BEYOND TRAVEL, ANG LEGACY NG ISANG CAVITEÑO

Sa panahon ngayon kung saan ang paglalakbay ay hindi na lang simple ng libangan kundi isang paraan ng pagtuklas sa sarili, may isang Pilipinong tunay na namukod-tangi, si Glen Gonzales, 34 taong gulang mula sa Brgy. 54, San Roque, Cavite.

Bunso sa apat na anak ng may-ari ng junk shop na sina Teresa at Bong Gonzales. Sa loob lamang ng pitong buwan, nagawa niyang marating ang hindi bababa sa isang destinasyon sa bawat isa sa 82 lalawigan ng Pilipinas—isang pambihirang tagumpay na naglagay sa kanya sa hanay ng pinakamabilis na manlalakbay sa bansa.

Ngunit ang kanyang paglalakbay ay hindi nasusukat sa bilis lamang. Bawat lalawigan na kanyang pinuntahan ay naging pagkakataon upang mas makilala ang kultura, kasaysayan, at mga kwento ng mga Pilipino.

Mula sa malamig na kabundukan ng Hilagang Luzon hanggang sa mga liblib na isla ng Mindanao, dala niya ang iisang layunin: tuklasin at ipagdiwang ang ganda ng sariling bayan.

Ayon sa kanya, higit pa ito sa personal na ambisyon. Isa itong mensahe na kayang mangarap ng Pilipino, at higit sa lahat, kayang abutin ang mga pangarap na iyon. Hindi rin doon nagtapos ang kanyang mga tagumpay.

Noong 2026, natupad niya ang isa pang pangarap, ang marating ang New 7 Wonders of the World. Sa pag-abot sa mga iconic na lugar na ito, pinatunayan niyang walang hangganan ang kayang narating ng determinasyon at sipag ng isang Pilipino. 82 PROBINSYA, ISANG MISION - ANG PAGLALAKBAY NG BUHAY.

Nagsimula ang lahat sa murang edad na 19, hindi bilang isang bihasang traveler, kundi bilang isang kabataang puno ng pangarap. Habang working student sa Australia, pinagsabay niya ang trabaho at pag-aaral, hinubog ang disiplina na magiging pundasyon ng kanyang hinaharap.

Dinala siya ng kanyang karera sa iba't ibang panig ng mundo mula Estados Unidos hanggang Caribbean kung saan natutunan niyang sulitin ang bawat pagkakataon. Sa halip na magpahinga sa kanyang mga bakasyon, pinili niyang maglakbay. Kapalit nito ang walang kapagurang pagtatrabaho sa mga panahong abala ang industriya.

Ngunit hindi naging tuwid ang kanyang landas. Dumaan siya sa isang madilim na yugto ng kanyang buhay, isang laban sa depresyon na nagtulak sa kanya upang huminto at muling mag-isip. Sa panahong iyon, napagtanto niya ang isang mahalagang katotohanan: ang paglalakbay ang nagbibigay sa kanya ng tunay na saya at kahulugan. MULA NOON, NAGSIMULA SIYANG MULI Ginamit niya ang paglalakbay bilang paraan ng paghilot.

Sa bawat lugar na kanyang napuntahan, unti-unti niyang nabuo muli ang kanyang sarili na mas matatag, mas malinaw ang layunin. Ang ruok ng kanyang paglalakbay ay ang pagkumpleto ng 82 probinsya ng Pilipinas, kung saan ang Basilan ang naging huling piraso ng kanyang mision.

Sa loob lamang ng 220 araw, mula Enero 20 hanggang Agosto 27, 2025 ay naisulat niya ang isang bagong kabanata sa kasaysayan ng Filipino Travel Community.

Hindi lang ito rekord. Isa itong patunay ng lakas ng loob at dedikasyon. Sa kasalukuyan, nakarating na siya sa 83 bansa at 34 estado sa Estados Unidos bitbit ang kanyang pasaporteng Pilipino at ang kanyang walang sawang pagnanais na tuklasin ang mundo.

HIGIT PA SA PAGLALAKBAY Ang kwento ni Glen Gonzales ay hindi lang tungkol sa mga lugar na napuntahan. Ito ay kwento ng muling pagbangon, ng paghahanap ng sarili, at ng walang takot na pag-abot sa mga pangarap. Pinapaalala niya sa atin na ang tunay na halaga ng paglalakbay ay hindi nasusukat sa dami ng destinasyon kundi sa kung paano tayo binabago nito.

