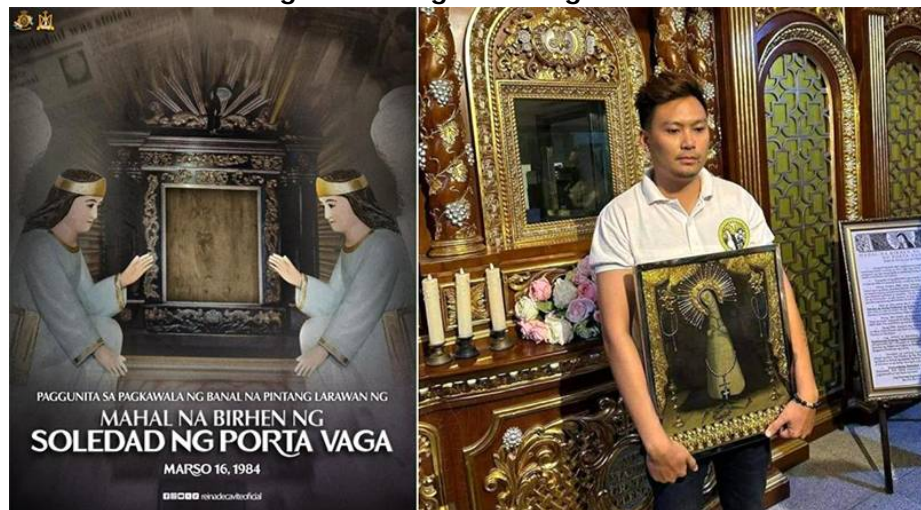

CAVITE CITY— Muling ginugunita ng mga deboto ngayong araw ang isang pangyayaring nagmarka ng malalim na sugat sa kasaysayan ng debosyon sa Mahal na Birhen ng Soledad ng Porta Vaga.



Apatnapu't dalawang taon na ang lumipas mula nang ang pinagpipitagang banal na larawan ay lapastangang mawala mula sa kanyang dambana noong Marso 16, 1984—isang pangyayaring nagdulot ng matinding dalamhati sa mga mananampalataya.

Ang Birhen ng Soledad ay matagal nang kinikilalang mahalagang simbolo ng pananampalataya at pagkakakilanlan ng mga deboto. Sa loob ng maraming taon, ang kanyang banal na larawan ay nagsilbing tahimik na saksi sa mga panalangin, pag-asa, at paghiling ng tulong ng mga mananampalataya.

Kaya naman nang matuklasang wala na ito sa kanyang kinalalagyan, agad na nabalot ng lungkot at pagkabigla ang buong pamayanan. Ayon sa mga tala, nadiskubre ang pagkawala ng banal na larawan sa loob ng simbahan, na nagdulot ng matinding pangamba sa mga deboto.

Ang balita ay mabilis na kumalat sa buong komunidad, at maraming mananampalataya ang nag-alay ng panalangin at naghangad na sana ay matagpuan muli ang mahal nilang Birhen. Sa mga sumunod na buwan, nagsagawa ng masusing paghahanap sa nawawalang larawan.

Ang mga deboto at tagapaglingkod ng simbahan ay hindi nawalan ng pag-asa, patuloy na umaasa na sa kabila ng pangyayaring ito ay muling makikita ang banal na imahe na matagal nang naging bahagi ng kanilang espiritwal na buhay.

Dumating ang inaasam na sandali noong Agosto 15, 1984, nang matagpuan ang larawan sa tulong ni G. Antonio Nazareno. Bagamat nagdulot ng malaking kagalakan ang pagkakatagpo sa mahalagang imahe, natuklasan ding wala na ang mga gintong palamuti at mamahaling hiyas na dati nitong taglay.

