USAID and RRDIC-I Unite to Propel Innovative Progress in Ilocos Region

The Regional Research, Development, and Innovation Committee – I (RRDIC-I), a committee of the Regional Development Council (RDC), signed a strategic Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with RTI International, implementing the U.S.-Philippines Partnership for Skills, Innovation, and Lifelong Learning (UPSKILL) Program.

The event, held at BakersPH in Laoag City, marks a significant step in advancing higher education and workforce development not only in the Ilocos Region but as part of a broader effort across the Philippines. With funding from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), UPSKILL collaborates with the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) to bridge the gap between technology innovation and commercialization, aligning these efforts with national development priorities.

Spearheaded by the Department of Science and Technology Region 1 (DOST-1), RRDIC-I is committed to ensuring that regional innovation projects contribute to socioeconomic growth, with the Ilocos Region positioned as a model for adopting new technologies.

USAID Philippines Deputy Mission Director Ms. Rebekah Eubanks noted that the MOU is a step in the right direction. "Regional development is

key to making an impact because it brings solutions rapidly to the communities that need them. Combining national policy with hands-on work in the field ensures that innovation takes place where it matters most." Eubanks reaffirmed the U.S. government's commitment to strengthening higher education in the Philippines.

Dr. Richard Abendan, Chief of Party for the UPSKILL Program, highlighted RRDIC-I's pivotal role in supporting micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) within Ilocos Norte as a template for national expansion. "The RRDIC, led by DOST-I, has already provided valuable support to MSMEs, like BakersPH, demonstrating the success of USAID's locally led development model," Abendan said. He emphasized that the partnership would unlock further collaboration between government agencies and higher education institutions (HEIs), to develop research productivity and



skilled graduates for economic development.

Dr. Teresita Tabaog, Regional Director of DOST-I and Chairperson of RRDIC-I, expressed gratitude and described the event as: "H-E-L-P—a help coming from a big brother." Tabaog also called for future initiatives to focus on cultivating skills while supporting the welfare of workers for inclusive and sustainable progress.

The MOU signing between RRDIC-I and the UPSKILL Program represents a critical milestone not only for the Ilocos Region but for the Philippines as a whole. This partnership among local governments, academic institutions, and

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27 Region X MSMEs to boost productivity thru DOST's MPEX program

The Department of Science and Technology—10 (DOST—10), through its S&T Consultancy services, assisted 27 micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in the five provinces of Northern Mindanao in boosting their business productivity.



The DOST Manufacturing Productivity Extension (MPEX) Program is designed to help businesses unlock their potential and achieve higher output levels. Through consultations and assessments, the program aims to identify areas for improvement, adopt modern technologies, and enhance management skills and knowledge.

DOST-hired external consultants are expected to help MSMEs in the manufacturing sector increase their efficiency and profitability by optimizing processes, upgrading equipment, and more.

The MPEX Program is DOST's initiative to strengthen STI support services for the production and manufacturing sectors, a strategy to foster wealth creation in Northern Mindanao.

MSMEs also receive

assistance in various aspects of compliance and certifications. This assistance includes helping with their FDA License to Operate (LTO) application, securing Certificates of Product Registration, designing plant layouts, and training on food safety practices such as basic food hygiene, good manufacturing practices, and even Halal certification. MSMEs can also receive assistance in crafting their packaging and labels.

Each consulting project will be completed within six months, covering both on-site and online consultations. The period includes site visits for technical needs assessments, implementation of recommendations, and remote follow-ups to monitor progress. At the end of each project, the consultants will submit a technical report documenting the assessment, analysis,

Processes, Mechanical Engineering, and Business Management.

These specialists will recommend productivity improvement measures tailored to each business, aiming for immediate implementation as firms work toward achieving their goals.

DOST implements MPEX annually. It supports the continuous development of MSMEs across the country. The upgraded firms will drive national economic growth while becoming globally competitive and sustainable.

PCC greenlights airport joint venture of Cavite province, SPIA consortium

The Philippine Competition Commission (PCC) cleared the joint venture of the Cavite provincial government and the Sangley Point International Airport (SPIA) consortium for the development of the new airport in Cavite.

On Monday, October 21, the PCC said the public-private partnership (PPP) to be implemented between the Cavite LGU and the consortium created by Luis Virata's Cavitex Holdings and the Yuchengco-led House of Investments will "unlikely result in a substantial lessening, restriction, or prevention of competition in the relevant market."

While House of Investments owns a majority stake in construction firm EEI Corporation, the competition watchdog said EEI's market power is not enough to block other companies from getting customers.

"The Commission found that competition between construction companies was robust due to the presence of numerous qualified contractors in the construction services market," the PCC said in its October 21 statement, pointing out "strong competitors" such as Megawide Construction Corporation and Makati Development Corporation.

"Should the parties themselves decide to limit competition, consumers will still have the ability to explore other options in the market due to the numerous available choices," it added.

The watchdog also said

having South Korean firm Samsung C&T Corporation on board as the project's main contractor ensures fair competition. Samsung C&T's former projects include the Burj Khalifa in

Dubai, the Petronas Towers in Malaysia, and the extension of Changi Airport.

Meanwhile, all the other companies in the SPIA do not have overlapping businesses.

The PCC's approval comes two years after the Cavite provincial government awarded the \$11-billion airport project — which is expected to decongest the Ninoy Aquino International

Airport — to the SPIA Development Consortium. The entities involved in the project will develop, own, operate, manage, and maintain the SPIA in Cavite. — **Rappler.com**

STARBOOKS, short for Science and Technology Academic and Research-Based Openly Operated Kiosk Station, is an innovative digital library offering students and teachers access to a vast collection of educational resources, including e-books, videos, and interactive modules.

