Kiko, Bam bag endorsements of mayors from Cavite, Laguna

Several mayors of vote-rich provinces Cavite and Laguna have endorsed the 2025 Senate comeback bid of former senators Francis "Kiko" Pangilinan and Paolo Benigno "Bam" Aquino IV, with two weeks to go before the May 12 elections.



Pangilinan secured the endorsement of 15 Laguna mayors during his meeting with the League of Municipalities of Laguna held at the Pila Municipal Hall on Tuesday, April 29. The backing of two other mayors were received by Pangilinan during separate courtesy visits.

"We are very grateful for the support we got in

Laguna. This is a huge help, especially that there are a few days to go before the elections," he said.

"They can be sure that we will work on strengthening the agricultural sector of Laguna," he added.

Aquino received the endorsement of three Cavite mayors on Wednesday, April 30.

"I am thankful for the endorsement, and I vow to work on increasing the budget for Free College Education Law so more students can benefit from it, including Cavite residents, en route to them having enough job opportunities," Aquino said.

Veterans journalist, former Kalibo Mayor Juan Dayang Killed

KALIBO, Aklan – Juan P. Dayang, 89, chairman emeritus of the Publishers Association of the Philippines Inc. (PAPI) and a prominent figure in Philippine journalism, was shot dead in his home at Casa Dayang in Villa Salvacion here at around 8 p.m. Tuesday, April 29, 2025.

Dayang, a highly respected figure in the media industry, was reportedly watching television when an unidentified gunman, wearing a bonnet, fired three shots from outside his residence.

He sustained a fatal neck wound and two gunshot wounds at the back. He was declared dead on arrival at the Dr. Rafael S. Tumbocon Memorial Hospital at 8:33 pm.

Dayang's long and distinguished career spanned decades. He served as president of PAPI for over 20 years, leaving an indelible mark on the organization and the Philippine publishing landscape.

His contributions extended beyond PAPI; he was also president of the Manila Overseas Press Club, a former director of the National Press Club, and the founding president of the Federation of

Cavite Day Celebrates World Malaria Day 2025

In line with the global observance of World Malaria Day, the Office of the Provincial Health Officer (OPHO) spearheaded a province-wide celebration held on April 28, 2025, at the Cavite Collaboration Center for Public Health in Trece Martires City. The event gathered medical practitioners from various public and private hospitals, as well as Rural Health Units (RHUs) across the province, to reinforce the importance of malaria prevention and control.

The program officially commenced with a warm welcome from Dr. Nelson Soriano, Provincial Health Officer I, who expressed his gratitude for the active participation of health care professionals in the fight

against vector-borne diseases. He emphasized the significance of collaborative efforts in sustaining a malaria-free Cavite.

The lecture proper opened with a presentation from Mr. Jommel Mojica, Nurse V –



Department of Health who delivered the latest updates on vector-borne diseases, including surveillance and control strategies. This was followed by an insightful

discussion from Mr. Raffy MacDonald, Nurse II - OPHO on the 1-3-5 Strategy—an effective approach for timely reporting and response to malaria cases within one,

three, and five days, respectively.

The event concluded with closing message from Dr. Armand Dotollo, who commended the dedication of the healthcare

community and encouraged continuous vigilance and community engagement in the prevention of malaria. (OPIO)

DOST Batangas launches Project SULOY; to transfer biofertilizer technologies to Batangueno Farmers

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Batangas conducted an orientation on innovative farming technologies and farming practices integration to introduce biofertilizer technologies to farmers and agriculture officers in Batangas as part of Project SULOY: Support Project for the Utilization of Locally-Developed Technology for Optimal Farming Yields through Technology Transfer via Zoom meeting platform, recently.

Project SULOY was conducted in collaboration with the National Institute of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology (UPLB-BIOTECH) in an aim to educate farmers and agriculture officers about the benefits of their developed biofertilizers and promote their adoption for improved agricultural productivity. Thirty-four participants attended the session, including farmers and municipal and city agriculture officers from selected municipalities and cities in Batangas.

Ms. Vita Anarna, University Researcher from UPLB-BIOTECH, led the session and discussed the application of biofertilizers such as Biogroe, Fertigroe, Hormogroe, Hi-Yeast, Micromix Biostimulant, Mykoplus, Nutrio, and Trichoderma, which are designed to improve soil health and enhance crop production. She also

introduced ACTIcon Biopesticide and Fruitect, two additional products for pest management and postharvest handling. Additionally, she explained how these biofertilizers can be integrated into local farming practices to increase yields and promote sustainability in agriculture.

Mr. John Maico M. Hernandez, Senior Science Research Specialist of DOST-Batangas, in his message, emphasized the importance of transferring these biofertilizer technologies to farmers to address local agricultural challenges and improve yields. Moreover, he highlighted that this initiative is part of DOST's broader effort to promote sustainable agricultural practices, enhance food security, and support the development of innovative solutions that can empower local farmers.

PHILHEALTH COVERS OUTPATIENT CARE FOR MALARIA

In 2023, the DOH Research Institute for Tropical Medicine (RITM) recorded a 90% increase in malaria cases from the previous year's 3,245 to 6,248. In 2024 however, 72 out of 82 provinces in the Philippines have been declared malaria free. These developments underscore the necessity of recommitting to our efforts towards controlling and eliminating malaria.

With this year's theme for World Malaria Day, "Malaria Ends With Us: Reinvest, Reimagine, Reignite", the World Health Organization (WHO) calls for a renewal of the global commitment to end malaria and urges collective efforts from the international policy level to community and individual action. In line with this, PhilHealth reaffirms the national commitment to eliminate malaria by 2030 through its benefits packages that cover services related to malaria.