Sa kabila ng pagkawala ng mga palamuting ito, higit na mahalaga para sa mga deboto ang pagbabalik ng mismong larawan ng Birhen. Ang pisikal na anyo ng banal na imahe ay nanatiling buhay na simbolo ng pananampalataya, higit pa sa anumang materyal na kayamanan na nawala.

Noong Agosto 19, 1984, muling ibinalik ang banal na larawan sa simbahan ng San Roque. Ang araw na iyon ay naging isang makasaysayang sandali para sa komunidad.

Umalingawngaw ang mga batingaw ng simbahan bilang tanda ng tagumpay at kagalakan. Maraming deboto ang napaluha—hindi na sa dalamhati kundi sa labis na pasasalamat at tuwa sa pagbabalik ng kanilang minamahal na Birhen.

Ang dating katahimikan na bumalot sa simbahan noong panahon ng pagkawala ay napalitan ng sigla at pagdiriwang. Ang mga deboto ay nag-alay ng panalangin at papuri sa Diyos, nagpapasalamat sa muling pagkakatagpo sa kanilang tagapamagitan.

Hindi naglaon, muling pinaghandaan ang maringal na paglalagak sa banal na larawan. Matapos ang panahon ng paghahanda at pagpapanumbalik ng karangalan nito, noong Setyembre 15, 1985 ay muling nailuklok ang pinagpipitagang imahe sa kanyang altar.

Ang bagong paglalagak na ito ay sumagisag hindi lamang sa pagbabalik ng larawan kundi sa muling pagbangon ng debosyon at pananampalataya ng mga mananampalataya. Ngayon, makalipas ang apatnapu't dalawang taon, patuloy na sariwa sa alaala ng mga deboto ang pangyayaring ito.

speed, battery-electric vehicle is designed to navigate the historic streets of the Walled City, blending modern innovation with cultural preservation.

Developed through a collaboration among DOST-National Capital Region (NCR), the DOST-Industrial Technology Development Institute (ITDI), the University of the Philippines Diliman (UPD), and Cagayan State University (CSU), the e-tranvia highlights Filipino ingenuity in sustainable mobility solutions.

Intramuros Administrator Atty. Joan M. Padilla emphasized the importance of partnerships between government and academe in delivering people-centered innovations.

"This collaboration reflects the strength of partnerships between the government and the

academe in delivering practical and people-centered solutions," Padilla said, expressing hope that the project would inspire further efforts toward greener mobility and smarter tourism systems.

Designed to echo the tranvias that once operated in Intramuros in the late 19th century, the vehicle complements the historic atmosphere of the area while offering an environmentally friendly alternative to traditional diesel-powered transport.

CSU led the conceptualization and structural development of the e-tranvia, including the vehicle frame, suspension system, and body paneling. The body and roofing panels utilize abaca fiber composite material, an innovation developed by DOST-ITDI.

Meanwhile, UPD handled the electrical and electronic systems,

equipping the vehicle with a lithium-ion battery, electric motor, controller, and charging infrastructure—effectively eliminating reliance on fossil fuels.

Science and Technology Secretary Renato U. Solidum Jr. underscored the role of such innovations in addressing rising fuel costs and supply concerns, while promoting accessible electric mobility across the country.

He also highlighted the importance of strengthening research and development in e-mobility, expanding charging infrastructure, and sustaining partnerships with higher education institutions.

At present, Intramuros has deployed one e-tranvia unit, with three additional units expected to arrive soon. Additional units are also planned for deployment in South Cotabato, Cagayan province, and