At sa bawat hakbang na kanyang tinahak, dala niya ang isang mahalagang paalala: Ang mundo ay malawak ngunit ang pangarap ng isang Pilipino ay mas malawak pa.

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 526-2026

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE DIGITAL KATIPUNAN NG KABATAAN PROFILING SYSTEM OF THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE TO PROMOTE DATA-DRIVEN YOUTH-CENTERED PROGRAMMING, PLANNING AND POLICY FORMULATION

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act. No 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides every local government unit shall exercise powers expressly granted those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10742, also known as Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, recognizes the existence of the Katipunan ng Kabataan, composed of all citizens of the Philippines residing in the barangay for at least six (6) months, who are at least fifteen (15) but not more than thirty (30) years of age, and who are duly registered in the list of the Commission of Elections (COMELEC) and/or the records of the Sangguniang Kabataan secretary;

WHEREAS, Department of the Interior and Local Government Memorandum Circular No. 2022-033 strengthens and reiterates the role of the Sangguniang Kabataan to conduct youth profiling, establish, maintain and update a database of youth in the barangay and ensure submission to the commission and proper turn-over to the next set of SK officials as stipulated in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 10742;

WHEREAS, the Katipunan ng Kabataan Profiling will enable the Sangguniang Kabataan to establish a Youth Information Database, the entries of which can be used by the Sangguniang Kabataan Council in crafting policies, programs and projects to advance the welfare of the Katipunan ng Kabataan;

WHEREAS, the institutionalization of the digital Katipunan ng Kabataan profiling system will improve the delivery of basic services for youth in the barangay, municipality and city, making it faster, more efficient, and more convenient on the part of the residents;

WHEREAS, the said digital profiling system will hasten and simplify the processing and release of barangay documents such as Barangay Clearance and Certifications and shall be used in the provision of services in relation to Youth Development within the province;

WHEREAS, the full participation of the youth in local governance can only be achieved if young people are properly informed and engaged through structure mechanisms such as profiling and orientation;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Sarno, duly seconded by Hon. Pagulayan and unanimously approved by the Members present, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite in a session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Digital Katipunan ng Kabataan Profiling System Ordinance of the Province of Cavite".

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy. It is the policy of the Provincial Government of Cavite to recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and ensure that all youth in the province are properly informed of their membership in the Katipunan ng Kabataan and be included in policy-making and program developments intended for registered youths.

SECTION 3. Objectives. This ordinance seeks to encourage and institutionalize the digital collection, updating and management of the Katipunan ng Kabataan profile system to enable the smooth delivery of programs and services intended for registered youths. It will also improve accessibility and efficiency in youth governance.

SECTION 4. Scope and Application. The Digital Katipunan ng Kabataan Profiling shall cover all youths residing and domiciled in every barangay of the province of Cavite for at least six (6) months, who are at least fifteen (15) but not more than thirty (30) years of age and who are duly registered in the list of the Commission on Election (COMELEC) and/or records of the Sangguniang Kabataan Secretary of their residency;

SECTION 5. Definition of Terms. As used in this ordinance:

1. **Katipunan ng Kabataan (KK)** – citizens who are 15-30 years old and have lived in the barangay for at least six (6) months
2. **Katipunan ng Kabataan Profiling** – a system prescribed by the Department of the Interior and Local Government that collects information about local youth to identify their needs and create programs and services for them
3. **Sangguniang Kabataan (SK)** - the governing body of the youth assembly of every barangay.
4. **Youth** - shall refer to those persons whose age ranges from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years old as defined in Republic Act No. 8044.

SECTION 6. Coverage. All qualified youths are required to enroll themselves in the Katipunan ng Kabataan Profiling Database System of the Sangguniang Kabataan in their respective barangay.

