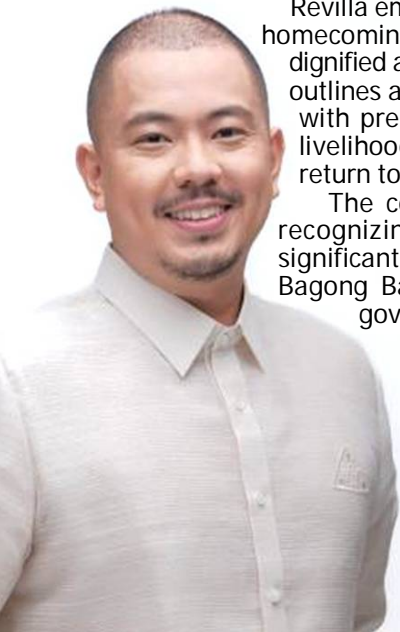

Cong. Bryan Revilla Pushes Bagong Balikbayan Act for OFWs

Imus City, Cavite – Congressman Bryan Revilla, together with the **AGIMAT** Party-list, proudly announced the successful passage of **House Bill 6643**, also known as the **Bagong Balikbayan Act**, on its third and final reading in the House of Representatives. The measure is designed to provide a comprehensive reintegration program for **Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs)** returning home.



Revilla emphasized that the bill seeks to ensure that the homecoming of OFWs will no longer be a burden but a dignified and well-supported transition. The proposed law outlines a complete reintegration framework, beginning with pre-departure preparations abroad, followed by livelihood and employment opportunities upon their return to the Philippines.

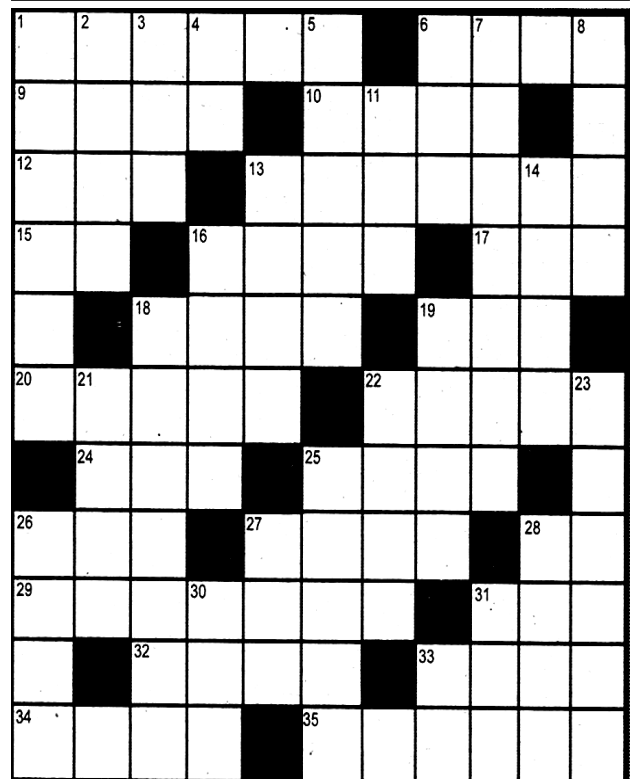
