Noong 1992, dumaan siya sa masakit na yugto ng buhay.

Isang mabigat na pagsubok na maaaring nagpabagsak sa iba, ngunit sa kaniya ay naging dahilan upang higit pang tumatag bilang ama at tao.

Sa kabila ng lahat, hindi niya kailanman tinalikuran ang kaniyang responsibilidad sa kaniyang mga anak.

ISANG AMANG HINDI SUMUKOKAILANMAN

Mayroon siyang apat na anak. Sa kabila ng kakulangan sa buhay, ginawa ni Kuya Ave ang lahat upang maitawid sa pag-aaral ang kaniyang mga anak.

Ang bunso ay nagtapos ng Information Technology, ang panganay ay naging Certified Public Accountant at ngayon ay nasa Canada na, ang pangalawa ay isang Licensed Electronics and Communications Engineer, at ang pangatlo naman ay nagtapos ng Computer Engineering.

Walang malaking puhunan o minanang kayamanan si Kuya Ave.

Ngunit mayroon siyang mga bagay na higit na mahalaga, sipag, tiyaga,

disiplina, at pagmamahal sa pamilya.

Noong 1993, sinimulan niya ang maliit na pagtitinda ng piyesa ng motorsiklo.

Mula rito ay isinilang ang Apple Dome Trading, isang negosyong ipinangalan niya bilang pagpupugay sa kaniyang mga magulang.

Sa loob ng maraming taon, naging bahagi siya ng simbahan hindi upang kilalanin kundi upang maglingkod.

Para kay Kuya Ave, ang pananampalataya ay hindi lamang nasa salita kundi nasa gawa, sa kabutihan sa kapwa, katapatan sa tungkulin, at pagiging mabuting halimbawa sa komunidad.

Noong Mayo 22, matagumpay na nagtapos si Cadet First Class Renzo Jamir Almodovar, 22-anyos at tubong General Trias, Cavite, bilang bahagi ng internasyonal na programa sa pagitan ng Philippine Military Academy at ng USMA.

Dating miyembro ng PMA "SIKLAB-LAYA" Class of 2025 si

Almodovar bago siya ipinadala sa Amerika sa ilalim ng Foreign Pre-Commission Training Institute program.

Sa loob ng apat na taon, sumailalim siya sa matinding akademikong pagsasanay, pisikal na disiplina, at pandaigdigang military leadership development sa West Point, isang institusyong kilala sa paghuhubog ng

mga lider na kalauna'y nagiging heneral, strategist, at pangunahing opisyal ng militar ng Estados Unidos at iba pang kaalyadong bansa.

Natapos ni Almodovar ang kursong Bachelor of Science in International Affairs na may espesyalisasyon sa Strategic Studies, isang larangang nakatuon sa geopolitics, pambansang



seguridad, military strategy, at internasyonal na ugnayan.

Hindi lamang ito simpleng akademikong tagumpay, ipinapakita rin nito ang kahandaan ng isang batang Pilipino na makipagsabayan sa pinakamahuhusay na military cadets mula sa iba't ibang panig ng mundo.

MGA PARANGAL NA NAGPATUNAY SA KANYANG HUSAY

Habang nasa Estados Unidos, nagkamit si Almodovar ng iba't ibang pagkilala na sumasalin sa kaniyang disiplina, tibay, at kakayahang mamuno.

Kabilang dito ang German Armed Forces Proficiency Badge Gold, isang prestihiyosong military distinction na iginagawad sa mga sundalong nagpapakita ng mataas na antas ng physical at military proficiency.

Natanggap din niya ang Norwegian Foot March Badge Silver, isang pagkilalang ibinibigay sa mga nakapapasa sa matinding endurance march ng Norwegian military standards.

Bukod sa pisikal na kakayahan, kinilala rin siya sa akademya matapos mapasama sa Dean's List ng USMA, patunay ng kaniyang natatanging academic performance sa gitna ng mahigpit na military training.

Nakamit din niya ang USMA Recondo Qualification, isang elite

recognition para sa mga kadeteng nagpapakita ng kahusayan sa tactical at military competencies.

Sa kabila ng mga internasyonal na parangal at oportunidad, nananatiling malinaw para kay Almodovar ang kaniyang layunin ang maglingkod sa bayan bilang bahagi ng Philippine Army.

Ayon sa mga ulat, nais niyang mapasama sa Infantry, Scout Ranger, at Special Forces, mga yunit na kilala sa pinakamahirap at pinakamapanganib na operasyon sa bansa.

Plano rin niyang paunlarin ang kaniyang kakayahan sa larangan ng Military Intelligence, isang kritikal na bahagi ng modernong depensa at pambansang seguridad.

Ang kaniyang direksiyon ay sumasalin sa bagong henerasyon ng mga opisyal-militar: mahusay hindi lamang sa combat training kundi maging sa strategic thinking, intelligence operations, at international security affairs.

Si Renzo ay anak ni Montano Almodovar, kasalukuyang Chief of Staff ng AFP Strategic Command at miyembro ng PMA "BANTAY-LAYA" Class

Ngunit higit sa pagiging anak ng isang mataas na opisyal, pinatunayan ni Renzo Jamir Almodovar na kaya niyang bumuo ng sariling pangalan sa pamamagitan ng sipag, disiplina, at husay sa pandaigdigang antas.

LUMALAWAK NA KAKAYAHAN NG PMA

- P200 million has been earmarked for the Cavite Center for Mental Health, ensuring that mental health services receive equal attention alongside physical healthcare.

This initiative marks Phase 1 of a long-term healthcare improvement program. The Provincial Government has assured Caviteños that Phase 2 and Phase 3 will follow, depending on the evolving needs of the hospital and its patients.

DOST-CALABARZON's Assistant Regional Director for Technical Operations, and Ms. Anna Marie S. Daigan, EnP, Supervising Science Research Specialist of PSTO Cavite. Joining them from the LGU were Ms. Maristel De Jesus of the Municipal Agriculture Office and Ms. Daphne Mae Patawe, head of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office. The installation was carried out with the assistance of representatives from MAEDEN Enterprises, DOST CALABARZON SARAI's partner for the AWS.

The newly installed AWS will enable the municipality to continuously monitor local

weather and environmental conditions in real time. The system records important data such as rainfall, temperature, humidity, wind movement, solar radiation, and atmospheric pressure. These datasets will support Project SARAI's initiatives by providing information needed for localized weather advisories, crop assessment, and seasonal farm planning based on local conditions.

A capacity-building activity was likewise conducted for participating LGU personnel to introduce the basic operation, functions, and intended applications of the AWS, including data access, monitoring, and initial data

processing procedures. Discussions also highlighted the importance of utilizing AWS-generated meteorological data in supporting evidence-based agricultural planning, climate resiliency, and disaster preparedness initiatives.

This deployment forms part of the continuing nationwide implementation of smart agriculture technologies by the UPLB SARAI Central Hub through its regional partners. Supporting the installation in Magallanes were Mr. Renel Angelo Taladad and Ms. Judy Ann Legaspi.

By providing access to localized and validated climate data, the project strengthens the municipality's capacity for disaster preparedness and

climate adaptation planning. The AWS is expected to support local farmers and the municipal office in developing more informed and responsive decisions toward climate-resilient agricultural strategies for the community.

The SARAI Centralized National Hub for Regional Operations (SARAI CeNTRO) is one of DOST's innovative agricultural initiatives, funded by the agency and monitored by DOST-PCAARRD. SARAI CeNTRO is currently being deployed nationwide through the University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB) in partnership with the DOST Regional Offices.