Earlier this year, PhilHealth increased its coverage for the following outpatient malaria services from Php 780 to Php 1,170:

- * Diagnostic Malaria

Smears

- * Rapid Diagnostic Test Medicines (Artemether + Lumefantrine)

- * Consultation, Patient Education, and Counseling

Members can avail these benefits at 1,816 accredited facilities including primary care facilities, outpatient malaria centers, and accredited level 1, 2, and 3 hospitals. Additionally, coverage for malaria without complications is also provided at Php 5,460 at primary care facilities and Php 7,800 at hospitals.

million voters based on Commission on Elections records.

Workers welfare

Meanwhile, several independent senatorial candidates made the rounds in the provinces as they continued their Elksyon 2025 campaign.

Ariel Querubin urged factory workers and residents of South Cotabato to vote for leaders who will address the concerns of the people.

"Mamili ng iboboto at susuportahan na kandidato na nagpakita talaga ng pagmamahal sa bayan natin at malasakit sa taumbayan. Yung totoo talaga," Querubin said during his campaign on Tuesday.

"Iyong iba, ang dali nilang sabihin, magpapakamatay ako [para] sa inyo. Ang dami. Akala nila sine, ang dali nilang sabihin. Easier said than done," he added.

(Vote for someone who genuinely loves the country and has a concern

for the people. Some political candidates say they will die for the country. Easier said than done.)

He said Mindanao's growing economy must have sustainable job opportunities, especially for laborers and the working-class sectors.

Ben Tulfo went to Masbate for his campaign. During his visit, Tulfo and Masbate Governor Antonio Kho observed a lagoon in the area, which has been a tourism hub.

"Nandito kami para humingi ng anything na advises at saka yung pakikinig, pakikipag-usap, at pakikipag-interaksyon doon sa mga Masbateño," Tulfo said.

(We're here to get some advice and to listen, talk to, and interact with the locals.)

Meanwhile, Willie Revillame held a motorcade for his campaign in Gapan, Nueva Ecija.

In a statement, TRABAHO party-list vowed

to address the challenges affecting the workers' health brought by climate change.

T R A B A H O spokesperson Atty. Mitchell-David L. Espiritu noted the absence of strong national regulations adapting to the unprecedented rise in the country's heat index levels.

The group said it would push for the improvement of medical benefits and health insurance coverage for workers. This includes access to preventive care, regular health screenings, and comprehensive health insurance plans that cover heat-related illnesses.

"Non-wage benefits and protections are essential to mitigate the financial burdens of medical expenses and to ensure timely medical attention for affected workers," said Espiritu.

Provincial Press Clubs of the Philippines. At the time of his death, Dayang held the position of Secretary of the Catholic Mass Media Awards.

His commitment to public service led him to serve as mayor of his Kalibo hometown, the provincial capital of Aklan, during the administration of the late President Corazon Aquino.

Dayang's caretaker, Marjorie Yap, said that around 9 a.m. on Tuesday, two unidentified men wearing bonnets were seen on a motorcycle near Dayang's residence, seemingly observing the house, suggesting that the attack was premeditated.

Police are currently investigating the incident and reviewing CCTV footages from the area to identify the suspects, who fled the scene on a motorcycle. The motive behind the murder remains unclear currently, and authorities are pursuing all possible leads.

The death of Dayang represents a significant

loss to the Philippine media and political landscape. His legacy of leadership, dedication to journalism, and public service will be remembered for generations to come. The nation mourns the passing of this remarkable individual.

In a subsequent telephone interview, PAPI President Nelson S. Santos declared: "We strongly condemn this killing, and we are calling for justice. HINDI niya deserved ang cruel and senseless end."

Santos said PAPI earnestly urges the Presidential Task Force on Media Security (PTFOMS) and its partner authorities to promptly investigate the Dayang case, identify the killers and the brains behind the murder, and bring them to justice

"We join the entire media community in demanding justice for our Chairman Emeritus and his family. We also extend our deepest condolences to his family and loved ones," Santos stressed.

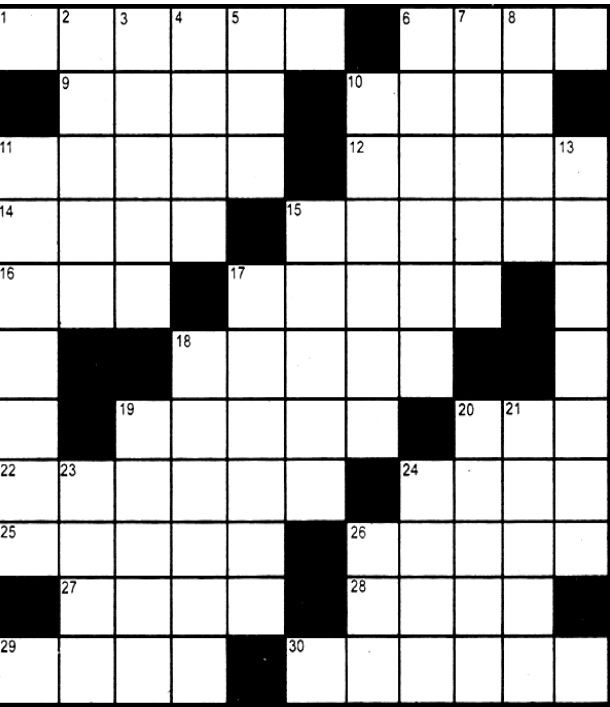


