ORDER

Before this Court is a verified petition for renewal of accreditation filed by Cavite Times Journal represented by its publisher Francia A. Orlain, praying for the renewal of its accreditation to publish all legal notices in this Court.

During the initial hearing on 04 April 2022, Atty. Andres Jose M. Alba appeared as counsel for the petitioner and marked Exhibits "A" to "V" inclusive of its sub-markings to prove compliance with the jurisdictional requirements and to support the allegations in the petition.

After going over the petition and the documentary evidence presented, the following facts were established, to wit:

Cavite Times Journal is a weekly newspaper with editorial and office address at Block 4, Lot 15, Sunnydale, The Garden Village, Bucandala 5, Imus, City, Cavite. The frequency of its publication is weekly and its issue is circulated every Tuesday. It officially started its circulation on 04-10 March 2004 and since then the said newspaper has been regularly published for a period of seventeen (17) years with fifty-two (52) issues last year (Annex A). The said newspaper was duly registered with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) Region IV-A (Calabarzon) (Annex D) and registered with Bureau of Internal Revenue with TIN No. 105-765-358-000 (Annex E). It has obtained and was granted Mayor's Permit and Business License with Business Permit Plate 2627 (Annex G), Baragay Clerance Endorsement (Annex H), Authority to Print (BIR 1921) (Annex I), and Burueau of Fire Protection FSIC No. R 138644 2021 and Sanitary Permit (Annex J).

It has been granted accreditation by the following Regional Trial Courts in the Province of Cavite: RTC Branch 22, City of Imus; RTC Tagaytay City; RTC Branch 90, Dasmariñas City; RTC Branch 23, Trece Martires City; RTC Branch 109, Carmona Cavite; RTC Branch 88, Cavite City; RTC Branch 89, Bacoor City, and RTC Branch 15, Naic.

Hence, the pieces of evidence presented show that petitioner Cavite Times Journal has all the qualifications and none of the disqualifications as set forth under A.M. No. 01-1-107*SC (guidelines in the Accreditation of Newspapers and Periodicals Seeking to Publish Judicial and Legal Notices and Other Announcements and in the Raffle Thereof).

In view of the foregoing, the instant petition is hereby GRANTED. The Cavite Times Journal is hereby allowed to participate in the raffle of judicial, legal notices and orders issued by all the courts within the jurisdiction of the Regional Trial Court of Naic, Cavite and to publish the said judicial and legal notices and orders within the Province of Cavite. The accreditation shall be valid within five (5) years from the date of approval unless suspended or revoked in accordance with the guidelines.

Petitioner is ordered to submit to the Office of the Executive Judge a copy of its newspaper before the date of each and every raffle participated in by it. The same is further ordered to faithfully comply with the following prescribed format by the Supreme Court appearing in its Circular No. 5-2002- dated January 11, 2002, to wit:

Let Cavite Times Journal be included in the list of accredited newspaper, which shall be posted in three conspicuous places of Regional Trial Court Naic, Cavite, Government Center Building, Trece Martires City, Cavite, and in the respective bulletin boards of Municipal Circuit Trial Court Maragondon-Ternate-Magallanes sitting in Maragondon, Cavite, Indang-Mendez Nuñez, Indang, Cavite, and Municipal Trial Court Naic, Cavite.