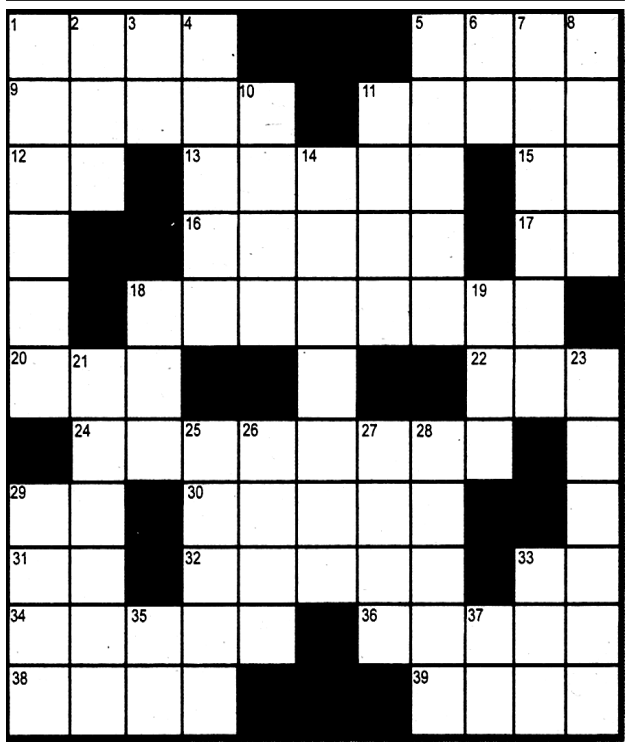
Malacañang Palace, according to CSU President Dr. Arthur G. Ibañez.

The initial material cost of each unit is estimated at ₱2.5 million. DOST-NCR Regional Director Engr. Romelen T. Tresvalles said efforts are underway to secure private sector partnerships to support large-scale production.

"By reimagining a symbol of our history through Philippine engineering and sustainable technology, we are breathing new life into the walled city," Tresvalles said.

The e-tranvia is currently available to the public free of charge through a rolling tour within Intramuros. The route includes key heritage sites such as Fort Santiago, Museo de Intramuros, Baluarte de San Diego, Foro de Intramuros, Centro de Turismo, nearby schools, and the Pasig Esplanade. **(Nelson Santos)**

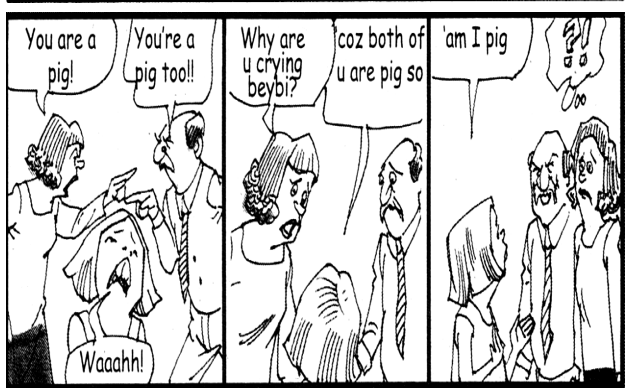
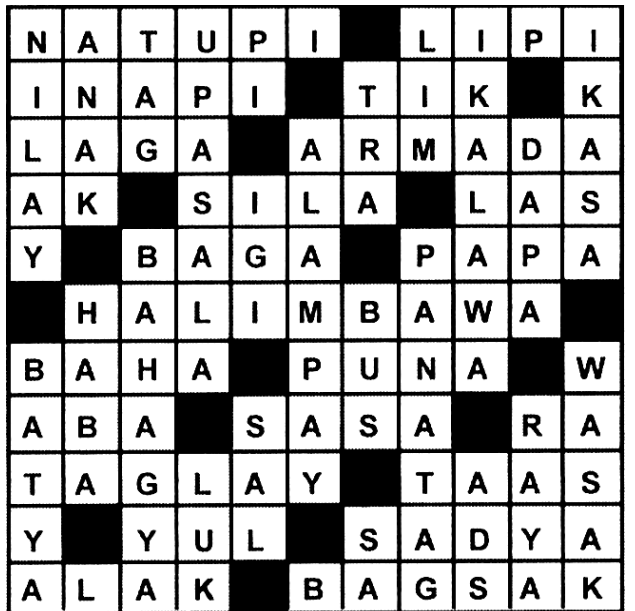