SECTION 7. Information needed for the Katipunan ng Kabataan Profiling. The said profiling shall contain the following information from the registrant youth;

1. Full Name
2. Date of Birth
3. Place of Birth
4. Sex/Gender
5. Nationality
6. Residential Address

7. Contact No.
8. Name of Parents
9. Educational Background
10. Membership in any Youth Organization
11. E-mail Address
12. Civil Status
13. Number of Family Members
14. Voter's Registration Status
15. If Person with Disability
16. If member of any Indigenous Community
17. Employment Status
18. If Out of School Youth (OSY)
19. If attended previous Katipunan ng Kabataan assembly

SECTION 8. Orientation. The Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) council in every barangay are required to conduct awareness orientation regarding the Katipunan ng Kabataan (KK) profiling at least twice a year, during the Linggo ng Kabataan celebration, Katipunan ng Kabataan (KK) assembly and Barangay assembly.

SECTION 9. Youth Information Database. A Youth Information Database shall be established in every barangay, which will serve as the repository of information for the Katipunan ng Kabataan Profiling System. To have a same information data to be used in the province, the Provincial Information and Communications Technology Office (PICTO) shall create and provide the necessary database system needed for the KK profiling which will be forwarded to the Local Youth Development Office (LYDO) of every city/municipality for distribution to their respective Sangguniang Kabataan Federation.

SECTION 10. Privacy Policy. Lawful Purpose and Confidentiality. All data gathered and collected under the digital Katipunan ng Kabataan (KK) profiling system (whether through automated or manual means) shall be processed in accordance with Republic Act No. 10173 (Data Privacy Act of 2012) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), including the principles of transparency, legitimate purpose, and proportionality.

Section 10.1 Nature of Processing and Scope. Processing shall include collection, recording, storage, retrieval, use, consolidation, blocking, erasure, or destruction of personal data, whether automated or manual, if contained or intended to be contained in a filing system.

Section 10.2. Declared Purposes (purpose limitation). The KK Profiling System shall be used only for the following declared, specified and legitimate purposes: (i) local youth development planning and program design; (ii) eligibility screening, targeting, prioritization, delivery, monitoring, and evaluation of youth-related benefits and services (including, but not limited to, scholarships, livelihood assistance, and disaster-related assistance); and (iii) official communications and reporting required by law or duly authorized government programs. Any processing beyond these purposes is prohibited unless authorized or allowed by law and subject to appropriate safeguards.

Section 10.3. Profiling/Automated Processing. If the Province/ City/ Municipality uses automated processing (including profiling) that becomes the sole basis for decisions that would significantly affect the data subject, the Personal Information Controller shall comply with the notification and consent requirements for automated decision-making under the IRR of the Data Privacy Act.

Section 10.4. Transparency/Privacy Notice. The collecting office shall ensure that data subjects are informed of the nature and extent of the processing of their personal data, including the declared purposes, and any data sharing to program-implementing agencies, consistent with the Data Privacy Act/Implementing Rules and Regulations (DPAIRR).

SECTION 11. Data Management. Access Limitation and Confidentiality. Access to the KK Profiling System and related records (digital and paper) shall be strictly role-based and limited to authorized personnel on a "need-to-know" basis for official purpose within the declared purposes. At a minimum, access may be granted only to: (i) SK Secretary and authorized SK personnel for data collection/verification; and (ii) the authorized personnel of the Local Youth Development Office (LYDO) for custody, program administration, and compliance. All authorized personnel shall be bound by continuing confidentiality obligations.

Section 11.1. Security Incidents and Breach Documentation. The Local Youth Development Office/Personal Information Controller (LYDO/PIC) shall document security incidents and personal data breaches and include them in the annual summary report required under the IRR, and shall take appropriate response measures consistent with Data Privacy Act and Implementing Rules and Regulations (DPAIRR) and National Privacy Commission (NPC) requirements.

Section 11.2. Retention and Disposal. Personal data shall be retained only for as long as necessary to achieve the

declared purposes, including any legally required audit periods, after which such data shall be securely disposed, anonymized, or otherwise rendered impossible to recover or reconstruct, using methods appropriate to the medium (paper or digital). The LYDO shall issue and implement a retention schedule for each major data category and program.

Section 11.3. Data sharing for Benefit Delivery. Disclosure to other government agencies for delivery of social protection or youth programs shall be limited to what is necessary for the declared purposes and subject to lawful basis and safeguards under the Data Privacy Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (DPAIRR).

SECTION 12. Separability Clause. If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. Repealing Clause. All ordinances contrary to this ordinance are hereby deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after its approval and compliance with the posting and publication requirements.




