## Mayor Randy Salamat Commends Success of Alfonso Road to Trail Challenge 2026

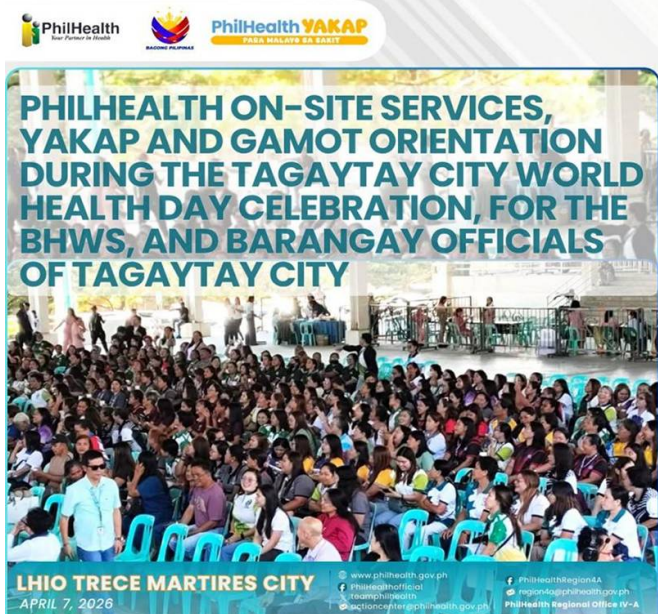

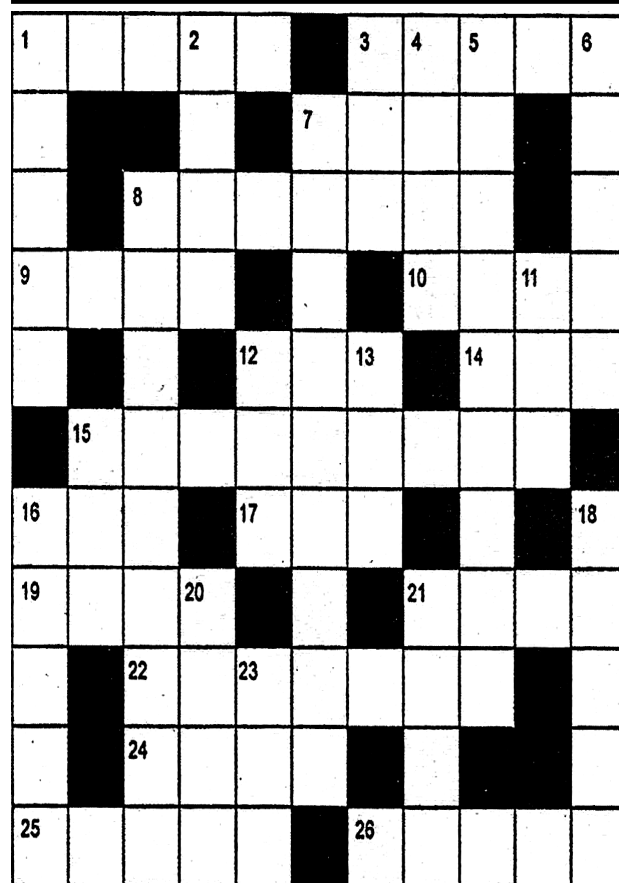

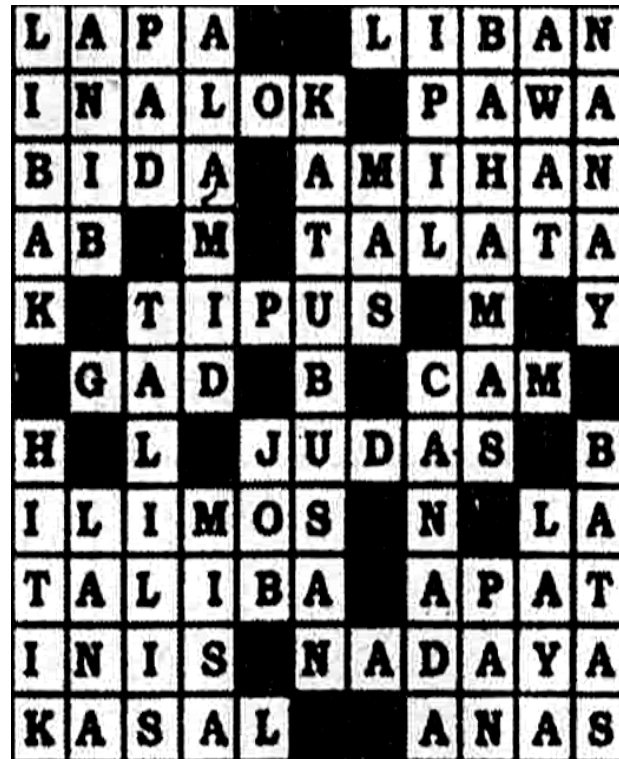