Mr. Carl Reyes, the regional focal person for STARBOOKS, successfully installed 13 kiosks across three schools namely Santo Tomas National High School, Lanna National High School, and Santo Tomas Technological International School.

During the closing program, Mr. Reyes presented a detailed overview of STARBOOKS, highlighting its features and providing a step-by-step guide on how to access and navigate the kiosk. He also emphasized the importance of monitoring, managing customer

profiles, and generating monthly transmittal files to track engagement.

Furthermore, Assistant regional director for Technical Operations discussed plans to encourage schools to actively use the kiosk, which she described as a "digital library in a box." Notably, the materials for the K-12 curriculum are already integrated into these kiosks.

With the recent installation of 13 additional kiosks, DOST Region 02 now has a total of 96 deployed across the region this year.

As the program expands, it is expected to play important role in advancing educational outcomes and promoting widespread digital literacy. By enhancing digital access, DOST Region 02 is cultivating a culture of responsible learning among both educators and students.

continue until the end of the year.

Welcoming the news, Dr. Cristina Ignacio-Alberto, founder of Hope in Me Club, a grassroots civic organization working closely with the Bacoor Local Government Unit on various health initiatives, particularly those focused on seniors, expressed her excitement. She stated, "This brings hope to millions of seniors awaiting this life-saving vaccine. We thank the DOH for listening to our voices and prioritizing the protection of seniors during this high-risk period. We look forward to seeing the vaccines reach our communities soon."

Dr. Ignacio-Alberto highlighted the heightened risk for seniors, noting that studies show influenza-related mortality impacts 67.1% of adults over 60 due to weakened immune systems. "The annual flu shot remains the most effective way to safeguard seniors from severe complications and hospitalization," she added.

Bayan Bakuna Lead Convenor Roderick Alapar echoed these sentiments, emphasizing that timely vaccinations are especially vital for seniors in preventing health risks and ensuring

they can enjoy their golden years in good health.

In a shared commitment to seniors' health, Bacoor City Mayor Strike Revilla expressed the city's excitement to become part of the nationwide flu campaign, noting the crucial role of local governments in ensuring vaccines reach their target populations. "Ikinagagalak namin na ilunsad ang programang ito sa Bacoor. Matagal nang hinihintay ng ating mga seniors at may comorbidities na mabakunahan sila laban sa flu. Sinisiguro namin na agad nilang matatanggap ang mga bakuna kapag dumating ito sa ating LGU. Pangunahing prayoridad natin ang kanilang kalusugan," said Mayor Revilla.

In addition to the flu vaccines, Bacoor City is also committed to providing comprehensive health initiatives, including free pneumococcal vaccines for seniors. This effort is part of the local government's key initiatives to safeguard the health of its vulnerable population, especially during the rainy season when respiratory illnesses tend to surge.

Health advocates are encouraging seniors to stay informed by keeping

in close communication with their barangays and local health centers for timely updates on vaccine availability.

As the DOH finalizes procurement, advocates urge seniors to continue observing minimum public health standards such as frequent hand washing, wearing of face masks, and using alcohol-based hand sanitizer. They also hope that in future years, vaccine distribution will occur earlier in the season, providing timely protection for seniors.

About Hope in Me Club
Hope in Me Club is a grassroots civic organization aiming to serve the underprivileged sectors of the society particularly in Bacoor City, Cavite. One of their core initiatives is taking care of senior citizens' health and well being.

About Bayan Bakuna
Bayan Bakuna is a grassroots senior citizens' organization that aims to promote the welfare of the elderly through productive legislative collaborations. They recently developed a position paper advocating for the implementation of RA 9994, also known as the Expanded Senior Citizens Act. This initiative includes advocating for free influenza and pneumococcal vaccines for indigent senior citizens.

Health Advocates Laud DOH for Near Rollout of Free Flu Vaccines for Seniors

Health advocates laud the Department of Health (DOH) and the leadership of Secretary Teodoro Herbosa as the health agency is already finalizing the procurement for the rollout of free annual flu vaccines. With influenza-like illnesses (ILIs) on the rise during the rainy season, these flu shots are crucial in protecting seniors, who are particularly vulnerable to respiratory diseases

Xavier University inaugurates DOST-funded waste-to-energy research laboratory

CAGAYAN DE ORO, PHILIPPINES—The science community witnessed a momentous event on September 25, 2024, when the Green Biohydrogen to Energy (Green BioH2E) Research and Development Laboratory was inaugurated at the College of Engineering, Xavier University—Ateneo de Cagayan.

The Department of Science and Technology's Philippine Council for Industry, Energy, and Emerging Technology Research and Development (DOST-PCIEERD) funded the state-of-the-art laboratory under the Institutional Development Program.

The facility aims to develop advanced clean technologies that convert municipal and industrial waste into renewable energy, providing waste-to-energy solutions for local governments and industries in Northern Mindanao. The laboratory seeks to drive the shift toward a circular economy by showcasing hydrogen-to-energy technologies that generate power and heat from waste.

The inauguration event, ARHIKA, started with a program at the Little Theater. Participants were enlightened about the Green BioH2E project led by Dr. Shierlyn S. Paclijan, alongside other waste-to-energy initiatives delivered by Engr. Edwin Richard R. Ortiz and Dr. Noel Peter B. Tan. The university President, Fr. Mars Tan, SJ, led the inauguration, which was joined by Dr. Hercules Cascon, Dean of the College of Engineering, at the press conference.
