisyu ng Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA)? May karapatan ka ba iigiit ang diskuwento at sa hindi pagpataw 12 percent value added tax (VAT) kahit wala kang OSCA ID?

Dapat talaga ay may ipakikitang ID ang isang senior dahil ayon sa batas. Inoobliga ang mga business establishment na magbigay ng tamang resibo na nakatala roon ang pangalan ng elder at ang halaga ng diskuwentong ibinigay.

Kung tumangging magbigay ng discount, ireklamo nyo sa OSCA ang establisimiyentong ayaw magbigay ng diskuwento kahit may ID kayo na patunay na kayo ay isang senior citizen, ayon sa batas. Mabigat ang parusa sa pagtangging magbigay ng diskuwento sa mga senior.

ALABANG-ZAPOTE ROAD WILL BE CLOSED FOR LIMITED HOURS STARTING FEBRUARY 1

THE SKYWAY O&M Corporation in a statement yesterday said that a ramp along the Zapote road will be close to motorists for limited hours starting February 1 to allow construction of the Skyway extension.

The company said vehicles would be allowed to pass from 5 a.m. to 9 a.m.

The Skyway project manager said that northbound motorists coming from the Alabang-Zapote Road are advised to take the Filinvest entry to the South Luzon Expressway as an alternative.

The temporary traffic scheme was agreed upon by Skyway, the Muntinlupa Traffic Management Bureau and Filinvest Alabang Inc.

Skyway said construction of the skyway was expected to be completed December 2019 but construction was suspended because of the expected high traffic volume during the holidays.

Personnel on the ground, at the time, were given the discretion to suspend construction work and reopen the lanes if traffic volume was extremely high.

Skyway had also announced the closure of the northbound lane of the West Service Road, the Alabang southbound exit and Bunye southbound exit toll

School kits were also given to children who are set to blend in schools near their evacuation camps.

Meanwhile, the College of Veterinary Medicine and Bio-Medical Sciences joined an inter-agency vet mission last January 18, together with the Cavite provincial vet, Cavite Veterinary Medical Association and other stakeholders. They gave free check-up and


medication to 64 horses and 100 dogs and cats in Tagaytay City and Magallanes.

Aside from faculty and students volunteering in evacuation centers, CvSU also opened the Administration Building of the Main Campus in Indang, Cavite as a free charging station last January 14. Around 90 residents affected by the

power interruption visited the station and charged an estimate of 260 items. Satellite campuses also launched various initiatives to help nearby evacuation centers.

As Alert Level 3 was announced, CvSU hopes to better serve its stakeholders and partners through possible livelihood programs for the remaining evacuees.




